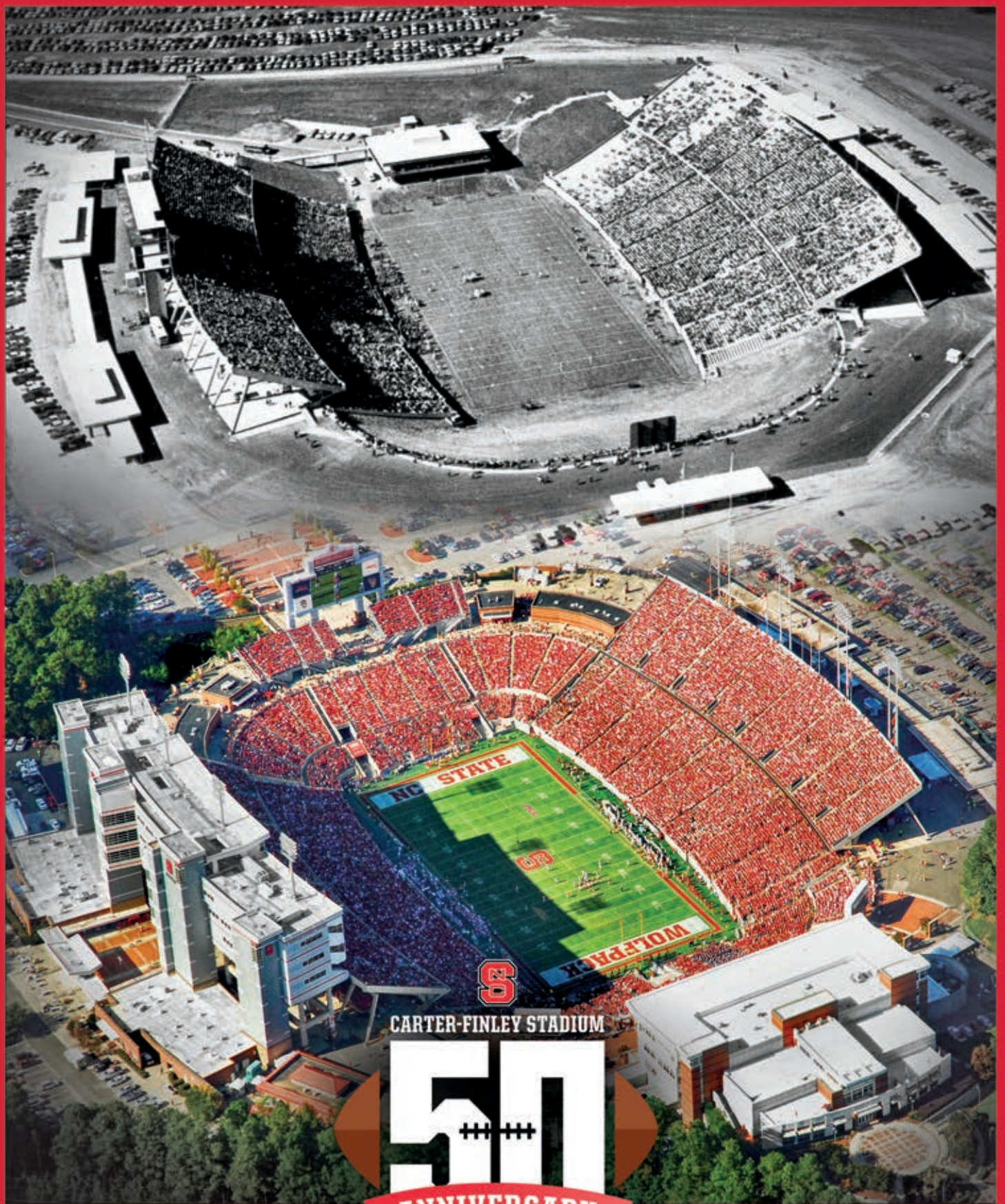

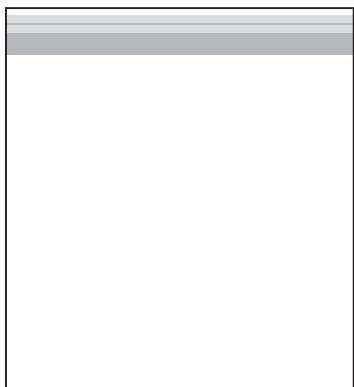

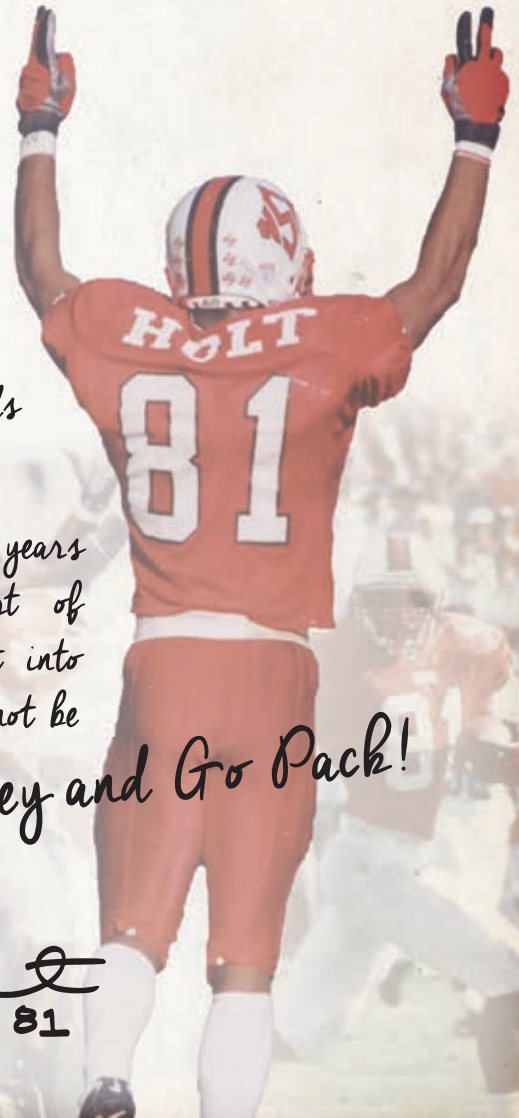

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NEW FOR 2016

CLEAR BAG POLICY

For the 2016 season, NC State will be instituting a clear bag policy at Carter-Finley Stadium. Please see the "Bags" section on page 3 for more information.

WOLFPACK EXPRESS TRAM

Look for Wolfpack Express Tram stops throughout select lots for assistance to and from the stadium. All trams will drop off at Gate 11 before the game, and pick up at Gate 11 for post-game assistance back to the designated stops. Trams will begin running 90 minutes prior to kick off.

ADA TICKET FRAUD

In order to provide accessible seats to individuals who need them and to protect the rights of our guests with disabilities, NC State Athletics requests that accessible seats not be resold or transferred to guests who do not have a need for accessible seating. If you possess accessible seats and are not able to attend a game, please contact the NC State Athletics Ticket Office to exchange your tickets for a non-accessible seat location prior to re-selling or transferring.

Ticket fraud includes, but is not limited to, the misrepresentation of a disability. NC State reserves the right to take appropriate action regarding misrepresentation, which may result in relocation, revocation of tickets, or ejection.

ALCOHOL POLICY

- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited inside Carter-Finley Stadium. Any attempt to bring alcohol into the stadium is a violation of facility policy and may result in denial of admittance, ejection, arrest, and/or ticket revocation.
- Persons of legal age may consume malt beverages and unfortified wine in Carter-Finley Stadium parking areas in connection with football tailgating. All visitors should carry a picture ID in accordance with university regulations at all times.
- Alcoholic beverage kegs, spirituous and mixed liquor are prohibited in all permitted parking areas, including vendor or university sanctioned events.

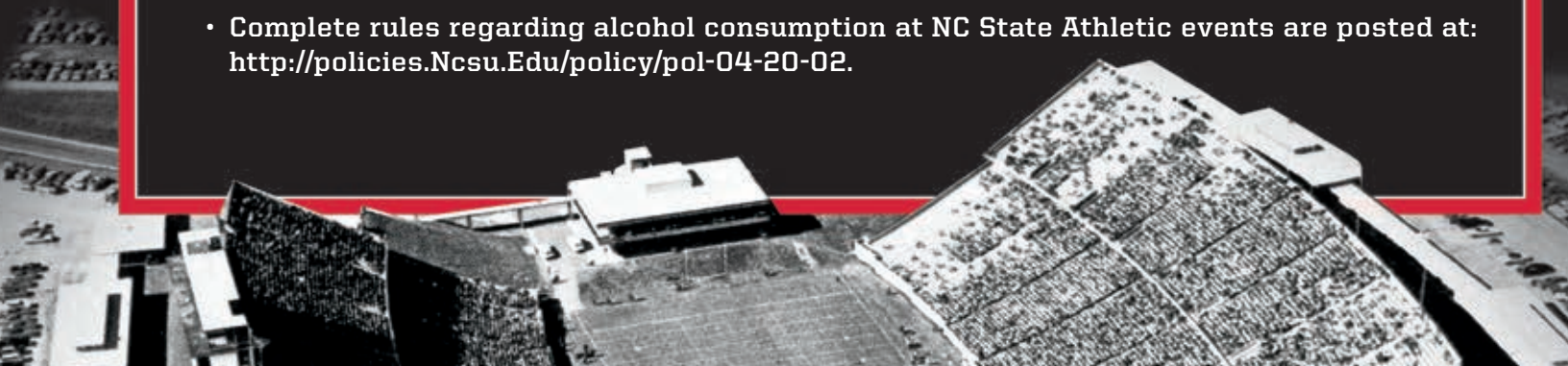
ACC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME INFORMATION

ADA SEATING

For game day assistance or exchanges, please visit the Ammons Family Ticket Center or the customer service stations at gates 4, 9 and 12. (exchanges subject to availability and are not guaranteed).

Service animals are permitted inside Carter-Finley Stadium for our guests with disabilities. Please have all necessary documentation at all times.

BAGS

To provide a safer environment for all guests, NC State has adopted a new bag policy for 2016.

The following items will be permitted into Carter-Finley Stadium, but will be inspected at bag check locations prior to entry:

- Any clear plastic, vinyl or PVC bag no larger than 12"x 6"x 12"
- Any clear plastic bag, 1 gallon or smaller
- Small purses or clutch bags no larger than 6.5"x 4.5"
(Approximately the size of your hand)
- An exception will be made for medically necessary items and diaper bags accompanied by children after proper inspection at a gate designated for the purpose.

NC State continues to encourage fans to not bring any bags into the stadium for safety, efficiency, and convenience at stadium entry. Food Lion Fast Lanes have been further expanded to expedite entry for guests without bags.

BIRTHDAY WISHES

Wolfpack fans have the opportunity to wish friends and family a happy birthday free of charge at home football games by having their name appear on the videoboard. All requests must be submitted online at GoPack.com/Birthdays at least 72 hours prior to the event. Any questions can be directed to the NC State Athletics Marketing Office at (919) 515-2102.

BOWL GAME INFORMATION

Bowl game ticket applications will be available online to all Wolfpack Club members and season ticket holders once NC State becomes bowl eligible.

The postseason priority deadline for Wolfpack Club donations is 5 pm on Friday, November 11, 2016.

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

If a situation arises which requires evacuation of Carter-Finley Stadium, we request your cooperation and assistance in exiting the facility in an orderly manner. For your safety, law enforcement and game day security staff are positioned in and around the stadium. A police command center is located inside the stadium between gates 4 and 5. During and after the game, campus police can be contacted at (919) 515-3000 or 911. Listen to the public address system for information about weather, emergency evacuations and other emergency information.

Once an evacuation announcement has been given, please proceed to the nearest stairway or exit. Outside the stadium, follow the directions of the event staff and do not attempt to re-enter the stadium. Listen to Mix 101.5 WRAL-FM or follow @PackGuestSrvcs on Twitter for more information.

In the case of an adverse weather situation, please seek immediate shelter.

FAMILY RESTROOMS

Family and single occupant restrooms are located on the north endzone concourse by sections 218 and 225. For nursing mothers, please visit the customer service booth located at gate 4 under Vaughn Towers for assistance.

FIELD ACCESS

Only authorized personnel with proper credentials will be permitted on the field before, during, or after a game. Any unauthorized person attempting to access or found on the field will be removed and subject to ejection and/or arrest.

GATE INFORMATION

Stadium gates open 1.5 hours prior to kick-off for access to general seating areas.

- Vaughn Tower patrons may enter 2 hours prior to the game through gates 4, 8, and 14 only.
- Accessible entrances: all gates are accessible
- Assisted listening devices: available at the Wolf Assistance areas near gates 4 and 9
- Chancellor's guests: gate 4
- High school coaches: gate 10
- Media will call: gate 5 (opens 3 hours prior to kick-off)
- NC State player guest: gate 10
- NC State recruits: gate 10
- Students: gate 6
- Visiting team will call: gate 10

GUEST SERVICES

Guest services stations are located on the west concourse near gate 4, the east concourse near gates 8 and 9, and on the north concourse near gates 12-14.

CONVENIENCE STATIONS:

- Faculty/Staff/Varsity Club parking lot
- Corner of Gate B

WOLF ASSIST TENTS:

Tents are located throughout the parking areas to provide information, answer questions, and offer assistance. Additional assistance will be provided by Tuffy's Paw Patrol throughout the stadium and parking lots.

LOST CHILDREN AND GUESTS

Lost children and guests should be taken to the police command center located inside the stadium between gates 4 and 5. Anyone looking for lost children or guests should contact the nearest usher, security personnel, or the police command center. Campus police can be contacted at (919) 515-3000 or 911. MILITARY TICKET DONATIONS

This year NC State Athletics is offering all fans an opportunity to donate their tickets to military personnel in the area. If you will not be attending a game, you may login to your online ticket account at GoPack.com/BuyTickets and under My Account you may easily donate your tickets to Vet Tix. You will receive a tax receipt from Vet Tix and help make sure Carter-Finley Stadium is packed all year long! For more information on Vet Tix, visit VetTix.org.

PARKING

All parking gates open five (5) hours before kick-off. Vehicles are not permitted to line up on public roads prior to the gates opening. Unattended vehicles in the roadway or public right-of-way are subject to be towed at the owner's expense.

All parking on the grounds of Carter-Finley Stadium is reserved and requires a valid permit for entry. General public parking is located at the College of Veterinary Medicine (CVM) Parking Deck and Cardinal Gibbons Lot for \$15.

If someone is in your space, please do not park in another space. Notify a parking attendant or call McLaurin Parking at (919) 749-1405.

****Thursday, September 1st - Westchase I, II and Handicap, Vet School Deck (CVM), and Cardinal Gibbons Lots will open at 5:00pm****

BUS PARKING:

Bus parking passes may only be purchased in advance for \$50 by contacting the NC State Athletics Ticket Office at (919) 865-1510 or TicketOffice@ncsu.edu. Bus parking passes will be directed to enter gate E and will be parked around PNC Arena. Due to limited availability, we will not be able to accommodate any buses without a bus parking pass.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING:

Accessible season parking is available for purchase on a priority basis through the Wolfpack Club. Vehicles are required to display a valid ADA Placard at all times on game day along with the season parking pass. Fans with special needs can also pay \$15 on game day to park at Westchase Handicap Lot and ride a shuttle to and from Gate 11. The shuttle begins running when parking lots open and only travels to and from the Gate 11. Riders of the shuttle will receive a boarding pass that should be shown to board the return shuttle after the game. An ADA Placard should be displayed at all times in the vehicle when parking in the Westchase Handicap Lot on game day.

RV PARKING:

For non-reserved RV parking information, please contact the NC State Fairgrounds at (919) 612-6767. The lot opens five (5) hours before kick-off.

PROHIBITED ITEMS AND BEHAVIOR

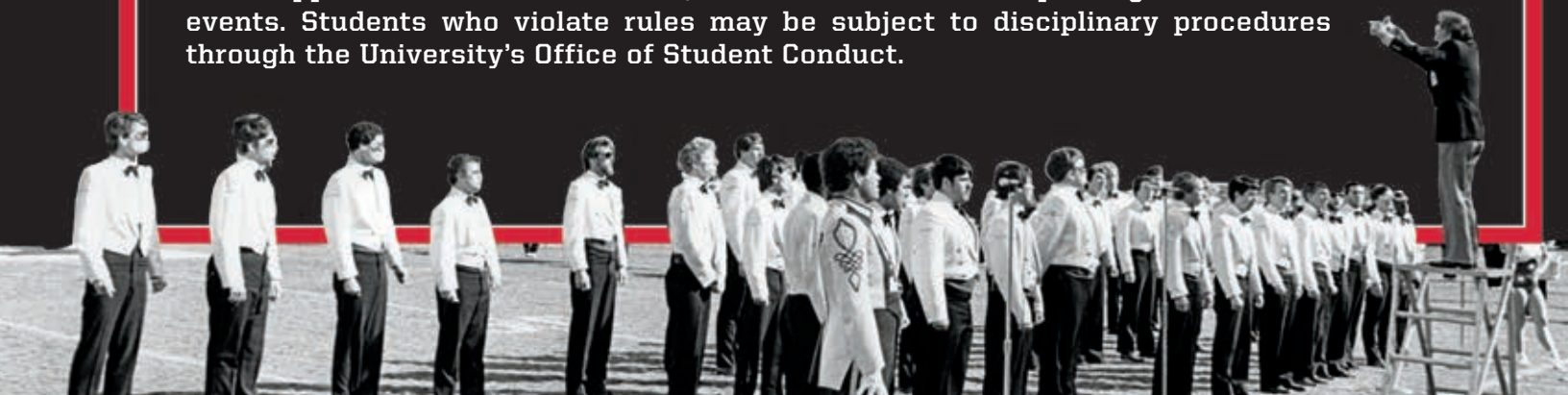
The ACC promotes good sportsmanship by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racial, or sexist comments or other intimidating actions directed at officials, student-athletes, coaches, patrons or team representatives will not be tolerated and are grounds for removal from Carter-Finley Stadium. Threatening or inconsiderate behavior such as profane and abusive language, fighting, or drunkenness shall not be tolerated within any tailgate area or within Carter-Finley Stadium.

The following items and activities are prohibited at Carter-Finley Stadium out of concern for the safety of our guests, employees, and participants:

- Animals*
- Artificial noise makers
- Bags - See page 3 for the new clear bag policy.
- Bicycles/Footwear with wheels/Hoverboards/Skateboards.
- Coolers/Ice Bags
- Drones/unmanned aerial vehicles
(including in surrounding parking lots controlled by NC State Athletics).
- Food or drink of any kind including containers such as bottles, cans, etc.*
- Laser pointers
- Poles/sticks for flags or signs
- Selfie sticks
- Signs/banners/flags larger than 3' x 2'
- Sitting/standing in the aisles
- Smoking (except in designated areas)
- Stroller (large, non-collapsible; collapsible strollers are permitted)
- Throwing objects in stands or onto field
- Umbrellas (no storage of item available at gates)
- Video cameras and Go Pros (hand-held still-cameras are permitted)
- Weapons

*Exceptions will be made for those with medical requirements or special needs; fans should carry any necessary documentation, credentials or identification. Diaper bags are permitted only if accompanied by an infant.

All persons and belongings are subject to search. Guests need to return unauthorized items to their vehicles. NC State University cannot safeguard items not permitted into the stadium. Prohibited items in the stadium will be confiscated and not returned. Patrons in violation of stadium policies are subject to removal from the stadium, arrest and prosecution under applicable laws and statutes, and could forfeit ticket privileges to future events. Students who violate rules may be subject to disciplinary procedures through the University's Office of Student Conduct.

RE-ENTRY/PASS OUTS

- Pass outs are available at all gates beginning with five (5) minutes remaining on the game clock in the second quarter.
- Fans re-entering the stadium must be in possession of their ticket and the pass out stub they received at the gate prior to exiting.
- Upon re-entry, all persons and belongings are subject to search by an event staff member.
- The issuing of pass outs ends at the start of the third quarter.

SIGNS/BANNERS/FLAGS

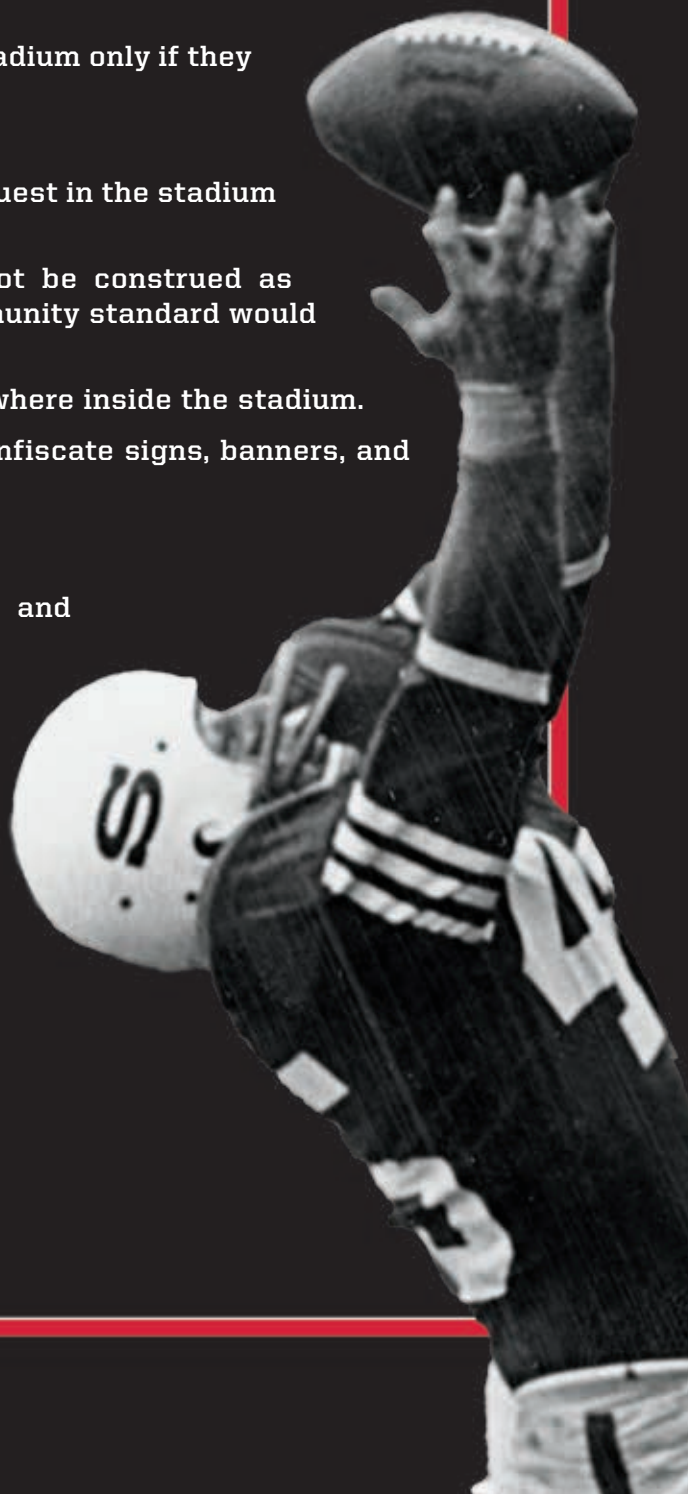
Signs/banners/flags are permitted within Carter-Finley Stadium only if they meet the following guidelines:

- The sign/banner/flag is not larger than 3' x 2'.
- The sign/banner/flag does not impair the view of any guest in the stadium or block any existing signage or vent.
- Information contained on the sign/banner/flag cannot be construed as vulgar, offensive, graphic, or outside of what the community standard would consider in "good taste."
- Signs/banners/flags are not permitted to be hung anywhere inside the stadium.
- Game management personnel reserves the right to confiscate signs, banners, and flags that violate stadium policies.

SMOKING

In accordance with North Carolina State Law and NC State University policies, Carter-Finley Stadium has been designated a non-smoking venue.

Smoking in any form through the use of tobacco products or "vaping" with e-cigarettes, is prohibited inside Carter-Finley Stadium except at the designated smoking areas at gates 1 and 11. Violators of this policy will be ejected from the stadium.

SPONSORSHIPS AND ADVERTISING

STROLLERS

Fans are permitted to bring folding/collapsible strollers into Carter-Finley Stadium. Large, non-collapsible strollers are prohibited. Strollers must be taken to a stroller drop-off location on the north concourse (gates 12-14), west customer service station (gate 4), or east concourse (gate 7). NC State assumes no responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged strollers or items left in strollers. All strollers will be searched so please allow ample time to enter the stadium.

TAILGATING POLICIES

The Athletics Department would like to remind our fans and guests of the following:

- Donors should obtain written permission from NC State Athletics Facilities, (919) 515-7369, before making any physical changes to their assigned parking space. Permanent structures are not allowed in the parking areas and will be removed.
- Beer and unfortified wine are the only alcoholic beverages that may be consumed in all NC State controlled parking lots.
- Tents must be confined to your parking space and not interfere with adjacent parking spaces, impede travel lanes or create safety hazards.
- Tents must be flame-retardant. Do not set up tents near hot coals or open flame.
- Barbeque grills are permitted. Open-flame fires are prohibited.
- Charcoal grills should be extinguished and coals disposed of properly.
- Clean up your area before entering the stadium so it's safe for you and others.
- Please recycle your cans and bottles. Look for the WE Recycle bins throughout the parking lots.
- Tailgating activities must not interfere with or obstruct adjacent parking spaces or traffic lanes.
- Please be considerate of your neighbor regarding loud music (no amplified sound).
- Secure your tailgate area before and during the game to protect your belongings. NC State assumes no responsibility for any lost or stolen items.
- Please use caution when throwing balls in the parking lots for the safety of all guests and vehicles.
- Vehicles parked on curbs or other undesignated areas will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Unauthorized vehicles are not allowed in the parking lots. This includes, but is not limited to: golf carts, hoverboards, motorized scooters, beer trolleys, unauthorized sponsor/promotional vehicles, etc.
- The distribution of promotional items on university property is prohibited unless prior approval has been received.
- All football patrons are subject to university policies and procedures.
- The use of drones or unmanned aerial vehicles is strictly prohibited on university property.

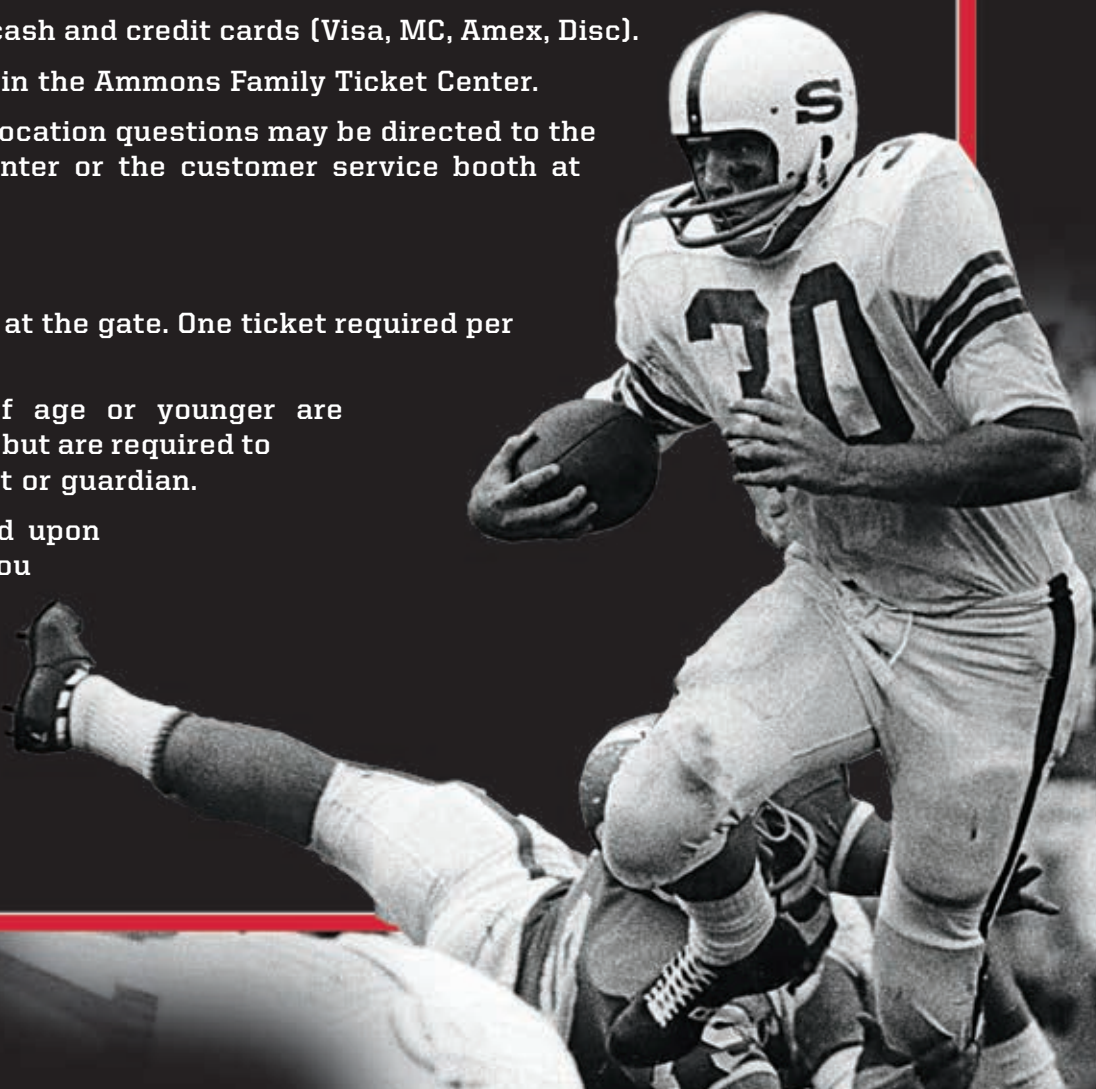

TICKET OFFICE INFORMATION: GAME DAY

- The Ammons Family Ticket Center is located on the west side of the stadium between gates 4 and 5.
- The Ammons Family Ticket Center opens two (2) hours prior to kick-off and closes at the start of the 4th quarter.
- The Ticket Office accepts cash and credit cards (Visa, MC, Amex, Disc).
- General will call is located in the Ammons Family Ticket Center.
- Any ticket resolution or relocation questions may be directed to the Ammons Family Ticket Center or the customer service booth at gate 4.

TICKET POLICIES:

- Tickets must be presented at the gate. One ticket required per person.
- Children two (2) years of age or younger are permitted without a ticket, but are required to sit in the lap of their parent or guardian.
- All tickets will be scanned upon entry into the stadium. If you have any issues with your ticket scanning please visit the Ammons Family Ticket Center located between gates 4 and 5.

TICKET REPRINTING:

The NC State Athletics Ticket Office can reprint tickets that have been lost, stolen or damaged for the ticket account holder only. All reprinted tickets will be held at will call for pickup on game day. Photo ID will be required to pick up reprinted tickets.

TICKET RESALE POLICY

Tickets may not be resold within 100 yards of Carter-Finley Stadium. Ticket resale can occur along the roads that form a perimeter around the stadium: Trinity Road, Gate B Road/Peter Karmanos Jr. Drive and Steve Stroud Way.

TRAFFIC INFORMATION

All permit lots require a displayed parking permit for entry. Please have your pass ready before entering the lot.

ARRIVAL TO THE GAME:

Parking Lots open five (5) hours prior to kick-off and no early entry is permitted.

BLACK LOTS

Enter through Gate A off of Trinity Road for the Stadium Southeast Lot.

WHITE LOTS

Enter through Gate B off of Trinity Road for the Murphy Center, Motor Home, and Stadium East Lots. Fairgrounds Reserved parking enters off of Youth Center Drive.

TICKET TRANSFERS

Season ticket holders may electronically transfer their tickets to other Wolfpack fans by logging into their online ticket account at GoPack.com/BuyTickets.

TOWED CARS

Illegally parked cars will be towed to Reedy Creek, located off of Edwards Mill Road. Vehicle pick up cost is \$100.00 at the owner's expense. If you need assistance, contact the nearest parking attendant or call McLaurin parking at (919) 749-1405.

RED LOTS

Enter through Gate C off of Trinity Road for the Stadium West Lot. Enter the Frank Weedon Lot off of Trinity Road across from the Gate C entrance.

YELLOW LOTS

Enter through Gate E off of Edwards Mill Road for Stadium North, Arena South, Arena West 6000, Arena West 5000, Arena North 4000, Arena North 3000, and Gate E Lots.

PURPLE LOTS

Enter through Gate F off of Blue Ridge Road for the Stadium North, IPF, and Westchase Lots 1-3.

ARRIVAL TO THE GAME CONTINUED...

ORANGE LOTS

Enter off of Trinity Road for the Faculty/Staff/Varsity Club, Trinity, TX, and Fairgrounds Lots.

GREY LOTS

Enter through Gate H off of Wade Avenue for Arena East 2000, Arena East 1000, Arena South, and Practice Field Lots.

DEPARTURE FROM THE GAME:

Please note the departure path for each gate is determined in cooperation with local law enforcement agencies to maximize safety and efficiency.

BLACK LOTS

Stadium Southeast Lot will exit through Gate A then turn left onto Trinity Road. Traffic will then turn right onto Blue Ridge Road and keep straight to Western Boulevard or turn left onto Hillsborough Street.

WHITE LOTS

Stadium East, Motor Home and Murphy Center Lots will exit through Gate B and continue straight on Youth Center Drive until it intersects with Hillsborough Street. The Fairgrounds Reserved Lot will exit onto Youth Center Drive and go left away from Trinity Road. Traffic will then turn right on Hillsborough Street.

RED LOTS

Stadium West Lot will exit through Gate C and turn right on Trinity Road. The Frank Weedon lot will exit onto Trinity Road and go left towards Edwards Mill road. Traffic will continue straight on Trinity Road or turn left onto Edwards Mill Road.

GREEN LOTS

Enter off of Blue Ridge Road for the College of Veterinary Medicine (CVM) Lot.

YELLOW LOTS

Stadium North, Arena South, Arena West 6000, Arena West 5000, Arena North 4000, Arena North 3000 and Gate E lots will exit through Gate E and turn right onto Edwards Mill Road.

PURPLE LOTS

Stadium North, IPF, and Westchase Lots 1-3 will exit through Gate F and turn left onto Blue Ridge Road.

ORANGE LOTS

Faculty/Staff/Varsity Club, Trinity, and TX lots will exit onto Trinity Road and go left towards Blue Ridge Road. The Fairgrounds Lot will exit onto Trinity Road and go right towards Blue Ridge Road. Traffic will then turn right onto Blue Ridge Road and keep straight to Western Boulevard or turn left onto Hillsborough Street.

GREY LOTS

Arena East 2000, Arena East 1000, Arena South and Practice Field Lots will exit through Gate H onto Wade Avenue heading east.

GREEN LOTS

College of Veterinary Medicine Lot (CVM) will exit onto Hillsborough Street.

Parents/guardians may stop by the police operations vehicle, between gates 4 and 5, the police command truck in the parking lots and fill out a Wolf Pup Locator wristband with important information to be placed on the child's wrist. 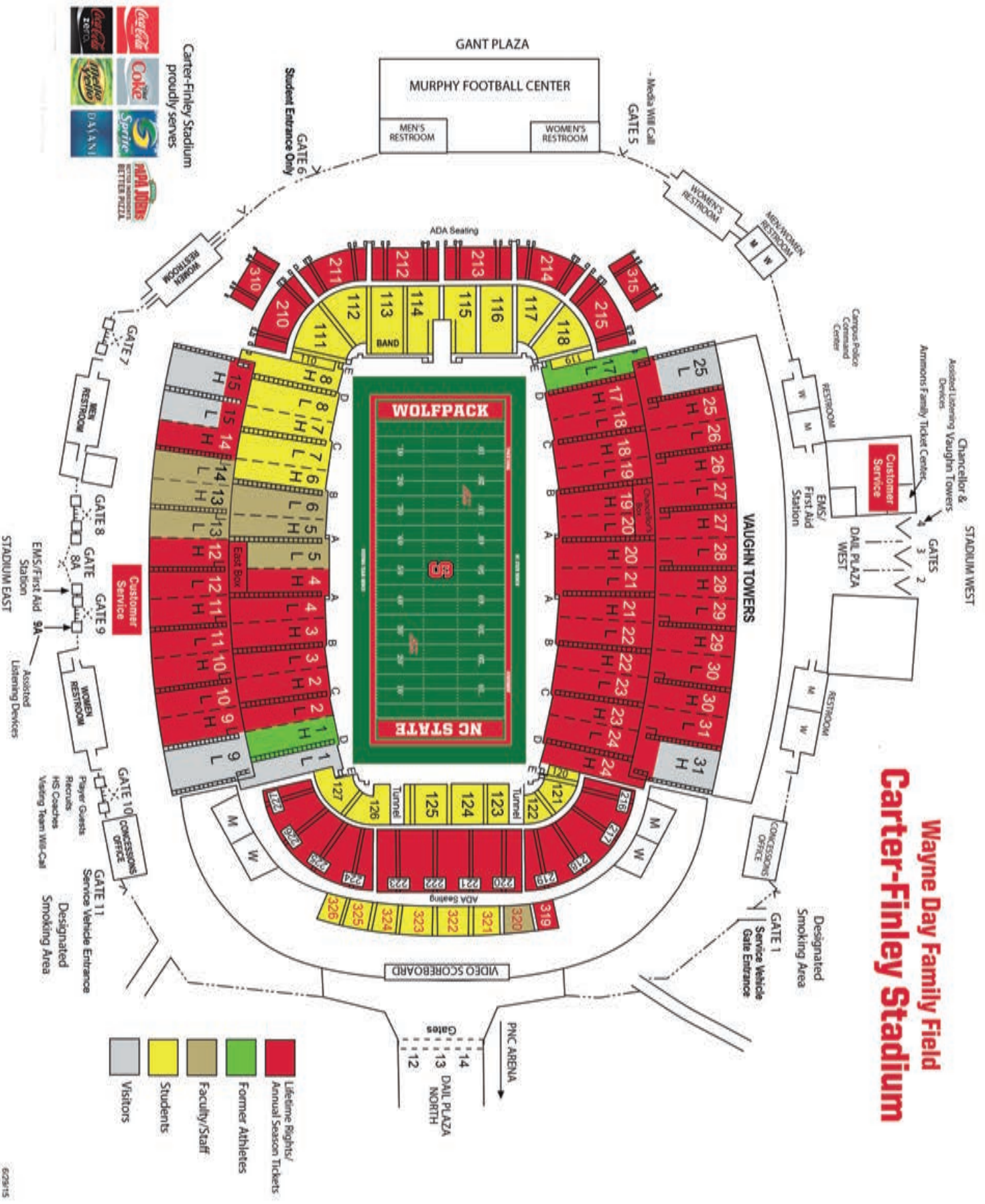

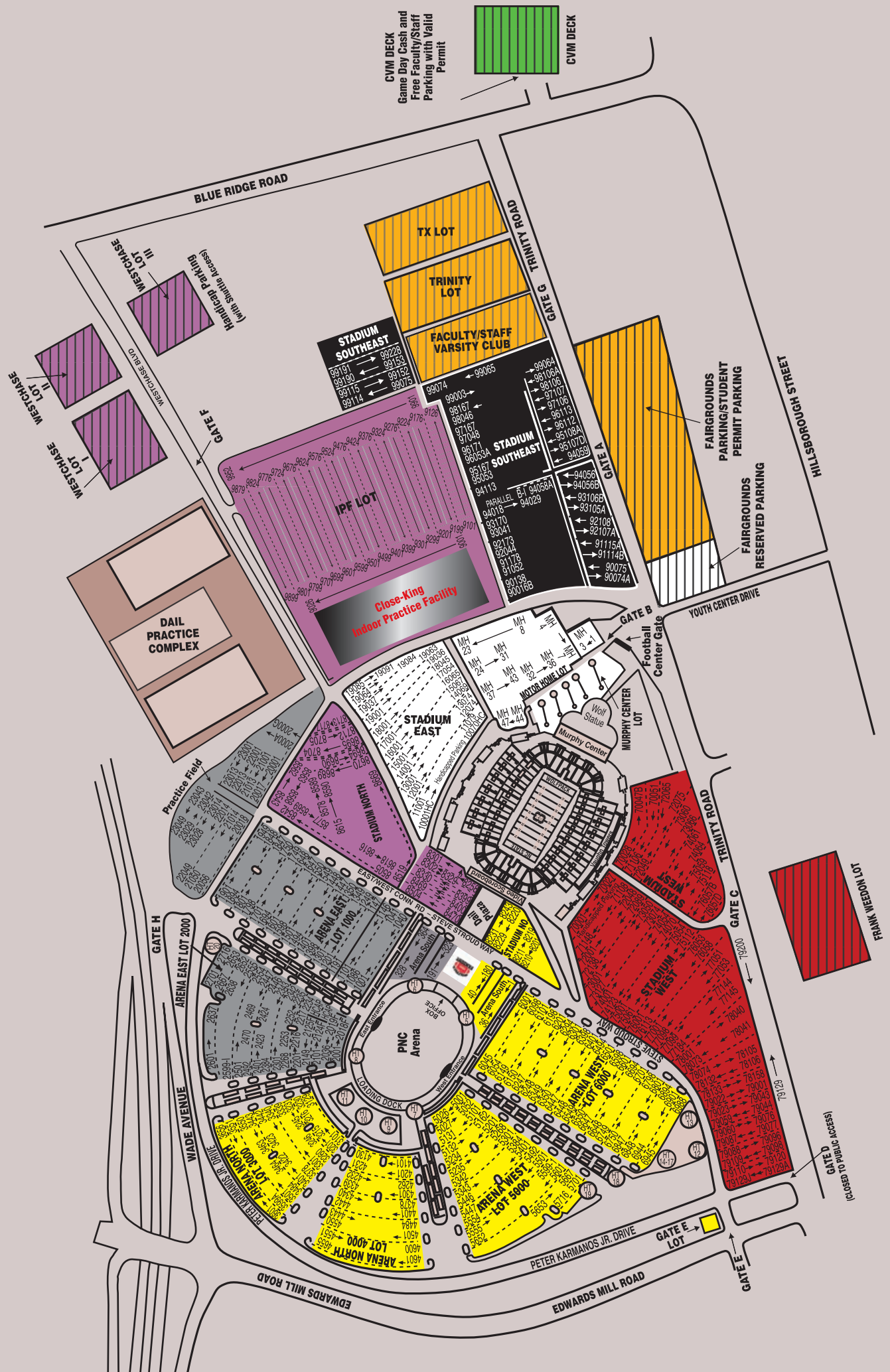

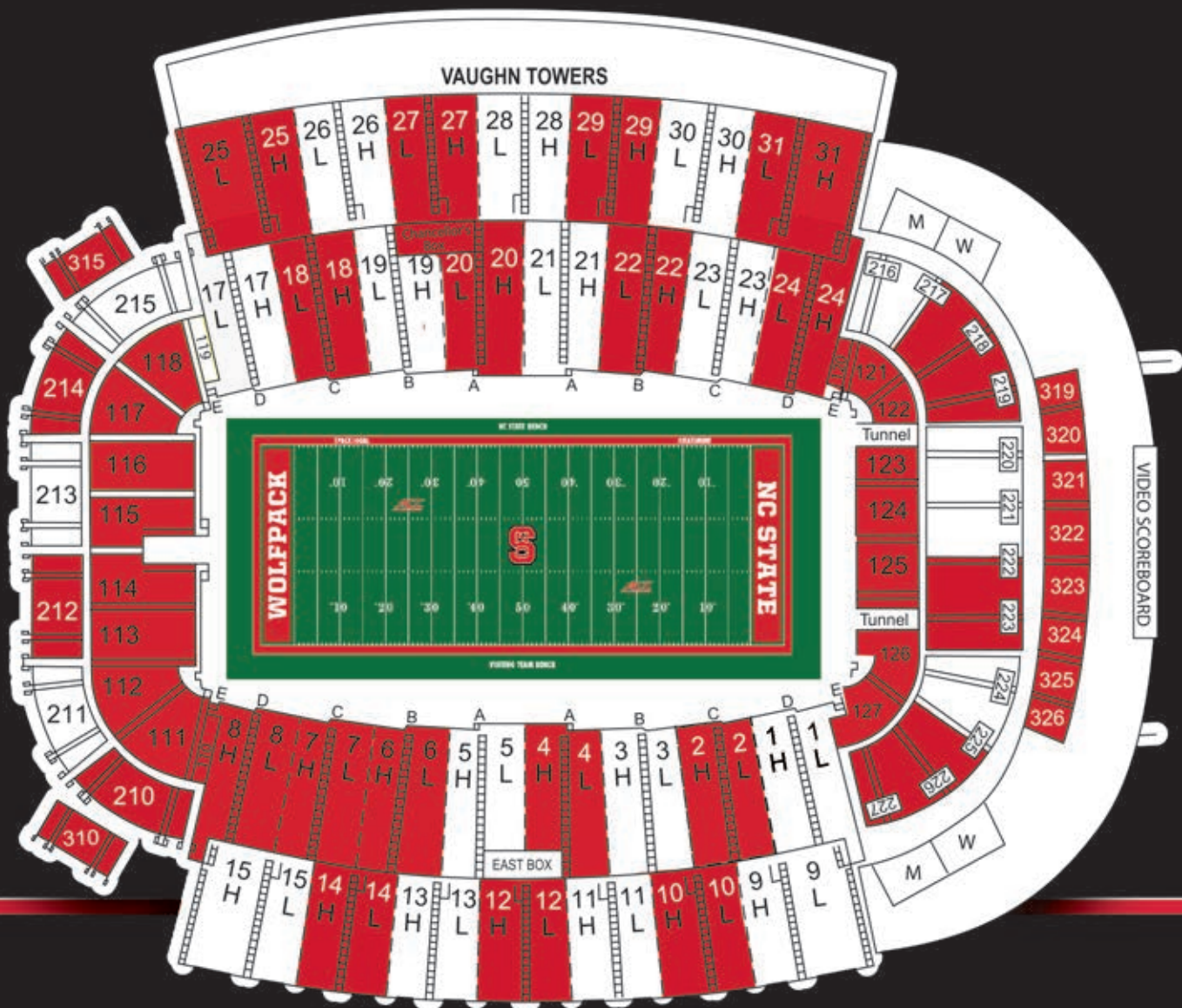
