PACK TRACKS

■ NC State opens its 111th season of basketball Wednesday when it hosts Charleston Southern.

■ The Pack returns three starters (**Manny Bates**, **Devon Daniels** and **D.J. Funderburk**) from last season's 20-12 team.

■ NC State has an interesting mix of veterans and youth on its team this season. The Pack returns 100 combined starts from last season's team. Of its 12 scholarship players, six have been in a college program for three years or more. The other six scholarship players are either true freshmen (5) or a redshirt freshman (1).

■ Seven players (six freshmen and transfer **Thomas Allen**) have an opportunity to make their NC State debut on Wednesday. That is 58.3% of the scholarship roster that hasn't appeared in an NC State uniform. This is not the most of the Kevin Keatts era though. In the 2018-19 season opener, the Pack had eight players make their program-debut in a 105-55 victory over Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 6, 2018.

■ Kevin Keatts is entering his fourth season as head coach of the Wolfpack. He has led NC State to 20-win seasons in all three years as head coach and the Pack and has gone .500 or better in ACC play in all three seasons. The Pack is 31-6 (.837) against non-conference opponents in regular season play under Keatts, including a 27-1 (.964) record at home. NC State enters Wednesday's contest having won its last 20 regular season home games against non-conference opponents.

Head Coach Kevin Keatts

■ Hired by NC State on March 17, 2017 as the 20th head coach in program history

■ Has a record of 65-36 (.644) in three seasons as head coach of NC State

■ His NC State teams have averaged over 80 points per game in both seasons he has been with the Pack. Prior to Keatts first team at NC State, the Pack hadn't had a team average over 80 points since the 1995-96 season

■ Led NC State back to the NCAA Tournament in his first season with the program and took the team to the NIT quarterfinals in his second season

■ Compiled a record of 72-28 (.720) in three seasons as head coach at UNC-Wilmington, including a 41-13 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play

■ Led Seahawks to three-straight regular season conference titles and was named the CAA Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2016

■ Coached UNCW to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2016 and 2017

■ Served as an assistant coach at Louisville for three seasons, helping lead the Cardinals to a 96-21 (.821) record from 2011-14

■ Prior to Louisville, Keatts served as the head coach at Hargrave Military Academy for 10 seasons

■ With two separate stints at Hargrave (1999-2001, 2003-2011), he compiled a 263-17 (.939) record with two national prep championships (2004, 2008), three runner-up finishes (2005, 2006, 2009) and two other appearances among the final four prep teams (2007, 2010)

■ Coached 14 players that have gone on to the NBA

■ Three Sweet 16 appearances, two Final Four berths and one National Championship as a coach.

■ Keatts and his wife Georgette have two sons, K.J. and Kaden

NOTING NC STATE

- Wednesday marks the fourth season with the Pack for Head Coach Kevin Keatts. He welcomes back three starters from last season's 20-12 team. In three seasons, Keatts has guided NC State to a 65-36 (.644) record, including 30-26 in ACC play.
- NC State will have 12 scholarship players available to play on Wednesday. Last season, it wasn't until the seventh game of the season that the Pack had more than eight scholarship players available to play. For most of the 2019-20 season, NC State only had nine scholarship players in uniform.
- This season is the first time with NC State that Kevin Keatts has not added any grad transfers to the program. In his first three seasons with the Pack, Keatts added two grad transfers to the program each offseason.
- The Pack added zero transfers of any kind to the program this offseason, the first time it hasn't added a veteran newcomer to the team under Keatts. In Keatts' first three seasons, the Pack added four veteran transfers (graduate, JUCO or four-year) each offseason.
- NC State signed five freshmen in the Class of 2020 to join the Pack. In his first three seasons combined at NC State, head coach Kevin Keatts added six freshmen total to the team.

WEDNESDAY STORYLINES

- Wednesday's game marks the first time since Nov. 14, 1998 that NC State has opened the season at Reynolds Coliseum. The Pack opened that season with an 81-60 victory over Maryland-Eastern Shore on Nov. 14, 1998. The 1998-99 season was the last season before the program moved home games to PNC Arena.
- Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, the regular season start date was pushed back three weeks. The Nov. 25 start date is the latest NC State has started its basketball season since 1995 when NC State defeated VMI, 104-78, on Nov. 25, 1995.
- The Pack is 20-2 since the 1999-2000 season when playing at Reynolds Coliseum. (1999-2000 season was the first for the program at PNC Arena).
- NC State has won 25 of its last 26 home-openers when played against a non-conference opponent.
- For the fourth consecutive season, head coach Kevin Keatts will have to replace his leading scorer from the previous season. This is the first time at NC State that he doesn't return the leading scorer, rebounder or assist man from last season. Last year, senior C.J. Bryce led the team in scoring and rebounding (13.3 and 6.3) and senior Markell Johnson led the team (and ACC) in assists (6.8).

YOUTH MOVEMENT

- NC State signed five freshmen to join the 2020-21 squad. In Keatts' first three seasons combined at NC State, he signed six freshmen total to join the team.

NC STATE - CHARLESTON SOUTHERN SERIES

- NC State leads the all-time series with Charleston Southern, 8-0.
- The Pack last played the Buccaneers in Keatts' first season as head coach of NC State. It was the Pack's second game of the season and NC State defeated CSU, 78-56. Phlandrous Fleming Jr., led Charleston Southern with 17 points that night in the loss to NC State. Fleming Jr., - now a senior - is the Preseason Big South Player of the Year.
- The 135-80 win for NC State over Charleston Southern on Nov. 28, 1990 remains one for the NC State record book. The Pack scored 70 points in the first half which is still the most in program history in the first half of a game. The 135 total points are the fourth-most in a single game in program history and remains the most points scored by an NC State team since 1975.

NOTING CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

- Charleston Southern went 14-18 last season, including a 7-11 mark in the Big South.
- The Buccaneers are picked third in the preseason Big South poll this season. The third-place prediction for CSU is the highest since the 2013-14 season.
- Senior guard Phlandrous Fleming Jr. is the Preseason Player of the Year in the Big South. He averaged 17.4 points per game last season and led the conference in rebounding (8.7). He was named the 2019-20 Defensive POTY in the Big South for his efforts on the defensive side of the ball.
- Overall, Charleston Southern returns three starters that all averaged in double figures last season and four of its top-five scorers overall.

REPLACE THE LEADING SCORER? NOTHING NEW FOR KEATTS

■ NC State lost its leading scorer from the previous season as C.J. Bryce and his team-best 13.3 points per game average graduated. The loss of the previous season's leading scorer is nothing new for Keatts though, since he became head coach of the Pack in the spring of 2017 he has to replace the team's leading scorer each season.

■ As a program, NC State has not had a player repeat as scoring leader since C.J. Leslie led the team in scoring in the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK IN 2019-20

■ Last season, NC State was one of only four teams in NCAA DI to have four players average 12.7 points or more a game. The Pack quartet of C.J. Bryce (13.3), Markell Johnson (12.8), D.J. Funderburk (12.8) and Devon Daniels (12.7) made NC State the only major conference team to accomplish this. The other teams in the NCAA that had a balanced scoring attack with four players averaging 12.7 points or more per game were Kent State, Richmond and UNC Asheville.

SENIOR DUO OF DANIELS AND FUNDERBURK TAKING OVER

■ NC State's senior tandem of Devon Daniels and D.J. Funderburk both showed steady improvement in their second seasons playing for the Pack in 2019-20.

■ Funderburk averaged 12.8 points per game on the season while Daniels averaged 12.7 points per game. Funderburk led the team in ACC-play with a 13.4 scoring average.

■ As a sophomore in 2018-19, Daniels averaged 9.3 points per game on 40.9% shooting and 4.4 rebounds per game in his first season in uniform for the Pack. In 2019-20, Daniels improved those numbers to 12.7 points per game on 47% shooting and 5.3 rebounds per game. Daniels also nearly doubled his steals per game average. In 2018-19, Daniels averaged 0.89 steals per game and he averaged 1.66 steals per game last season.

■ Funderburk averaged 8.8 points per game on 55.2% shooting and 4.2 rebounds per game as a red-shirt sophomore in 2018-19. Last season, he improved those numbers to 12.8 points per game on 60.9% shooting and 6.1 rebounds per game.

FUNDERBURK 4TH IN SINGLE SEASON AND 2ND IN CAREER FG%

■ NC State junior forward D.J. Funderburk has proven to be an efficient offensive player as he ranks second on NC State's career field goal percentage list and fourth on the single season list.

■ The Cleveland, Ohio native's career field goal percentage of 58.3% currently ranks second in NC State history. His season field goal percentage last season of 60.9% is the fourth-best all-time.

■ Funderburk shot 57.4% in 19 conference games and 60.9% overall. He would lead the conference in overall field goal percentage and ACC field goal percentage, but did not meet the 5.0 field goals made per game average to be ranked.

IMPORTANCE OF A DEEP BENCH

■ Since Kevin Keatts has arrived at NC State, the Pack has had one of the best benches in the country.

■ In 101 games with Keatts as head coach, NC State's bench has averaged 24 points per game and has outscored the opponent's bench by 806 points (2,424 bench points for NC State and 1,608 for its opponents).

■ Kevin Keatts teams have accounted for 11 of top-21 NC State bench scoring performances since 1999-2000 season, including the top-3 (see chart to left).

MANNY BATES EMERGING AS ONE OF NATION'S TOP SHOT BLOCKERS

■ 29 games into his NC State career, Manny Bates has already made his mark on the NC State record book.
 ■ Bates closed his freshman campaign with 83 blocks (2.86 bpg) to lead the ACC in blocks, marking only the second time since 1977 that an NC State player led the ACC in blocks (Beejay Anya - 2.5 bpg) and the first time in program history an NC State player led the ACC in blocks in conference games.
 ■ Bates had multiple blocked shots in 25 of 29 career games, including the first 17 of the season.
 ■ The Fayetteville, N.C., native had a career-best seven blocked shots in NC State's win over Detroit Mercy on Nov. 10. The seven blocked shots tied for the sixth-most in a single-game in NC State history and ranks as the second-most in a game in the 20-year history of PNC Arena.
 ■ Bates led the NCAA in block percentage in Ken Pomeroy's ratings in 2019-20. KenPom calculates block percentage as the percentage of opponents' two-point shots that are blocked by the player while he is on the court. Bates has a 16.0 block percentage meaning the Fayetteville native blocks nearly 1-in-6 two-point shot attempts when he is on the floor.

BIGGEST FRESHMEN CLASS YET FOR KEATTS

- Head Coach Kevin Keatts signed the biggest freshmen class since he took over NC State as he inked five Class of 2020 prospects.
- Four of the five signees are North Carolina natives: Nick Farrar (Apex), Cam Hayes and Shakeel Moore (Greensboro) and Jaylon Gibson (Zebulon).
- The Pack's largest freshmen class under Keatts prior to this class was his three-man signing class (Manny Bates, Jericole Hellems and Ian Steere) in the Class of 2018.

FOCUSING ON THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA

- Kevin Keatts has emphasized the importance of keeping recruits in-state since becoming head coach of NC State.
 - In addition to the four freshmen in the Class of 2020, NC State also signed two in-state Class of 2021 prospects in the early signing period in November.
 - Overall, (counting Durham, N.C. native Josh Hall who signed an NLI with NC State but opted to go pro), NC State has signed seven North Carolina natives in the last two recruiting classes.
 - NC State has the most North Carolina natives (8) on its roster of the four in-state schools in the ACC. Wake Forest has six North Carolina natives, while Duke and North Carolina both have five.
 - "I think it's becoming more and more popular for guys to come to NC State. When I first came here I had a theory that in-state guys, if they didn't get an offer at one point from North Carolina or Duke, I think they would look at it as a disappointment and go outside of the state to sign with another Power 5 team."

NC STATE SIGNS THREE PROSPECTS IN CLASS OF 2021

- NC State inked three Class of 2021 prospects in the early signing period in November
- Four-star prospects Ernest Ross (Alachua, Fla.) and Terquavion Smith (Farmville, N.C.) and three-star prospect Breon Pass (Reidsville, N.C.) all signed with the Pack.
- Ross and Smith are both top-100 prospects in the Class of 2021 on numerous recruiting lists. Pass is a two-sport star that has numerous Power 5 offers to play wide receiver, but has elected to play college basketball.

KEATTS: "IT'S THE MOST VERSATILE ROSTER WE'VE HAD"

- In his October press conference, Kevin Keatts described his team with the following quote: "It's our most versatile roster that we've had, and I wish it was a perfect 2020 because now we feel confident that on every given night, you'll finally get a chance to see our system fully implemented. Obviously, we know that we're going to have some challenges, just because everybody else will. But that being said, I love our roster. I love our versatility. I love the fact that guys can play multiple positions."
- Keatts said the most versatile player on the roster is redshirt freshman Dereon Seabron who they feel comfortable playing at the 1, 2, 3 and if they go small can even play at the 4.
- Keatts described junior Jericole Hellems as his tight end. If a team places a big man on him, the St. Louis, Mo., native ranked third on the team with 34 three-pointers last season and can bring his defender away from the basket. If he has a guard on him, Hellems has the low-post game that he can take the guard down low and score over him.

DEFENSIVE PRESSURE UNDER KEATTS

- In the first two seasons under Kevin Keatts, the Pack led the ACC in forcing opponent turnovers. Last season, the Pack ranked fifth in the ACC, forcing 14.2 turnovers per game, but due to a lack of depth the Pack had to hold back on the defensive pressure that has come to define the Keatts era. In his first season with NC State in 2017-18, the Pack forced 487 opponent turnovers, an average of 14.8 per game. In 2018-19, NC State forced 560 turnovers, an average of 15.6 per game. The 560 opponent turnovers are the third-most forced turnovers in program history. Last season, NC State forced an average of 14.2 turnovers per game. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 37-14 (72.5%) when it forces an opponent into 15 or more turnovers.

PACK HAS BEEN ONE OF ACC'S BEST UNDER KEATTS IN TURNOVER MARGIN

- In three seasons with Kevin Keatts, NC State has finished second twice and in fourth place last season in the ACC in turnover margin. The Pack had a +2.64 turnover margin in 2017-18 and a +3.08 turnover margin in 2018-19. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 52-21 (71.2%) when it has the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent and just 13-15 when it has more turnovers than its opponent.
