PACK TRACKS

- NC State opens its 112th season of basketball Tuesday evening when it hosts Bucknell.
- The Pack has won 26 of its last 27 home-openers when played against a non-conference opponent.
- The Pack has won 23 consecutive regular season home games against non-conference opponents and has a 30-1 record against non-conference opponents in regular season home games under head coach
- NC State finished last season with a 14-11 (9-8 ACC) record. The Pack lost leading scorer Devon Daniels to a torn ACL on Jan. 27, but regrouped to win its final five ACC road games to finish with a winning record in league play for the fourth consecutive season under Kevin Keatts.
- The Pack returns four players who started over half of the games last season: Jericole Hellems (24), Manny Bates (23), Thomas Allen (15) and Cam Haves (13), In addition, NC State returns Dereon Seabron who made eight starts late in the season after the Pack had lost Daniels to a season-ending injury.
- Senior forward Jericole Hellems is the Pack's leading returning scorer at 12.9 points per game. The St. Louis, Mo., native was an Honorable Mention All-ACC selection last season.
- NC State has to replace two double-digit scorers from last season's team. Guard Devon Daniels averaged a team-best 16.5 points per game last season, while forward **D.J. Funderburk** averaged 12.6 points per game.

NOTING NC STATE

- Between COVID pauses and injuries, Kevin Keatts was constantly juggling the lineup last season. In 25 games, eight players started at least eight games. Five of those eight players return this season.
- Kevin Keatts is entering his fifth season as head coach of NC State and for the fifth consecutive season he will have to replace the previous season's leading scorer. Devon Daniels led the team in scoring last season at 16.5 points per game. Jericole Hellems is the leading returning scorer at 12.9 points per game.
- North Carolina's team? Nine of NC State's 14 players are from the state of North Carolina. That's the most of the four ACC programs based in North Carolina. UNC has six of its 17 players from the state. Duke has five of its 14 players from the state and Wake Forest has four of its 19 players from the state.
- NC State only has two players (Thomas Allen and Jericole Hellems) who will complete their eligibility this season. Allen is a redshirt senior, who played his first two seasons at Nebraska before transfering home to NC State. Hellems is the only four-year senior on the team. He and redshirt junior Manny Bates have each been in the program four years. Nine of NC State's 14 players are either in their first or second seasons with the program.
- After not adding any transfers last season for the first time since he became head coach, Kevin Keatts added two transfers this offseason in Providence transfer Greg Gantt and Virginia transfer Casey Morsell. Keatts has now added 13 transfers to the program in his five seasons as head coach.

NOTING BUCKNELL

- Bucknell went 5-7 last season playing a COVID-abbreviated, Patriot League-only slate. Tuesday's game will be Bucknell's first non-league contest since Dec. 28, 2019.
- The Bison advanced to the Patriot League Tournament semifinals before falling to eventual champion, Colgate (NC State's opponent on Saturday, Nov. 13).
- Bucknell has been the dominant program in the Patriot League for a little over a decade. The Bison won eight Patriot League regular-season titles in a nine-year span from 2011-19, and the Bison went to the NCAA Tournament in 2011, 2013, 2017 and 2018 during that stretch.
- Bucknell was picked sixth in the preseason Patriot League poll. The Bison return two starters (Andrew Funk and Xander Rice) from last season's team.
- Bucknell junior forward Jake van der Heijden is from Raleigh and attended Ravenscroft.

TUESDAY STORYLINES

- Both programs have a connection to legendary head coach Jim Valvano. Valvano's second head coaching job was at Bucknell from 1972-75. He had a 33-42 with the Bison before leaving to take the Iona job. After five seasons and two NCAA Tournament bids at Iona, Valvano became head coach at NC State on March 27, 1980. He coached the Wolfpack for 10 seasons and compiled a 209-110 record with NC State, including quiding the team to the 1983 National Championship.
- The Pack has won 26 of its last 27 home-openers when played against a non-conference opponent. (NC State lost to William & Mary in the season-opener for the 2015-16 season. The Pack also dropped its home-opener in the 2019-20 season, but it was a conference game against Georgia Tech.)
- The Pack has won 23 consecutive regular season home games against non-conference opponents and has a 30-1 record against non-conference opponents in regular season home games under Kevin Keatts.
- A big reason for this success is NC State's ability to turn its opponent. In home games against non-conference opponents, NC State is averaging to force 19 turnovers per game and has nearly a +7 turnover margin. The Pack is also averaging 9.3 steals per game in home games against non-conference opponents.
- Last season when NC State forced an opponent into 15 or more turnovers the Pack was 10-1. When its opponent had less than 15 turnovers, NC State was 4-10.
- Last season, NC State only had two players appear in every game. By the end of the season, NC State only had seven scholarship players available for most games. Greg Gantt is still working his way back from an offseason injury, but the other 11 scholarship players should be available for NC State on Tuesday night.
- Sophomore guard Cam Hayes looks to build on a strong end to his freshman campaign. The freshman had anything but a normal freshman year. Between abbreviated summer workouts because of the pandemic and two separate COVID outbreaks on the team during the season, Hayes missed valuable time on the court. He ended the regular season by scoring in double figures in four of the last five regular season games, including a season-best 20 points in the win at Notre Dame. He averaged 11 points per game over the last eight games of the season.

NC STATE - BUCKNELL SERIES

- Tuesday will mark the second meeting all-time between the two programs.
- NC State won the only previous meeting, 99-86, on December 5, 2015. Maverick Rowan scored 27 points to lead all scorers, while Cat Barber finished with 24 points and Caleb Martin scored 212. Bucknell led 73-72 with 8:24 remaining in the game, but the Pack responded with a 13-2 run to put the game away.

REPLACE THE LEADING SCORER? NOTHING NEW FOR KEATTS

■ NC State lost its leading scorer from the previous season as Devon Daniels and his team-best 16.5 points per game average graduated. The loss of the previous season's leading scorer is nothing new for Keatts though, since he became head coach of the Pack in the spring of 2017 he has to replace the team's leading scorer each season.

HELLEMS HAS SHOWN SUSTAINED IMPROVEMENT

- NC State senior forward Jericole Hellems has improved his numbers every season of his collegiate career. After making a jump in every statistical category as a sophomore, Hellems made another jump as a junior as he has increased his output in every category.
- The Saint Louis, Mo., native was the only NC State player last season to lead the team in at least one game in points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks.

MANNY BATES EMERGING AS ONE OF NATION'S TOP SHOT BLOCKERS

- 53 games into his NC State career, Manny Bates has already made his mark on the NC State record book.
- In the win over Campbell on 12/19/20, Bates registered his 100th career block in just his 34th career game. He is the fastest player in program history to 100 blocks and is the fastest ACC player to 100 career blocks in over 20 seasons. Since 1985-86, Wake Forest's Tim Duncan and Georgia's Tech Alvin Jones are the only ACC players to get to 100 blocks in less games than Bates.
- In 24 games last season, Bates has 64 blocks (2.67), including a career-best eight at Saint Louis on 12/17. He led the for the second consecutive season and finished 11th in the NCAA.
- Bates is now aiming to be the first ACC player since Duke's Shelden Williams to lead the ACC in blocked shots for three consecutive seasons.
- Bates has multiple blocked shots in 40 of 54 career games, including the first 17 of his career.
- Bates ranks third (83 freshman season) and sixth (64 sophomore season) on NC State's single-season
- Bates closed his freshman campaign with 83 blocks (2.86 bpg) to lead the ACC in blocks, marking only the second time since 1977 that an NC State player led the ACC in blocks (Beejay Anya - 2.5 bpg) and the first time in program history an NC State player led the ACC in blocks in conference games.
- Bates led the NCAA in block percentage in Ken Pomeroy's ratings in 2019-20. KenPom calculates block percentage as the percentage of opponents' two-point shots that are blocked by the player while he is on the court. Bates has a 16.0 block percentage meaning the Fayetteville native blocks nearly 1-in-6 two-point shot attempts when he is on the floor.

IMPORTANCE OF A DEEP BENCH

- Since Kevin Keatts arrival at NC State, the Pack has had one of the best benches in the country.
- In 126 games with Keatts as head coach, NC State's bench has averaged 23.2 points per game and has outscored the opponent's bench by 850 points (2,950 bench points for NC State and 2,100 for its opponents).
- Kevin Keatts teams have accounted for 11 of top-21 NC State bench scoring performances since 1999-2000 season, including the top-3. (see chart to left for best bench performances under Keatts).

PACK HAS BEEN ONE OF ACC'S BEST UNDER KEATTS IN TURNOVER MARGIN

■ In four seasons with Kevin Keatts, NC State has finished second twice, third place once fourth place once in the ACC in turnover margin. The Pack had a +2.64 turnover margin in 2017-18 and a +3.08 turnover margin in 2018-19. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 65-24 (73.0%) when it has the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent and just 14-23 when it has more turnovers than its opponent.

DEFENSIVE PRESSURE UNDER KEATTS

■ In the first two seasons under Kevin Keatts, the Pack led the ACC in forcing opponent turnovers. After ranking fifth in the ACC in his third season, the Pack was back towards the top, finishing in second place. In his first season with NC State in 2017-18, the Pack forced 487 opponent turnovers, an average of 14.8 per game. In 2018-19, NC State forced 560 turnovers, an average of 15.6 per game. The 560 opponent turnovers are the third-most forced turnovers in program history. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 47-15 (75.8%) when it forces an opponent into 15 or more turnovers.

NC STATE ADDS THREE TALENTED SIGNEES IN 2021 CLASS

- NC State has added three four-star freshmen to this year's roster in Breon Pass (Reidsville, N.C.), Ernest Ross (Alachua, Fla.) and Terquavion Smith (Greenville, N.C.)
- Smith won three consecutive North Carolina Class 2A State Titles and was named North Carolina Mr. Basketball and North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year. Ross was named Player of the Year in Florida by the coaches association and led his high school to the state championship game, while Pass is one of the more decorated dual-sport signees in NC State history. Pass had power five offers to play both college basketball and college football. Pass averaged 32.6 points and 12.3 rebounds per game on the basketball court and caught 35 passes for 758 yards and 11 touchdowns on the football field as a senior.
