@PackWrestle Aims for Third Straight ACC Championship

After capturing back-to-back ACC gold in 2019 and 2020, the NC State wrestling team will be looking to win three straight ACC Championships for the first time since 1988-91, as the Wolfpack will host the 2021 ACC Championship on Sunday, Feb. 28 in Reynolds Coliseum.

The schedule: 11:00 AM First Round Matches • 1:00 PM Semifinals • 3:30 PM Consolation Semifinals • 5:00 PM Consolation Finals • 7:00 PM Finals. The finals will be televised on the ACC Network, and all the other action will be streamed on ACC Network Extra on two mats.

A Chance at History

If NC State captures its third straight ACC Championship, the Wolfpack will take over the ACC lead among current schools with the most team titles.

In addition to the conference high mark, the Pack will be looking to capture three straight ACC Championships for only the third time in school history. NC State previously won three straight a pair of times: 1981-83 and 1988-91 (school record four straight).

Leading the ACC Pack

The Wolfpack had four wrestlers finish with a perfect record in ACC duals, and enter the 2021 ACC Championship with four No. 1 seeds. The Pack only had a pair of No. 1 seeds each of the last four years, and the four this year are the most since the 2016 team title.

Hayden Hidlay Going for Fourth Straight ACC Title

R-Sr. Hayden Hidlay will be going for his fourth straight ACC individual title, as he took top honors in each of his first three seasons - all at 157 pounds.

In the ACC, he would become only the 10th wrestler in ACC history to win four championships, and the first to do so since Devin Carter of Virginia Tech (2011-12, 2014-15). He would also become only the second non-heavyweight to accomplish the feat winning all four at the same weight (Al Palacio, UNC, 1983-87).

At NC State, he would become the fifth wrestler to accomplish the four-peat, and the first since Darrion Caldwell (2007-09, 11).

Hidlay is a perfect 6-0 all-time at the ACC Championship, outscoring his foes a combined 58-14. Last year both wins were for bonus (24-6). He is a perfect 27-0 all-time vs. ACC foes in all collegiate competitions, 19-0 in duals and 15-0 vs. ranked ACC foes.

Camacho Looking for Second Straight Title

Another NC State wrestler won individual gold last year, and is back looking for a repeat title.

As R-Fr. last season, Jakob Camacho not only won his first ACC Championship in his first try, but he knocked off #2 ranked and returning NCAA Finalist Jack Mueller in the 125 pound finals, 11-4. For his efforts, Camacho was named the ACC Championship Most Outstanding Wrestler.

Camacho once again enters as the No. 2 seed. He went 4-1 in ACC duals, four bonus point wins, outscoring his foes 68-28.

ACC Championship (& Finals) Experience

The Wolfpack's 2021 ACC Championship lineup features nine wrestlers that have previously seen action at an ACC Championship. In fact, those nine grapplers have combined to already wrestle at 19 previous ACC Championships during their careers.

Even more impressive, seven of the nine with previous ACC Championship experience have advanced to at least one ACC Finals matchup. Those seven have wrestled in 10 previous ACC Finals.

Hayden Hidlay Winning Streak

Dating back to last season, R-Sr. Hayden Hidlay has won each of his last 23 matches, and 35 of his last 36 matches overall at 157 pounds. The 23 straight wins are currently an ACC-high (19).

It has been over one year since Hidlay has taken a collegiate loss - in the Cliff Keen finals on Dec. 7, 2019.

New to the Party

Despite all 10 starters returning from last year's ACC winning squad, one Wolfpack true freshman has made his way into the starting lineup and will wrestle at his first ACC Championship.

Ed Scott has taken over as the starter at 149 pounds. He is 4-4 on the season and opened his ACC career with a 13-1 major over Spencer of UVA and closed the ACC dual season with a 12-6 win over #22 Finesilver of Duke. Scott was a two-time PA state champion (79-0 combined during his junior and senior season) and was ranked the #19 overall recruit coming out of high school by FloWrestling.

Sixth Straight Year Finishing in Top-10 of the Coaches Poll

For the sixth straight season, the NC State wrestling team has finished in the top-10 of the final NWCA Coaches Poll. After finishing the dual season with a 6-1 record, the Pack finished the 2021 regular season ranked #7 nationally.

The Pack started the 2021 season at #4 and remained there for the first four polls. NC State then was up to #3 nationally for a couple of weeks after back-to-back top-15 ACC wins over Pitt and UNC. The #3 national ranking was the second-highest in school history (also accomplished the four polls last season), and only bested by a final ranking of #2 in 2016.

A loss at then-#8 Virginia Tech, dropped NC State to #7. The Pack was ranked #7 the final three polls of the season.

NC State has been ranked in the top-10 in the Coaches Poll for 82 straight polls dating back over six seasons, after having not been ranked in the top-10 at all since 1993.

Nine of 10 Ranked, Six in Top-10, Two in Top-3

In this week's rankings from InterMat, NC State has nine of the 10 weights ranked among the top-20, including six in the top-10. The Pack leads the ACC in both categories, and the nine ranked overall is second nationally to only Iowa (10).

Four of the five starters from the 2016 #1 recruiting class are ranked: Tariq Wilson (#8 at 141), Hayden Hidlay (#2 at 157), Thomas Bullard (#19 at 165), and Daniel Bullard (#8 at 174).

The Pack's 2018 recruiting class was ranked #3 nationally, and four members from that signing class are also ranked: Jakob Camacho (#6 at 125), Jarrett Trombley (#10 at 133), Trent Hidlay (#3 at 184) and Deonte Wilson (#13 at 285).

The newest Pack wrestler to be ranked is true freshman Isaac Trumble at 197 pounds, as he is now #18 after defeating #5 Bonaccoris of Pitt in his ACC debut.

Winning ... ACC Wrestler of the Week

A pair of NC State wrestlers were named ACC Wrestler of the Week this season. R-Fr. Hunter Lewis (149) was first on Jan. 12 after he pinned #10 Millner of App State in the extra matches. Freshman Isaac Trumble (197) followed on Jan. 26 after his 6-1 win over Pitt's #5 Bonaccosi in his ACC dual debut.

Four Wolfpack wrestlers combined to win ACC Wrestler of the Week honors seven times last season. Last year marked the sixth straight season the Wolfpack led the ACC for the most ACC Wrestler of the Week selections.

Hayden Hidlay Aiming for NC State Wrestling History

Hayden Hidlay is vying to become the first-ever NC State wrestler to become a four-time All-American.

As a redshirt freshman in 2018, Hidlay was an NCAA finalist at 157 pounds, and followed that up with a fourth place showing in 2019. Last year, he was named a first-team All-American.

He is currently second in school history in career win/loss percentage (.934 - 85-6).

Winning the Duals

Dating back over the past six seasons, NC State has won 88 of its 97 duals (90.7 percent) overall. That winning percentage sits third-best in the NCAA over the last six seasons, and the 88 dual victories lead the nation (next highest is Missouri at 82).

At NC State (2013-pres.):

- Named coach of the Pack in Spring 2012. In the Spring of 2018, awarded a contract extension through June of 2025.
- Named the 2018 Dan Gable co-NCAA Coach of the Year and the 2016 National Coach of the Year by FloWrestling.
- Two-time ACC Coach of the Year (2018, 2020). NWCA National Coach of the Year finalist in 2018, 2019 and 2020.
- Led Pack to three ACC Championships (2016, 2019, 2020). Back-to-back titles in 2019 and 2020 was the first time for NC State since 2001-02.
- NC State has finished in the top-10 of the Coaches Poll the last six seasons, 82 straight polls ranked in the top-10.
- NC State's 2020 final ranking of #3 nationally in the Coaches Poll was the second-highest in school history.
- NC State has gone 21-1 over the last two seasons in duals, including the first-ever undefeated season (15-0) in 2020.
- NC State claimed both the regular season title and then the ACC Championship in both 2019 and 2020.
- NC State swept the ACC awards last year: Coach of the Year, Wrestler of the Year (Hayden Hidlay) and Rookie of the Year (Trent Hidlay). NC State has had five of the last seven ACC Wrestlers of the Year.
- NC State has earned 18 All-America honors in the last seven years, a school record for most in that span.
- Led NC State to six straight top-20 finishes at the NCAA Championships, the most top-20 finishes in a row in school history. In 2018, school and ACC best 4th place finish, first-ever team trophy.
- In his first eight seasons, has had 57 NCAA qualifiers, highlighted by a school record 10 in 2017. In the last four seasons, NC State has qualified 44 of its 50 starters.

- He did not concede a takedown in either match last year (5-0 in takedowns total). He was named the 2020 ACC Championship Most Valuable Wrestler.
- Consensus top-10 wrestler at 125 pounds in his second season. Ranked #6 by InterMat and #3 by FloWrestling. Also #5 in both of the Coaches Panel Rankings this year.
- 4-1 in ACC action in 2021. All four wins were for bonus points (1 tech fall, 3 majors), and he outscored his ACC foes a combined 68-28.
- 7-1 overall in 2021, with five bonus point wins.

- In his second season, ranked #10 by both InterMat and FloWrestling. Also #11 in the latest Coaches Panel Rankings.
- Split time in the Pack's lineup at 133 pounds this year with Fr. Ryan Jack. Both went 1-2 in all ACC duals. Downed Jack in a wrestle-off after last dual, 6-5.
- Went 1-2 in ACC duals. Bumped up to 141 pounds vs. Duke for an 11-5 win. Both losses at 133 pounds were to top-8 foes: #4 Phillippi of Pitt (4-2) and #8 Myers of Virginia Tech (13-5).

- Majoring in biological science. Named a 2020 NWCA Scholar All-American with a perfect 4.0 GPA.

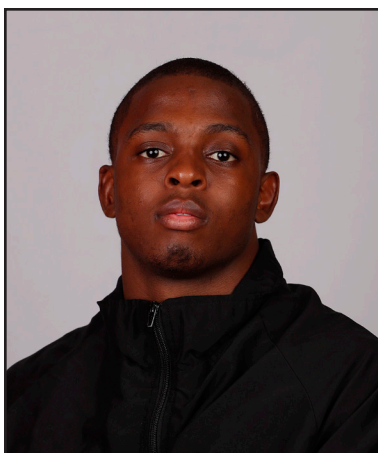
