PACK FACTS

THE MATCHUP: LOUISVILLE

Louisville comes to Raleigh fourth in the ACC. The Cardinals have a 21-7 advantage in the all-time series and have won four straight over the Wolfpack. The Cardinals came to Raleigh in 2008 in the first meeting between the two schools, where Louisville won 3-1. This season, Louisville is 2-3 on the road.

LAST TIME OUT

Winners of four of their last five, NC State will look to win its fourth ACC series of the season. The Wolfpack is coming off a 4-1 midweek victory over East Carolina and taking two out of three from Virginia last weekend.

HOGUE IS HEATING UP

Josh Hogue's walk-off home run against Virginia gave him 10 games with multiple RBIs. Brayden Fraasman and Hogue enter the weekend on seven-game hitting streaks, the longest by an NC State player this year. Hogue hit his team-leading seventh home run of the season against the Pirates on Tuesday. He leads the team in SLG% (.602), doubles (13), and total bases (71).

BIG A

The Wolfpack bullpen is starting to establish itself again. Freshman Anderson Nance picked up his fifth win of the season after tossing five innings of no-run baseball on Tuesday against ECU, retiring 13 straight batters at one point. He is second on the team in ERA (3.37) and has thrown 34.2, the most of a bullpen arm. It was the third time Nance has gone five innings this season, with the first coming against UNCG earlier in the season to earn his first win. He struck out a career-high six batter against the Spartans.

HOME SUCCESS AT THE DOAK

Welcome to our house. Doak NC State is 16-5 this season in the friendly confines of Doak Field. Doak Field at Dail Park has served as a dominant home field advantage for the Wolfpack since 1966. In 2024, the Pack finished with a 28-7 record at The Doak. Since head coach Elliott Avent came to Raleigh to take over the #Pack9 program in 1997, NC State has posted a 645-236 (.732) record in games played at Doak Field at Dail Park. NC State has now won 20 or more games at The Doak 23 times since Avent's first year as head coach in 1997.

GETTING ON BASE

Ty Head had reached base safely in his first 15 games in his career before the streak ended in game 16 against Wright State. Last season, Jacob Cozart drew 52 walks in 61 games to finish second in program history for most walks in a season. His 37 walks on the season are second in the ACC and fourth in the nation overall, but the most by a freshman. He is 10 walks away from cracking the top 10 in program history.

SACRIFICE BUNT LEADER

The nation's leader in sacrifice bunts resides in Raleigh. Matt Heavner has 12 on the season to lead the country. No one else on the Wolfpack has more than one. It is the most sacrifice bunts since J.T. Jarrett had 20 in 2018.

Heavner also has three home runs this season, matching his total over his first two seasons with the Wolfpack. His third home run of the season was a grand slam in the Wolfpack's loss against USC Upstate. Heavner has only batted in the eighth or ninth spot in the order all season.

PACK FACTS

SAVES FROM SHAFFNER

The Wolfpack has lost one game all season when leading after the sixth inning. A key contributor to that success has been Andrew Shaffner, who has come out of the bullpen. Shaffner has appeared 12 times this season and is 3-1 with a 2.70 ERA. He has 29 strikeouts and just five walks and leads the team with three saves. In his outing against UNCG, Shaffner pitched a career-high 4.1 innings and finished with a career-best seven strikeouts.

STELLAR STARTER

Dominic Frinton, the conference leader in innings pitched, will look to add to his total when he makes his ninth start of the season Friday. His 2.85 ERA is 10th in the league, and he ranks fourth in strikeouts with 62.

A LIFT FROM LANPHERE

Drew Lanphere came on in the seventh and, with his grand slam, not only was it his first home run of the season, it extended his on-base streak to 16 games, which is a tie for the longest this season by a Wolfpack player.

It was the fourth grand slam of the season for the Wolfpack.

COMEBACK PACK

NC State rallied to win 16 times (42% or 16/38 of its wins in 2024) this past season after going behind first.

Through 29 games this season the Wolfpack are 8-5 when the opponent scores first. Sunday's comeback win was the ninth time NC State has come back to win this season and the first win when trailing after the eighth inning.

RECORD AGAINST IN-STATE OPPONENTS

NC State finished 8-9 against in-state opponents in 2024, including a season sweep against Wake Forest to end the regular season.

NC State is 6-2 against in-state opponents in 2025. Since taking over the NC State baseball program in 1997, head coach Elliott Avent has led the Pack to a 367-189 (.659) against in-state foes.

TOUGH TO STRIKEOUT

Justin DeCriscio hit home runs in back-to-back games against Virginia. He is one of the country's toughest batters to strike out. In 102 at-bats, DeCriscio has struck out just seven times, putting him second in the ACC and 23rd in the nation in the category.

POTTS BEGINNING TO STIR

Freshman Tristan Potts had just pitched in two-thirds of an inning, throwing a total of 10 pitches. Against Virginia, Potts came out of the bullpen in games two and three, throwing two scoreless innings, striking out a batter, and allowing just one base runner to help keep the deficit at two.

GOLDEN SPIKES

NC State pitcher Dominic Fritton was named to USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List, as announced by the organization last week. The Golden Spikes Award is awarded annually to the top amateur baseball player in the country.

Fritton, a junior from Fuquay-Varina, N.C., is one of just 45 student-athletes and 12 from the ACC featured on this year's Midseason Watch List.

D1 BASEBALL MIDSEASON RANKINGS

Fritton was named a Midseason Second Team All-American by D1 Baseball last week. D1 Baseball also released their midseason position player rankings, with six Wolfpack players ranked.

LEADS=WINS

The Wolfpack has just one loss this season when leading after the sixth inning. Jacob Dudan has looked like his freshman All-American self. 2024 Freshman All-American has two saves on the season and has come on in 12 games in relief. Over his last six outings, Dudan has not allowed a run and just given up three hits with 10 strikeouts. NC State is 19-1 when leading after the sixth inning.

CLEAN BASEBALL=BEST BASEBALL

NC State plays its best baseball when it plays clean baseball. The Wolfpack is 13-2 when it makes no errors, compared to an 9-9 record when it makes at least one error.

USING THE LONG BALL

The Duke series saw six different NC State players combine to hit eight home runs over the three-game series, giving NC State the most in a series this season. On Saturday, The Wolfpack is 17-4 in games when they hit at least one home run in a game compared to 3-6 when they hit zero.

NC State has 45 home runs on the season, with Josh Hogue, with seven to lead the team. NC State is sixth in the ACC and 42nd in the nation in home runs hit.

OUTSLUGGING THE COMPETITION

Once again the Wolfpack sported an impressive record when it out hit its opponents in 2024, finishing the year with a 30-4 when it recorded more hits than the opposing team.

This year they are 17-1 when doing so. Since 2017, NC State now is 235-25 (.898) when it has out hit its opponent. This season when NC State opponents out hit NC State, the Wolfpack are 2-9.

PACK FACTS

REGULARS IN THE LINEUP

Three Wolfpack players to appear in all 33 games played this season, Ty Head, Luke Nixon and Chris McHugh, all three lead the Wolfpack in one offensive category or another. McHugh leads NC State in hits (42), and RBIs (36).

Nixon leads NC State in triples (2) and runs scored (34). Nixon has 11 stolen bases this season, making him the only Wolfpack player with double-digit steals and steal attempts.

STRIKE FIRST, STRIKE HARD, NO MERCY

NC State held a 22-5 record when scoring first last season. The Pack totaled 51 runs in the first inning and went on to out score its opponents 464-383 in 2024. Thus far, the Wolfpack are 13-6 when scoring first and have out scored their opponents 263-171 in 33 games.

The Wolfpack has totaled 23 runs in the first inning this season and is 9-3 when doing so. NC State does its damage in the middle innings, recording with the most runs scored coming in the 5th inning with 41 thus far.

RUNS RULE!

The Wolfpack opened its 2025 campaign with an Opening weekend sweep of Fordham. Winning 11-1, 12-2 and 19-6 each of the Wolfpack's victories was decided by run rule. Since then they have added six more run-rule victories for a total of nine on the year with Canisius, Campbell, Wright State, NC A&T, Virginia Tech and Davidson also sharing the same fate.

The Wolfpack has also been run ruled three times this season: Virginia Tech, USC Upstate and Duke.

PACK IN THE SHOW

The 2024 season saw 36 NC State Wolfpack baseball alumni play or coach in some form at the pro level. There has been 51 players who attended NC State to play in the major leagues. In 2024 had five players representing five different MLB franchises – Trea Turner (Phillies), Carlos Rodon (Yankees), Andrew Knizner (Rangers), Patrick Bailey (Giants) and Evan Justice (Rockies). And two coaches, Aaron Bates (Dodgers- hitting coach) and Josh Miller (Astros Pitching Coach)

In 2025 Carlos Rodon was named Opening Day starter for the New York Yankees, Trea Turner started at shortstop for the Phillies and Patrick Bailey was the starting catcher for the Giants.

RED WHITE & PACK

Cooper Consiglio, Jacob Dudan and Derrick Smith were all invited to the 2024 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Training Camp.

The Wolfpack trio were three of just 56 premier non-draft eligible college players invited to this summer's National Team Training Camp.

ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK: RYAN MAROHN

After tossing his second complete-game shut-out of the season, NC State Baseball's Ryan Marohn has been named ACC Pitcher of the Week.

Marohn earned his third win of the season on Sunday over Wright State, as he was virtually unhittable all afternoon as the lefty from Chantilly, Va. put up nine scoreless innings, holding the Raiders to just four hits while walking just one and striking out a career high 14 batters. Marohn struck out nine straight batters between the sixth and ninth innings and 10 of the last 12 batters he faced. Marohn threw 126 pitches on the day, the most in his career, with a strike percentage of 69%.

After throwing a complete-game seven-inning shutout against Canisius, Marohn has now thrown 17 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to the fifth inning against Coastal Carolina in the Jacksonville Classic on February 23rd. It is the first Wolfpack nine-inning complete game since Matt Williadsen did it against UNC in 2022.

FEELING GRAND

Freshman Ty Head made sure his first collegiate home run was a memorable one. With the Wolfpack trailing Canisius 1-0, Head flipped the game with a grand slam for his first home run in a Wolfpack uniform. It was the first grand slam from a Wolfpack batter since Alex Sosa hit one against #8 Wake Forest in May 2024.

The second grand slam of the season came from Josh Hogue against Campbell in a 3-0 ball game to break the game open. The Wolfpack is 17-39 (.436) with the bases full as a team. McHugh is 4-4 in his opportunities, and Josh Hogue is 4-5 with a grand slam in the season. Overall, with runners in scoring position, NC State is hitting .342.

Matt Heavner hit the third grand slam of the season for NC State in the loss to USC Upstate.

BRING OUT THE BROOMS

NC State brought out the brooms five times this past season (Townson, Boston College, Notre Dame, Ball State and Wake forest). NC State has recorded 81 weekend sweeps (three-game or four-game series against the same opponent) since Avent's first season in 1997. The Pack has tallied 44 sweeps since the completion of the 2012 season and 73 sweeps since the completion of the 2002 campaign.

The most three-game/four-game sweeps an Aventura-coached Wolfpack team has recorded in a single season has been five, which has now been accomplished in 2024, 2023, 2022, 2019, 2013, 2010, 2006 and his first season with the Pack in 1997. The Pack already has three this season with a sweeps of Fordham, Canisius and Wright State.

PACK FACTS

THE DUDE BACK ON TRACK

Jacob Dudan registered his first career start against Campbell. Dudan went 3.0 IP, allowing no runs, no hits, and no walks, matching his career best in strikeouts with six. Dudan started the game striking out five of six batters, picking up his first win of the season.

Dudan then earned his first save of the season in game one against Wright State getting the last six outs allowing just one hit and striking out four.

After a season earning Freshman All-American recognition, NC State pitcher Jacob Dudan was named to the 2025 D1 Baseball Preseason All-American First Team.

Dudan, who earned ACC All-Freshman Team honors in 2024, led the Wolfpack with 27 pitching appearances, all of which came out of the bullpen. Dudan's six saves ranked second on the team, as the freshman did not allow an earned run in his first eight collegiate appearances.

Dudan finished his standout freshman season with a 4-2 record, 4.50 ERA, and 56 strikeouts over 48.0 innings pitched. Dudan led a talented group of Wolfpack freshman pitchers with 56 strikeouts.

D1 Baseball ranked Dudan as the No. 1 relief pitcher in college baseball.

CAREER FIRSTS

Andrew Shaffner and Heath Andrews got their first collegiate wins during the opening weekend. Shaffner came on in relief in game one, pitched 3.2 innings, and only allowed three hits and no runs. Shaffner made his first career start against Richmond.

In his second career start, Andrews pitched a career-best 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on two hits and five strikeouts, which is also a career-high.

Freshman pitcher, Anderson Nance, made an impressive debut against Liberty, taking the mound in the fifth inning. Over three solid innings, he allowed just one hit while striking out two batters. He earned his first collegiate win against UNCG where he went five innings with two strikeouts allowing no runs.

HOT START TO THE SEASON

Under head coach Elliott Avent, the Wolfpack is 22-7 on opening day. NC State has not dropped a season opener since 2016 against Old Dominion.

The Pack are currently on an nine-game winning streak on opening day, which is the longest streak in winning its first game of the year under head coach Elliott Avent.

WELCOME BACK, MATT

After missing the 2024 season due to injury, Matt Willadsen made his long-awaited return to the mound in game three against Fordham, finishing one inning with three strikeouts. In his first outing in 623 days, he threw 17 pitches, with 12 of them being strikes despite a first-pitch home run.

Willadsen made his first start to the season against Liberty and 46th overall in a wolfpack uniform. Against the Flames, he went 2.1 innings and struck out two but gave up five runs. He is 16-12 in his Wolfpack career with a 4.57 ERA.

BECHTEL BOMBS

Sophomore Jake Bechtel has two career hits, both are home runs. His second came as a pinch hitter against Fordham, opening his season with a

three-run home run. It was the second straight year Bechtel had gone deep in his first at-bat of the season. It was the first pinch-hit home run in two years for NC State.

PACK DEBUTS

Nine Wolfpack newcomers debuted throughout Opening Weekend, with six starting and five playing their first career game at the D1 level.

Transfer Chris McHugh led the Wolfpack, hitting .556 with five hits, seven runs, six RBIs, and a home run in his first at-bat with the Wolfpack.

Matt Ossenfort also hit a home run in his first at-bat with NC State. OF Brayden Fraasman totaled five hits, including a double and a home run, to finish with 6 RBIs on the weekend. Ryan Jaros started the third game at third base and racked up two hits and an RBI in his first game with NC State.

Ryder Woodson and Brandon Novy recorded their first collegiate hits, and Jet Gilliam came on defensively for his first time in a Wolfpack uniform.

Landon Carr and Tristan Potts became the 10th and 11th Wolfpack players to make their debuts this season after both coming on in the Jacksonville Classic

RPI RANKS

Since 2021, NC State's baseball team has consistently maintained a strong Rating Percentage Index (RPI), reflecting their competitive performance. Their year-end RPI rankings are as follows:

These rankings place NC State among the top programs nationally, with an average RPI ranking within the top 10 during this period.

PRESEASON PACK

For the second consecutive year, NC State baseball was ranked No. 13 in D1 Baseball's 2025 Preseason Top 25 poll, as announced by the publication.

Baseball America Tabbed the Wolfpack No. 16, while Perfect Game had NC State at No. 36.

FRESH FACES

NC State's spring roster is comprised of 39 student-athletes, featuring 20 newcomers and 19 returners. Earlier this month, D1 baseball tabbed the Wolfpack as the No. 23 freshman class in the nation.

A few Juco transfers for Pack fans to keep an eye on include Brayden Fraasman, who was ranked No. 28 in the top 50 impact transfer hitters, as well as Landon Carr (No. 30) and Eli Pillsbury (No. 47), both included on Top 50 impact Juco transfer pitchers according to D1 Baseball.

PACK RECAP

The Wolfpack concluded the 2024 season with a trip to Omaha and the College World Series. NC State finished with a 38-23 record. It was the 34th time in program history advancing to the NCAA Tournament. For the seventh time in program history, the NC State baseball team was named one of the 16 NCAA Regional host sites for the 2024 Division I Baseball Championship. advance to their sixth Super Regional in program history, where they defeated Georgia.

PRODUCTION TO REPLACE

The Wolfpack offense excelled once again in 2024, finishing the season with 101 total homers, 426 RBI and 464 runs scored. Between losses to graduation, the MLB Draft and the transfer portal, NC State returns just 18% of its home runs (19 of 101), 26% of its RBI (114 of 426) and 23.9% of its runs scored (111 of 464) from the 2024 campaign.

The quintet of Brandon Butterworth, Jacob Cozart, Alec Makarewicz, Garrett Pennington, and Eli Serrano leave perhaps the largest void from season to season that NC State has experienced in recent years. They were the only five players on last year's roster who participated in all 61 of the Wolfpack's games, accounting for 75 percent of the team's home runs, 65 percent of both runs scored and runs batted in, and nearly 70 percent of total bases.

READY TO MAKE AN INSTANT IMPACT

The Wolfpack added 10 transfers to its 2025 roster – Justin DeCriscio (San Diego), Ryan Jaros (Georgia Tech), Trenton Lyons (Ole Miss), Matt Ossenfort (Vanderbilt), Chris McHugh (VCU), Julien Peissel (UNCG), Jet Gilliam (Southern Nevada), Landon Carr (Gaston), Eli Pillsbury (John A Logan), Brayden Fraasman, (Lincoln Trail).

2024 DRAFT SUCCESS

NC State had four players drafted in the 2024 MLB Draft – Jacob Cozart (Cleveland Guardians ,2-48), Eli Serrano III (New York Mets, 4-111), Brandon Butterworth (San Diego Padres, 12-360), and Logan Whitaker (Minnesota Twins, 19-578). The Wolfpack's four draft selections in the 2024 MLB Draft marks the eighth time since 2015 the Wolfpack has had at least four players selected in a single draft. Whitaker, NC State's most recent draft pick, marked the 131st MLB Draft selection under head coach Elliott Avent.

TOP PROSPECTS, 2025 & 2026 DRAFT

According to D1 Baseball, the Wolfpack has six of the top 75 draft prospects for the 2025 draft: Dom Fritton (20), Heath Andrews (31), Derrick Smith (37), Shane Van Dam (50), Brayden Fraasman (55), Andrew Shaffner (70).

1,000 WINS IN RED AND WHITE

Head coach Elliott Avent achieved yet another milestone in his coaching career in Feb. 18's 5-3 series-clinching victory over VCU. With the win, Avent captured his 1,000th win as the head coach at NC State. He became the fifth active Division I head coach with 1,000 wins at one school with two wins over his alma mater, VCU. The 28-year Wolfpack head coach joins Danny Hall (Georgia Tech), Keith Guttin (Missouri State), John Anderson (Minnesota) and Gary Gilmore (Coastal Carolina) on the active list. He also became the 35th qualifying Division I head coach (active or inactive) to reach 1,000 wins at one school. Avent's 1,000th victory with the Pack came exactly 9,864 days following his first win at NC State on Feb. 15, 1997, over Charleston Southern (6-0).

- The No. 1 movie at the U.S. box office was the 1997 Special Edition re-release of "Star Wars: Episode IV - A New Hope." On that day, it earned approximately \$7.38 million.
- The average cost of a gallon of gas in the United States was \$1.23.
- On the same day, NC State women's basketball registered a 65-62 win over Maryland in Raleigh.
- NC State men's basketball recorded a 60-59 upset victory at No. 4 Wake Forest on Feb. 17, 1997.

#TEAMCHRISCOMBS

On Sept. 3, 2020, NC State baseball lost a special member of its program in former player Chris Combs. He lost a four-year battle with ALS at the age of 45.

Combs' jersey (No. 26), which was honored in Spring 2020, can be found on the padding in right field to remember his outstanding baseball career and tireless pursuit for a cure for ALS.

#TeamChrisCombs was founded by Chris and his wife, Gena, and aims to raise awareness about ALS while raising funds for targeted research. - » Named head coach at NC State in 1996, prior to the start of the 1997 season, and has molded the Wolfpack into one of the nation's best and most consistent programs
- » Captured his 1,000th win at NC State on Feb. 18 against VCU (5-3) to become just the fifth active Division I head coach to win 1,000 games at one school.
- » Reached the 1,200 career-win mark on March 12, 2023, and currently ranks fourth among active Division I head coaches with 1,200 career victories (one of only six active Division I head coaches with 1,200 or more career wins)
- » Reached the 900-win milestone as the skipper at NC State on April 6, 2021. He is the all-time winningest coach in NC State history
- » Named the manager for USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team in 2021, which was his first time serving as manager and third time on the CNT staff (2004 and '15)
- » Named the 2021 ABCA/Rawlings Atlantic Region Coach of the Year and USA Baseball College Coach of the Year
- » Under his leadership, NC State returned to the College World Series in 2024, the program's fourth appearance in program history and third in his tenure
- » In 2024, he guided the Wolfpack to its 12th NCAA Regional in the last 14 seasons it has been held.
- » His 2019 and 2021 squads saw eight players each selected in the MLB First-Year Player Draft, tied for the second-most all-time at NC State
- » NC State has hosted an NCAA Regional seven times in program history - each of which have come under Avent's leadership
- » He is one of just nine active Division I head coaches to surpass 1,000 career wins. He did so in 2017 when he accomplished the feat in a 13-0 victory against NC Central
