HUBBARD AT THE HELM

Joining in December of 2023, Marc Hubbard is the 10th head coach in program history.

In his first fall season at the helm of the Wolfpack, Hubbard led the program to one of their most successful seasons in 30 years. Through the first seven games under coach, NC State had its best start to a season since 1992, opening with a record of 5-0-2. His team posted a 10 win season and fell back into the United Soccer Coaches Poll rankings for the first time since 2019, climbing to a high of No. 12 in the country. The squad finished conference action with its best record (3-3-2) in the ACC since 2017. For the month of October the team went undefeated which included ranked matches against No. 2 Stanford, No. 24 Virginia Tech, No. 21 Hofstra, and No. 10 SMU. A 7-0 win over Winthrop in September marked the most goals scored by the Pack since the 1996 season.

The postseason led to a NCAA Tournament berth, reaching the Sweet Sixteen for the first time since 1996, taking out Charlotte and fourth-seeded Georgetown along the way. Hubbard was the only first year coach to land in the third round of the 2024 NCAA bracket. All of this was capped off by two MLS SuperDraft selections, sophomores Hakim Karamoko and Donovan Phillip. Karamoko was the 10th overall pick by D.C. United, making him the second highest overall pick in program history. As well as two second team All-ACC honors (Taig Healy and Hakim Karamoko), an All-ACC Freshman Team honor (Niko Markovic), and two USC NCAA DI All-South Region honors (Karamoko on first team and Healy on second team).

SERIES HISTORY (leads 10-8-4)

- Friday's meeting marks the 23rd contest between the NC State Wolfpack and Boston College Eagles.
- The Wolfpack last met with the Eagles in Raleigh in 2023 which resulted in a 2-0 victory.

- Up until last season, NC State and Boston College faced each other every season since they first met in 2004. Four matches between the two have gone to overtime.

QUICK NOTES

- The Wolfpack started the season ranked at No. 14 in the preseason United Soccer Coaches poll, where it finished last season. After just week one of the regular season, the squad landed at eighth in the country, the last time the program was ranked that high was in September of 2018.
- Through two weeks of competition, the Pack was boosted to the No. 5 spot, marking the program's highest-ever ranking in the United Soccer Coaches poll (which began in 1996).
- In the fourth poll of the season, the Pack was pushed to No. 2 in the nation, marking a new program high for the United Soccer Coaches poll.
- NC State was picked to finish eighth in a competitive Atlantic Coast Conference that features four of the nation's preseason top 10 teams according to the United Soccer Coaches Poll.
- A win over Queens to open the season on Thursday moved the team's season opening record under Marc Hubbard to 2-0.
- A crowd of 5,083 fans at the game vs. North Carolina on Friday, Sept. 5 set a new Dail Soccer Stadium attendance record.

ACROSS THE ACC

- NC State is one of two ACC schools (other being Duke) to feature at least four players on the TopDrawerSoccer Preseason Top-100 Players to Watch List.
- The ACC holds five teams ranked nationally in the top-25 (No. 1 Wake Forest, No. 2 NC State, No. 3 Stanford, No. 14 Clemson, and No. 19 Duke).
- NC State is the only ACC school to not yet concede a goal.

ACROSS THE NCAA

- Donovan Phillip leads the country in goals per game with 1.43 average and leads in shots on goal per game with 3.00 average.
- The team leads the country in goal differential (23-0) and is for second in shots on goal per game with a 9.57 average.
- NC State is one of three schools to not yet concede a goal.

PACK FACTS

- The full breakdown of NC State's 2025 squad includes 14 returners and 17 newcomers (7 freshmen, 10 transfers).
- The Pack brings back leading playmakers Taig Healy and Donovan Phillip, each who had six goals last season. Healy also tallied six assists while Phillip had four.
- In total, NC State has seven of its 14 goal scorers from 2024 back with the team in 2025. Those seven men accounted for 19 of the team's 38 goals last season.
- NC State returns six players who started 10+ games during the 2024 season - Logan Erb (12 starts), Taig Healy (20 starts), Isaac Heffess (20 starts), Drew Lovelace (11 starts), Nikola Markovic (17 starts) and Donovan Phillip (14 starts).
- A total of eight returners on this year's roster earned at least one starting nod in 2023. Nine of the 14 returners made an appearance on the pitch last year.

EYES ON PHILLIP

Junior forward Donovan Phillip was named to the 15-player ACC Men's Soccer Preseason Watch List. He closed out his sophomore campaign being drafted to the Colorado Rapids, but elected to come back and continue using his collegiate eligibility.

Spending his 2025 summer with the Flint City Bucks, the Saint Lucia native shared the title as the leading scorer in the USL2. He was also named to the USL2 Team of the Year for the Central Conference, as well as the Player of the Conference for his league. He was then ultimately named the Player of the Year for the entire USL2 league.

Seven games into the season and Phillip leads the team with 10 goals. He recorded a hat trick in five minutes against Wofford, making him the first player for the Pack to have a hat trick since Conor Kelly did it (also against Wofford) in 2022. He then went on to record another hat trick in the William & Mary game, scoring four goals in 25 minutes. He is the first NC State player to double-digit goals in a season since 2012.

PACK AT HOME

In the last five seasons, the Wolfpack has posted a 28-16-8 (.615) record in games played on its home turf. Included in that record is a 1-1 draw against No. 4 Syracuse in 2022, 1-1 draw against No. 10 Clemson in 2023, and a 5-1 victory against No. 12 SMU in 2024.

In just the first season with Hubbard at the helm, the Pack only lost two home matches (back-to-back against No. 6 North Carolina and Duke). Eight home wins in 2024 marked the most wins in a season at Dail since 2019.

RANKED OPPONENT RECORD

The five seasons leading up to the Marc Hubbard era only included one victory and five draws against ranked opponents. In just the first season with Hubbard at the helm, the Pack picked up two victories, two losses, and three draws to opponents in the top-25. One loss being to sixth-ranked North Carolina and the other to eighth-ranked Marshall in the NCAA Sweet 16.

2024 REWIND

- The Pack went 10-5-5 (3-3-2 ACC) during the 2024 season.

- NC State went undefeated against non-conference opponents during the regular season, winning five matches and tying three, and outscoring opponents 19-5.
- The Pack gutted out several draws during the 2024 regular season, three of which were against ranked opponents, but most notably a scoreless decision at No. 2 Stanford.
- NC State concluded the regular season with a 0-1 loss at Wake Forest, who would go on to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament. Its postseason run was finished by Marshall, who fell by one goal to Vermont in the national championship.
- The Pack shut out six opponents in 2024, which included No. 2 Stanford, No. 24 Virginia Tech and fourth-seeded Georgetown in the NCAA Tournament, all on the road.
- In 2024, NC State finished ninth in the Atlantic Coast Conference. The squad fell to Virginia at home in the first round of the 2024 ACC Tournament.

FOOTY IN THE FAMILY

- Isaac Busenze: grandfather and father both played on the National Team for Uganda, older brother played at Loyola Maryland
- Mohamed Kallon: uncle played at Inter Milan and is the head coach of Sierra Leone National Team
- Drew Lovelace: father played soccer at Methodist
- Donovan Phillip: father played professionally in Jamaica, uncle also played professionally and is currently on the Senior National Team, mom also represented Saint Lucia in soccer
- Carlos Santamaria: dad, Pofirio played professionally in Mexico
- Sam Terranova: dad, Justin, is the men's coach at Methodist
- Caden Tolentino: sister, Paige, was a member of the NC State women's soccer team in 2024

NEW COACH

Marc Hubbard added Joel Tyson back in January to round out his assistant coaching staff. Tyson spent the last six seasons as the head coach of the men's soccer program at Wofford College. While with the Wolfpack, he will focus on all aspects of recruiting and coaching, including but not limited to the goalkeepers.

In his six years as the leader of the Terriers, his student-athletes garnered 22 All-Southern Conference Honors, including one SoCon Player for the Year and two SoCon Freshman of the Year recognitions. In his fifth season as head coach, a successful conference campaign in 2023 led to him being named the SoCon Coach of the Year.

Prior to taking over the helm in Spartanburg, S.C., Tyson coached in the USL for two years with Charlotte Independence.

RED TERRORS

The Red Terrors is the official support group for NC State soccer. The student-led organization has helped create one of the best home atmospheres in the ACC and in the nation and is now the largest student club on campus. Even during the 2020-21 COVID season, the Red Terrors would station themselves up on the top of the Reynolds Parking Deck to watch the matches from afar when they could not be in the stadium.
