THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

Coach Maureen Magarity, beginning her ninth season as head coach, has led UNH to its best two-year run in the history of the program the last two seasons.

UNH went 19-12 overall and 9-7 in America East last season, following up on 26-6 and 15-1 marks in 2016-17. The Wildcats advanced to the America East semifinals each season. The team's 45 victories over the last two years combined is the best two-year win total in school history.

Junior forward Ashley Storey, who missed all of last season with an injury, and Alli Gribbin, the lone senior on the team, lead the Wildcats into the season as captains. Sophomore guard Amanda Torres worked her way into a starting lineup that had been composed of all seniors late last season.

The Wildcats – with seven freshmen among the 13 players on the roster – play their home opener against Sacred Heart on Sunday, Nov. 18 at 1 p.m.

SCOUTING MINNESOTA

- The Golden Gophers went 24-9 overall and 11-5 in the Big 10 last year.
- They lost in the second round of the NCAA tournament and Big 10 tournament.
- Former Minnesota standout Lindsay Whalen makes her coaching debut on Friday night.
- Destiny Pitts was named Big 10 freshman of the year last season.
- Destiny Pitts and Kenisha Bell were both named to the preseason All-Big 10 team picked by media and coaches
- The Golden Gophers were picked third in the league's preseason poll.
- They return four of their five starters, accounting for 67.3 percent of points, 68.9 percent of rebounds and 78.1 percent of assists.
- Kenisha Bell set school records last year in free-throws made (187) and free-throw attempts (255). Her total assists (223) was the second most in the past 30 years of the program's history.
- Bell averaged 20 points per game, 5.4 rebounds, 6.8 assists and 2.6 steals.
- Bell finished sixth in the nation in free throw attempts, seventh in free throws made, ninth in assists per game and 10th in total assists
- Pitts led the team with 7.2 rebounds per game. She was ranked fourth in the league for 3-pointers (90).
- Pitts was named the Big 10 freshman of the year seven times.

SCOUTING NORTH DAKOTA STATE

- North Dakota State went 9-20 overall and 2-12 in the Summit League last season.
- The Bison opened the season with a 49-43 win over Mayville State on Tuesday night.
- They play Creighton at home on Friday night.
- Michell Gaislerova and Tyrah Spencer led North Dakota State with 13 points each against Mayville.
- The Bison return four of their top scorers from last season.
- Forward Reilly Jacobson averaged 11.6 points and 6.7 rebounds per game.
- Sarah Jacobson, no relation to Reilly, averaged 10.5 points and 4.5 assists a game.

HOME COOKING

Only two of UNH's eight games in November are at home. In contrast, the Wildcats play four of their five December games in Lundholm Gymnasium. The November home games are against Sacred Heart on Sunday, Nov. 18 at 1 p.m. and against Bryant University on Sunday, Nov. 25 at 1 p.m.

UNH plays home games against the University of New England on Thursday, Dec. 6 at 7 p.m.; against Holy Cross on Sunday, Dec. 9 at 1 p.m.; against Dartmouth on Friday, Dec. 21 at 11 a.m. and against Princeton on Saturday, Dec. 29 at 1 p.m.

The Wildcats open the America East portion of the schedule with a game at Maine on Wednesday, Jan. 2. They play their first home league game against play Binghamton on Saturday, Jan. 5 at 1 p.m.

HOW YOUNG IS YOUNG?

So just how young are these Wildcats?

UNH has one senior on the roster with three juniors, two sophomores and seven freshmen.

The average age of the Wildcats on opening day, Nov. 9, is 19 years, eight months and 12 days.

THE FRONT COURT

Junior Ashley Storey, 6-foot-3, returns to lead the team in the frontcourt. Storey started 17 games her freshman year and was named to the America East All-Rookie team after averaging 5.4 points and 3.4 rebounds. She averaged 4.9 points and 4 rebounds as a sophomore before missing last season.

"We expect a lot from Ashley," Magarity said. "She's come back much stronger and on the court she hasn't missed a beat. We're going to rely on her to rebound and score. She can score in a lot of different ways and can run the floor very well for a big kid."

Sophomore Maggie Ahearn, 6-foot-2, sat out last season after transferring to UNH from Providence College. She played five games as a freshman at Providence.

Storey and Ahearn are joined up front by three freshmen: 6-foot Faith Bonett, 6-foot-2 Ivy Gogolin and 6-foot-3 Mary Foster.

THE BACKCOURT

Sophomore Amanda Torres, 5-foot-7, is the lone returning starter from last season.

"Amanda had a great freshmen year and gained a lot of valuable experience when she ended up as the starting point guard," Magarity said. "She needs to step up even more with her leadership this year. She pushes the ball in transition and gets the team going. She's very aggressive off the bounce and her first step is really quick and her outside shooting continues to improve."

Alli Gribbin, a 5-foot-11 senior captain, junior Caroline Soucy, 5-foot-9, and junior Sarah Clement, 5-foot-8, are the upper classmen in the backcourt.

The freshmen guards are 5-foot-6 Kari Brekke, 5-foot-9 Kali Grimm, 5-foot-10 Mariah Gonzalez and 5-foot-5 Sarah Serbascewicz.

GOING TO SEE THE GOLDEN GOPHERS

The opener at the University of Minnesota marks the head coaching debut of former Golden Gopher and WNBA standout Lindsay Whalen and sold out 14,625-seat Williams Arena weeks ahead of the game.

"They have a commemorative t-shirt made for coach Whalen," Magarity said. "She's obviously a living legend in Minnesota. Having her back is really exciting for the Minnesota program. It's kind of neat to be a part of that. I think we're really lucky that we have that opportunity and we're going to look at it that way, as just living in the moment and having fun and anything can happen. First game of the year and you never know."

UNH freshman Kali Grimm is from Norwood Young America, Minn. "That will be really special," Magarity said. "I think Kali's going to bring a lot of people. It's going to be an experience, for sure."

THE COACH

Maureen Magarity, entering her ninth year as head coach, has led UNH to winning seasons in each of the last two and four of the last five seasons.

She guided the team to a record-smashing mark of 26-6 overall and 15-1 in America East in 2016-17. The 26 wins were three more than the Wildcats had ever won in a season and the league record was the team's best ever and earned the school's first America East women's basketball regular season championship.

Along the way, the team set a school record with 13 consecutive wins.

UNH went 19-12 overall and 9-7 in the league last year. The 45-18 overall record over the last two seasons was the top mark for any two-year stretch in program history.

Magarity has a 130-112 record through her eight seasons and stands fourth in all-time wins at UNH. She is three wins out of the third spot and six out of the No. 2 spot on the list.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

While the UNH women's basketball team is facing Minnesota and North Dakota State for the first time, it's not the first time UNH teams have squared off with the Golden Gophers and Bison.

Among the encounters:

- The UNH women's hockey team beat Minnesota, 4-1, in the semifinals of the American Women's College Hockey Alliance tournament in 1998.
- The Wildcats went on to win the AWCHA title, before the NCAA sponsored the event, with a 4-1 win over Brown.
- The Minnesota men's hockey team beat UNH, 5-1, in the NCAA championship game in 2003 in Buffalo.
- UNH fell at North Dakota State in the semifinals of the NCAA Division I FCS tournament on Dec. 20, 2013.
- The Bison went on to win the national championship. They have won six of the last seven FCS national titles.

MAUREEN MAGARITY

HEAD COACH - NINTH SEASON

MARIST '03

Maureen Magarity (Marist '03) is entering her 9th season as the head coach of UNH women's basketball. She currently sits in fourth place all-time in career wins with 130. Through eight seasons, she has posted more wins than any other UNH coach in that span of time.

In the 2017-18 season, the team posted a 19-12 overall record, 9-7 in conference play (.613 win percentage). This was tied for her second highest winning percentage as head coach. They were also an impressive 9-4 at Lundholm Gymnasium. The Wildcats had a huge America East Conference Quarterfinal win against Stony Brook 71-54 at Cross Insurance Arena in Portland, Maine. They lost in the semifinals to Maine, the eventual America East Champions. During the regular season, the 'Cats took both Xavier and Boston College to overtime on the road and even led the games late in the second half.

Magarity led the UNH women's basketball team to the best season in program history in 2016-17, her seventh season as head coach.

The Wildcats compiled a long list of superlatives and accomplishments under Magarity. After being picked to finish sixth in the America East pre-season poll, the Wildcats earned their first-ever America East regular season championship, put together the program's best won-loss record and crushed the previous record for wins in a season.

Magarity directed the team to a 26-6 record. The previous best mark for wins was 23. The Wildcats hit the 20-win mark for only the third time in program history and the first since the 1983-84 season. Along the way, the Wildcats broke the school record for consecutive wins with 13 and they won 19 of their last 20 regular season games. UNH's 15-1 record in America East games was also a program best.

Led by Magarity, the Wildcats posted the second-best turnaround in NCAA Division I in 2016-17 as they bounced back from a 12-18 season in 2015-16.

Magarity and members of her team earned numerous awards over the course of the highly successful season. Magarity was named America East Coach of the Year, only the second Wildcat coach to be so honored and the first since 1993-94. She was also a finalist for the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Coach of the Year Award.

Under Magarity's tutelage, junior center Carlie Pogue was named America East Player of the Year. She was the second Wildcat to receive the award and first since 1988-89. Pogue was also named First-Team All-Conference in America East. In addition, junior forward Kat Fogarty was named Second-Team All-Conference and junior guards, Brittnei Lai and Olivia Healy were named Third-Team All-Conference.

Among the many highlights of the season was a 50-44 win over Maine in Lundholm Gymnasium on Jan. 19. That victory gave Magarity 100 wins as a head coach. She finished the season with a 111-100 record as coach of the Wildcats.

Magarity became the sixth head coach in program history in May 2010 and the youngest coach of a Division I team – men's or women's – in the country.

Magarity has quickly made a positive impact on the program with three winning seasons in her first six years as head coach.

Magarity completed her sixth year as head coach of the University of New Hampshire women's basketball team during the 2015-16 season. One of UNH's top players in program history, Elizabeth Belanger, finished her career in style led by Magarity. Belanger finished her career with 1,453 points and 703 rebounds. She ranks fifth all-time in scoring, seventh in rebounding, and is one of only three Wildcats to eclipse 1,400 points and 700 rebounds.

UNH finished the 2014-15 season with an overall record of 17-12 and 9-7 against America East opponents. The Wildcats finished the season fourth in the league standings and reached double digit wins for the fourth consecutive year. The Wildcats garnered four America East All-Conference accolades for the second straight year, the most the program has received since the 2001-02 season. Led by First Team honoree Elizabeth Belanger, the junior guard was joined by All-Academic and All-Defensive Team mention Kaylee Kilpatrick, Third Team honoree Ariel Gaston and All-Rookie Team member Carlie Pogue.

In 2013-14, Magarity led UNH to a 19-12 record and 12-4 in America East play, including a postseason appearance and the most wins (19) in over 16 years. During the 2013-14 season, Magarity guided the Wildcats to six consecutive wins and an 8-1 start to conference play, the best nine game conference stretch in program history. The Wildcats reached the America East Championship semifinal for the second consecutive year, which UNH has not accomplished since the 1988 and 1989 conference tournaments. New Hampshire again led the America East Conference in free throw percentage for the fourth consecutive season, powered by the program's most efficient free throw shooter, Kelsey Hogan. The Wildcats had four student-athletes receive all-conference accolades. The award winning quartet consisted of

First Team selection Hogan followed by Second Team mention Corinne Coia, Third Team honoree Elizabeth Belanger and All-Academic recipient Kaylee Kilpatrick.

Despite missing 14 games due to maternity leave during the 2012-13 season, Magarity guided the Wildcats to its first America East Championship semifinal appearance since 2005. Under the direction of Magarity, Hogan made the game-winning 3-pointer at the buzzer to defeat Stony Brook University, 49-46, in the conference quarterfinals. The Wildcats had three representatives on the all-conference team, led by Second Team selections Cari Reed and Morgan Frame. Belanger garnered All-Rookie honors, the 12th Wildcat in program history to accomplish the feat.

In just her second year at the helm in Durham, Magarity guided the Wildcats to their second postseason appearance (beyond conference postseason play) in the program's 37-year history when UNH advanced to the 2012 Women's Basketball Invitational. New Hampshire finished the year with a 16-14 overall record to mark the team's first winning season since 2006 and most wins since 2002. In comparison, UNH was a combined 33-87 the four years prior to her arrival. Magarity earned a B.A. in Communications and Public Relations with a minor in Psychology from Marist College in 2003. In addition, she earned an M.P.A. in Public Administration while at Marist in 2005.

As a player, Magarity served as team captain her junior and senior seasons and led the Red Foxes to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2004. She garnered two All-MAAC Second Team selections, and was a 2004 MAAC All-Tournament Team choice. Magarity earned two MAAC Scholar-Athlete awards (2002, 2004) and received the James Pizzani Award for dedication and loyalty as a senior.

Before transferring to Marist, she played one season at Boston College. While at BC, the Eagles reached the semifinals of the preseason WNIT and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2000.

Magarity is a member of the WBCA and is a recent 2012 graduate of the WBCA Center for Coaching Excellence seminar.

Magarity, her husband Brendan, their three-year old daughter Charlotte and ten-month old daughter Caroline, reside in Nottingham, N.H.
