SIX THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

Minnesota heads to Wisconsin this week for a Border Battle against the Badgers. Wisconsin leads the all-time series 61-60-8 and the teams have traded road wins in the last two matchups. Minnesota won 37-15 in 2018 at Wisconsin and the Badgers prevailed 38-17 in Minneapolis last season. Minnesota's 2018 win was its first in the series since 2003 and first in Madison since 1994. The teams play for Paul Bunyan's Axe after previously playing for the Slab of Bacon.

Tanner Morgan did not throw a touchdown in Minnesota's 34-31 win against Purdue (Gophers rushed for five scores), ending his streak of consecutive games with a touchdown pass at 18. Morgan's 18 straight games with a touchdown pass is a school record and spanned from Dec. 26, 2018 to Nov. 13, 2020. Morgan threw 36 touchdowns during the steak and Minnesota was 13-5 during that time.

Mohamed Ibrahim is averaging 170.3 rushing yards per game, which ranks second in the nation and first for anyone who has played at least five games. He ranks 10th the nation in rushing yards (817) despite playing in only five games. The nine people above him have all played in eight or more games and the next closest individual who has played in only five games is D'vonte Price of FIU, who is ranked 39th with 581 yards. Ibrahim ranks tied for fourth nationally in rushing touchdowns (13) and everyone ahead of him or tied with him has played in at least seven games.

4 Mohamed Ibrahim has 11 career 100-yard rushing games, which includes a current streak of six in a row (rushed for 140 yards or more in 2020 Outback Bowl and first five games of the 2020 season). Ibrahim's six-game streak is

tied for the second-longest in program history with Laurence Maroney (11/13/04 - 9/24/05). Maroney is the school record holder as well, rushing for 100 yards or more in seven straight games from 12/31/03 - 10/9/04.

Mohamed Ibrahim leads the Big Ten in rushing attempts (155), rushing yards (817), rushing touchdowns (13) and scoring (78). Ibrahim's 13 touchdowns have covered a collective 41 yards (longest of the year is 16 yards and he has seven 1-yard touchdown runs). His 29 career touchdowns (9 in 2018, 7 in 2019 and 13 in 2020) rank tied for sixth in school history with Rodney Smith. The school single-season record for rushing touchdowns is 18 and was set by Gary Russell in 2005 when Minnesota played 12 games. Ibrahim's 13 touchdowns ranks tied for fourth in school single-season history with David Cobb (2014), Darrell Thompson (1987) and Jim Perkins (1976). Ibrahim has 155 rushes this year, which means he is averaging a touchdwon every 11.9 rushes.

Minnesota has attempted only two field goals this year.
Brock Walker was good from 29 yards vs. Michigan and
25 yards at Maryland. Minnesota opponents have made only 2
of 8 FGs this year (Michigan 0-3, Maryland 1-2, Purdue 1-3).

TCF BANK STADIUM

Minnesota is 48-32 at TCF Bank Stadium. The Gophers opened TCF with a 20-13 win against Air Force in 2009, but then dropped to 7-13. Since Nov. 26, 2011, Minnesota is 41-19 at home in its last 60 games.

Minnesota is 16-8 at TCF Bank Stadium under Coach Fleck.

TCF Bank Stadium has hosted Gopher Hockey, MNF, an NHL game, international soccer, MLB All-Star concert, U2, Rolling Stones, Beyonce, One Direction, Luke Bryan and Florida Georgia Line. The Minnesota Vikings and Minnesota United also played seasons on campus while their stadiums were being constructed.



HEAD COACH // FOURTH SEASON

P.J. Fleck was named head football coach at Minnesota on January 6, 2017. Fleck, 39, is the 30th head coach in the program's history. He has a career record of 55-40 and is 25-18 at Minnesota.

In 2019, Fleck led Minnesota to unprecedented heights as the Gophers won 11 games for the first time since 1904. Minnesota also won seven Big Ten games for the first time in school history, beat two top-10 teams, won a Jan. 1 bowl game and ended the season ranked No. 10.

Fleck was voted Big Ten Coach of the Year by his fellow conference head coaches and was named AFCA Region 3 Coach of the Year. He was also named a finalist for the George Munger Award, Dodd Trophy, Eddie Robinson Award, Bear Bryant Award and AFCA National Coach of the Year.

Minnesota won four Big Ten games by at least 20 points for the first time since 1934 and beat No. 5 Penn State at home and No. 9 Auburn in the Outback Bowl. This was the first time that Minnesota beat two top 10 teams in the same season since 1956. It was also the first time that Minnesota won a Jan. 1 bowl game since 1962.

The Penn State win was Minnesota's first win against a top-five team since it beat No. 2 Penn State on the road in 1999. It was Minnesota's first home win against a top-five team since it beat No. 1 Michigan 16-0 in 1977. The Outback Bowl victory against Auburn was Minnesota's best ranked nonconference win in school history.

The Gophers ascended to No. 7 in the AP Poll, which was the team's highest ranking since it was No. 5 on Nov. 19, 1962. Minnesota was also ranked No. 8 in the College Football Playoffs, which is its highest CFP ranking in school history. The Gophers ended the year ranked No. 10, which was their best ranking to end a season since 1962.

Minnesota averaged 34.1 points per game, which was the third most in school history. The Gopher defense allowed only 306.6 yards per game, which was the fewest since 1977.

Minnesota was led on offense by quarterback Tanner Morgan (All-Big Ten Second Team), running back Rodney Smith (All-Big Ten Second Team) and receivers Tyler Johnson (All-Big Ten First Team) and Rashod Bateman (All-Big Ten First Team). Johnson and Bateman became the first teammates ever to both be named All-Big Ten First Team wide receivers.

Morgan set a slew of single-season school records, including passing yards, passing touchdowns and consecutive games with a touchdown. Smith rushed for more than 1,000 yards and became Minnesota's career leader in all-purpose yards. Johnson set single-season school records in receptions, receiving yards and receiving touchdowns and left Dinkytown as the school's career record holder in receiving yards and touchdowns. Bateman was named Big Ten Receiver of the Year and was one of 12 semifinalists for the Biletnikoff Award as he set program records for a sophomore in receiving yards and touchdowns.

Minnesota's defense was paced by Antoine Winfield Jr. (All-Big Ten First Team) and Carter Coughlin (All-Big Ten Second Team). Winfield was named the program's seventh Unanimous All-American and was one of five finalists for the Bronko Nagurski Award, which is presented to the best defensive player in the nation. He led Minnesota in tackles and tied a school modern-era record with seven interceptions. Coughlin ended his career as one of the best to ever wear the Maroon and Gold. He ranks third all-time in sacks and fourth in tackles for loss.

Off the field, Minnesota had 53 players named Academic All-Big Ten and Blaise Andries and Sam Renner were named Academic All-Americans.

In 2018, Fleck led Minnesota to a 7-6 record and regular-season wins against Wisconsin, Purdue, Indiana, Fresno State, Miami (Ohio) and New Mexico State. The Gophers beat Georgia Tech 34-10 in the Quick Lane Bowl and the 24-point margin of victory was the largest bowl win in school history.

Minnesota also made history when it won the final game of the regular season (Wisconsin) and its bowl game (Georgia Tech), as that was the first time ever that the Gophers won the final game of the season and a bowl game.

Under Fleck, a young Minnesota team beat rival Wisconsin for the first time since 2003 and for the first time on the road since 1994 to reclaim Paul Bunyan's Axe. The Gophers also downed Purdue's potent offense, as they held the Boilers to a season low in points (10) and yards (233). Minnesota also beat Fresno State, which finished the season ranked No. 18, to give the Bulldogs one of their two defeats om the season. The win against Fresno State also marked the first time that Minnesota beat a team ranked in the final AP poll since 1999.

The Gophers had 112 players on the roster and 58 (51.7%) were freshmen, which was the most in the nation in 2018. The Gophers had 78 under-classmen (69.6%), which ranked tenth in college football.

Fleck played two freshmen quarterbacks (Zack Annexstad, Tanner Morgan) and both threw for more than 1,200 yards and seven touchdowns. Minnesota's two leading rushers (Mohamed Ibrahim, Bryce Williams) were both freshmen and three of Minnesota top-four receivers (Rashod Bateman, Chris Autman-Bell, Demetrius Douglas) were freshmen. On defense, freshman Terell Smith led Minnesota with eight pass breakups.

Minnesota set a program record as eight Gophers were named Big Ten Player of the Week, and Tyler Johnson became the first Minnesota receiver ever to record 78 catches, 1,169 yards (single season school record) and 12 (single season school record) touchdowns in a season.

In 2017, Fleck led a young and inexperienced Gopher squad, as 49 of Minnesota's 110 players (44.5%) were freshmen or redshirt freshmen and 76 (69%) were underclassmen. Fleck guided Minnesota to a 5-7 record and those five wins were the most by a first-year Gopher head coach new to the program since the legendary Murray Warmath won seven games in 1954.

Fleck won his Gopher debut against Buffalo, which made him the school's first head coach to win his debut since John Gutekunst in 1986 (before Fleck, Minnesota's six most recent head coaches all lost their first game). Minnesota then posted a dominating 48-14 win at Oregon State, which made Fleck the first Gopher coach to win a true road opener since 1954 when Warmath and the Gophers won 46-7 at Pittsburgh.

Minnesota's 34-point win at Oregon State was the Gophers' tenth largest margin of victory in a road game since 1920 and largest since 2006. The 48 points were the most the Gophers scored on the road since they beat Northwestern 49-21 in 1980.

Minnesota posted three 30-point wins in 2017, as it beat Oregon State by 34, Nebraska by 33 and Middle Tennessee by 31. The last time Minnesota won three games by 30 points in the same season was 2005 when it started the year with three straight with three straight 30-point wins The Gophers beat Nebraska 54-21 in Fleck's first season. The 54 points were the most that the Gophers scored in a Big Ten game since they beat

The Gophers beat Nebraska 54-21 in Fleck's first season. The 54 points were the most that the Gophers scored in a Big Ten game since they beat Indiana 63-26 in 2006. The 54 points were the 14th most scored by Minnesota since 1946 and the fifth most against a Big Ten opponent in the same timeframe.

Off the field, Fleck and his team can often be found at the University of Minnesota Masonic Children's Hospital and annually host a diaper drive during training camp and a turkey drive during Thanksgiving to give back to the community. Minnesota has also hosted canned food drive and school supplies drive under Fleck. In the classroom, Minnesota has posted program record GPAs under Fleck, which included a school record 3.21 in the 2019 fall semester.

Fleck came to Minnesota after spending four years as the head coach at Western Michigan, where he was 30-22 overall and 21-11 in the Mid-American Conference. While leading the Broncos, Fleck authored one of the most memorable turnarounds in college football history. The Broncos were 1-11 in his first year in 2013, but ended the 2016 season with a No. 12 ranking, a 13-1 record, a conference championship and a berth in the Cotton Browl

The Broncos were 12-0 in the 2016 regular season and posted wins against Big Ten opponents Northwestern and Illinois. Fleck then led his team

to a 29-23 win against Ohio in the Mid-American Conference championship game before ending the season with a narrow bowl game defeat to

Fleck was named MAC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2016 and in 2016 he the Broncos to their first MAC Championship since 1988

Earning FBS Region 3 Coach of the Year from the American Football Coaches Association. Fleck was also named a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award and the George Munger Award after Western Michigan became the first team in MAC history to win each of its eight league games

Fleck turned Western Michigan into a pipeline for the NFL as well. In 2016, the Broncos had Willie Beavers (121st overall to the Minnesota Vikings) and Daniel Braverman (230th overall to the Chicago Bears) taken in the NFL Draft.

In the 2017, Fleck saw three of his former players selected from Western Michigan in Corey Davis (fifth overall to the Tennessee Titans), Taylor

Moton (64th overall to the Carolina Panthers) and Keion Adams (248th overall to the Pittsburgh Steelers). Davis, who was the first Consensus All-American in Western Michigan history, caught 91 passes for 1,427 yards and 18 touchdowns in 2016. He ended his career with 5,212 yards in four seasons, which makes him the Football Bowl Subdivision all-time career receiving record holder. Davis joined Randy Moss as the only Mid-American Conference receiver to be drafted in the first round.

Off the field, Western Michigan had a program-record seven student-athletes named to the 2016 MAC Distinguished Scholar Athlete team and the Bronco team posted a 3.14 program GPA in Fleck's last semester at the school.

Prior to his time at Western Michigan, Fleck served as the wide receivers coach for the NFL's Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 2012 and coached the receivers at Rutgers from 2010-11. He coached receivers and was the recruiting coordinator at Northern Illinois in 2009 and tutored the receivers for the Huskies from 2007-08. Fleck's coaching career began at Ohio State as a graduate assistant in 2006.

Fleck played receiver at Northern Illinois from 1999-2003 and helped lead the Huskies to a No. 10 ranking, a 10-2 record and wins against Maryland, Alabama and Iowa State in his final season. He ranks in the top five in Northern Illinois history in career receptions (179) and receiving vards (2.162). Fleck holds the school record for punt returns (87) and ranks second in punt return vards (716). He earned First Team All-Mid-American Conference in 2003 and was named Academic All-MAC and Second Team CoSIDA Academic All-American. He graduated in 2004 with a bachelor's degree in elementary education.

Fleck played the 2004-05 seasons with the NFL's San Francisco 49ers. He signed with the 49ers as a free agent in 2004 and spent most of his time on the practice squad before seeing action against New England late in the season. He spent the 2005 season on the injured reserve roster and in 2006 he stopped playing professionally and started his coaching career.

Fleck and Michigan's Jim Harbaugh are the only Power Five conference coaches who both played and coached in the NFL. Fleck, Harbaugh and East Carolina's Scottie Montgomery are the only coaches in the FBS who have played and coached in the NFL.

Fleck and his wife, Heather, have four children, Gavin, Carter, Paisley (P.J.) and Harper.

Everyone, not just athletes and athletic teams can share, use and live the ROW THE BOAT lifestyle in their personal and professional lives. By applying ROW THE BOAT, one can have the proper perspective to overcome adversity and humble success by living a lifestyle dedicated to serving and giving.

FUTURE: When rowing a boat, as in life, you aren't able to see what is coming your way. Your back is actually facing the future, unable to see what's coming next. Facing the opposite direction can be a very scary and uncomfortable position to be in. However, as in life, worrying about the future only prohibits you from being your absolute best in the present. You aren't able to control the future, but you can control how you react and prepare for it with every stroke you take.

PRESENT: You are rowing in the present, which is the ONLY thing you can actually control while rowing a boat. You determine whether you take your oar out of the water or keep rowing. You control whether you ROW fast or slow, confident or hesitant, efficient or rushed and whether you ROW for yourself or others! If you stop rowing, you will not go anywhere. As a team, you control whether all of you want to ROW together with purpose, or ROW because you have to. If you ROW on just one side of the boat, you will go in circles. MINNESOTA'S MORGAN

■ Tanner Morgan was named All-Big Ten Second Team last year after setting school records for passing yards (3,253), touchdowns (30), completion percentage (66.0%), yards per game (250.2), TD-INT ratio (4.28) and pass efficiency rating (178.7). Morgan is 17-7 as a starter and he ranks fourth in school history in touchdown passes (43), sixth in passing yards (5,687), eighth in completions (375) and 10th in passing attempts (598).

NEAR PERFECTION

Tanner Morgan played two of the best games in Big Ten history last year, as he completed 21-of-22 passes (95.45%) for 396 yards and four touchdowns at Purdue and 18-of-20 passes (90%) for 339 yards and three touchdowns against Penn State. Florida State's Jameis Winston was the only other quarterback to have two games with 90% completion percentage, doing so during his Heisman Trophy-winning campaign in 2013. Morgan's 95.45 completion percentage at Purdue is the best mark in Big Ten history for any quarterback who attempted 15 or more passes.

BATEMAN'S BACK

Rashod Bateman announced on Aug. 4 that he was forgoing his remaining eligibility at Minnesota because of personal health concerns surrounding COVID-19. However, he opted back in after the Big Ten announced its safety guidelines for the 2020 season and on Sept. 30 his eligibility was restored by the NCAA.

AGENT ZERO

Rashod Bateman set Minnesota freshman and sophomore receiving records wearing No. 13, but is wearing No. 0 in 2020. Bateman is the first Gopher ever to wear No. 0 and switched from No. 13 to No. 0 because there is zero tolerance for racism in Minnesota's culture and it is a call to action to end racism in our society.

ALL-AMERICAN RECEIVER

▶ Rashod Bateman has played in 31 games for Minnesota and is one of the best to ever wear the Maroon and Gold. He has 147 career catches (6th in school history) for 2,395 yards (6th in school history) and 19 touchdowns (fifth in school history). Bateman was named Third-Team All-American, All-Big Ten First Team, Big Ten Receiver of the Year and was a semifinalist for the Biletnikoff Award in 2019. He caught 60 passes for 1,219 yards (second most in a single season) and 11 touchdowns (tied for second most in a single season) last year.

RECORD SETTER

Rashod Bateman has caught at least one pass in all 31 games (fifth in school history) he has played in and has 10 career 100-yard receiving games (fourth in school history). He set school sophomore records for receiving yards (1,219) and touchdowns (11) and set school freshman records for receptions (51) and receiving yards (704).

BATEMAN'S BANK

▶ Rashod Bateman has totaled 620 receiving yards in his last five home games at TCF Bank Stadium. He opened this year with nine catches against Michigan for 101 yards, had eight catches for 111 yards against lowa and made four receptions for 59 yards against Purdue. He ended last season with 147 yards against Wisconsin and 203 yards against Penn State. His 203 yards against Penn State is a stadium record, while his 147 yards against Wisconsin is the second most ever for a Gopher at TCF Bank Stadium.

MIGHTY MO

Mohamed Ibrahim ranks ninth on Minnesota's career rushing list with 2,581 yards despite playing in only 26 games. Forced into a starting role because of injuries to Rodney Smith and Shannon Brooks in 2018, Ibrahim rushed 217 times for 1,160 yards (second most ever for a Gopher freshman) and nine touchdowns. He rushed for more than 100 yards in five games in 2018 to become the first Gopher freshman to do so since Laurence Maroney (five 100-yard games) in 2003 and set a freshman single-game record with 224 yards against Georgia Tech.

LAST SIX GAMES

Mohamed Ibrahim has rushed 175 times for 957 yards (5.46 average) and 14 touchdowns in his last six games. He ended last season with 140 yards and one touchdown against Auburn and then opened this season with 140 yards and two scores versus Michigan. Ibrahim then churned out 207 yards and four scores at Maryland and 224 yards and four touchdowns at Illinois. He also notched 144 rushing yards against lowa and 102 yards and three touchdowns against Purdue. He is the second Gopher ever to record six straight 100-yard games (Laurence Maroney did it twice and owns the school record of seven straight games with 100-yarads rushing).

ALL-PURPOSE YARDS

Mohamed Ibrahim set a career high with 282 all-purpose yards (224 rush, 31 receiving, 27 kick return) at Illinois. His 282 all-purpose yards ranks as the seventh most productive game in school history and are the most for a Gopher running back since Laurence Maroney had 333 (ranks second all-time in school history) versus Purdue in 2005.

MORE MO

Mohamed Ibrahim's three career 200-yard games are tied for first in school history. Ibrahim rushed a career high 41 times for 207 yards and four touchdowns at Maryland and rushed 30 times for 224 yards and four touchdowns at Illinois. Ibrahim became the first Big Ten back to rush for 200 yards and four touchdowns in consecutive games since Larry Johnson (Penn State, 2002). Ibrahim is only the second Gopher ever to record two consecutive 200-yard rushing games (Terry Jackson II in 2002 vs. Northwestern and Michigan State) and his eight touchdowns in two consecutive games is a school record. At Maryland, Ibrahim's four touchdowns all came in the first half, making him the second Gopher ever to rush for four touchdowns in one half. Minnesota's all-time rushing leader (and radio analyst) Darrell Thomson rushed for four second-half scores against Bowling Green in 1986.

MILESTONES

Rashod Bateman, Mohamed Ibrahim and Tanner Morgan all hit milestones this year. Bateman (receiving) and Ibrahim (rushing) eclipsed 2,000 career yards, while Morgan crossed 5,000. Bateman has 472 receiving yards this year and now has 2,395 career receiving yards, which ranks sixth all-time in school history. Ibrahim has 817 rushing yards this year and now has 2,581 career rushing yards, which ranks ninth all-time in school history. Morgan has thrown for 1,033 yards this season and now has 5,687 career passing yards, which ranks sixth in school history.

LITTLE, BUT A LOT

Minnesota lost only three seniors (Tyler Johnson, Rodney Smith and Shannon Brooks) on offense from last season, but all were significant contributors. Johnson is Minnesota's all-time leading receiver, while Smith is Minnesota's career record-holder for all-purpose yards and Brooks scored 22 career touchdowns.

RING THE BELL

▶ Chris Autman-Bell was Minnesota's No. 3 receiver each of the past two seasons, but has a larger role this year (14 catches, 315 yards, 1 TD, 22.5 yards/catch). He has played in 31 career games and has made 70 catches for 1,135 yards (25th in school history) and six touchdowns. He has caught at least one pass in 30 games and has made one catch in 25 straight games. He made 28 catches for 371 yards and five touchdowns in 2019 and made 28 catches (fourth all-time for a Minnesota freshman) for 449 yards (third all-time for a Minnesota freshman) in 2018. He also led the team with a 16.03 yards per catch average in 2018.

100-YARD GAME

Chris Autman-Bell recorded his first career 100-yard receiving game at Maryland when he caught four passes for 112 yards and one touchdown. He then set a career high in receiving yards with 129 against Purdue. His previous high prior to this season was 97 and came at Purdue in 2019.

GREEN LINE

Seth Green has played in 31 games, mostly as a Wildcat QB. He has rushed 111 times for 389 yards and 15 TDs. Green has completed 5-of-6 career passes for 37 yards (3 TDs) and has four career receptions (65 yards), which includes a 20-yard catch this year.

DRAFTED

Minnesota had five players (four defense, one offense) selected in the 2020 NFL Draft. The Buccaneers took Antoine Winfield Jr. and Tyler Johnson, while the Giants picked Carter Coughlin and Chris Williamson. The Packers took Kamal Martin. The five players are the most for the Gophers in the modern-day NFL Draft, which features seven rounds. Minnesota last had five players drafted in 1990, but that is when the draft had 12 rounds.

CONSISTENT VOICE

▶ Joe Rossi took over as Gopher defensive coordinator after Minnesota's 55-31 loss at Illinois in 2018. Since then, the Gophers are 16-6. In 2019, the Gophers ranked tenth in the nation in total defense, allowing only 306.6 yards per game (fewest amount since 1977). Minnesota, which allowed only 22.5 points per game last year, was ninth in the nation in passing yards allowed (184.2) and 23rd in rushing defense (122.4). The Gophers were 17th in interceptions (14) and 24th in first downs defense (229).

FAMILY ROOM DEFENSE

Minnesota's defense had to replace its top four tacklers from 2019. Minnesota's most experienced defensive position is its secondary, despite All-American safety Antoine Winfield Jr., leaving with two years of eligibility remaining. Minnesota returned Coney Durr and Benjamin St-Juste (was unavailable against lowa and Purdue), who each totaled 10 pass breakups in 2019. Jordan Howden, who made 57 tackles a year ago, returns at one safety spot and lanky sophomore Tyler Nubin (29 tackles) fills Winfield's spot. Veterans Justus Harris, Calvin Swenson (saw extensive action against Purdue), Phillip Howard (started vs lowa, Purdue) and Terell Smith provide depth.

LINED UP

Notre Dame grad transfer and lone returning starter Micah Dew-Treadway (1.0 TFL, 1 FF) anchors the rebuilt defensive line. Redshirt freshman DeAngelo Carter starts as well and has one sack and one interception - off of a Boye Mafe pass breakup - which he returned 21 yards at Maryland. Mafe, who was unavailable against Purdue, has 16 tackles, 3.5 sacks, two pass breakups and one forced fumble, while Esezi Otomewu has 13 tackles and one sack. Logan Richter, Noah Hickcox, Jalen Logan-Redding and Thomas Rush all saw extensive action versus Purdue.

IN THE MIDDLE

Mariano Sori-Marin leads a young group of linebackers. He made 42 tackles in 2019, as he saw extensive action in relief of an injured Kamal Martin. Sori-Marin has 29 tackles and three pass breakups this season. Josh Aune, tfreshman Cody Lindenberg and James Gordon have also started this year. Aune (game-sealing INT vs Purdue) has played in 18 career games, but mostly on special teams. Gordon has played in nine career games and so has fellow linebacker Donald Willis, who has played this year.

KICKERS, PUNTERS

► The Gophers return their starting long snapper in Brady Weeks and kicker in Michael Lantz. Lantz was second on the team in scoring last season with 71 points. Brock Walker added 15 points (3 FG, 6 PAT). Lantz and Walker have both kicked for Minnesota this year. Middle Tennessee State grad transfer Matthew Stephenson punted in the first two games for Minnesota, while 26-year old freshman Mark Crawford from Australia was not available. Crawford has punted in the last three games.

SOMETHING SPECIAL

Preston Jelen (5-10, 210) has turned into a special teams standout. He blocked a punt against Michigan and Minnesota scored two plays later (Morgan 14 yards to Kieft). The blocked punt was the first for the Gophers since 2018 (Justus Harris vs Indiana). Jelen also had three tackles on special teams at Maryland.

LAST 20

Minnesota is 15-5 in its last 20 games (wins against Auburn, Fresno State, Georgia Southern, Georgia Tech, Illinois (2X), Maryland, Nebraska, Northwestern, Penn State, Purdue (2X), Rutgers, South Dakota State and Wisconsin). Minnesota's 15-5 mark is tied with Iowa for second in the Big Ten behind Ohio State (19-1). Wisconsin is 14-6, while Penn State and Indiana are 12-8. Michigan is 11-9, while, Northwestern is 10-10 and Michigan State is 9-11. Nebraska and Illinois are both 8-12 and Purdue is 7-13. Maryland is 6-14 and Rutgers is 3-17.

11 WINS

Minnesota was one of only three Big Ten teams to win at least 11 games last season. The Gophers finished 11-2 and were joined in the 11-win category by Ohio State (13-1) and Penn State (11-2). Minnesota beat Penn State 31-26 and did not play Ohio State.

FRIDAY FOOTBALL

Minnesota played its third and final Friday game this year when it beat Purdue 34-31. Minnesota is 7-2 under head coach P.J. Fleck in non-Saturday games. It is 2-2 on Friday (wins: Indiana 2018, Purdue 2020; loss Maryland 2020, Iowa 2020), 2-0 on Wednesday (bowl wins against Auburn and Georgia Tech) and 3-0 on Thursday (beat Buffalo, New Mexico State and South Dakota State).

NEW COACHES

 P.J. Fleck hired three new assistants prior to the 2020 season in Mike Sanford Jr. (OC / QBs), Paul Haynes (Cornerbacks) and Chad Wilt (Defensive Line).

COACHING EXPERIENCE

Four of Minnesota's assistant coaches have head coaching experience. Mike Sanford Jr. (OC/QBs) was the head coach at Western Kentucky from 2017-18, while Paul Haynes (Cornerbacks) led Kent State from 2013-17. Joe Harasymiak (Defensive Backs, Safeties and Co-DC) was the head coach at Maine from 2016-18 and was named the 2018 FCS Coach of the Year. Clay Patterson (Tight Ends) was the head coach at Northeastern Oklahoma A&M College from 2016-17, earning conference coach of the year honors in 2017.

SPIRIT AWARD

Multiple-time cancer survivor Casey O'Brien is back for another season. O'Brien gave the keynote address at the Big Ten Football Kickoff Luncheon in July 2019 and then played against Rutgers and Maryland last season. He received the 2019 Disney Spirit Award for being college football's most inspirational figure.

CALLING CARD

Two hallmarks of a P.J. Fleck team have been controlling the clock and playing clean football. Minnesota ended 2019 ranked fourth in the nation in time of possession (34:12) and tied for fifth in fewest penalties per game (4.31). Minnesota has won the time of possession in every game this season and has taken less or the same number of penalites as its opponents in four games.

AWAY FROM HOME

▶ Minnesota is 8-2 in its last 10 games away from home.

100 YARDS

 Minnesota is 16-5 under Coach Fleck when it has a 100-yard rusher. However, it is 2-3 this year.

SCORING FIRST, UP AT HALF

Minnesota is 21-3 all-time under Coach Fleck when it scores first and 24-2 when it is leading at the half.

NONCONFERENCE WINS

 Minnesota has won a nation-leading 19-straight nonconference games. The Gophers last nonconference loss was to No. 2 TCU in 2015.
