## Weekend Info

Minnesota heads back south for the Auburn Tournament this weekend in Auburn, Ala. They will be the lone team from the Big Ten team at the tournament.

The Gophers will play their first game on Friday against Binghamton at 12:30 p.m. Minnesota will then play the host Auburn at 6 p.m. in their second game of the day. Saturday will be another double-header as Minnesota faces Georgia Southern at 10 a.m. and Auburn at 3:30 p.m. They will close out the weekend with another game against Binghamton at 9 a.m. on Sunday. Both games against Auburn can be watched on SEC Network +.

Binghamton is looking for their first win of the 2020 season and has an overall record of 0-5 after they were swept in the Aggie Classic their last time out.

Auburn is 9-7 going into the fourth week of the season and is coming off a 1-4 weekend at the Mary Nutter Classic.

Georgia Southern has got off to a 10-4 start to the season and competed in the Eagle Round Robin this past weekend where they went 2-2.

## Weekend Recap

The Gophers finished 3-2 at the Baylor Tournament. They beat Tulsa twice and Texas State once, but took losses against Texas State and Baylor.

Minnesota lost 3-2 to open the weekend against Texas State but bounced right back as Amber Fiser threw a no-hitter in an 11-0 victory in five innings against Tulsa. The Gophers took the rematch against Texas State on Saturday morning with a 4-0 victory. Later that day, they fell to the Baylor Bears in a 2-1, eight-inning battle. The Gophers finished the weekend strong with a 3-1 win over Tulsa.

Fiser has been named the Big Ten Pitcher of the Week for the eleventh time in her career after a dominant weekend. The 2019 All-American tossed a five-inning no-hitter against Tulsa on Friday and followed it up with a complete-game shutout against Texas State the following game. She took the loss in relief against Baylor but did not allow an earned run, as Baylor walked it off under international tiebreak rules.

MaKenna Partain shined defensively and booked herself the No. 7 spot on SportsCenter Top-10 Saturday night after a diving stop and back-handed flip to get the out at second base. The highlight clip has reached 90,000 views and was featured on SportsCenter and NBC Sports.

**Fiser's Finest**

Amber Fiser has already cemented herself as one of the top players in Gopher softball history and is making a case for one of the top players in all of NCAA softball. She is fifth all-time in program history in wins (77) and strikeouts (757). With UCLA's Rachel Garcia taking an Olympic redshirt, Fiser is the NCAA active leader in strikeouts.

In 2019, Fiser was named a First Team NFCA All-American, was a Honda Cup Award Finalist and was named the Big Ten Pitcher of the Year. She ranked third in the NCAA in wins, fifth in strikeouts and 12th in ERA. Her 31 wins on the season tied for second all-time in program history and 346 strikeouts were third all-time. She set a school record and matched a conference record with six Big Ten Pitcher of the Week awards. She also picked up two NFCA Division I Pitcher of the Week awards.

Fiser can't seem to get over the 13-strikeout mark. She has hit the impressive number seven times in her career including twice already in opening weekend. She tossed 20 strikeouts last weekend and is third in the NCAA in season strikeouts. The All-American tossed a no-hitter against Tulsa at the Baylor Invitational. Fiser pitched four complete-game one-hitters in 2019. She has thrown three no-hitters in her career, one in 2020 and two in 2018. Her last perfect game was at Purdue on Apr. 27, 2018.

**Run MaKenna, Run!**

MaKenna Partain has etched her name into Gophers history and has a chance to leave as one of the most productive offensive players in team history but has done so quietly when it comes to national attention. She has already made 190 career starts with the majority of her action coming at second base. She is fifth in career runs at 173 and seventh in career doubles at 47. Both records are in reach as Tyler Walker holds the record with 197 career runs and Kaitlyn Richardson has the doubles record with 64. Partain spent last season as the Gophers leadoff batter and broke the program single season record with 66 runs. She also set program and Big Ten record with five runs scored at Maryland on Mar. 23.

**Leading the Way**

Natalie DenHartog leads Minnesota in batting average (.439), runs (10), home runs (3), slugging percentage (.707) and on-base percentage (.574). The sophomore from Hopkins, Minn. has also been hit by seven pitches and ranks seventh in the country in HBPs per game.

**Pass the Pease, Please**

In the circle, Autumn Pease has impressed with five starts and a total of eight appearances. The sophomore transfer has tossed 36 strikeouts and has allowed only ten earned runs over 33 innings of work for a 2.12 ERA and 3-1 record. Pease was an instrumental piece in the upset over No. 5 Florida State. The sophomore tossed six innings of work in that Feb. 14 game and struck out six.

**Atta Kid!**

Freshman Sydney Strelow is batting .316 with five doubles, one home run, nine RBIs and has scored five runs this season. She has also drawn five walks and has been hit by one pitch for an on base percentage of .409 on the year. The freshman shined in Minnesota's victory against No. 5 Florida State. She launched her first career home run and followed it up with a seventh inning, two-out walk-off single to lift the Gophers to victory.

**Where in the World is Carlie Brandt!?**

Carlie Brandt has played seven positions (all but catcher and right field) in her Gophers career. She has found a home at shortstop in the early part of 2020 and has made a big impact.

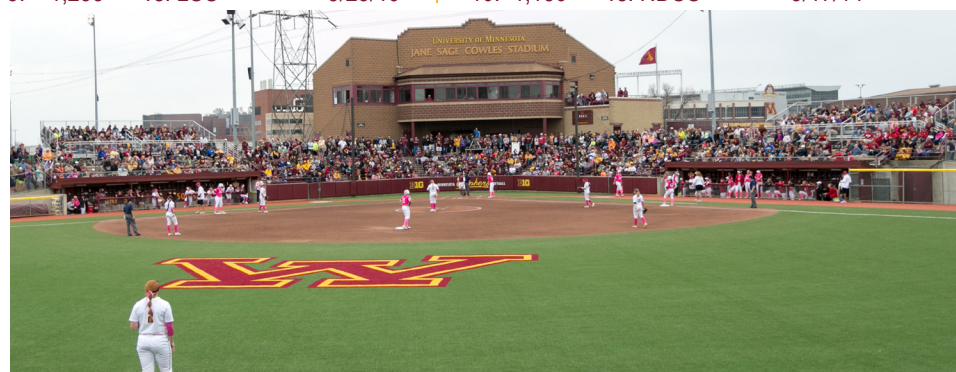

### JANE SAGE COWLES STADIUM

Jane Sage Cowles Stadium is in it's 21st season hosting the Minnesota softball program. In the same location as the Bierman Softball Complex, the field was reconstructed and renamed in 2000 thanks to a generous donation from Sage and John Cowles. The complex holds dimensions of 205 feet at the corners and 220 feet to straight-away center field. The facility has both grandstand (bench-back), stadium (box-chair) and with additional portable bleacher seating down the left field line Jane Sage Cowles Stadium can hold a capacity 1,450 fans.

In 2019, the Gophers became the first Big Ten team since Michigan in 2016 to advance to the Women's College World Series. They were the first team other than Michigan since Nebraska in 2013 to advance and became just the fifth Big Ten team going back to 1987 to make it to the WCWS.

Minnesota has placed themselves firmly at the top of the Big ten year-after-year with seven straight seasons in the top-3 including a regular season title in 2017. They have also made it to the Big Ten Tournament Championship game in five of the last six seasons including the last four straight and have won four titles in that span.

## HEAD COACH » JAMIE TRACHSEL

Jamie Trachsel enters her third season as the head coach of the University of Minnesota softball team after being named the Gophers' seventh head coach in program history on July 24, 2017.

Trachsel led the Gophers to historic heights in her second season leading the program. Minnesota finished the year with a 46-14 record and reached the Women's College World Series for the first time ever in the NCAA era. They rolled through the Minneapolis Regional with three wins, one over NDSU and two over Georgia. They followed with two victories over LSU in the first ever Minneapolis Super Regional. Trachsel coached five All-Big Ten honorees and five NFCA Great Lakes All-Region honorees. Under Trachsel's watch, Amber Fiser was also named the Big Ten Pitcher of the Year and a First Team All-American.

The Gophers closed out the 2019 season ranked No. 8 in both the USA Today/NFCA Top-25 Coaches Poll and the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top-25 Poll. The No. 8 ranking is the highest the Gophers have finished a season in either major poll. They also finished No. 7 in the NCAA RPI, which is not only the highest RPI to finish a season, but the highest at any point in program history. Trachsel and her staff were named the NFCA Great Lakes All-Region Coaching Staff of the Year.

The Gophers have also made history in the classroom under Trachsel. Their term GPA of 3.63 set in the spring of 2019 was the highest in program history. Eleven different players notched 2019 Academic All-Big Ten honors.

In her first season at the helm of the program, Trachsel led the Gophers to a 41-17 season, their third straight Big Ten Tournament title and sixth consecutive NCAA tournament. Four Gophers earned All-Region honors, four earned All-Big Ten and Kendyl Lindaman was named Big Ten Player of the Year while earning All-American honors. A notable win during the 2018 season was the Gophers upset win over No. 9 Arizona in Tucson Arizona on March 14. The Gophers snagged a 1-0 win in extras to mark just the second time in 30 seasons that the Gophers defeated Arizona and just the fourth win all time in the series. The Gophers closed out the season winning 21 of their final 24 games.

Trachsel came to Dinkytown from Iowa State, where she led the Cyclones for one year following six at the helm of perennial NCAA Tournament contender North Dakota State.

Trachsel arrived in Ames following 14 seasons at North Dakota State, including the final six as co-head coach. In those half-dozen seasons, NDSU compiled a 221-109 overall record (.670), a 98-19 mark (.838) in the Summit League and advanced to NCAA Regional play five times. The Bison won their conference regular-season championship and the tournament championship five times each with Trachsel as co-head coach.

North Dakota State won at least 30 games – including a school-record 45 in 2015 when it climbed as high as 41st in the NCAA Percentage Ratings Index (RPI) – for 10 straight seasons. The Bison advanced to the NCAA Regionals seven of the last eight years. The 2009 club won the Norman (Okla.) Regional to advance to the NCAA Super Regional in Tempe (Ariz.).

Her tenure with NDSU began with two seasons (2002-04) as a graduate assistant, followed by three (2005-07) as an assistant coach, three (2008-10) as associate head coach and the last six (2011-16) as co-head coach.

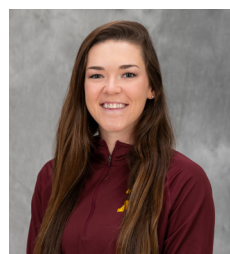

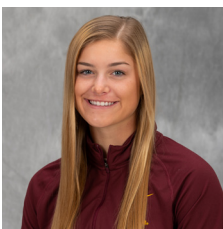
