OPENING TIP-OFF

- Minnesota (8-8, 1-3 B1G) is headed on the road to take on Wisconsin (3-11, 0-4 B1G) in a mid-week matchup on Wednesday night. The Jan. 12. matchup can be streamed on B1G+ and can be found on KFAN+ with Justin Gaard and Lynnette Sjoquist on the call.
- Minnesota's matchup with Wisconsin is the first of two meetings this season with the second coming later this month on Jan. 30, at Williams Arena. The last time the Gophers and Badgers faced off was on Feb. 14, 2021, when Kadi Sissoko dropped a team-high 20 points while Sara Scalia (17) and Jasmine Powell (15) also scored in double figures on the way to the win in Minneapolis. Wisconsin brings back three starters from that 68-63 loss to the Gophers with it's scoring leader Imani Lewis (27) not a part of those returners.



Deja Winters' 20 points vs. Maryland marks the fifth different Gopher to score 20 or more points in a game this season.

- The Golden Gophers are coming off a respectable performance against a top 10 team in Maryland (12-4, 4-1 B1G). Without All-Big Ten guard Jasmine Powell (family matter) and head coach Lindsay Whalen (appendectomy) the Gophers had strong performances from Deja Winters (20), Sara Scalia (19) and Kadi Sissoko (15) to hang with the high powered Terrapins. Carly Thibault-DuDonis served as acting head coach for the second straight game.
- Sara Scalia extended her double figures scoring streak to six with her performance against No. 10/9 Maryland. In her last six games Scalia has averaged an impressive 20.2 points per game, has shot 46.3 percent from three and has averaged 6.0 rebounds per game. This season Scalia ranks 13th in the Big Ten in scoring average (15.3) and is fifth in 3-point percentage at 42.2 percent and is third in threes made per game at 2.94 and has made the second most total threes at 47.
- As a team this season Minnesota has the second-best three-point field goal percentage in the Big Ten at 37.2 which is also good enough for 14th best in the NCAA. On average the Maroon and Gold make 8.6 threes per game, good enough for the 30th best mark in the nation and the third best in the conference. In total the team's 138 made threes is the most in the Big Ten and the 10th most in the country.
- Minnesota will welcome back guard Jasmine Powell on Wednesday as the junior has distributed the basketball at the best rate of her career so far this season. The junior guard is third in the Big Ten this season in assists per game at 5.7, good enough for the 22nd best rate in the country. She is one of just 10 players in the country to average 13.5 points per game and 5.7 assists per game, in that list, just three are on Power 5 teams, all of which are in the Big Ten conference.
- Since joining the starting lineup on Dec. 12, vs. Michigan, Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux has pushed her rebounding average significantly up, averaging 5.2 rebounds including an average of 3.2 on the offensive glass. She also has averaged 5.6 points per game while shooting 70 percent from the floor.
- On the road this season Powell has been Minnesota's steady scorer at 17.3 points per game, nearly four points higher than her season average. Minnesota's perimeter defense has been outstanding on the road, allowing just 26.9 percent on the road. On the flip side the Gophers have had no issues shooting from beyond the arc on the road, shooting 37.5 percent, nearly identical to their season average of 37.2.

- Laura Bagwell Katalinich: Native of Minnesota, won high school state championship on Williams Arena floor; previously played at Cornell and Penn
- Katie Borowicz: Joined Gophers as early enrollee on Jan. 2; graduated early from high school after signing NLI in November of 2020
- Caroline Strande: Won the Ms. Basketball in the state of Wisconsin over fellow Gopher Rylan Baker (West Bend, Wis.) of the University of Minnesota women's soccer program
- Erin Hedman: Used to figure skate competitively for 6-7 years
- Deja WInters: Was recruited by Carly Thibault-DuDonis while she was at Eastern Michigan
- Bailey Helgren: Was a 'Court Kid' at head coach Lindsay Whalen's games when she played for the Golden Gophers in the early 2000s
- Maggie Czinano: Her sister Monika, is currently a senior on the lowa women's basketball team and started all 30 games for the Hawkeyes last season
- Gadiva Hubbard: Cousin, Briante Weber, played at VCU and has spent time with five different NBA teams
- Alanna Micheaux: Wears the No. 54 because it was her mother's number in college when she played at Kansas
- · Kayla Mershon: Native of Minnesota, won high school state championship on Williams Arena floor; spent first two seasons at Nebraska
- Jasmine Powell: Personal goals are to win an NCAA championship and to play in the WNBA
- Sara Scalia: Grew up going to Gophers games; parents had courtside season tickets to Minnesota Lynx while Lindsay Whalen was a player
- Klarke Sconiers: Went to the same high school (Christ the King) as women's basketball legends Sue Bird and Chamique Holdsclaw
- Kadi Sissoko: First Gophers player ever from France; spent freshman season at Syracuse
- Alexia Smith: First five-star recruit for either the men's or women's programs at Minnesota since at least the 2011 class
- Caroline Strande: Finished fifth in Wisconsin state high school history in career points; also owns high school state record with 9 goals in one soccer game
- Kelly Curry: Was a freshman on the 2004 Final Four team, which was Lindsay Whalen's senior season; was previously an assistant at North Dakota State (2008-10) and Minnesota (2010-14) and most recently served as head coach at Macalaster College in Saint Paul (2014-18).
- Carly Thibault-DuDonis: Father, Mike, is the head coach of the WNBA's Washington Mystics, and he was the head coach of the Connecticut Sun when the team drafted Lindsay Whalen in 2004; brother, Eric, is the associate head coach of the Mystics; husband, Blake, is the head women's basketball coach at UW-River Falls.

FACING WISCONSIN

- Minnesota and Wisconsin meet for the 82nd time on Wednesday. It is the Gophers most played series, tied with lowa.
- Minnesota has two Wisconsinites on its roster in freshmen Erin Hedman (New Berlin; Eisenhower HS) and Caroline Strande (Racine; Racine Lutheran HS). Conversely, Wisconsin has two Minnesotans on its roster: freshman Sacia Vanderbpool from Byron, Minn. (Byron HS) and Sara Stapleton from Blaine (Centennial HS).
- Losers of two straight the Badgers have not won a game since Dec. 16, when the team defeated Illinois State 70-60 at the Kohl Center. Since then the team has also had two games canceled against Eastern Illinois and Purdue.
- Junior Julie Pospíšilová and sophomore Brooke Schramek rank among the top Big Ten players for most improved scorers. Pospíšilová ranks sixth, upping her scoring from 8.9 last season to 14.5 this season, an improvement of 5.6 points per game. Schramek ranks eighth, improving her scoring from 2.9 as a freshman to 7.0 this season.
- Head coach Marisa Moseley is familiar to Minnesota as she previously served as an assistant for the Golden Gophers from 2007-09 under then head coach Pam Borton. In two seasons the Gophers were 40-24 and 22-14 in the Big Ten, making the NCAA Tournament both years and winning a tournament game in 2009.
- Individually, Sydney Hilliard is fourth in the Big Ten in steals per game this season at 1.92 while she also ranks fourth in the conference in field-goal percentage at 56.3, which is 31st best in the NCAA. Katie Nelson plays the most minutes per game in the conference at 37.74, which is the ninth-highest rate in the country this season. Nelson also does a good job handling the ball for the Badgers, holding the fifth-best assist-to-turnover ratio in the Big Ten at 2.38 this season.
- As a team, Wisconsin's best statistic amongst Big Ten teams is the Badgers' sixth-best turnovers per game rate at 15 per game. The Badgers' are respectable in fewest fouls and fewest turnovers this season, both ranked seventh in the conference and are eighth in scoring defense at 66.4 per game.

WHAT'S ON THE LINE VS. WISCONSIN FOR THE GOPHERS

• Minnesota is looking to win its fourth straight game in the Border Battle series against the Badgers. Head coach Lindsay Whalen's Gophers are 5-1 all-time against Wisconsin in the first three years under the Gopher alum.

GOPHER NUMBERS TO WATCH

- After moving into the program top 10 in career threes, Sara Scalia now needs just four threes to pass Sari Noga (2010-14) for the eighth-most threes made at Minnesota. Scalia is also 10th in career threes attempted and is 49 away from moving into ninth at Minnesota.
- Gadiva Hubbard moved into eighth at Minnesota in total minutes played and is now 69 minutes away from moving to seventh all-time. Hubbard is also 19 points from passing Debbie Hunter (1979-93) for the 14th most points in program history.

POWELL LEADS GOPHERS TO FIRST BIG TEN WIN OF 2022

- Paced by Powell's 19 points, the Gophers also got 11 points from Kadi Sissoko, all coming in the fourth quarter, to keep Rutgers at bay in the wire-to-wire road victory.
- Without head coach Lindsay Whalen (appendectomy) it was Carly Thibault-Dudonis who filled in as acting head coach for the Gophers. Thibault-DuDonis and the rest of the Gophers' coaching staff led the Maroon and Gold to the program's first win at Rutgers (previously 0-6 in Piscataway).
- The Jan. 6, matchup between Rutgers and Minnesota

marked the first time in Big Ten history that both teams were coached by 'acting head coaches'

WHALEN IS A FIRST-TIME NOMINEE FOR BASKETBALL HOF

- After a legendary playing career, Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen was named a first-time nominee for the Basketball Hall of Fame in December.
- A press conference announcing the Finalists from the North American and Women's committee for the Class of 2022 will be held during NBA All-Star Weekend, which is scheduled for Fri., Feb. 18, in Cleveland, Ohio.

SCALIA NAMED BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

• After her incredible performance where she scored a career high 37 points and hit nine threes junior guard Sara Scalia was named the Big Ten Player of the Week for the first time in her career. Scalia, a two-time Freshman of the Week honoree and All-Big Ten Honoralbe Mention player, earned the distinction for the first time in her career.

SARA SCALIA'S HISTORIC NIGHT VS. OHIO

- Scalia is the first Gopher ever (men's or women's) to hit nine threes at Williams Arena, a building that opened 93 years ago in 1928.
- Scalia's 37 points are the most in program history without making a free throw.
- Scalia's 69.2 percent (9-of-13) shooting night from beyond the arc is the best percentage by any player in the NCAA this year when making nine or more threes.
- Scalia's nine threes tied her for the second most threes made against a non-conference opponent in Big Ten history and is the second most threes in a single game by any Gopher ever (men's or women's).
- Scalia's 37 points is the most any player has scored under head coach Lindsay Whalen.
- Scalia scored 13 points in the second quarter vs. Ohio and another 12 in the third quarter giving the Stillwater, Minn., native, five different quarters this season where she has scored 11 points or more. No other Gopher has scored more than 10 points in any other quarter this season.

DEJA WINTERS SCORES 1,000TH POINT VS. OHIO

 Graduate student Deja Winters got back on track offensively against Ohio and in doing so eclipsed the 1,000 point threshold for her career. Winters, who made stops at Seton Hall and North Carolina A&T before joining the Gophers, scored 16 points in the win and registered three blocks on the defensive end for the second time this season.

MICHIGAN RALLIES TO DEFEAT GOPHERS IN ANN ARBOR

- After leading at halftime on the road the Gophers were unable to hold off the No. 13/11 Michigan Wolverines at the Crisler Center.
- Jasmine Powell, a Michigan native, scored a team-high 19 points while fellow Michigan native Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux made her first career start in the road loss.

MICHEAUX NAMED BIG TEN FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

• For the first time in her young career Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux was honored by the Big Ten Conference for her performance. The Wayne, Mich., native, scored 23 points off the bench for the Gophers against UNC (12/1/21) to earn the distinction. On her 8-of-10 shooting, Micheaux secured the most points by a non-starter for the Golden Gophers since Gadvia Hubbard scored 28 points off the bench against Maryland in 2017.

SHORT-HANDED GOPHERS DROP B1G OPENER TO NEBRASKA

- Without All-Big Ten point guard Jasmine Powell (lower leg injury) the Golden Gophers nearly pulled off a win against Nebraska (9-0, 1-0 B1G) in the conference opener at Williams Arena.
- For the first time this season the Golden Gophers had multiple 20-point scorers with Kadi Sissoko (25) and Sara Scalia (20) leading the offense.
- The three-point loss to Nebraska marks the eighth consecutive meeting decided by 6 points or less dating back to 2014

MINNESOTA FALLS JUST SHORT IN B1G/ACC CHALLENGE

Despite Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux's career performance
of 23 points, the Gophers fell short against UNC in the
2021 B1G/ACC Challenge. Three Gophers scored in
double figures on the night with Deja Winters (17) and
Gadiva Hubbard (14) helping the Gophers put up the
most points this against the Tar Heels who came into
Wednesday's matchup with the second-best ranked
defense in the nation.

POWELL GOES OFF AGAINST UTSA IN 29-POINT WIN

- Junior guard Jasmine Powell erupted for 23 points and added eight assists and six rebounds to lead the Golden Gophers past the UTSA Roadrunners 81-52.
- Powell's 8 assists to just one turnover was the junior's best assist-to-turnover ratio performance since taking over the starting point guard role in 2019

GOPHER OFFENSE HAS BEST PERFORMANCE OF THE YEAR VS. BRADLEY

- Minnesota stopped Bradley (3-2, 0-0 MVC) in their tracks, holding the Braves, a 2021 NCAA Tournament team, to 31 percent from the floor in a 73-54 victory. Sara Scalia led the Golden Gophers with 19 points while Kadi Sissoko (12), Jasmine Powell (12) and Alanna Micheaux (10) all scored in double figures.
- The win over Bradley was head coach Lindsay Whalen's 50th win of her career

WINTERS MAKES BIG IMPACT AT BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS

• After five games consistently producing on the offensive end, graduate transfer Deja Winters moved into the starting lineup for the first time this season against Syracuse (11/21/21). Winters used the opportunity to drop 16 points on 5-of-10 shooting while hitting four triples. Winters went on to lead the Gophers on the offensive end at the Battle 4 Atlantis, scoring at a clip of 15.6 points per game while shooting 10-of-21 from three and posting an average of 2 steals and 1.3 blocks per game in the Bahamas.

GOPHERS CAN'T OVERCOME DEFICIT, DROP GAME TO OKLAHOMA IN BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS FINALE

- Deja Winters and Jasmine Powell both scored 18
 points for the Gophers in the loss against the Sooners
 with Winters' 18 points being a new season-high for the
 graduate studnet
- Oklahoma finished with a tournament high 40 threes in three games at the Battle 4 Atlantis with Taylor Robertson's 20 being an individual high.

SISSOKO DROPS CAREER-BEST DOUBLE DOUBLE VS. HER OLD TEAM AT THE BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS

- Kadi Sissoko scored 23 points and brought down a career-high 13 rebounds in the Gohpers' win over Syracuse in the consolation bracket at the Battle 4 Atlantis.
- Sissoko's nine offensive rebounds was also a career high, but more improtantly the Gophers got the sevenpoint win over the Orange.
- Sara Scalia also dropped another five threes in the win, making it the first time in the junior's career she hit five or more threes in consecutive games. The five threes was, at the time, the sixth time in Scalia's career she has hit

five or more from beyond the arc.

SCALIA SHOOTS WELL IN GOPHERS LOSS TO NO. 2 UCONN

- Sara Scalia did not shy away in the Gophers matchup with No. 2/2 UConn in the opening round of the first women's Battle 4 Atlantis. The junior nailed five threes and scored 17 points in Minnesota's 88-58 loss to the Huskies in the Bahamas.
- Scalia scored 15 points in the first half, and 12 in the second quarter. She scored 12-straight points for the Gophers in the second, all from beyond the arc. By the end of Scalia's hot shooting Minnesota had pulled themselves to back within one with the score at 31-30 with 4:54 left in the half. UConn responded, scoring 16 of the next 21 points in the game to take a 12-point lead into the locker room.

GOPHER OFFENSE COMES ALIVE IN WIN OVER AMERICAN

- The Golden Gopher bench came alive in the team's victory over American on Wednesday night. Laura Bagwell Katalinich led the Maroon and Gold off the bench with eight points while Deja Winters (7), Alanna Micheaux (6) and Alexia Smith (4) all contributed to the season-high effort from the reserves.
- Against American Kadi Sissoko led all scorers with 17 points after leaving the George Washington game with an injury. The newly masked Sissoko's 17 points was a season-high and her six made field goals tied her season high while also hitting a 3-pointer for the second consecutive game.
- Laura Bagwell Katalinich returned from a hip injury after missing the first three games of the season. In limited minutes the graduate student finished a perfect 4-for-4 from the floor, hitting timely shots and grabbing timely rebounds in the win over American highlighted by a buzzer-beating jumper at the end of the third quarter.

MINNESOTA DEFENSE MAKES HISTORY VS. GW

• Minnesota downed George Washington on Nov. 14 by a score of 48-32 in arguably the program's best defensive performance in team history. The Golden Gopher defense held the Colonials to just 19.2 percent shooting from the floor, the best in program history, and the 10 made field goals by the Colonials tied for the fewest made field goals allowed in a game in school history. Against George Washington the Gophers posted six different opponent-lows in the Whalen era, highlighted by the team's defensive field goal percentage.

POWELL GOES OFF IN 2ND HALF VS. ASU

- Against Arizona State (Nov. 12) Jasmine Powell scored all 21 of her points in the second half and in overtime to lead Minnesota to the win. She scored 10 points alone in the third quarter and connected on a career-high nine field goals in the win. Powell stuffed the stat sheet by grabbing a game-high nine rebounds, eight on the defensive glass, while also handing out five assists for the second-straight game.
- Another notable performance from Minnesota's first win of the season included Edina, Minn., native Bailey Helgren having a breakout game on the boards. She gathered eight rebounds, four on the offensive end, and had a steal and crucial second-half block. Helgren converted on her first bucket in the Maroon and Gold and played just under 30 minutes in the victory over the Sun Devils
- Scalia's streak of at least one 3-pointer made was snapped against Arizona State on Friday at 17 games.

GOPHERS INK A TOP 10 RECRUITING CLASS ON NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

- Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen announced the addition of four student-athletes that have signed National Letters of Intent to join the Minnesota women's basketball program for the 2022-23 season. Signing NLIs with the Golden Gophers are Mara Braun (Wayzata, Minn.), Amaya Battle (Hopkins, Minn.), Mallory Heyer (Chaska, Minn.) and Niamya Holloway (Eden Prairie, Minn.).
- Whalen on the signing class: "I am thrilled to announce this incoming recruiting class that includes four young women who exemplify what it means to be a Gopher," Whalen said. "As the highest ranked class in school history, we are not only proud of the basketball players that these young women are, but how they carry themselves in the community and in the state of Minnesota. They are going to make an impact that will last for years to come."
- As a group the 2022 Signing Day class of Braun, Battle, Heyer and Holloway is the best in program history. According to Jr. All Stars the Gophers bring in the No. 4 ranked class in the nation and, as of Oct. 31, ESPN had Minnesota as the No. 7 ranked class in the country.

SCALIA GOES OFF FOR 25 VS. JACKSONVILLE

• Minnesota's season opener turned out to be the Sara Scalia show against Jacksonville. The Stillwater, Minn., native, dropped a game-high 25 points in the game, the most by a Gopher in a season opener under head coach Lindsay Whalen. Scalia's afternoon was highlighted by her 14 points in the second quarter, the third most points in a second quarter in program history. Scalia also extended her streak of scoring in double figures to 14 games dating back to the 2020-21 season, which is the longest active streak on the team.

BOROWICZ UNDERGOES SEASON-ENDING SURGERY

- University of Minnesota head women's basketball coach Lindsay Whalen announced on Nov. 1, that sophomore guard Katie Borowicz (Roseau, Minn.) will miss the remainder of the season after undergoing surgery today to repair a non-athletic related injury.
- Borowicz was an early enrollee for the Golden Gophers last season and played in 14 games with one start. She had the highest 3-point percentage (.375) of any student-athlete on the roster with at least 30 attempts and shot a team-high 40 percent from beyond the arc in Big Ten play. Out of Roseau High School, Borowicz was a four-star recruit according to ESPN and was the 98th ranked player overall in the class.

WHALEN ENTERING FOURTH SEASON WITH GOPHERS

- Lindsay Whalen enters her fourth season as the head coach of the Golden Gophers with a record of 45-39 record overall and a 21-33 mark in Big Ten play.
- She is already fifth in program history for victories, while her win percentage is fourth best among those with at least 50 games coached.
- Whalen has coached one WNBA draft pick, one All-American, nine All-Big Ten honorees, two members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team, one Big Ten All-Defensive Team player and seven Academic All-Big Ten honorees.

GOPHERS FACE ONE OF B1G'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULES

- Minnesota finished the 2020-21 season 8-13 and 7-11 in Big Ten play and this season will play the toughest schedule in the Big Ten.
- The Maroon and Gold's 2021-22 schedule includes up to 13 NCAA Tournament teams from last season with Minnesota's opponent win percentage (.582 in 2020-21) being the highest among any other schedule in the Big Ten.
- The 2021-22 schedule includes up to 15 teams that finished in the AP Top 25 or were receiving votes, the most in the Big Ten.
- ullet 21 potential opponents last season had a record of .500 or better, the most in the Big Ten.

HUBBARD TAKES OVER NO. 13

- For the first time since 2004 a student-athlete at the University of Minnesota will wear the No. 13 for the women's basketball, that student-athlete is sixth-year senior Gadiva Hubabrd.
- "[Hubbard] stuck here all four years with me," Whalen said. "That's a number she wanted to wear, so I'm real proud she's going to wear it."
- Since Lindsay Whalen ended her playing career with the Golden Gophers in 2004, no player in the program has worn her No. 13.
- Hubbard who is working on her master's degree in sport management is one of 12 players returning from last season's 8-13 team. The 5-9 Virginia Beach native averaged 11.1 points, 3.5 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 1.1 steals per game last season. She led the Gophers in free-throw percentage (92.1).
- "I am honored that my jersey hangs in the rafters of Williams Arena and am grateful for the impact the 'U' has had on my life," she said. "Moving forward, however, I would like to have the No. 13 available for others that come to the

university and represent the Gophers on the court."

• None of the six numbers and seven jerseys (Debbie Hunter also wore No. 13) that have been raised to the rafters of Williams Arena have officially been retired. However, out of respect for Whalen and the impact she has had on the program, no player has been given her number since her career ended.

MARCH MADNESS IS COMING TO MINNEAPOLIS

- Announced on Sept. 29, the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship will use March Madness marketing and branding beginning with the 2022 tournament, which culminates with the Women's Final Four on April 1-3 in Minneapolis.
- That was one of the recommendations from a comprehensive external review of gender equity issues in connection with NCAA championships, including issues that arose during the 2021 Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Championships.
- Details of how the March Madness brand will be incorporated into the Division I women's basketball tournament are still being developed.
- Coverage of all rounds of the 2022 Division I Women's Basketball Championship will continue on the ESPN family of networks.

WHALEN NAMED TO THE WNBA'S W25

- Three years since her last game, Lindsay Whalen has added another honor to her renowned professional career.
- In honor of the WNBA's 25th season, Whalen was named to "The W25" Sunday, cementing her status as one of the 25 greatest players in league history.
- Selected fourth overall in the 2004 WNBA Draft by the Connecticut Sun, Whalen played six seasons with the Sun before returning to her home state and spending the final nine years with the Minnesota Lynx. Both the Lynx and Sun have since retired her No. 13 jersey.
- Whalen's quick WNBA resume includes being a five-time All-WNBA selection, a five-time All-Star, a four-time champion and a three-time assists leader.

THE 2021-22 MINNESOTA FRESHMAN CLASS

- In addition to Katie Borowicz, who already joined the program as an early enrollee, Minnesota signed two other players to National Letters of Intent and they will join the program for the 2021-22 season: Maggie Czinano and Alanna Micheaux.
- Hailing from Watertown, Minn., Czinano (sih-NON-oh) is a 6'0 guard who attends Watertown-Mayer High School. She's a three-time all-conference honoree and was named all-state this past season as she averaged 21 points, 2.2 steals and 2.1 assists per contest.
- Czinano has helped her school to a pair of conference championships, a section championship and a third-place finish at the 2017 state tournament. Her AAU team is the Minnesota Fury, which won back-to-back state titles in 2019 and 2020 and finished second at the 2019 UAA Nationals.
- Micheaux (mih-SHOW) comes to the Gophers from Wayne, Mich., and Wayne Memorial High School. A 6'2 forward, she is a four-star recruit, the No. 75 player overall in the country and the No. 9 power forward according to ProspectNation. com. She was also named a McDonald's All-American Game nominee.
- Micheaux is coming off a junior season in which she was named first team all-state and all-region as she averaged 26.4 points, 14.0 rebounds, 3.2 blocks, 2.6 assists and 1.8 steals per contest while shooting 64 percent from the floor. She helped lead her team to district and regional championships and an appearance in the Final Four in her first two seasons at Wayne and a third district championship a year ago before COVID-19 brought the season to an end.

HEAD COACH LINDSAY WHALEN FOURTH SEASON · MINNESOTA, 2004



One of the most decorated players in women's basketball history, Lindsay Whalen returned to her alma mater as the 12th head women's basketball coach at the University of Minnesota on April 13, 2018.

In her three seasons guiding the Golden Gophers, Whalen has led the team to a 45-40 mark (.534) with a trip to the WNIT in 2018-19. In addition, she has coached one WNBA draft pick, one All-American, nine All-Big Ten honorees,

two members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team, one Big Ten All-Defensive Team player and 18 Academic All-Big Ten honorees.


The 2020-21 campaign, which took place amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, saw a young Gophers squad improve their conference win total from five to seven as they went 8-13 on the season and 7-11 in conference play. With 10 of its 13 players either freshmen or sophomores, no team in the Big Ten had a higher percentage of its roster comprised of underclassmen than Minnesota. In fact, of the 13 Gophers on the roster, six were playing in their first season of collegiate basketball and three transfers were playing in their first year at Minnesota.

Jasmine Powell was named Second Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches and Honorable Mention All-Big Ten by the media covering the conference. Meanwhile, Sara Scalia was chosen Honorable Mention All-Big Ten by the coaches and media.

In Whalen's second season the Gophers went 16-15, including winning 11 straight games at one point, which was the sixth longest win streak in program history. During the stretch, they won four straight on the road, the seventh longest such streak at Minnesota. Included in the 11-game streak was an 80-66 upset of then-No. 19 Arizona State

Five members of the team took home season honors from the Big Ten. Taiye Bello was a consensus All-Big Ten Second Team selection by the league's coaches and media, while Powell was a consensus pick for both All-Big Ten Honorable Mention and the Big Ten All-Freshman Team. Gadiva Hubbard was an All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honoree by the media, as was Scalia, who also earned a place on the media's Big Ten All-Freshman Team.

In her first season at the helm of the Gophers, Whalen guided the



Minnesota began the 2018-19 season by winning its first 12 games, tied for the third best streak in team history.

With the 12-0 start, Whalen tied her former coach, Pam Borton (2002-03), for the best undefeated start by a coach in their first year at a Big Ten school since the incorporation of women's athleties in the conference in 1982-83. The only coach at a Big Ten school with more wins in his or her first year there was Ohio State's Debbie Wilson, who started 14-0 in 1972-73.

Under Whalen's tutelage, Kenisha Bell earned honorable mention All-America honors from the AP, was a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Defensive Player of the Year Award, garnered consensus First Team All-Big Ten honors from the league's coaches and media and was a member of the All-Big Ten Defensive Team. In addition, Destiny Pitts was named First Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches (second team by the media), and Taiye Bello was an All-Big Ten honorable mention honoree.

Whalen returned to the Gophers after destroying the program's record book in the early 2000s, finishing her career as Minnesota's all-time points leader, along with being second all-time in assists and third all-time in steals. A four-time all-state selection at Hutchinson High School, about an hour west of Minneapolis, Whalen went on to become the catalyst for the most successful seasons in the history of Gopher women's basketball.

In international competition, Whalen was a key piece to dominant performances by Team USA in world championship and Olympic competition. Whalen played for two gold medal teams at the World Championships (2010, 2014) and has also won two Olympic gold medals (2012, 2016).

As part of Whalen's agreement to become head coach, she continued to play for the Minnesota Lynx before retiring at the end of the 2018 season. Previously, Whalen announced in February of 2018 that she was retiring from international competition. She had played for the U.S. National team since 2002, joining Team USA following her sophomore season with the Gophers.
