About Minnesota

The No. 8 University of Minnesota gymnastics team is back at Maturi Pavilion this week as it hosts border rival and No. 13 lowa at 4 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 25. The match will be broadcast live on BTN.

Minnesota most recently competed at the Big Five Meet at the Huntington Center in Toledo, Ohio. Lexy Ramler won the all-around (39.575) and tied for first on the beam (9.950), while Mya Hooten claimed the top spot on the floor (9.975). As a team, the Gophers scored 196.500 to finish third. Minnesota competed against Michigan State, Rutgers, Penn State and Nebraska on Saturday night and finished behind Michigan State and Nebraska.

Minnesota's best event was the floor where it finished with a 49.550, which tied for the fifth best score in school history. The 49.550 also tied for Minnesota's top floor score ever away from home. The Gophers also tallied a 49.550 at Ohio State in 2018 and at Arizona State in 2004. On Saturday, the Gophers had three of the top four finishers in Hooten (first, 9.975), Ona Loper (tied for second, 9.925) and Halle Remlinger (tied for second, 9.925).

Gophers in the Rankings

Minnesota comes in at No. 8 overall in the national rankings. The Gophers are second in the nation on floor, seventh on vault, ninth on bars and 25th on beam.

Lexy Ramler is ranked the No. 1 ranked gymnast in the all-around and is also ranked No. 4 on both bars and beam and No. 23 on vault. Ona Loper is ranked No. 6 in the nation in the all-around, highlighted by a No. 13 ranking on the floor. Minnesota's other gymnast who is ranked in the top 20 is Halle Remlinger, who is No. 19 on the floor. Mya Hooten, who is one of the most dynamic gymnasts on the floor and already has a perfect 10 this year on the apparatus, was previously ranked No. 5 in the nation. However, she fell out of the rankings as she has not competed the minimum amount of times on the floor to be ranked by NQS.

B1G Weekly Honors

Most recently, senior Lexy Ramler was named Big Ten Gymnast of the Week after her performance at the Big Five Meet at Elevate Toledo last Saturday. This is the 20th time that Ramler has earned the award in her career, extending her own conference record in that category.

Ramler, who is from St. Michael, Minn., placed first in the all-around with a score of 39.575, which was the highest score on Saturday and would have been the top score in the Friday portion of the competition as well. Ramler scored a 9.950 on beam (tied for first), 9.875 on vault (tied for second), 9.875 on bars (tied for second) and 9.875 on floor (tied for tenth) at the Big Five Meet to finish in the top two in three events and in the top 10 in all four rotations. She also successfully defended her all-around title at the Big Five Meet, as she won last year with a program-record score of 39.850.

Loper Nominated for AAI Award

Ona Loper has been named a nominee for the AAI Award, presented to the nation's most outstanding senior. Teammate Lexy Ramler won the award last season.

The AAI Award is widely considered the Heisman Trophy of women's gymnastics. AAI has been awarding this honor for more than 30 years. NCAA head coaches were asked to submit a nomination for the candidate or candidates of their choice. After the initial nominations, the field is narrowed to the top six student-athletes. Loper is one of 31 nominees for the award this year and is ranked No. 6 in the nation in the all-around. She is one of the nation's top performers on vault this year and recorded a perfect 10 at home against Michigan earlier this season.

She has won two all-around competitions this year (vs. Ohio State and at Maryland / Pitt) and has either set or tied career highs this year in the all-around, vault, bar and floor. Loper has been named Big Ten Gymnast of the Week twice this year and has earned the honor five times in her career.

The Loper and Ramler File

Ona Loper had a season of a lifetime in 2021, starting with an all-around title and Big Ten Gymnast of the Week honors during the first week of the season. Loper went on to secure 12 event titles and two perfect 10s on vault, including one at the Athens Regional Semifinal. At the conclusion of the regular season, Loper was ranked tied for No. 3 on vault, No. 10 on floor, No. 17 on bars and No. 13 in the all-around. Loper's influx of success heightened in the postseason, becoming the Big Ten Floor Champion and Athens Regional Vault and Floor Champion. She was the top finisher for the Maroon and Gold at the NCAA Championships after she set a career-high 39.6375 in the all-around with event scores of 9.9625 on vault, 9.9250 on floor and 9.8750 on both bars and beam. Loper finished third on vault and fourth in the all-around at the competition.

Lexy Ramler won her third consecutive Big Ten Gymnast of the Year honor and the prestigious AAI Award. Ramler won 31 event titles this season and was named the Big Ten Gymnast of the Week six times. She ended the year tied for No. 1 in the nation on beam, No. 3 on bars, tied for No. 5 on vault, tied for No. 28 on floor and No. 2 overall in the all-around. Ramler was a Big Ten Champion on bars, beam and in the all-around. At the Big Five Meet, Ramler set the program record all-around score with a 39.850.

Scouting Iowa

lowa started the season with wins against Eastern Michigan and Texas Woman's University before finishing second at the tri-meet with Minnesota and UCLA. The Hawkeyes then posted Big Ten dual wins against Michigan State, Nebraska and Penn State before placing first in a quad meet against Rutgers, Kent State and Ursinus. Iowa competed on Friday at last week's Big Five Meet at Elevate Toledo and finished fourth out of five teams. The Hawkeyes finished with a 196.225 to finish fourth in the five team event.

lowa has earned two Big Ten weekly honors this season. Junior JerQuavia Henderson was the Specialist of the Week on Jan. 10 and Marissa Rojas garnered Freshman of the Week honors on Jan. 25

Last Time Against Iowa

This will be the second time that Minnesota will face lowa at Maturi Pavilion this season. The Gophers welcomed the Hawkeyes to the Twin Cities for a tri-meet earlier this year with UCLA on Jan. 17. Minnesota won that meet with a 196.900 in front of a 3,887 fans, which set a regular season meet record. Iowa was second with a 195.950.

Ramler won the all-around title at the mid-January meet with a score of 39.700. Her top tallies of the night came on bars and beam, where she recorded a 9.950 on each apparatus. Ona Loper finished second in the all-around competition with a 39.525 and her best result was on vault where she scored 9.950.

During her seventh season at the helm of the Golden Gopher program, Hansen led the women's gymnastics team to a heightened level of success. The season was highlighted by the program's first Big Ten Championship since 2006 and claiming a spot at the National Championship for the first time under the new eight-team format.

Under Hansen's guidance, the Gophers broke numerous team records including a new team score record of 197.750 set at the Big Ten Championship. Minnesota also set a new record on floor (49.575) and uneven bars (49.575) while notching the second-highest vault score in program history (49.525) at the NCAA Regional Semifinal and third-highest beam score (49.600).

Hansen coached senior Lexy Ramler to her third consecutive Big Ten Gymnast of the Year honor and the prestigious AAI Award. Ramler won 31 event titles this season and was named the Big Ten Gymnast of the Week six times. She ended the year tied for No. 1 in the nation on beam. Hansen guided freshman Mya Hooten to an incredible breakout year as she secured the first perfect 10 on floor in program history

The Gophers had multiple All-Big Ten Team representatives in 2021 including Ramler, Loper and Hooten leading the way with first team honors, Mary Korlin-Downs, Maddie Quarles, Tiarre Sales and Hannah Willmarth represented the Maroon and Gold on the Second Team All-Big Ten. The Gophers touted the highest number of gymnasts to be honored by the conference, with Michigan earning the next highest with five gymnasts recognized.

There was a record-breaking number of All-Americans from the 2021 season. Ramler earned WCGA All-American honors in the all-around, vault, bars and beam. Loper was named a WCGA All-American on vault and also Second Team All-America on floor and in the all-around. Freshman phenom Hooten was recognized as an WCGA All-American on floor. Korlin-Downs was awarded with Second Team WCGA All-American honors on beam and Quarles was Second Team WCGA All-American on vault.

At the conclusion of the 2021 NCAA Championship Semifinal, the University of Minnesota made program history with 11 total Championship All-American honors. Loper led the way for the Gophers with All-American honors on vault and in the all-around, along with Second Team All-American honors on floor. Ramler earned All-American recognition on beam, while also recording Second Team honors on bars, vault and in the all-around. Hooten continued to impress in her first collegiate season, with All-American honors on floor and Second Team honors on vault. Korlin-Downs was awarded the first All-American honor of her career on beam and Quarles rounded out the honors as a Second Team All-American on vault.

In the classroom, all 13 age-eligible student-athletes in Maya Albertin, Kate Grotenhuis, Korlin-Downs, Mallory LeNeave, Loper, Lexi Montgomery, Abbie Nhylin, Quarles, Ramler, Halle Remlinger, Tiarre Sales, Ali Sonier and Hannah Willmarth earned Academic All-Big Ten honors. Eight representatives of women's gymnastics also earned Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honors including Albertin, LeNeave, Loper, Nylin, Ramler, Remlinger, Sales and Willmarth.
