About Minnesota

The No. 9 University of Minnesota gymnastics is on the road this week when it travels to No. 4 Utah for a marguee nonconference showdown at 8 p.m. on Friday, March 4.

Lexy Ramler scored a perfect 10 beam and Mya Hooten scored a perfect 10 on floor as Minnesota recorded a program-best 198.025 to beat border rival lowa last Friday at Maturi Pavilion. Minnesota's previous best team score was a 197.750 set last season at the Big Ten Championships, which the Gophers won. Minnesota's team depth was on display, as the Gophers posted a program-best score without setting any program records in a single event. The Golden Gopehrs won all four events and were dominant in doing so. Their lowest score of the night was a 49.400 on vault. Minnesota had the top six scores on the bars and the top four marks on the floor.

Ramler's perfect 10 on the beam was the fourth of her career and her first this year. She was also perfect at Illinois in 2021 and in 2020 against Illinois and in a 2020 quad-meet against Rutgers, Bowling Green and Ursinus. Ramler now has five perfect 10s in her career, as she also recorded a 10 on vault at the Big Five Meet in 2021. Hooten's perfect 10 on the floor was the third of her career and second this year. She also scored a perfect 10 against Michigan this year and a perfect 10 at home against Nebraska in 2021. Hooten also set a career high on the vault with a 9.975 and tied her career high on the bars with a 9.875.

Gophers in the Rankings

Minnesota comes in at No. 9 overall in the national rankings. The Gophers are ranked third in the nation on floor, seventh on vault, 11th on bars and 33rd on beam.

Lexy Ramler is ranked the No. 2 ranked gymnast in the all-around and is also ranked tied for fifth on bars and beam. She is tied for 42nd on vault and is tied for 52nd on floor. Ona Loper is tied for 12th in the all-around and is ranked tied for 18th on floor and tied for 28th on bars.

Mya Hooten, who is one of the most dynamic gymnasts on the floor and has two perfect 10s this year on the apparatus, was previously ranked No. 5 in the nation. However, she fell out of the rankings as she has not competed the minimum amount of times on the floor to be ranked by NQS.

B1G Weekly Honors

Senior Lexy Ramler and sophomore Mya Hooten were honored by the Big Ten this week after their strong performances last Friday at home against lowa. Ramler was named Big Ten Gymnast of the Week, while Hooten was honored as the Big Ten Specialist of the Week. Both Ramler and Hooten helped lead Minnesota to a program best 198.025 score against lowa, which was also the first time that the Gophers ever broke 198.

This is the 21st time (third time this year) that Ramler has earned the award in her career, extending her own conference record in that category. This is the second time this year and the third time in her career that Hooten has been named Specialist of the Week. Ramler, who is from St. Michael, Minn., placed first in the all-around against lowa with a score of 39.775 (tied for third highest score in school history). She scored a perfect 10 on the beam, which was her first of the season, and the fourth of her career. It was her fifth career perfect 10 as she has a 10 on the vault in 2021. Ramler recorded a 9.950 on both the bars and floor and she received a 10 from one judge on the floor. She scored a 9.875 on the vault.

Hooten is a Woodbury, Minn., native and earned Big Ten Specialist of the Week honors after a career meet against the Hawkeyes. She posted a perfect 10 on the floor, which was her second of the year and the third of her career. She also set a career high on the vault with a 9.975 and tied her career high on the bars with a 9.875.

This is the third straight week that a Gopher has been named Big Ten Gymnast of the Week, as Ramler was recognized last week and Ona Loper was honored two weeks ago.

Loper Nominated for AAI Award

Ona Loper has been named a nominee for the AAI Award, presented to the nation's most outstanding senior. Teammate Lexy Ramler won the award last season.

The AAI Award is widely considered the Heisman Trophy of women's gymnastics. AAI has been awarding this honor for more than 30 years. NCAA head coaches were asked to submit a nomination for the candidate or candidates of their choice. After the initial nominations, the field is narrowed to the top six student-athletes. Loper is one of 31 nominees for the award this year and is ranked No. 6 in the nation in the all-around. She is one of the nation's top performers on vault this year and recorded a perfect 10 at home against Michigan earlier this season.

She has won two all-around competitions this year (vs. Ohio State and at Maryland / Pitt) and has either set or tied career highs this year in the all-around, vault, bar and floor. Loper has been named Big Ten Gymnast of the Week twice this year and has earned the honor five times in her career.

The Loper and Ramler File

Ona Loper had a season of a lifetime in 2021, starting with an all-around title and Big Ten Gymnast of the Week honors during the first week of the season. Loper went on to secure 12 event titles and two perfect 10s on vault, including one at the Athens Regional Semifinal. At the conclusion of the regular season, Loper was ranked tied for No. 3 on vault, No. 10 on floor, No. 17 on bars and No. 13 in the all-around. Loper's influx of success heightened in the postseason, becoming the Big Ten Floor Champion and Athens Regional Vault and Floor Champion. She was the top finisher for the Maroon and Gold at the NCAA Championships after she set a career-high 39.6375 in the all-around with event scores of 9.9625 on vault, 9.9250 on floor and 9.8750 on both bars and beam. Loper finished third on vault and fourth in the all-around at the competition.

Lexy Ramler won her third consecutive Big Ten Gymnast of the Year honor and the prestigious AAI Award. Ramler won 31 event titles this season and was named the Big Ten Gymnast of the Week six times. She ended the year tied for No. 1 in the nation on beam, No. 3 on bars, tied for No. 5 on vault, tied for No. 28 on floor and No. 2 overall in the all-around. Ramler was a Big Ten Champion on bars, beam and in the all-around. At the Big Five Meet, Ramler set the program record all-around score with a 39.850.

Scouting Utah

No. 4 Utah is one of the deepest and most consistent teams in the country. Utah is ranked No. 2 on the beam and floor, No. 4 on vault and No. 5 on the bars and is led by 2020 U.S. Olympic Team member Grace McCallum. The freshman helped Team USA earn a silver medal at the Tokyo Olympics and is having a terrific start to her collegiate career. She is ranked No. 4 in the all-around and is ranked fourth on the floor, tied for 13th on the vault, tied for 13th on the beam and 16th on the bars.

Lucy Stanhope is tied for No. 6 in the nation on the vault, while Jaedyn Rucker checks in at No. 13. Five different Utah gymnasts are ranked in the top 40 in the nation on the floor and led by Sydney Soloski who is No. 3 in the nation. Malie O'Keefe paces Utah on the beam and is ranked second in the nation.

HEAD COACH » JENNY HANSEN

During her seventh season at the helm of the Golden Gopher program, Hansen led the women's gymnastics team to a heightened level of success. The season was highlighted by the program's first Big Ten Championship since 2006 and claiming a spot at the National Championship for the first time under the new eight-team format.

Under Hansen's guidance, the Gophers broke numerous team records including a new team score record of 197.750 set at the Big Ten Championship. Minnesota also set a new record on floor (49.575) and uneven bars (49.575) while notching the second-highest vault score in program history (49.525) at the NCAA Regional Semifinal and third-highest beam score (49.600).

Hansen coached senior Lexy Ramler to her third consecutive Big Ten Gymnast of the Year honor and the prestigious AAI Award. Ramler won 31 event titles this season and was named the Big Ten Gymnast of the Week six times. She ended the year tied for No. 1 in the nation on beam. No. 3 on bars, tied for No. 5 on vault, tied for No. 28 on floor and No. 2 overall in the all-around. Ramler was a Big Ten Champion on bars, beam and in the all-around. At the Big Five Meet, Ramler set the program record all-around score with a 39.850.

Hansen guided freshman Mya Hooten to an incredible breakout year as she secured the first perfect 10 on floor in program history

The Gophers had multiple All-Big Ten Team representatives in 2021 including Ramler, Loper and Hooten leading the way with first team honors, Mary Korlin-Downs, Maddie Quarles, Tiarre Sales and Hannah Willmarth represented the Maroon and Gold on the Second Team All-Big Ten. The Gophers touted the highest number of gymnasts to be honored by the conference, with Michigan earning the next highest with five gymnasts recognized.

There was a record-breaking number of All-Americans from the 2021 season. Ramler earned WCGA All-American honors in the all-around, vault, bars and beam. Loper was named a WCGA All-American on vault and also Second Team All-America on floor and in the all-around. Freshman phenom Hooten was recognized as an WCGA All-American on floor. Korlin-Downs was awarded with Second Team WCGA All-American honors on beam and Quarles was Second Team WCGA All-American on vault.

At the conclusion of the 2021 NCAA Championship Semifinal, the University of Minnesota made program history with 11 total Championship All-American honors. Loper led the way for the Gophers with All-American honors on vault and in the all-around, along with Second Team All-American honors on floor. Ramler earned All-American recognition on beam, while also recording Second Team honors on bars, vault and in the all-around. Hooten continued to impress in her first collegiate season, with All-American honors on floor and Second Team honors on vault. Korlin-Downs was awarded the first All-American honor of her career on beam and Quarles rounded out the honors as a Second Team All-American on vault.

In the classroom, all 13 age-eligible student-athletes in Maya Albertin, Kate Grotenhuis, Korlin-Downs, Mallory LeNeave, Loper, Lexi Montgomery, Abbie Nhylin, Quarles, Ramler, Halle Remlinger, Tiarre Sales, Ali Sonier and Hannah Willmarth earned Academic All-Big Ten honors. Eight representatives of women's gymnastics also earned Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honors including Albertin, LeNeave, Loper, Nylin, Ramler, Remlinger, Sales and Willmarth.
