SCOUTING WKU

The Hilltoppers kick off 2023 against the Golden Gophers for the first time in over 10 years. The last time the two teams met was back in 2012 in Boca Raton, Fla., with the Gophers picking up a 1-0 win. Picked second in the C-USA Preseason Poll, Western Kentucky finished the 2022 season with a 38-13 record, including an impressive win over No. 5 Alabama. Western Kentucky returns Taylor Davis, who was the lone Hilltopper to be selected to the C-USA Preseason All-Conference Team.

SCOUTING BUTLER

After winning the Big East Championship for two-straight seasons, the Bulldogs turn to eight freshmen in 2023. Seated at fourth in the Big East Preseason Poll, Butler competes against Minnesota to open the year. The Maroon and Gold meet the Bulldogs in the Sunshine State once again, as they last competed 81 miles down the road in Tampa, Fla., in 2019. The Gophers lead the series over Butler, 2-1.

SCOUTING PORTLAND STATE

In her seventh season at the helm of the Portland State softball program, Meadow McWhorter welcomes back her entire coaching staff from last season. In 2022, she reached the 96-win mark; just four wins shy of 100. The Vikings were picked fourth in the Big Sky preseason poll after their season was cut short in the conference semifinals.

SCOUTING COLGATE

After reaching the Patriot League Tournament last season, Colgate will turn to its upperclassmen to open the 2023 season. The Raiders return 2022 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, First Team All-Conference selection, and NFCA All-Northeast Region Second Team standout in Jillian Herbst. Herbst started all 48 games and finished her freshman season with a .365 batting average. In the circle, Bailey Misken returns for her senior season. The pitcher was named to the 2022 Patriot League All-Tournament Team and recognized as Pitcher of the Week on Feb. 15, 2022.

NEW STAFF ON DECK

Minnesota welcomes back Head Coach Piper Ritter and Associate Head Coach Carly Wynn, along with the addition of Assistant Coach Annie Smith and Volunteer Assistant Bailey Oetting. Smith joins the Gophers' staff after three seasons at Arkansas, where she earned NFCA South Region Staff of the Year honors. Smith also made stops at Auburn, Georgia Southern, and Mississippi State. Oetting began her coaching career as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator with Arizona Christian University in Phoenix. She spent the 2019 season as the head coach at Sauk Valley Community College in Dixon, III., before two years as a graduate assistant at Southern Arkansas.

FIERCE FRESHMEN

Head Coach Piper Ritter welcomed six freshmen to 'The U' this season hailing from five different states. Sydney Schwartz (Victoria, Minn.) and Billi Connell (Luverne, Minn.) represent the state of Minnesota while Breezy Burnett (Jacksonville, Fla.), Jess Oakland (San Jose, Calif.), Addison Leschber (Thrall, Texas), and Maggie Werner (Greenville, Wis.) all made the trek to play for the Land of 10,000 Lakes.

The five newcomers bring a bundle of wealthy experience to Minnesota's roster. Schwartz was named 2022 Star Tribune Metro Player of the Year and the Gatorade Minnesota Softball Player of the Year in both 2021 and 2022. Connell was recognized to the 2022 Class AA Minnesota Fastpitch Association and MN Softball Hub All-State First Teams.

Burnett landed on the 2020 Extra Innings Top 100 National Rankings as the No. 4 Outfielder and the No. 29 player for the class of 2022. Leschber was a five-sport athlete at Thrall High School (volleyball, basketball, track, powerlifting, and softball) while being named to the Extra Innings Softball Extra Elite Class of 2022 as both an infielder and outfielder.

A Wisconsin native, Werner earned 11 letters as a four-sport athlete (softball, volleyball, basketball, and cross country) and named to the 2022 Wisconsin Fastpitch Softball Coaches Association Division I All-Star Team. Oakland rounds out the freshmen class after a successful prep career in California. After totaling 44 home runs, 159 RBIs and 135 runs in her four-year prep career, Oakland earned the title of 2022 Ms. Softball State Player of the Year, the top high school honor in the Golden State.

TACTFUL TRANSFERS

The Gophers added three high-level transfers from Power Five programs for the upcoming season in Amani Bradley (Cal), Taylor Krapf (Duke), and Bri Enter (Florida State).

Bradley made 53 starts and 55 appearances for the Bears during her senior season while posting a .283 batting average and a .336 on-base percentage. While at Duke, Krapf competed in 26 games with three starts, including an NCAA Super Regional game against UCLA. In her previous season with the Seminoles, Enter saw three starts with 13 appearances while finishing with a perfect 2-0 record and 1.44 ERA.

SUNSHINE STATE STUNNAS

A trio of new Gophers return to their home state this weekend to open the 2023 season. Breezy Burnett, Taylor Krapf, and Bri Enter all hail from the Sunshine State.

ONE OF OUR OWN

Graduate outfielder, Natalie DenHartog, has been recognized amongst the best in the country. DenHartog has earned preseason awards from D1 Softball (Preseason Outfield Power Rankings No. 11, Preseason D100 Player No. 47), Softball America (2023 Preseason Top 100 No. 56), and Extra Inning Softball (Extra Elite 100 No. 40).

Head Coach 3rd Season Minnesota, 2004 Career Record: 58-39-1 (.591) Piper Ritter was named the eighth head coach in program history on May 3, 2020 after 13 seasons as the Gophers pitching coach. The 2022 season marks her second year as the Gopher head coach and 15th year with the program as

The former Minnesota standout pitcher has developed four of the top hurlers in Minnesota softball history in Briana Hassett, Sara Moulton, Sara Groenewegen and Amber Fiser. In the shortened 2020 season, Ritter coached Amber Fiser and Autumn Pease each to Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors. She has coached Gophers to 42 Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors in her tenure. She has coached pitchers to five All-American honors, three Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors and has coached seventeen no-hitters.

Ritter helped take the Gophers to new heights in 2019 with the program's first-ever Women's College World Series appearance in the NCAA era. A big reason for the Gophers success came from the circle. Fiser was named the Big Ten Pitcher of the Year, First Team All-American, Honda Award Finalist, Academic All-District, broke a school record and tied a conference record with six Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors and was a two-time NFCA Pitcher of the Week honoree. Fiser finished second for most wins in a single season with 31 and third for strikeouts with 346 in 2019. She pitched every single inning of both the Minneapolis Regional and Super Regional. Ritter was part of her second NFCA Great Lakes Regional Coaching Staff of the Year honor to cap off a successful 2019 season.

In 2018, Ritter coached the Gophers to the 14th lowest ERA in the NCAA and second lowest in the Big Ten with a 1.90 mark as a staff. Ritter guided Fiser to a 27-10 season with a 1.69 ERA. Ritter coached the Gophers to the third lowest ERA in the NCAA in the 2017 season with a 1.19 ERA as a staff. With the success in the circle the Maroon and Gold went a program best 56-5 overall. They broke a record for longest win streak to start a season with 19 and longest win streak ever with 26 straight. Prior to the 2017 season the Gophers were never ranked in the top-10 in either major polls. They reached No. 1 in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches poll and No. 3 in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll. They won their first regular season Big Ten title since 1991 and their third Big Ten tournament championship in four years. Groenewegen went on to become the first Gopher to ever win All-American honors in three seasons after an impressive 2017 season. She went 31-4 with a 0.63 ERA and 307 strikeouts. The ERA was the second lowest in the NCAA and second lowest ever recorded in Gophers history. Along with head coach Jessica Allister and associate head coach Jessica Merchant, Ritter was part of the NFCA Great Lakes Regional Coaching Staff of the Year in 2017. As a staff in 2014 Moulton, Groenewegen, and Nikki Anderson set single-season school records for shutouts with 22 and strikeouts with 487, both marks put the Gophers in the top three nationally during which led Minnesota to post its winningest season in 15 years. That season the Gophers captured the Big Ten Tournament title, and seal its first-ever NCAA super regional berth, posting a team ERA of 2.00.

Top Hurlers

In 2016 Groenewegen again was dominant in the circle under Ritter's guidance. She went 31-7 with a 2.03 ERA and 336 strikeouts. She threw three no-hitters including a perfect game against FAU. For the second straight year she earned NFCA All-American honors being named to the First Team and earned three national player of the week awards and five 816 Pitcher of the Week accolades. Ritter guided Groenewegen to Big Ten Freshman of the Year and Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors in 2014, making the White Rock, B.C. native the third player in conference history to win both awards in the same season. Groenewegen finished the season with the nation's top strikeouts-per-seven-innings rate at 11.6 and was a top-10 finalist for the inaugural NFCA Freshman of the Year Award. She helped Groenewegen become the third player in conference history to win Big Ten Player, Pitcher and Freshman of the Year awards in her career after another solid season in 2015. Groenewegen was named a NFCA Second-Team All-American and finished the season with an ERA of 1.67, best in the Big Ten. The 2015 Gophers had more strikeouts than any other season and posted a team ERA of 2.34. Groenewegen graduated as the all-time Gophers strikeout leader with 1,214 in her career.

Ritter helped Minnesota make a dramatic turnaround by mentoring Moulton, who left Minnesota with program records for wins (112), appearances (178), innings pitched (1,017), complete games (108), no-hitters (five), shutouts (47), and at the time strikeouts (1,184). Moulton went on to earn NFCA Second Team All-America honors after being selected fifth overall in the 2013 National Pro Fastpitch College Draft. She was a four-time All-Big Ten honoree, a top-25 finalist for the 2014 NFCA National Player of the Year Award, and was a top-30 finalist for the 2014 Senior CLASS Award. As a staff in 2014 Moulton, Groenewegen, and Nikki Anderson set single-season school records for shutouts with 22 and strikeouts with 487, both marks put the Gophers in the top three nationally during which led Minnesota to post its winningest season in 15 years. That season the

Gophers captured the Big Ten Tournament title, and seal its first-ever NCAA super regional berth, posting a team ERA of 2.00.

In 2013, Moulton set Minnesota's single-season wins record with a 32-12 record, and tied another record with 14 shutouts. The All-Big Ten First team selection threw two consecutive no-hitters during the season. Moulton led the Big Ten in ERA (1.57), strikeouts (308), wins (32), starts (45) and innings pitched (275.5).

Ritter also tutored Hassett to one of the best seasons in program history in 2009. Hassett set program records by racking up 414 strikeouts and pitching 39 complete games. Her strikeout mark was more than 100 better than the previous record, set in 2004 by Ritter. Hassett also spent 3070 innings in the circle in 2009, becoming just the second Golden Gopher ever to pitch over 300 innings in a season. Hassett thrived in two seasons under Ritter, finishing among the top-five in six career pitching categories, including a school record 88 complete games.

Ritter guided Hassett to a record-breaking 2008 season in her first year in charge of Minnesota's pitching staff. Hassett went 21-8 with a 1.82 earned run average that season. At the time, Hassett's 276 strikeouts were the third-most in a single season in Minnesota history, trailing only Ritter's totals of 311 during 2003 and 301 during 2002.

Playing Career

During her four-year playing career with the Gophers (2001-04), Ritter became one of the most accomplished pitchers in program history. She left the university with career records for strikeouts (1,122), innings pitched (921.1), games (173), wins (88), shutouts (33), and complete games (85). Her career strikeout mark ranked third all-time in the Big Ten and 14th in NCAA history. Ritter threw a record-tying five career no-hitters for the Gophers, including two perfect games. Ritter earned All-Big Ten honors all four years at Minnesota, including a first-team selection in 2003 when she posted 11 shutouts and what was then a single-season record 311 strikeouts. She also gamered NFCA All-Mideast Region accolades three times during her career and led the Gophers to the NCAA Regional Tournament two times (2002 and 2003).


JANE SAGE COWLES STADIUM

Jane Sage Cowles Stadium is in its 24th season hosting the Minnesota softball program. In the same location as the Bierman Softball Complex, the field was reconstructed and renamed in 2000 thanks to a generous donation from Sage and John Cowles. The complex holds dimensions of 205 feet at the corners and 220 feet to straight-away center field.
