## OPENING TIP-OFF

• The University of Minnesota women's basketball team (14-5, 4-4 B1G) will take on Illinois (8-10, 2-6 B1G) in its second straight Big Ten road game on Sunday afternoon. The contest against the Fighting Illini is scheduled to tip at 2 p.m. on B1G+ while Justin Gaard and Lynnette Sjoquist will broadcast the game on KFAN+.

• Minnesota suffered a road loss to rival Wisconsin on Tuesday. In the team's fourth game in nine days, the Gophers fell short on the offensive end, with true freshman Grace Grocholski and sophomore Amaya Battle leading Minnesota's attack with 13 and 12 points, respectively. Grocholski hit three triples in the loss while Battle shot 50 percent from the floor (6-of-12) and handed out four assists to just one turnover in 31 minutes. As a team Minnesota took care of the ball with just five turnovers while Mara Braun tied her career high in blocks (3) on the defensive end.

• Since 2009, only two Big Ten players have pulled down 15 rebounds and hit five or more threes in any game and against Michigan State sophomore Mallory Heyer became the only player that has done it twice. Heyer's first such game came last season when she had 28 points and 15 rebounds against Wisconsin where she hit 5-of-7 threes. Heyer has averaged 8.3 rebounds in her last six games with 2.5 of those coming on the offensive end. On the offensive end Heyer has been lethal from beyond the arc in the last five games, hitting an average of three shots from the 3-point line per game as opposed to just 1.7 per game in her first 14 games.

• The Big Ten announced that Grace Grocholski was named the latest Freshman of the Week after her performances against Indiana and Michigan State. Last week the Wisconsin native dropped an average of 15 points, five rebounds and 2.5 assists while shooting 73.3 percent from the floor and 62.5 percent from beyond the arc. This season Grocholski is the only Big Ten freshman to average 11.0 points, 4.6 rebounds while shooting 36 percent or better from beyond the arc.

• Mara Braun was named to the Cheryl Miller Award top 10 list on Wednesday. The Wayzata, Minn., native leads the Golden Gophers in scoring (17.7). Her 56 made threes rank her second in the Big Ten and is ninth in the country. She's second in the NCAA in free throw percentage at 94.8 percent, a category that no Big Ten has led nationally since 2006 (Adrienne Squire, Penn State).

• Minnesota's offense has been elite in the fourth quarter this season with the Maroon and Gold owning a 19.2-13.5 on average in the final quarter. In conference play in the fourth Minnesota's offense has been efficient in all facets shooting 48.7 percent (57-of-117) from the floor and 40.7 percent (13-of-32) from three.

• Last season the Gophers were ranked 291st in the NCAA and 13th in the Big Ten in turnovers per game (17.7) per game but through 19 games this season are ranked 20th in the country and No. 3 in the Big Ten at 12.8.

• Minnesota and Illinois are meeting for the 73rd time, with Illinois holding a 41-31 advantage in the series that started back in 1974. Minnesota holds a record of 10-25 against the Fighting Illini in the state of Illinois.

- McKenna Johnson enrolled early with the Gophers, graduating from high school early and forgoing her senior season of basketball.
- Both Mara Braun and Maggie Czinano are student-athlete ambassadors with Special Olympics Minnesota.
- Redshirt freshman forward Niamya Holloway helped co-found the Black Student Union and worked to promote youth leadership at Central Middle School in Minnesota and promoted racial equity as a senior officer for the Dare 2 Be Real organization.
- Mallory Heyer was an outstanding volleyball player at Chaska high school, emassing over 1,000 kills in her career and led her volleyball team to a 2AAAA Section runner-up finish in 2019.
- Niamya Holloway was a two-time high school high jump state champion at Eden Prairie high school where she cleared a personal record 5-10. Her senior year she won a state championship in the high jump, took third in both the 4x200m relay and the 4x400m relay and was ninth in the shot put competition. Two days after the state championship track meet, she was at summer workouts with the Gophers.
- Freshman Ayianna Johnson played five different sports throughout high school. She was a member of the basketball, football, golf, wrestling and track and field teams throughout her time at Jefferson high school in Wisconsin.
- Graduate transfer guard Janay Sanders is the first Gopher to play for the Minnesota Golden Gophers from the state of North Carolina (Charlotte).
- Freshman forward McKynnlie Dalan's family runs a gym in Washington.
- Sophie Hart is the lone Gopher to have played in the NCAA Tournament in her career. She came off the bench for the Wolfpack while playing her first two seasons at NC State.
- Brynn Senden is a third-generation Gopher. Both of freshman guard's parents were student-athletes at the University of Minnesota. Senden's mother, Kristen, was a gymnast while her father, Stuart, played on the men's hockey team. Senden's grandfather, Bruce Vandersall, was also a member of the Gopher football staff from 1973-82.
- Sophomore guard Amaya Battle and Niamya Holloway both attended the Black Student-Athlete Summit this past summer in Los Angeles, Calif.
- Freshman Grace Grocholski won two state basketball titles in the state of Wisconsin, winning the championships in back-to-back seasons where Grocholski was the team's leading scorer both seasons.
- Sophomore Mara Braun won a gold medal with Team USA this past summer at the FIBA 3x3 Nations League Final where her U21 team finished undefeated against both U21 and U23 age group teams.
- Freshman Ajok Madol brought back a bronze medal with Team Canada this past summer with the U19 team in Spain.
- Ayianna Johnson has claimed in interviews that she can hit a "7 of 8-iron about 250 yards off the golf tee."

## THE GOLD EXPERIENCE

• The Minnesota Golden Gophers are the youngest team in the Big Ten with 11 underclassmen (does not include redshirts in their third year of college).

• Minnesota is comprised of eight freshmen and three sophomores along with two juniors, one senior and one graduate student. Despite the youth on the team, the Gophers still returned 55.9 percent of their scoring from last year's team.

• The Maroon and Gold have eight different players who call the Land of 10,000 Lakes their home, which is tied for the most of any team in the Big Ten from their home state (Michigan State).

• Minnesota's upperclassmen are led, in experience, by guard Janay Sanders who has played in 129 career games and 3092 minutes in her career. Meanwhile juniors Sophie Hart and Maggie Czinano have combined to play in 100 games while senior Aminata Zie has appeared in nine Division I games and not since 2020-21.

• Despite the youth on the roster the Gophers team still brings in a total of 239 Division I starts between Sanders (87), Heyer (49), Braun (47), Battle (43) and Czinano (13). Of Minnesota's 14 players, six made their college debuts against LIU on Nov. 8, at Williams Arena.

## WE CAN HANG

• Minnesota's defense has been outstanding this season, with the team's 59.9 points per game allowed sitting in second among Big Ten teams. This season the 'U' allows teams to shoot just 38.9 percent from the floor, which is the fourth in the conference while committing just 13.0 fouls per game, which is No. 1 in the league and eighth in the country through Jan. 24.

• The 'U' has also forced 17.3 turnovers per game, which has led to 17.9 points per game off turnovers. That rate of 17.3 turnovers forced per game is No. 5 in the conference this season.

• Minnesota's turnover margin has been solid this season at 4.4, good enough for the No. 3 spot in the Big Ten and 38th in the country. Individually sophomore Mara Braun is the team's leader in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.9, which is No. 7 in the conference this year.

## FACING ILLINOIS

• Illinois has won nine of the last 10 games with the Golden Gophers, with Minnesota's last win against the Fighting Illini was on Feb. 6, 2019.

• The Fighting Illini have dropped two straight after winning two in a row with their latest losses coming to No. 12/12 Ohio State (67-59) and Maryland (90-82). Illinois' last win at home was against Rutgers, a 28-point win. This season out of Illinois' 10 losses, eight have come within nine points.

• Individually this season Illinois is led on the offensive end by Genesis Bryant at 14.9 points per game, which is 11th in the Big Ten, while also adding 1.4 steals per game on the defensive end. The team's primary rebounder has once again been Kendall Bostic, who brings down an average of 8.9 boards per contest, which is No. 3 in the conference. On the defensive end Brynn Shoup-Hill has once again been effective with an average of 1.2 blocks per game, which is fifth in the Big Ten this season.

• As of Jan. 24, Illinois is the No. 2 team in the Big Ten in turnovers per game at 11.5, which is also top-10 in the nation. The Fighting Illini shoot an elite 45.8 percent from the floor, which is 34th in the country while the team's 75.1 points per game is No. 52 in the nation.

• Most recently Illinois started Makira Cook, Genesis Bryant, Adalia McKenzie, Kendall Bostic, Camille Hobby, with the group being the fourth different starting lineup this season. The latest starting lineup for the Fighting Illini has a record of 3-3 this season.

• Illinois women's basketball returned 93.4% of its scoring from the 2022-23 season, which is the second-highest percentage across the NCAA. That breaks down to 2,251 of 2,410 points returning for the Illini. In those returners are all five starters from last season and 10 total players. This season, 10 different Illini have scored double digits.

## THE RISE OF G-MONEY

• True freshman Grace Grocholski has proved to be one of the best freshmen in the Big Ten Conference this season. The North Prairie, Wis., native has performances of 26 (Norfolk State) and 19 twice (Michigan and Indiana). Grocholski as of Jan. 25 leads all Big Ten Freshmen in points per game (11.0). Grocholski is also the only freshman in the Big Ten this season that has produced two 19-point games against conference foes (Michigan, Indiana).

• Grocholski has been deadly from beyond the arc in her first college season, with the rookie having three different games with five made threes. Her three games with five made threes this season tie her for the third-most in the country among freshmen, and tie her at the top spot among Power 5 freshmen.

• Grocholski has proven that she can also produce against top talent in the country, averaging 12.3 points per game against ranked opponents and shooting 42.9 percent from the floor and adding five rebounds per game.

## AROUND THE WORLD IN A DAY

• Sophomore standout Mara Braun had one of the busiest summers one can have after their first year of college, playing basketball in four countries outside of the United States as a member of Team USA's U21 3x3 team.

• During her FIBA 3x3 campaign the Wayzata, Minn., native traveled to Handan, China and Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, along with a training trip to Colorado Springs. Braun's time with Team USA resulted in a gold medal at the FIBA 3x3 Nations League Final, where she led the Red, White and Blue in scoring in the title game against China.

• Shortly after her return to the U.S., Braun joined her teammates on a trip to Croatia and Greece where the team played in three exhibition contests against local club teams.

• Braun led the team in scoring as a true freshman (15.6 ppg) in 2022-23, becoming the first true freshman to do so since Rachel Banham in 2011-12 (16.1). She ended the 2022-23 season scoring in double figures in each of her final nine games and hit at least one three in each of her final 12 contests.

## DIAMONDS AND PEARLS

• Minnesota's "B1G 3" have returned with sophomores Amaya Battle (9.0 ppg, 5.9 rpg, 4.4 apg) and Mallory Heyer (10.4 ppg, 7.1 rpg) joining Braun (15.6 ppg, 3.3 rpg).

• The sophomore class has returned with a vengeance so far in 2023-24 with Braun leading the way with an impressive 17.7 points per game clip while Battle has posted a career high in points (20), assists (10), steals (5) and rebounds (12) while Heyer has notched three more double doubles this season, highlighted by her 18 points and 15 rebounds against Michigan State.

• Battle was a stat-sheet stuffer in her rookie campaign, highlighted by crushing a 45-year-old freshman single-season record for assists in a season (Joan Kowalsky, 1977-78). Battle finished with 133 assists, edging Kowalsky by 27. She's now just 80 assists away from breaking into the program's all-time top 10 in assists.

• After ending her first season as the No. 1 rebounding freshman in the Big Ten (7.1 per game), Mallory Heyer has improved on the glass in her sophomore season at 8.2 per game, which is No. 5 overall in the Big Ten this season while her 8.4 rebounds per game in Big Ten play sits at the No. 4 spot.

## THE BIG TEN TOURNAMENT IN MINNEAPOLIS

• On April 20, 2022, the Big Ten announced that the Big Ten basketball tournaments in 2023 and 2024 were coming to Minneapolis and the Target Center. Target Center will host both the men's and women's tourney in 2024.

• The 2023 Big Ten Tournament had a record-setting attendance of 47,923 fans during its first year in Minneapolis at the Target Center. The event featured three of the 10 largest single-session crowds in the event's 30-year history, and its 6,846 average per session was the most since 2008.

• The 2022 Women's Final Four, which was held in Target Center, set an attendance record with over 216,000 spectators. The 216,000 fans were the most at the Women's Final Four since 2004, which was when the Golden Gophers led made their first Final Four in New Orleans.

## TICK, TICK, BANG: MARA BRAUN

• Sophomore Mara Braun earned some well-deserved preseason recognition prior to the start of the 2023-24 season. The second-year Gopher was named to the Big Ten's 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team, as voted by the league's coaches. Braun was one of just two sophomores to be honored by the conference's coaches, joining Cotie McMahon of Ohio State.

• Braun has upped her game from deep this season, making an average of 2.9 per game, good enough for third in the Big Ten this season. Her free throw percentage of 94.8 (55-of-58) is the second best in the nation.

• Braun's program record of 37-straight free throws made was no surprise as the Wayzata, Minn., native holds a career percentage of 90.3 in 48 games, shooting 139-of-154.

• In just her 31st game sophomore Mara Braun reached 500 career points, eclipsing the mark with her 25-point performance against Chicago St. Braun reached the half-century mark the third-fastest in program history, just two games shy of the program record of 29 games by Lindsay Whalen. She was one game shy of Laura Coenen and beat out the likes of WNBA draftees Rachel Banham (32 games), Kenisha Bell (32) and Amanda Zahui B. (34).

• Braun has shown why she was deserving of the Preseason All-Big Ten selection, scoring 20 or more points in nine of the team's 19 games so far this season. She now scored in double figures 38 times in her 48-game career and has registered 17 20-point performances, with the Gophers record being 13-4 in those contests.

## LET'S WORK: THE NEW COACHING STAFF

• First year head coach Dawn Plitzuweit brought along many from her previous staff, including her entire assistant coaching staff from West Virginia. Associate head coach Jason Jeschke and assistant coaches Aaron Horn and Ariel Braker all joined Plitzuweit from Morgantown.

• New NCAA rules allowed the addition of more on-court coaches starting this season. Plitzuweit announced the elevation of Rachel Banham and Tyler VanWinkle as assistant coaches. Banham also serves as the team's Director of Quality Control while VanWinkle is also the team's Director of Video Services.

• Plitzuweit's assistant coaching staff brings in a plethora of experience and success at multiple levels. Jeschke has been with Plitzuweit for six seasons, Horn has been with Coach P since 2016 while Braker joined Plitzuweit's staff in 2021 at South Dakota. VanWinkle also worked with the staff in West Virginia as the team's video coordinator.

• Both Braker and Banham were successful on the court as NCAA players. Braker was a part of four Final Four teams while playing at Notre Dame, reaching the NCAA Championship game three times. Banham finished her college career as the No. 1 scorer in Big Ten history and left as the sixth-highest Division I scorer ever with 3,093 points.

## MULTI-SPORT ATHLETES

• Of Minnesota's 14 student-athletes, 10 of them were multi-sport athletes at the high school level.

• Most notably Ayiana 'AJ' Johnson was a five-sport athlete at Jefferson High School in Jefferson, Wis. On top of being a standout basketball player, Johnson was a top-five nationally ranked discus thrower and won a pair of Division 2 state championships. Johnson also helped her high school's golf team win a regional title while also participating in wrestling and football. On the gridiron Johnson played both quarterback and offensive line. Johnson has stated in interviews that she can hit a "7 or 8-iron about 250 yards off the tee."

• Redshirt freshman Niamya Holloway was a two-time state high jump champion in the state of Minnesota and was also state qualifier in the shot put and multiple relay teams for Eden Prairie. Her personal best mark was 5-11.

• Additionally, Mara Braun, Maggie Czinano, Janay Sanders and Sophie Hart were all were on their high school track and field teams. Braun was a state qualifier in the triple jump, Czinano holds multiple school records in sprints, Sanders was a state qualifier in the high and long jumps while Hart was a high jumper for her father, Tom Hart, at Farmington high school.

• Multiple Gophers on the 2023-24 roster were also standout volleyball players. Led by Mallory Heyer who had over 1,000 kills for Chaska high school. McKynnie Dalan was also a standout on the volleyball court as well as Grace Grocholski. Lastly, Ajok Madol was a member of her high school's soccer team during her prep career.

## CHECK THE RECORD

• Mallory Heyer has started her career by starting all 49 of the games she has played in. Her streak of 49 straight starts to kick off a career at Minnesota is the fifth-longest streak in program history.

• Grace Grocholski is on pace to make the second most threes in a single season by a freshman in program history (2.3 per game). Grocholski is also on pace for the second most 3-point attempts by a freshman in school history.

• Mara Braun's consecutive free throws streak ended against Purdue at 37. The 37 straight made free throws dated back to last season and ended as the fifth-longest streak in Big Ten history. The longest active streak on the team is Amaya Battle with 16 straight, the longest streak of her career.

NEXT-GEN GOPHS

- McKenna Johnson and Tori McKinney signed their National Letters of Intent to join Minnesota in 2024-25. Johnson brings a dynamic game to the Gophers as the No. 60 ranked recruit in the latest 2024 ESPN top 100 rankings. In her most recent season, the 5-9 guard averaged 26.1 points, 10 rebounds, 2.7 steals and 2.0 assists per contest.
- Johnson joined the Maroon and Gold as an early enrollee after graduating high school early. Johnson will be eligible to suit up for the Gophers, but is not anticipated to play during the 2023-24 season.
- McKinney earned back-to-back Defensive Player of the Year laurels from Prep Girls Hoops during the 2022 and 2023 AAU season, which she played with North Tartan. In McKinney's most recent AAU campaign she averaged 11.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.1 steals.

FIND A WAY

- Find A Way, one of Plitzuweit's coaching montras, has helped the Gophers come from behind three different times when they trail after the third quarter. Those games include: at Michigan, vs. Drake and vs. Purdue. Minnesota's largest comeback in the fourth quarter this season was an 11-point comeback against Drake, a game the Gophers won in double overtime.
- Behind the new leadership of Dawn Plitzuweit the Golden Gophers have started 14-5, the team's best 19-game start to a season since 2014-15 when the team started 16-3 and made the NCAA Tournament (lost in First Round).
- Among Plitzuweit's accomplishments this season, Minnesota's 16-point road win over Michigan stands out, tying the team's largest road Big Ten win since 2019 (20-point win over Purdue).
- Plitzuweit's record breaking first win over LIU was a 35-point victory, the largest margin of victory for Minnesota in a coaching debut in program history. Plitzuweit's debut included a program record for points in the first quarter with 34 (quarters were introduced to NCAA WBB prior to the 2015-16 season).

MOVE DA CROWD

- On Dec. 4, the Gophers announced an advanced sellout for the Feb. 28, matchup with Iowa. Over 13,000 fans are expected to witness the border battle between the Gophers and Hawkeyes, which will be streamed on Peacock.
- The University of Minnesota hosted 10,869 fans against No. 8/8 UConn on Nov. 19, one of the largest crowds for any women's basketball game this season.
- For Minnesota, the 10,869 fans were the most at a single game for the program since 2018, when the team sold out their season opening game against New Hampshire. Since 2007, the UConn game was just the second time the program had hosted over 10,000 fans at a game.
- The 10,869 fans against UConn marked the 24th time in program history the Gophers had hosted over 10,000 fans with the total being the 20th-largest crowd in program history.

IF YOU WANT TO DANCE

- The latest NET Rankings have been updated with the Minnesota Golden Gophers sitting at No. 33 through 19 games. Minnesota currently has six wins over top 100 teams. The NET algorithm was adopted in the 2020-21 season when the Division I Women's Basketball Committee officially moved on from the RPI system.
- As of Jan. 25, the Gophers are 6-3 against top 100 teams in the NET rankings, defeating Michigan State (No. 20) Nebraska (No. 34), Michigan (No. 42) defeating Purdue (No. 78), Stony Brook (No. 66) and Drake (No. 63) and losing to UConn (No. 4), Iowa (No. 5), Indiana (No. 12) and Maryland (No. 29).
- As of Jan. 23, there are 11 teams on Minnesota's 2023-24 schedule that are included in the latest ESPN Bracketology by Charlie Creme. Minnesota has faced all but one of them with seven of the 11 being from the Big Ten (Maryland, Indiana, Michigan State, Nebraska, Ohio State, Penn State and Iowa).

- Minnesota most recently moved 'off the bubble' after the team's victory over Nebraska. The 'Last Four Byes' are Penn State, Iowa State, Maryland and Miami. Minnesota is currently projected as a eight seed in the Stanford pod.

LET'S ROCK: STARTING FAST

- On average the Maroon and Gold have outscored their opponents 18.8 to 15.2 in first quarters this season. In the first half the Golden Gophers have outscored their opposition on an average of 37.8-28.7.
- Mara Braun has posted two 14-point first quarters this season. In first halves this season Braun has posted performances of 23 points (Chicago State), 17 points (Grambling and Kentucky) and 14 points (Lindenwood and Michigan). Freshman Grace Grocholski also scored 17 of her 26 points against Norfolk St., in the first half.

## TOO TOUGH: CLOSING STRONG

- Minnesota has been elite down the stretch of games this season, out scoring their opponents, on average, 19.2 to 13.5 in the fourth quarter this season. This season the Gophers have held their opponents to 36.5 percent (92-of-252) from the floor in the fourth quarter and just 26.8 percent (26-of-97) from beyond the arc.
- The team's best fourth quarter defensive performance this season was against CSUN where they tied a program record for points allowed in a quarter at just two.

## THE NIA FACTOR

- It was an emotional debut for redshirt freshman Niamya Holloway against LIU on Nov. 8, the Eden Prairie, Minn., native waited 607 days between official basketball games. Holloway overcame a torn ACL and made the most of her debut by scoring 11 points off the bench, six coming in the fourth quarter, while grabbing six rebounds with five coming on the offensive glass, a team high.
- According to HerHoopStats, Holloway is one of three players in the NCAA this season to average 1.6 steals per game while playing less than 13 minutes per game (Audrey Koch of Providence and Jessika Evans of Tulsa).
- This season Holloway is tied for 15th overall in the Big Ten this season in steals per game (1.5) and is the highest ranked player in steals per game while coming off the bench.

## SOPH THE GOPH

- In her first full season with the Maroon and Gold Sophie Hart been steady in the team's eight Big Ten contests, averaging 10.0 points per game and shooting 55.7 percent (39-of-70) from the floor while adding an average of 4.9 rebounds, and is second on the team in conference play in offensive rebounds with 16.
- Overall this season Hart leads Minnesota in field goal percentage at 59.9, but falls just short of the Big Ten and NCAA standard of five field goals made per game to qualify among the leaders (Hart makes an average of 4.6 per game). Hart's field goal percentage would rank her No. 4 in the Big Ten this season and would be No. 21 individually in the country.

- This season Minnesota is 12-0 when leading at halftime and 11-0 when leading after the third quarter.
- The Gophers are 11-1 when allowing 59 or less points this season.

## HEAD COACH DAWN PLITZUWEIT FIRST SEASON • MICHIGAN TECH, '95



Dawn Plitzuweit was named the 13th women's basketball coach in Minnesota history on March 18, 2023.

Plitzuweit (PLITTS-zoo-white) joined the Maroon and Gold after serving as the head coach at West Virginia University last season where she led the Mountaineers to an NCAA Tournament berth in 2023.

Plitzuweit has made an immediate impact on the Golden Gophers, posting the third-best start to a season in program history through 12 games at 11-1.

Prior to her season in Morgantown, Plitzuweit also served as the head coach at South Dakota from 2016-22. During her six seasons in Vermillion, S.D., she amassed a 158-36 record, including an 83-10 mark in the Summit League. The three-time Summit League Coach of the Year, Plitzuweit led the Coyotes to three regular-season championships, three conference tournament championships, four NCAA Tournament appearances and a berth in the 2022 NCAA Sweet 16 during her tenure at USD.

Plitzuweit brings in a career coaching record of 365-141 (.721) in 16 seasons as a head coach, including a 248-103 (.707) at the Division I level. Prior to South Dakota and West Virginia Plitzuweit also was the head coach at Northern Kentucky (2012-16) and Grand Valley State (2002-07). She also was an assistant coach at Michigan (2007-12), Green Bay (1998-02), Wisconsin (1997-98) and her alma mater Michigan Tech (1995-97).

As a head coach Plitzuweit has been a mainstay in post-season play, reaching either the NCAA Tournament or WNIT in 15 of her 16 seasons as a head coach. She holds the Summit League record for overall winning percentage (.814) and conference winning percentage (.892). She's totaled 15 winning seasons, two 30-win campaigns and nine 20-win seasons.

Plitzuweit's honors over her coaching career include the 2021-22 Kay Yow Award, presented annually to the Division I women's head college basketball coach who embodies a winning spirit while displaying great character, on and off the court. She was the Summit League Coach of the Year three straight years (2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20). She also was the 2005-06 NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year at Grand Valley State University.

Statistically, Plitzuweit's teams in each of the past five seasons have ranked in the top 20 nationally in turnover margin, including the 2022-23 season at West Virginia at a margin of 6.1, which was the No. 1 mark in the Big 12 and the ninth-best margin in the country.

A 1995 graduate of Michigan Tech, Plitzuweit earned back-to-back GLIAC Player of the Year awards, four all-conference honors and three all-defensive team nods. She led the Huskies to a 99-22 record and four trips to the NCAA Division II Tournament. She was a Division II Bulletin All-America Second Team selection and a two-time Kodak All-America honorable mention pick (1994, 1995). She earned WBCA All-Academic accolades in 1994 and 1995 and was named Michigan's NCAA Woman of the Year in 1995.
