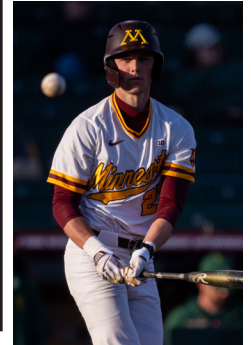

## WEEKLY NOTES

### HISTORICAL NOTES

-The 'U' is in its 136th year in program history in the spring of 2024.

-John Anderson is in his 43rd year at the helm of the Gopher baseball program and has compiled a 1,379-1011 career record. This includes a 615-419 record in Big Ten play.

-On April 22, 2022, Anderson became the first BIG coach to ever surpass 600 wins in conference play. He looks to add to that total this season.

### ANDERSON'S FINAL RIDE

-The 2024 season will be head coach John Anderson's 43rd and final year leading the Gophers. He announced in December that he will retire at the conclusion of the season.

-Anderson has led Minnesota to 11 Big Ten titles and have made the NCAA Tournament 19 times. He is an eight-time Big Ten Coach of the Year honoree and was named Midwest Region Coach of the Year three times.

-Anderson's career began as a player for the Gophers in 1974 before he became a student assistant from 1976-77 and graduate assistant in 1978. From 1979-81, he served as an assistant coach before being hired as the head coach in '81.

### JUNIOR LEADERSHIP

-Minnesota's roster consists of 12 juniors that have gained valuable experience in their first two seasons as members of the youngest team in the Big Ten in 2023.

-Eight of the 12 juniors saw regular playing time last season in key roles. Brady Counsell, Jake Perry and Ike Mezzenga made up the Minnesota infield

for most of the season, while Jake Larson found his way into 32 games. Tucker Novotny was the Friday starter in 2023 and Connor Wietgreffe, Noah Rooney, and Seth Clausen played prominent roles in the Gopher bullpen.

### WIETGREFFE'S WORLD

-Junior LHP Connor Wietgreffe put together his fifth quality start of the season on Saturday afternoon at Michigan.

-The Prior Lake, Minn. native pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs on three hits and three walks. Wietgreffe fanned eight Wolverine hitters in the start and picked up his team-high fourth win of the season.

-In two starts in the month of April, Wietgreffe has pitched 12.2 innings, allowing just two runs. He has struck out ten batters and has a 1.42 ERA while picking up two wins.

-The southpaw currently ranks fifth in the Big Ten in ERA (3.40), tied for third in wins (4), seventh in innings (50.1) and tenth in strikeouts (46).

### NEELS BY THE NUMBERS

-Sophomore Weber Neels has picked up where he left off after a stellar freshman season.

-Neels leads the team in average (.321) and RBIs (25). He is second in on base percentage (.437) and doubles (8), walks (17) and is third in hits (35). He is also slugging .477 with three home runs for the season.

-Splitting time at catcher and first base, Neels is one of three players that has played all 30 games this season and leads the team with 421 putouts.

### CONSISTENCY IN COUNSELL

-Counsell has been a consistent bright spot in the Gophers lineup. He reanks in the top five in all offensive categories including leading the team in home runs (8), runs (29), total bases (67), walks (19) and stolen bases (12).

-A Milwaukee, Wis. native, Counsell is slashing .290/.395/.540. He has 36 hits, including seven doubles, and 19 RBIs.

-Counsell leads the team with 79 assists, playing all 30 games at second base.

### PRODUCTIVE PITCHING

-The Gophers' pitching staff has put together impressive numbers among Big Ten ranks to begin the season. The Gophers have allowed the second-fewest runs (166) and earned runs (135) in the Big Ten. As a team, the 'U' ranks fifth in the Big Ten in ERA (5.11) and sixth in opponent hitting (.266). The team also ranks third in the conference in strikeouts per nine innings (9.5).

### NEWCOMERS MAKING AN IMPACT

-Kyle Remington has been a staple out of the Gophers' bullpen. He was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week on Mar. 11. He continued his impressive

freshman season by working 1.2 innings of relief against Michigan. He held the Wolverines scoreless, allowing one hit, zero walks and picked up one strikeout.

-Tyler Hemmesch has pitched 16.2 innings in eight appearances for the Gophers in his rookie season. He's tallied 16 strikeouts with a 2.70 ERA and is holding opponents to .179 average off him.

-Charlie Sutherland has appeared in 16 games this season with three starts. He has emerged as one of the Gophers' go-to hitters off the bench. In 26 at bats, he is slashing .308/.438/.462 with a home run, a double, six RBIs and four runs scored.

-Senior transfer Justin Thorsteinson has provided the Gophers a trustworthy arm in the back end of the bullpen. In 21.2 innings, he has a 2.91 ERA and 21 punch outs.

-Freshman Jack Taxdahl earned his first start behind the dish on Saturday afternoon. He went 1-4 with a run scored in the win. In seven games this season, he is hitting .364 with an RBI and two runs scored.

-Freshman Jack Spanier has seen an increase in playing time after flashing the leather at shortstop. In 12 games played, he has recorded eight putouts and 25 assists without committing an error. Spanier

has also picked up five hits since seeing more regular action.

### WEEKEND RECAP

-The Gophers fell 8-1 in game one of a doubleheader on Saturday afternoon. Michigan starter Kurt Barr held Minnesota to one run on five hits in a complete game on the mound. Brady Counsell drove in the Gophers' lone run with his seventh home run of the season.

-The 'U' answered in game two behind a six-run second inning. Jake Perry hit his fourth home run of the year in the inning, a three-run shot. For the day, Perry went 3-4 with a walk and a home run, four RBIs and two stolen bases. Brady Counsell also drove in two runs in the second inning, his 17th and 18th of the year. Wietgrefe pitched 6.0 innings of two-run ball and the Gophers coasted to an 8-3 win.

-The Wolverines jumped out to an early lead in game three after scoring seven runs in the first two innings. The Maroon and Gold got a pair back after back-to-back home runs by Mezzenga and Fitzgerald. It was the third time this season Minnesota has hit back-to-back home runs. Michigan tacked on two more before Counsell hit his eighth home run of the season to make it a 10-3 final in favor of the Wolverines.

- Packy Casey completed his tenth season with the Gophers in 2023, after previously serving as the volunteer assistant from 2014 to 2016.
- Has been promoted twice during his tenure, most recently to recruiting coordinator in the summer of 2018. He's helped bring in several outstanding recruiting classes and his 2021 class ranked in the top-50 nationally.
- Minnesota has 241 wins since his arrival in 2014 with two Big Ten Championships, a Big Ten Tournament Championship in 2018, two NCAA Regional appearances and the program's first NCAA Super Regional berth in 2018.
- Since Casey has donned the Maroon and Gold, Minnesota has turned into an offensive juggernaut which led the Big Ten in hitting, overall and in conference play, for three straight seasons from 2016 to 2018, and again in 2020.
- Packy is wearing No. 56 this season in honor of the 1956 National Championship team.



### TY MCDEVITT

ASSISTANT COACH-PITCHING & PLAYER DEVELOPMENT, 8TH SEASON
