#### THE MCDEVITT ERA

-Tv McDevitt enters his first year at the helm of the Gopher baseball program after John Andersons retirement after 43 years.

-The 'U' is entering its 137th year in program 15-10 history in the spring of 2025.

> -Throughout their time in the Big Ten the Gophers are 1,223-847-5.

> -McDevitt picked up his first career victory in convincing fashion with a 14-3 victory over Houston on Feb.14.

#### HISTORICAL NOTES

-The 'U' is in its 137th year in program history in the spring of 2025. They finished 25-23 overall with an 11-13 conference record. The 'U' ended the season on a high note taking the final two games of the season on the road at Northwestern.

-The Gophers hit 68 homeruns last season, the most in the BBCOR era and in 25 years. That team now sits No.4 in school history.

#### **D1BASEBALL HONORS**

-Senior Jake Perry and junior Weber Neels were named D1baseball 2025 Preseason Player Rankings: Top 50 Lists.

-Senior Josh Fitzgerald was named a Top 100 outfielder.

- Fitzgerald was named the No.74 outfielder.
- Perry was ranked the No.23 third baseman and Neels the No. 40 catcher.

#### RETURN TO HEALTH

- -Redshirt junior Noah Rooney (LHP) will return to the mound in 2025 after missing the 2024 season due to an elbow injury.
- Rooney has thrown 24.0 innings thus far out of the Gopher bullpen and holds a 2-1

record with 20 strikeouts.

#### **GOPHERS PRODUCING POWER**

-The Gopher offenese has slugged 40 home runs in the first 25 games of the season.

- 11 different Gophers have hit at least one home run this season.
- Junior Drew Berkland leads the team with 10, fellow Junior Easton Richter is right behind him with seven.
- Along with home runs the Gophers have hit 54 doubles and 7 triples for a total of 101 extra base hits.

#### PATIENCE AT THE PLATE

- Minnesota's patience at the plate has paid off. As a team the Gophers have drawn 129 walks and been hit by pitch 35 times for 164 free passes.
- Junior Weber Neels has been hit a team leading 10 times. Fellow junior Drew Berkland leads the team with 17 base on balls. Six different Gophers have been walked 10+ times through the first 28 games.

#### SLINGING SOUTHPAWS

- Senior lefty Justin Thorsteinson had a standout performance versus High Point where he picked up a career high 11 strikeouts through 5.0 IP, while only giving up one hit.
- Red shirt junior Noah Rooney has also been a force on the mound throwing 24.0 innings with 20 strikeouts.

Ty McDevitt was named the 16th head coach in program history on May 22nd, 2024 following the retirement of John Anderson, who coached the Gophers for 43 seasons.

McDevitt is entering his ninth season on the staff but first at the helm of the program. Prior to being named skipper, McDevitt served as the teams pitching coach from 2019-2024 and was a volunteer assistant from 2017-2018.

During his time as the pitching coach, Gopher pitching rose to new heights. During the 2024 season the staff ranked first in the Big Ten in fewest earned runs and home runs allowed. They ranked third in ERA, K/H per nine innings, and hits allowed and fourth in strikeouts.

Under McDevitt's watch, the Gophers have had 11 different pitchers drafted (seven in the top-10 rounds), two All-Americans, a Big Ten Pitcher of the Year, the Big Ten Freshman of the Year, four first team All-Big Ten selections, two Second Team All-Big Ten nods, and All-Big Ten Third team honoree and two Big Ten All-Freshman Team members. Minnesota has also had nine hurlers selected as the Big Ten Pitcher of the Week under McDevitt.

Before joining the Gopher coaching staff, MecDevitt was a staple in the Minnesota bullpen. During his playing career (2012-2016) he made 45 appearances including five starts. He posted a 9-4 career recorded and had an ERA under four in three seasons. In 2016, McDevitt's senior season, the Gophers won the Big Ten Championship for the first time since 2010. That year, McDevitt posted a 3.77 ERA and a 4-1, totaling 23 strikouts in 28.2 innings.



# **ALEC CRAWFORD**

PITCHING COACH, 3RD SEASON

-Connor Gandossy joined the Gopher staff as an assistant coach in June of 2024. He will focus on hitters and catchers at Minnesota. He comes to Minnesota after spending the last seven seasons as hitting coach and recruiting coordinator for the Creighton Baseball program. He was also responsible for the Bluejay catchers. 
-Connor also made an impact on the recruting trail, recruiting classes consistently in the top 100.


# **NOLAN SUMMERFIELD**


-While pursuing his undergrad degree, he spent time working with the Wareham Gateman of the Cape Cod League and Pierre Trappers of the Expedition League.
