GAME NOTES

STARTING FIVE

- The Golden Gophers women's basketball team will wrap up its three-game homestand Wednesday night against No. 3 UCLA. Following the game, Minnesota will travel west to play Washington and Oregon.
- The Maroon and Gold improved to 3-2 in Big Ten play after defeating No. 21 USC 63-62 on Sunday. It marked the Gophers' first win over an AP Top 25 opponent since defeating No. 19 Arizona State 80-66 at Williams Arena on Nov. 17, 2019.
- Grace Grocholski led the Gophers with 25 points, eight rebounds and a season-high three steals against the Trojans. Grocholski matched her career high in field-goal attempts, going 10-of-20 from the field and 5-of-10 from beyond the arc.
- Sophie Hart and Mara Braun also made impactful contributions in the win over the Trojans. Hart finished with 15 points, six rebounds and two steals. Braun posted career highs of 10 rebounds and 10 defensive rebounds while adding six points, two assists, two blocks and one steal.
- Braun and Grocholski have each reached 1,000 career points this season. With those milestones, Minnesota now has three active 1,000-point scorers, including Amaya Battle. Brylee Glenn is nearing the mark with 910 career points.
- Battle has recorded 541 career assists, ranking fourth in Minnesota history. She needs four more assists to surpass Shayne Mullaney (544) for third on the program's career assists list. This season, the Hopkins, Minn., native leads the Gophers in assists (61) and rebounds (118). She ranks No. 14 in assists per game and No. 10 in rebounds per game in the Big Ten.

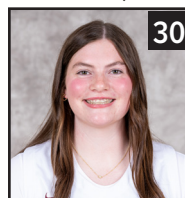

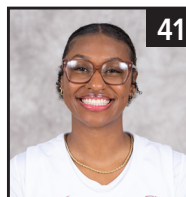

GOPHERS' QUICK HITTERS

- Mara Braun is a student-athlete ambassadors with Special Olympics Minnesota.
- Niamya Holloway helped co-found the Black Student Union and worked to promote youth leadership at Central Middle School in Minnesota and promoted racial equity as a senior officer for the Dare 2 Be Real organization.
- Niamya Holloway was a two-time high school high jump state champion at Eden Prairie high school where she cleared a personal record 5-10. Her senior year she won a state championship in the high jump, took third in both the 4x200m relay and the 4x400m relay and was ninth in the shot put competition. Two days after the state championship track meet, she was at summer workouts with the Gophers.
- The 2025-26 season is the first time that sisters Tracey and Zoey Bershers will play on the same team. Before transferring to Minnesota, Tracey played with their other sister, Sara, at UAB.
- Brynn Senden is a third-generation Gopher. Both of the junior guard's parents were student-athletes at the University of Minnesota. Senden's mother, Kristen, was a gymnast while her father, Stuart, played on the men's hockey team. Senden's grandfather, Bruce Vandersall, was also a member of the Gopher football staff from 1973-82. Her younger sister Tenley just finished her freshman season on the women's soccer team.
- Junior Grace Grocholski won two state basketball titles in the state of Wisconsin, winning the championships in back-to-back seasons where Grocholski was the team's leading scorer both seasons.
- Junior Mara Braun won a gold medal with Team USA in 2023 at the FIBA 3x3 Nations League Final where her U21 team finished undefeated against both U21 and U23 age group teams.
- Junior Taylor Woodon's father, Johnny, played football at the University of Minnesota.
- Freshman Makena Christian was named Wisconsin State Player of the Year, leading the Hartford Union Orioles to the North Shore Conference Championship and state semifinal game.
- Niamya Holloway was honored with the 2025 Big Ten Jackie Robinson Community & Impact Award. The award recognizes student-athletes at Big Ten institutions who strive to have a positive impact not only in their chosen sport, but also within their community.

WHERE THEY RANK

- Minnesota is ranked No. 14 in the NET and is one of nine Big Ten teams in the top 25. The Gophers also received 12 votes in this week's AP Top 25 poll.
- Minnesota leads the nation with 11 games holding opponents to 50 points or fewer. No other team in the country has more than eight such games, and the next closest team in the Big Ten is Maryland at seven games.
- The Maroon and Gold rank No. 1 in the nation and the Big Ten in fewest turnovers per game, averaging 10.4.
- Minnesota's 1.62 assist-to-turnover ratio ranks seventh nationally and third in the conference.

SERIES HISTORY

- UCLA leads the all-time series 3-1, dating back to 1979.
- The Gophers' lone win came in 2004 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament when Minnesota defeated UCLA 92-81 at Williams Arena.
- In the teams' last meeting, the Gophers fell to the Bruins 79-53 at Pauley Pavilion when UCLA held the No. 1 ranking in both the AP and USA TODAY Coaches Polls.

THE ORIGINAL G-MONEY

- This season, Grace Grocholski leads Minnesota with 222 points and 13.9 points per game.
- The guard-forward is shooting 52.5% from the field, 48.2% from 3-point range and 83.3% from the free throw line. She's one of two players in the country this season to boast those shooting percentages (min. 100 field goal attempts) along with Nebraska's Britt Prince.
- Grocholski ranks sixth nationally and first in the Big Ten in 3-point percentage.
- She also ranks fourth in the conference in 3-pointers made (41) and 3-pointers made per game (2.56).
- She ranks second on the Gophers' roster with 44 assists.
- She also ranks fourth in the conference in 3-pointers made (41) and 3-pointers made per game (2.56).
- Against No. 7 Maryland, Grocholski knocked down a career-high nine 3-pointers on her way to a career-best 31 points, tying for the second-most 3-pointers ever made in a game by a Gopher.

BATTLE TIME

- Amaya Battle is one of only two active NCAA players with more than 1,000 career points, 600 career rebounds and 500 career assists.
- Battle has recorded 1,289 points, 646 rebounds and 541 assists. Olivia Miles is the only other player to reach those marks, finishing with 1,761 points, 728 rebounds and 784 assists.
- Along with Battle, Rachel Banham is the only other Golden Gopher to record at least 1,000 points, 500 assists and 600 rebounds.
- Battle also ranks fourth all time in career assists in Minnesota's record book.

GOPHERS IN THE PROS

- Minnesota alum Rachel Banham kicked off Unrivaled play with the Lunar Owls this month.
- The Owls have competed three times this season, with Banham appearing in all three games. Banham is averaging eight minutes per game and has scored 16 points this season.
- Next, the Owls will face the Mist on Saturday at 7:30 p.m. CT. The game can be streamed live on TruTV.
- Banham also announced a podcast with WNBA veteran Aari McDonald titled Unfiltered at Unrivaled. The first episode will launch Jan. 15, with special guest Paige Bueckers.

HOLLOWAY EARNS JACKIE ROBINSON COMMUNITY AND IMPACT AWARD

- Niamya Holloway was honored by the Big Ten Conference back in November, being named Minnesota's Jackie Robinson Community and Impact Award recipient.
- Presented by Discover, it was established in 2025 to recognize student-athletes at Big Ten institutions who strive to have a positive impact not only in their chosen sport, but also within their community.

FRESH IMPACT

- Freshman Makena Christian has made an impact off the bench for the Gophers this season. She is averaging 5.3 points per game and has collected 22 rebounds.
- In her debut against North Dakota on Nov. 4, the guard recorded a career-high 23 points.
- She is the first Gopher to score 23 points in her debut since Lindsey Lieser did so against Ball State on Nov. 20, 1999.
- The mark also ranks ninth all time in points by a nonstarter.

eligible for the 2025-26 season. She started all games last year, averaging 8.9 points per game.

GROCHOLSKI NAMED TO BIG TEN WEEKLY HONOR ROLL

- After recording her second career double-double against Drake, Minnesota junior Grace Grocholski earned recognition on the Big Ten Weekly Honor Roll.
- Grocholski shot 8 of 9 from the field and 2 of 3 from 3-point range against the Bulldogs. She led the Golden Gophers with 18 points, three assists and a season-high 11 rebounds while shooting 88.9% from the field and 66.7% from beyond the arc. Eight of her rebounds came on the defensive end, matching a career high.
- The guard-forward ranks fourth nationally and second in the Big Ten in 3-point shooting at 50%.

CONTRACT EXTENSION

- Minnesota Director of Athletics Mark Coyle announced in June a contract extension that will keep head coach Dawn Plitzuweit in the Maroon and Gold through the 2031 season.
- Plitzuweit enters her third season as head coach of the Minnesota women's basketball program in 2025-26, following a standout campaign that saw the Gophers win the WBIT (Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament) Championship, their first postseason title since 2012.
- Minnesota is 45-27 overall under Plitzuweit, and she has led the Gophers to back-to-back postseason championship-game berths for the first time in program history (2024 WNIT, 2025 WBIT).

NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

- Dawn Plitzuweit and her staff welcomed four signees on Nov. 12, 2025 in Adit Kuol (Kampala, Uganda), Natalie Kussow (Hartland, Wis.), Tori Oehrlein (Crosby-Ironton, Minn.), and Kylee Paben (Omaha, Neb.) have signed to join the Minnesota women's basketball program for the 2026-27 season.
- ESPN's top 25 recruiting rankings for the 2026 women's NCAA basketball class were released Nov. 21, with the class earning the No. 19 spot.
- Kuol, has quickly established herself as a standout talent on the basketball court. In just one season at The King's Academy in Seymour, Tennessee, Kuol made an immediate impact, recording an impressive 539 rebounds during her junior campaign. Her presence in the paint and ability to control the boards played a key role in leading The King's Academy to the TSSAA Division II-A Final Four, where the team finished as state runner-up.
- Kussow, set Arrowhead's all-time girls' scoring record by December of her junior year. Kussow ended the 2024-25 season with 1,982 career points, averaging 26.3 points per game as a junior. Rated No. 23 nationally by 247Sports and No. 40 by ESPN HoopGurlz, Kussow was named the 2025 Gatorade Player of the Year and Milwaukee Journal Sentinel Wisconsin State Player of the Year as both a sophomore and junior. A two-time conference champion at Arrowhead High School, Kussow led the Warhawks to a Wisconsin state championship as a sophomore.
- The all-time leading scorer at Crosby-Ironton, Oehrlein posted the second-highest singleseason scoring total in Minnesota State High School League history in 2024 with 1,159 points, averaging 35.1 points per game. On the court, Oehrlein is ranked No. 2 in Minnesota, No. 38 nationally by 247Sports, and No. 58 by ESPN HoopGurlz.
- Competing at the Class A level of high school basketball in Nebraska,

Paben is a four year varsity letterwinner who has consistently delivered standout performances. As a junior, she earned all-conference, all-city, and all-state honors after averaging 13.2 points, 6.6 rebounds and 1.3 steals per game. After winning back-to-back Nebraska state high school championships, Paben was named to the all-state tournament team in both her sophomore and junior seasons, highlighted by being recognized as the Most Outstanding Player at the 2025 Nebraska State Tournament.

2024-25 SEASON NOTABLES

- The 2024-25 campaign saw Minnesota reach the 25-win milestone for the first time since 2004-05. The program won the 2025 WBIT Championship, earning its first postseason title since 2012.
- Minnesota earned its first AP Poll ranking since 2019, when the Gophers entered the polls at No. 24 on Jan. 13, 2025. The last time Minnesota was ranked before the 2024-25 season was on Dec. 30, 2019, the Gophers were ranked No. 24 after 12-straight wins.
- The Gophers reached the 25-win mark for the first time since 2004-05, and only the third time in program history a Gophers' squad has hit the milestone.
- Head Coach Dawn Plitzuweit earned her 400th career win in a come-from-behind victory over Illinois. The Maroon and Gold rallied from an 11-point deficit to beat the Fighting Illini.
- Minnesota finished with a 8-10 conference mark, improving from a 5-13 2023-24 record, earning them the No. 12 seed in the Big Ten Tournament in Indianapolis hosted at Gainbridge Fieldhouse.
- The Gophers played a total of 17 non-conference opponents during the regular and postseason going 17-0 against them. During the regular season, Minnesota set a new program record with 12 non-conference wins. The Gophers hit 11 wins during seven different seasons, most recently in 2018-19.
- Minnesota had its best 17-game start in program history with a 16-1 record before falling to No. 8 Maryland. The Gophers came close twice posting 15-2 marks to begin a season during 2002-03 and 2003-04.
- Annika Stewart, Grocholski and Battle all earned CSC (College Sports Communicators) Academic All-District Honors. Battle was recognized as an Academic All-American, the first Gopher to earn the honor since 2021.

WBIT CHAMPIONS

- The Golden Gophers concluded the 2024-25 season by winning the Women's Basketball Invitational Tournament (WBIT), marking the program's second postseason title. Minnesota previously won the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI) in 2012.
- In the championship game, Minnesota never trailed after taking an 18-8 lead in the first quarter and held Belmont to just 33.3 percent shooting from the field.
- Tori McKinney was named WBIT MVP after recording a career-high 26 points, along with three steals and three assists. She was joined on the WBIT All-Tournament Team by Amaya Battle.
- The Gophers' run to the WBIT title included four road wins, at Toledo, Missouri State, Florida and Belmont, and one home victory at Williams Arena over Gonzaga.

THE ROAD TO HINKLE

- After earning the No. 2 seed and an at-large bid to the Women's Basketball Invitational Tournament, the Gophers opened their tournament run with road victories over Toledo in the first round and Missouri State in the second round.
- Minnesota returned to "The Barn" for one final home game against Gonzaga. In the overtime win, Amaya Battle recorded the program's first points/assist double-double of the season, finishing with 35 points and 10 assists in the come-from-behind victory.
- The Gophers then made a quick trip to Hinkle Fieldhouse in Indianapolis for the WBIT semifinals, where they faced No. 3 seed Florida. A 66-52 win over the Gators secured Minnesota a spot in the championship game

BREAKING DOWN THE WBIT

- Minnesota was selected to compete in the Women's Basketball Invitational Tournament (WBIT), joining six other Power Four conference programs in the 32-team field. Arizona earned the No. 1 overall seed in the event.
- Now in its third season, the WBIT is a single-elimination tournament owned and operated by the NCAA. It serves as the second-tier postseason competition in women's college basketball, behind the NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament.

2024 ALL-BIG TEN GOPHERS

- Amaya Battle and Grace Grocholski earned All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honors by both the coaches and media.
- Maggie Czinano was named Minnesota's Sportsmanship Honoree for the second consecutive season.
- The Golden Gophers had 10 Academic All-Big Ten selections including returners Amaya Battle, Mara Braun, Grace Grocholski, Sophie Hart, Niamya Holloway, Kennedy Klick, and Brynn Senden.

MARA AND USA BASKETBALL

- Mara Braun, a guard from Wayzata, Minn., was one of 21 collegiate standouts that earned an opportunity to try out for the team that represented the U.S. at the FIBA Women's AmeriCup in Santiago, Chile from June 28-July 6.
- Despite not making the team, Braun had the opportunity to compete with the best talent at the NCAA level.
- Prior to the invite, Braun had experience with USA Basketball's 3x3 program, winning gold at the 2023 FIBA 3x3 Nations League Final.

GOPHERS SET FOR SEVEN GAMES WITH TV PARTNERS

- The Big Ten Conference announced a total of seven Minnesota women's basketball games will be broadcast nationally on Big Ten Network and FS1.
- Minnesota will be broadcast live on BTN in its games against Maryland (Dec. 7), Michigan (Jan. 5), Washington (Jan. 18), Iowa (Feb. 5), Nebraska (Feb. 12), and Wisconsin (Feb. 15). The Gophers' game against Michigan State will be live on FS1 (Feb. 22).
- Overall, every single Golden Gopher women's basketball contest will be broadcast on either a linear television network or on a streaming service.

TWO CHAMPIONSHIPS, ONE FAMILY

- Before leading the Gophers to the WBIT crown, Head Coach Dawn Plitzuweit's daughter won the Division II National Championship with Grand Valley State.
- Plitzuweit coached Grand Valley State to its first DII title in 2006, nearly 20 seasons later her daughter, Lexi, helped them win their second.

GOPHER RADIO NETWORK

- Lynette Sjoquist and Justin Gaard are teaming up for their fifth season as the Golden Gopher radio broadcast team.
- The 2025-26 season marks Sjoquist's 25th year on air covering Gopher women's basketball.
- The Gopher Radio Network will carry every game, home and away, on GopherSports.com.
- Fans can also listen in on KFAN+ 96.7 FM or the iHeartRadio app.

HEAD COACH DAWN PLITZUWEIT THIRD SEASON • MICHIGAN TECH, '95



The 2025-26 season will be the third season for Dawn Plitzuweit at the helm of the Golden Gophers women's basketball program. Plitzuweit was named the 13th women's basketball coach in Minnesota's history on March 18, 2023.

Plitzuweit (PLITTS-zoo-white) holds a career coaching record of 410-168 (.709) in 18 seasons as a head coach, including a 293-130 (.693) mark at the Division I level. She's totaled 17 winning seasons, two 30-win campaigns and 11 20-win seasons.

Minnesota went 25-11 in Plitzuweit's second year, highlighted by winning the 2025 WBIT (Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament) Championship, marking the 17th time in 18 seasons Plitzuweit has reached a postseason tournament. The Golden Gophers recorded their first 25 win season since 2004-05 (26-8, 12-4 B1G) and back-to-back 20 win seasons since 2017-18 and 2018-19. Plitzuweit also coached two Gophers to All-Big Ten Honorable Mention accolades in Amaya Battle and Grace Grocholski.

In Plitzuweit's first season, the Gophers won 20 games, finishing with an overall record of 20-16. The squad reached the WNIT Championship game and finished as the runner-up. In 2023-24, Plitzuweit coached a pair of All-Big Ten Honorable Mention guards in Mara Braun and Amaya Battle while also helping Grace Grocholski to a unanimous Big Ten All-Freshman Team selection.

Plitzuweit joined the Maroon and Gold after serving as the head coach at West Virginia University for the 2022-23 season where she led the Mountaineers to an NCAA Tournament berth.

Before her season in Morgantown Plitzuweit also served as the head coach at South Dakota from 2016-22. During her six seasons in Vermillion, South Dakota, she amassed a 158-36 record, including an 83-10 mark in the Summit League. The three-time Summit League Coach of the Year, Plitzuweit led the Coyotes to three regular-season championships, three conference tournament championships, four NCAA Tournament appearances and a berth in the 2022 NCAA Sweet 16 during her tenure at USD.

Prior to South Dakota and West Virginia Plitzuweit also was the head coach at Northern Kentucky (2012-16) and Grand Valley State (2002-07). She also was an assistant coach at Michigan (2007-12), Green Bay (1998-02), Wisconsin (1997-98) and her alma mater Michigan Tech (1995-97). She holds the Summit League record for overall winning percentage (.814) and conference winning percentage (.892).

Plitzuweit's honors over her coaching career include the 2021-22 Kay Yow Award, presented annually to the Division I women's head college basketball coach who embodies a winning spirit while displaying great character, on and off the court. She was the Summit League Coach of the Year three straight years (2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20). She also was the 2005-06 NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year at Grand Valley State University.

Statistically, Plitzuweit's teams in six of the past seven seasons have ranked in the top 20 nationally in turnover margin, including this 2024-25 season at a margin of 4.5, which was the No. 1 mark in the Big Ten and ninth-best margin in the country.

A 1995 graduate of Michigan Tech, Plitzuweit earned back-to-back GLIAC Player of the Year awards, four all-conference honors and three all-defensive team nods. She led the Huskies to a 99-22 record and four trips to the NCAA Division II Tournament. She was a Division II Bulletin All-America Second Team selection and a two-time Kodak All-America honorable mention pick (1994, 1995). She earned WBCA All-Academic accolades in 1994 and 1995 and was named Michigan's NCAA Woman of the Year in 1995.
