NOTE: Fully Automatic Timing became required for world records in January 1977. Prior to 1977, manual timers often used a conversion of +0.24 seconds added on to any hand-timed 100m or 200m marks, and +0.14 seconds (or +0.24 — varying depending on the timer) added on to any hand-timed mark in the 400 meters, 4x100 and 4x400m relay events.
