GAMEDAY NOTES

- The Aces fell to Purdue Fort Wayne, 72-66, in Evansville's final game prior to Thanksgiving.
- Three freshmen are among the top five scorers for the Aces this season. Leading UE's freshmen is Makayla Wallace who is third on the team, averaging 9.3 points per game. Also in the top five in scoring average are Tayzha Buck (8.5 points per game) and Anna Newman (8.0).
- After swatting three shots against Purdue Fort Wayne, junior center Kaylan Coffman moved into sixth all-time in Evansville program history in career blocks.
- Through four games, freshman guard Tayzha Buck leads Evansville in three-pointers made (11) and three-point percentage (45.8%). Buck's marks in each category also place her in the top five in the MVC sitting second in three-point percentage and fourth in triples per game.
- After missing much of last season due to an injury, redshirt senior guard Brooke Bishop has picked right up where she left off. In nine games last season, Bishop led the Aces in scoring in three of those games. This season, Bishop has led or been tied for the lead in scoring for Evansville in two of the four games, finishing with nine or more points in all four contests.
- Of the Aces' 12 student-athletes who have seen playing time this season, five are averaging eight or more points per game. Leading the way is redshirt senior Brooke Bishop who is averaging 10.8 points per contest while senior Kerri Gasper and freshman Makayla Wallace have recorded 9.3 points per game.
- Evansville snapped a 22-game losing streak with its 67-58 road win over Chicago State on Nov. 10.
- The road win was the first for the Purple Aces since a 52-44 victory at Indiana State on March
- Against Murray State, freshman Makayla Wallace scored 16 points, the most by a Purple Ace in their freshman debut since Shyla McKibbon scored 16 at Eastern Illinois on Nov. 15, 1997.

MVC Player of the Week

Sara Rhine, Jr., F, Drake

Sara Rhine continued her stellar play at the Vancouver Showcase. In three games, Rhine averaged 20.3 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.0 steal per game, helped Drake go 2-1 with wins over Power 5 members, Rutgers and No. 12/13 South Carolina with its lone loss to No. 1 Notre Dame, claim third place at the inaugural 8-team event and she was named MVP of the consolation game against South Carolina. In the comeback victory over Rutgers she scored 18 points on 7-of-13 shooting from the floor and 4-of-5 from the free throw line to go with four rebounds and one steal

in 23 minutes. Against No. 1 Notre Dame, which won the tournament, she scored 18 points on 8-of-14 shooting, and pulled down five rebounds in 18 minutes. Rhine had her best game in the win over No. 12/13 South Carolina, she scored a team-high 23 points on 8-of-14 shooting from the floor and 8-of-10 from the free throw line in addition to pulling down six rebounds and grabbing one steal in 29 minutes. Rhine is second in the MVC in scoring at 17.9 points per game, fourth in rebounding at 8.0 per game and fourth in shooting 55.6.

 Basketball on December 21, 2016.
- Spent five years as an assistant before being named interim head coach on February 29, 2016.
- Recorded his first head coaching victory in a 61-59 triumph over Illinois State in Moline, Illinois in the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament.
- Ruffing's .452 win percentage in his first full season is the best in program history.
- In his first full season at the helm, Ruffing led the Aces to a 14-17 overall mark and an 8-10 record in conference play.
- Under his direction, Sara Dickey (first-team) and Camary Williams (honorable mention) each earned All-Missouri Valley Conference honors for 2016-17.
- With Dickey's first-team honor, she became the first student-athlete in program history to earn three first-team all-conference honors and the first to be named to the all-conference team in all four seasons.


