### GAMEDAY NOTES

- Evansville is looking to snap an 11-game losing streak when the Purple Aces host Indiana State on Friday night.
- Friday night's contest is te Aces' annual Play 4 Kay game sponsored by "Thumbs-Up" Promotions. The first 150 fans inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse will receive a free women's cance awareness hat.
- The Aces and Sycamores meeting on Friday marks the 54th time the two sides have done battle with Indiana State owning a 36-17 advantage in the series.
- In the series with Indiana State, the Aces are looking for back-to-back home victories for the first time since the 2006-07 and 2007-08 seasons.
- A win would give UE its first MVC victory of the season and its first win of 2018.
- Evansville enters a three-game homestand over the next two weeks, its longest homestand of the season. Since the start of the 2016-17 season, the Aces are 11-12 at home with a 3-5 mark inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse this season. UE hasn't lost a game to an in-state opponent inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse since an 81-65 loss to Valparaiso on November 22, 1991.
- Sophomore guard Kadie Dearing has seen increased playing time recently. The Huntingburg, Ind. native has played 76 minutes over the last three games while seeing just 77 total minutes of action in the previous 17 contests.

### GAME OVERVIEW

Evansville takes on Indiana State in its lone contest of the weekend as the two travel partners meet in their second matchup of the season and their 54th meeting all-time. The Sycamores lead the all-time series with the Aces, 36-17, and captured the first meeting between the two sides this season in comeback fashion, 56-48, after Evansville dominated much of the first half. Since they last met on January 7, Evansville is 0-6 and the Sycamores are 4-2. Indiana State boasts this week's MVC Player of the Week in guard Ashli O'Neal who averaged 21.5 points per game to help lead ISU to a pair of road wins at Loyola and Valparaiso last weekend.

- Just once since 2012 has either team scored 70 points in a game in the series with Indiana State scoring 71 in a 71-53 win over the Aces on February 27, 2015.
- Evansville is looking for back-to-back home victories over Indiana State for the first time since the 2006-07 and 2007-08 seasons.

### ONE TO WATCH



#3 ASHLI O'NEAL 5-5, SOPHOMORE, GUARD WYOMING, OHIO

- Named MVC Player of the Week on Monday after averaging 21.5 points, five rebounds, and a pair of assists in two road victories for Indiana State.
- Sits second on the team in scoring average (10.9) and total assists (31), and is third in total steals with 23.
- Has played and started in all 20 contests during her sophomore campaign.
- Scored a season-high 22 points twice, most recently in a 67-54 win at Valparaiso on Sunday afternoon.
- Played in 23 games, averaging 19 minutes per contest and 4.5 points per game during her freshman campaign.
- Came to Indiana State following a strong career at Wyoming High School in Wyoming, Ohio where she was twice named Cincinnati Hills League Athlete of the Year.

### ACES NOTES

#### **Record Update**

A number of Aces are on pace to enter the top 10 of Evansville single-season record book. Graduate guard Hannah Noe sits one three-pointer away from tying Dian Starry for tenth with 55 triples in a single-season. If the season ended today, junior guard Kerri Gasper would set a single-season record for free-throw percentage as Gasper is 38-40 (95%) from the charity stripe which would best Mallory Ladd's 94.9% in the 2012-13 season. Sophomore guard Kaylan Coffman has amassed 28 blocks on the year, two away from tying Jamie Gray for 10th in single-season rejections.

#### **Efficient Evansville**

This season, the Aces are one of the more efficient shooting teams in the Missouri Valley Conference. Evansville leads the conference in three-point field goal percentage (36.4%) and free-throw percentage (83.2%) while sitting sixth in the MVC in field goal percentage (39.7%).

#### **Back Home Again**

Evansville enters a three-game homestand over the next two weeks, its longest homestand of the season. Since the start of the 2016-17 season, the Aces are 11-12 at home with a 3-5 mark inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse this season. UE hasn't lost a game to an in-state opponent inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse since an 81-65 loss to Valparaiso on November 22, 1991.

#### **Stifling Defense**

In the Purple Aces' 79-53 win over Westminster, Evansville held the Blue Jays to just 27% shooting from the field. The 27% field goal percentage is the lowest an Aces opponent has recorded since Evansville limited Indiana State to just 25.5% (14-55) on Dec. 30, 2016.

#### Stellar Debut

Graduate guard Hannah Noe recorded a careerhigh 33 points in the Aces' 89-81 victory over Murray State on Sunday. Noe's 33 points were the most for a Purple Ace in their debut since at least 2001-02 and the third-highest scoring output since then, as well.

#### Getting It Done at the Line

In their 89-81 victory over Murray State, Evansville hit 28 of its 32 attempts at the free throw line. The 28 made free throws were the most for the Purple Aces since knocking-down 33 against Indiana State on January 27, 2015.

#### "Movin' On Up"

The Aces amassed an 11-win improvement last season, its third-largest in program history. Evansville tallied 13-win increases in 1986-87 and 1998-99.

#### **Double-Digit Dubs**

The Aces rebounded with a 14-win season in 2016-17, giving UE its third double-digit victory campaign in the past four years.

#### **Ruffing's Fast Start**

Head coach Matt Ruffing recorded the secondbest record in a coach's first full season in program history. Ruffing's 14 wins were just shy of Misty Murphy's 15 victories in the 2008-09 season, but Ruffing's .452 win-percentage exceeds Murphy's .441.

#### A Dish Best Served Cold

With the 65-59 win over Missouri State in the quarter finals of the MVC Tournament, the Aces avenged a 75-66 MVC Tourney semifinal loss to the Bears that ended UE's run for a tournament title in 2015.

#### Magic Matt

In two Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, head coach Matt Ruffing has picked up a pair of tourney-opening victories. Ruffing's first MVC Tournament victory came as interim head coach in 2016 as the Aces defeated ISU, 61-59. Ruffing then led UE to a 65-59 triumph over reigning tournament champion Missouri State in 2017.

#### **Efficient Evansville**

Shooting .380 from the field on the season, UE finished the season strong, shooting under .400 just once in the final seven games of the season. During that stretch, the Aces compiled a six-game winning streak and shot .508 in an 81-50 road victory over Loyola Chicago, a season-best in MVC competition.

#### **Peaking Purple Aces**

The Aces' 65-59 win over MSU in the 2017 MVC Tournament quarterfinals marked the third-straight season that UE has captured a win in the tournament. The longest such streak is four-straight seasons, happening twice, from 1998-99 to 2002-03 and 2005-06 to 2009-10.

#### Continuity is Key

In their 31 games last season, the Aces used just one starting lineup. Sara Dickey, Kerri Gasper, Brooke Dossett, Camary Williams, and Sasha Robinson played and started in each contest.

# LAST TIME OUT

**CHICAGO, III.** - The University of Evansville women's basketball team got off to a hot start, but was cooled-off in the second quarter in an 82-63 loss to Loyola in Chicago, III. on Sunday afternoon.

"The first quarter wasn't too bad. We gave them some easy looks and some things they shouldn't have, but that second quarter is unacceptable," said Aces head coach Matt Ruffing. "Credit to Kate (Achter) and her staff. They got their kids to play harder than we did and that's something we've seen over and over and over again."

Junior guard Kerri Gasper (15) and redshirt sophomore guard Marley Miller (14) combined for 29 points to lead the Aces while freshman guard Kayla Casteel added 13 points for UE. Gasper came within range of a triple-double, tallying seven boards and five assists to go along with her 15 points. For the Ramblers, Jessica Cerda paced Loyola with 16 points, all coming in the opening half.

Miller got Evansville off to a fast start as the Olney, Ill. native scored the Aces' first five points and put UE ahead 5-2 in the opening two minutes. After Loyola pushed back with an 8-0 spree to take a 10-5 lead, sophomore guard Macie Lively drained a jumper and Miller got involved again with her second triple to tie the game at 10. A heavily contested first quarter ended with a pair of Rambler free throws that gave Loyola a narrow 19-17 advantage.

Loyola controlled much of the second quarter as the Ramblers utilized a 16-2 run in the first six minutes of the period to open up a 16-point 35-19 lead. Gasper helped stop the run with a pair of free throws under the three minute mark in the frame, but Loyola closed the quarter with an 8-0 run to take a 43-21 lead into the halftime break.

The Aces offense got going once again in the third quarter as Evansville cut its deficit to 19 twice in the first three minutes of the period. It was


