GAMEDAY NOTES

- Evansville and Louisville are meeting for the 13th time in series history with the Aces owning an 11-2 advantage in the all-time series.
- The Aces and Cardinals series dates back to 1983 with the most recent meeting coming in 2014 when 11th-ranked Louisville captured a 3-0 win.
- Evansville has lost its last three road openers, last capturing a win at Marshall, 1-0, on Aug. 27, 2017.
- Like Evansville, the Cardinals opened the regular season last Thursday, falling to Saint Louis, 2-1, on the road.
- Leading goal scorer from the spring, Aboubacar Camara, returns for the fall after tallying six goals last season.
- A menace to opposing defense in the spring, sophomore Pablo Guillen returns to the fold for the Aces. The 2020-21 MVC Freshmen of the Year, Guillen led Evansville with four goals a season ago and recorded his first of the 2021 campaign in the 53rd minute on a penalty that gave Evansville an early 1-0 lead over Bellarmine on Thursday.
- Evansville played two exhibitions of its own, falling to 14th-ranked Kentucky, 4-1, on the road before grabbing a convincing 4-0 win over Hanover at Arad McCutchan Stadium on Sunday.
- Of Evansville's five goals scored during the preseason, just once Ace scored twice with senior Jakub Hall notching a pair of goals, one against each of UE's exhibition opponents.

TEAM NOTES

ALL COMING BACK

After a spring season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Aces return nearly everyone for the fall campaign. Of Evansville's 23 letter winners a season ago, all but three return to the pitch for the Aces, while just one starter does not return for the fall. Included in the returners are Evansville's leading goal-scorer and MVC Freshman of the Year, Pablo Guillen, who tallied four goals in the spring. In all, the Aces return 93.5% of their minutes played last season with the top 11 players in terms of minutes played all back.

NINE NEWCOMERS

Added to the 20 returners are a crop of nine newcomers that represent a wide-variety of states and nations. Five domestic and four international players highlight the newcomers with three players from Spain and one from Denmark included in the entering players.

NEARLY PULLING THE UPSET

The Aces game dangerously close to pulling an upset last Sunday at No. 19 Missouri State. Evansville tied the game in the 64th minute on Guillen's volley and looked poised to earn a result in Springfield. The Bears struck late, earning a penalty and converting in the 86th minute for the 2-1 win.

THE MARATHON CLUB

Four players returning for the Aces in the fall played significant minutes in the spring. Four Aces played 850 or more minutes last season, including Evan Dekker, who logged an average of 90.5 minutes per contest, playing less than 90 minutes in just two matches.

LONG TIME COMING

Despite its struggles in the win column over the last two seasons, Evansville record in non-conference home games has been impressive as of late. Over their last six non-conference contests at Arad McCutchan Stadium, the Aces are 3-1-2. Thursday's game against Bellarmine will mark UE's first home non-con contest in 697 days, dating back to a 2-0 loss to Santa Clara on Sept. 29, 2019.

CHALLENGING ITSELF

Evansville faces a difficult schedule in 2021 with plenty of opportunities for the Aces to make their mark. Already facing a ranked opponent with an exhibition matchup with 14th-ranked Kentucky, Evansville's schedule features four meetings with ranked opposition. Second-ranked Indiana and two contests against No. 12 Missouri State highlight the slate along with a trip to perennial contender Louisville.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

PRO PEDIGREE

Entering his first season with the Aces, freshman Porter Pomykal has professional pedigree. The Corinth, Texas native is the brother of FC Dallas midfielder Paxton Pomykal, who has appeared in 56 matches for the MLS club. Additionally, Paxton Pomykal has seen action in 27 national team matches, including earning a senior national team cap for the US against Uruguay in 2019.

WATCH OUT FOR HALL

A prolific scorer in his prep days, junior Jakub Hall has appeared to find his stride during the preseason. Smashing home 78 goals and adding 34 assists for West Lafayette HS, Hall has scored twice this preseason, once against both Kentucky and Hanover.

CONTINUING THE DENMARK LINE

One constant in recent years for Evansville has been the presence of Danish players in the Aces backline and in goal. Freshman Oliver Hald represents the next in line for UE, joining his fellow countryman, Frederik Reimer, Simon Waever, and Matheus Nors, who all have starred for the Aces in recent seasons.

GOALS BY NATIONALITY

Evansville heads into the fall with most of its goal production in recent seasons coming from foreign players. All five goals scored in the spring came from international student-athletes. The most recent goal scored by a homegrown player came off the head of Ethan Garvey against Bradley on Nov. 9, 2019.

GUILLEN RACKS UP CHANCES

The Aces leader in goals, points, shots, and shots on-goal last season, sophomore Pablo Guillen created a bevy of chances in his debut season. Guillen recorded at least a shot in every match last season except for the final match of the season against Drake.

PK PABLO

When Evansville earns a penalty, it's clear that the Aces' first choice is Pablo Guillen. The Spaniard was the taker on all three penalties the Aces earned last season, converting a pair. Guillen's lone miss came in the 82nd minute at Bradley on March 4, 2021 that ricocheted off the post.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

48th Season

The 2021 fall campaign marks the 48th season of men's soccer at Evansville. In 48 years of play, the Aces have captured 537 wins, scored 1,721 goals, and have a goal differential of +375.

Aces Abroad

A pair of Evansville men's soccer alums are helping clubs across the pond. Recent graduate Tommy Skupien '19 is currently the first team sport scientist for Chesterfield F.C. of England's National League. Member of the Aces 1990 Final Four team, Paul Nevin is coaching atop one of the best leagues in the world as first team coach for West Ham United in the English Premier League. Joining Nevin in the EPL is fellow teammate and former Everton, Rangers, and Scottish defender David Weir, who currently works as loan manager for Brighton & Hove Albion.

MVC Coaching Facts

Entering the season, Evansville head coach Marshall Ray is still tied for the newest head coach in The Valley with Drake head coach Gareth Smith, as both entered the MVC as head coaches for the 2015 season. The third-longest tenured head coach in the Valley is Loyola's Neil Jones, who took the helm of the Ramblers' program in 2012. The two longest tenured head coaches in the MVC are Missouri State's Jon Leamy (29 seasons) and Bradley's Jim DeRose (25 seasons).

Post-Playing Careers

Evansville has sent its fair-share of alumnae to professional playing careers, but plenty of Aces have also pursued careers in the sport off of the pitch, as well. This preseason, Evansville featured former student-athletes in its "Once an Ace, Always an Ace" series, including Tom Skupien (first team sport scientist, Chesterfield FC), Ally Mackay (Assistant GM, Nashville SC), Dylan Terry (Partnership Development Manager, Racing Louisville FC and Louisville City FC), Matt Sebek (Chief Experience Officer, St. Louis City FC), and Frederik Reimer (Media Coverage/Writing, FC Nordsjælland).

LAST TIME OUT

EVANSVILLE - In its regular season opener, the University of Evansville men's soccer team scored first, but allowed two late goals in a 2-1 loss to Bellarmine on Thursday evening at Arad McCutchan Stadium in Evansville.

"It's a good lesson to learn early in the season. We went up a goal and we lost our composure a bit and gave a goal on a set piece and were chasing the game. We had some opportunities," said Aces head men's soccer coach Marshall Ray. "Credit to Bellarmine, who put us under some pressure and unfortunately tonight we didn't respond. We've got to regroup and get ready for our next match against a very good Louisville side."

Sophomore midfielder Pablo Guillen scored his fifth career goal and the first of the fall on a penalty kick, recording two shots and putting both on goal. Evansville was led by junior Jakub Hall and his three shots on the night as the West Lafayette, Ind. found the frame with one of them. In goal for the Aces, senior Matt Bryant made two saves, allowing two goals on the evening.

The first half was dotted by opportunities from both teams, but the Aces maintained possession for most of the opening 45 minutes. Evansville tallied its first shot of the regular season just six minutes in on a shot by Hall that was blocked by a sliding Knight.

Evansville tallied two more shots before 15 minutes had passed, including a shot from Guillen that forced a save from Knights keeper Connor Range. After Hall put another shot on frame in the 27th minute, the two sides combined for just one shot on an attempt from Bellarmine's Nate Girao that sailed high as the match remained scoreless at the half.

The activity picked-up and quickly in the second half, beginning with a shot from senior Filip Johansson that had to be tipped over the cross bar by the Knights. On the ensuing corner, Evansville got its breakthrough. A foul was committed in the box, earning the Aces a penalty. Guillen was tasked with stepping up to the spot and calmly finished to the right side to put the Aces in front, 1-0.

Just five minutes later, Bellarmine found their equalizer coming off a free kick just to the side of the 18-yard box. A low driving ball was whipped into the box, deflecting off the legs of an Ace and past keeper Matt Bryant to tie the match.

In the 61st minute, Evansville appeared to have another chance to go in front after being awarded a penalty. A corner sent in by Guillen in the box was initially called a penalty in UE's favor, but was reversed after a discussion.

With the match appearing to be headed for overtime, Bellarmine pounced on a chance inside the final 10 minutes of regulation. The Knights sent a ball to the far side of the box, which was controlled by Bellarmine's Micah Linscott, who fired towards the left side of goal, finding the back of the net.

Evansville attempted again and again, sending in long ball after long ball to the top of the box late in the match, but the Aces were unable to find their equalizer in the 2-1 loss to the Knights.





COACH NOTES

- After nearly a decade on the sidelines as an assistant coach at the University of Evansville, Marshall Ray was announced as the sixth men's soccer coach in school history on Dec. 8, 2014.

- Ray, whose affiliation with the Aces program dates back more than 20 years, began his second season at the helm of the program in 2016. The Calvert City, Ky., native first stepped foot on campus as a player in 1995 before returning as the top assistant to former UE coach Mike Jacobs prior to the start of the 2006 season.

- As a player, Ray starred for the legendary former UE head coach Fred Schmalz, stepping into a starting centerback role for the team as it reached the 1995 MVC championship match against Creighton. Unfortunately, he would deal with injury issues in the middle part of his college career, which included a conference title in 1996, but he bounced back to score six goals and earn a Scholar-Athlete all-region honor as a senior in 1999.

- Since Ray stepped back on campus in 2006, UE players have been presented with more than 50 all-conference honors and 15 all-region designations. Two former Aces, Cory Elenio and Alec Dufty, have gone on to play in Major League Soccer, and most recently, Mark Anthony Gonzalez put together a stellar rookie season with Sporting KC-affiliated Swope Park Rangers in the the USL.


