GAMEDAY NOTES

• The 40th all-time meeting between the two storied programs sees Evansville in search of its first win over the Hoosiers since Nov. 25, 1990 in the NCAA Tournament that sent the Aces to their second Final Four in program history.

• The Bloomington-based side enters Tuesday midweek matchup with a 7-3-4 overall record, but has only lost to teams who were ranked first, second, and 22nd nationally at the time of competition. Evansville's three losses came to similar opponents with the Aces falling to current No. 9 Xavier, No. 11 Louisville, and No. 19 Missouri State.

• Evansville jumped a spot to eighth in the United Soccer Coaches' West Region rankings following a 3-0 dismantling of regionally-ranked Drake on Sunday afternoon.

• Freshman Nacho Diaz found the net twice more in the win, pushing his season total to nine goals, the most in the Missouri Valley Conference and 12th-most in the nation. By himself, Diaz has outscored three NCAA Division I teams, with Columbia having scored just seven times in 12 games this season and Hartford and North Florida only finding the back of the net six times in 12 matches in 2022.

• In goal, graduate Alex Vidizzoni has been the unsung hero of the Aces season, racking-up five shutouts. Vidizzoni's five clean sheets place him second in The Valley in the category and 30th in the nation.

EVANSVILLE - On a day that the Aces celebrated their five seniors, the University of Evansville men's soccer team put on one of its most thorough performances of the season, earning a 3-0 win over Drake in MVC action at Arad McCutchan Stadium on Sunday in Evansville.

Evansville wasted little time jumping on the scoreboard as Diaz fired a shot in the seventh minute that deflected off a defender and fell to Phillip, who clipped it into the back of the net for the opener. Just over five minutes later, the Aces found their second of the opening half as junior Tobias Bak whipped in a cross that Diaz finished to make it a 2-0 lead for Evansville inside the first quarter hour of the match. Evansville's defense excelled in the first 45 minutes, allowing just three shots from the Bulldogs with none coming on goal.

The Aces came out of the second half with the same energy they did to open the match, winning possession and staying on the attack. Earning a free kick from 30 yards out, junior Oliver Hald placed it perfectly, finding Diaz inside the six, who snuck in front his defender and headed it in near post to make it a three-goal lead. As the final minutes ticked away, Evansville nearly made it four goals on the day, but freshman Tancredi Fadda's goal was waved off due to offside.

COACH NOTES

- After nearly a decade on the sidelines as an assistant coach at the University of Evansville, Marshall Ray was announced as the sixth men's soccer coach in school history on Dec. 8, 2014.
- Ray, whose affiliation with the Aces program dates back more than 20 years, began his second season at the helm of the program in 2016. The Calvert City, Ky., native first stepped foot on campus as a player in 1995 before returning as the top assistant to former UE coach Mike Jacobs prior to the start of the 2006 season.
- As a player, Ray starred for the legendary former UE head coach Fred Schmalz, stepping into a starting centerback role for the team as it reached the 1995 MVC championship match against Creighton. Unfortunately, he would deal with injury issues in the middle part of his college career, which included a conference title in 1996, but he bounced back to score six goals and earn a Scholar-Athlete all-region honor as a senior in 1999.
- Since Ray stepped back on campus in 2006, UE players have been presented with more than 50 all-conference honors and 15 all-region designations. Two former Aces, Cory Elenio and Alec Dufty, have gone on to play in Major League Soccer, and most recently, Mark Anthony Gonzalez put together a stellar rookie season with Sporting KC-affiliated Swope Park Rangers in the the USL.
