

# **GAMEDAY NOTES**

- · Wednesday regular-season finale represents the 15th meeting all-time between the Aces and Bruins with Evansville owning a 10-3-1 advantage in the all-time series.
- The two sides played to a scoreless draw in their meeting earlier this season on Oct. 5 in Nashville.
- · Belmont enters the finale with a 6-3-6 record and has earned three-straight results, most recently capturing a 2-0 win over EIU on Nov. 2.
- Much is still on the line in the Missouri Valley Conference heading into the final day of competition. Evansville could finish as high as second or as low as fifth, while Belmont could finish as high as third and as low as fifth. Missouri State has locked-in the top seed in the championship, while SIUE and Bradley are locked in the six and seven seeds, respectively.
- Evansville enters the final match of the regular season ranked inside the top 50 in the nation in three statistical categories. The Aces are 15th in shot accuracy, 35th in save percentage, and 39th in shutout percentage. Individually, freshman Nacho Diaz is 18th in total goals, 22nd in goals per game and shot accuracy, 29th in shots on goal per game, 34th in total points, and 40th in points per game, while graduate goalkeeper Alex Vidizzoni is ranked 21st in save percentage, 38th in shutouts, and 91st in total saves. ference play.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

**EVANSVILLE -** On the road for the final time in MVC play, the University of Evansville men's soccer team could not keep pace with UIC in a 2-0 loss on Saturday night in Chicago, III.

"We were much better in the second half. In the first half, we struggled to get into the game and in the second half we created a few more chances and it's unfortunate that Tancred (Fadda) hit one off the crossbar and they went straight down and credit to the kid, he picked his head up and was able to get a ball in the back of the net from 45 to 50 (yards) out," said Aces head coach Marshall Ray. "We still had some other opportunities late and had another one from Jose (Vivas) off the bar, but all in all, we didn't do enough tonight to get a result. We've got to get ourself back together and get home to play Belmont and protect our home field and finish the regular season with a win."

The Aces tallied 10 shots on the night to 16 for the Flames with sophomore midfielder Jose Vivas recording the bulk of Evansville's chances, finishing with four shots on the night. Graduate goalkeeper Alex Vidizzoni faced five shots from the home side on the night, making three saves to push his season total to 51.

It was a quiet start to the night from a scoring standpoint in the first half as UIC recorded nine shots and the Aces tallied four in the opening stanza. Vidizzoni helped keep the match scoreless, making a pair of saves in what was a scoreless draw at the break.

UIC broke the deadlock 21 minutes into the second half, scoring courtesy of Paul Brauckmann to take the 1-0 lead. Just two minutes later, the Flames added a second goal as Josh Torres found the back of the net off an assist from Preston Huitron as UIC captured the 2-0 win.

#### **COACH NOTES**

- After nearly a decade on the sidelines as an assistant coach at the University of Evansville, Marshall Ray was announced as the sixth men's soccer coach in school history on Dec. 8, 2014.
- Ray, whose affiliation with the Aces program dates back more than 20 years, began his second season at the helm of the program in 2016.
   The Calvert City, Ky., native first stepped foot on campus as a player in 1995 before returning as the top assistant to former UE coach Mike Jacobs prior to the start of the 2006 season.
- As a player, Ray starred for the legendary former UE head coach Fred Schmalz, stepping into a starting centerback role for the team as it reached the 1995 MVC championship match against Creighton. Unfortunately, he would deal with injury issues in the middle part of his college career, which included a conference title in 1996, but he bounced back to score six goals and earn a Scholar-Athlete all-region honor as a senior in 1999.
- Since Ray stepped back on campus in 2006, UE players have been presented with more than 50 all-conference honors and 15 all-region designations. Two former Aces, Cory Elenio and Alec Dufty, have gone on to play in Major League Soccer, and most recently, Mark Anthony Gonzalez put together a stellar rookie season with Sporting KC-affiliated Swope Park Rangers in the the USL.
