GAMEDAY NOTES

• The two sides met just once earlier this season in a wild match that ended in a 4-3 win for Missouri State in Springfield. Tied at one at the half, the two sides proceeded to score four goals in a seven-minute span starting in the 61st minute. With the match tied at three, Missouri State slipped a ball across the face of goal in the 81st minute that an Aces defender deflected into the back of the net, scoring what would be the game-winner for the Bears.

• This season, the Bears have allowed just nine combined goals across 16 matches. Just two teams have scored multiple goals in a match against MSU; Tulsa, in a 3-0 win over the Bears that is the only loss of the season for Missouri State, and Evansville, in their lone meeting this season.

• Evansville is looking for its first MVC title since capturing the 1996 MVC Tournament crown. 1996 also represents the Aces last NCAA Tournament berth, something that is also on the line on Sunday afternoon.

• With his clean sheet against Belmont on Thursday, graduate goalkeeper Alex Vidizzoni moved into a tie for seventh in program history for most shutouts in a single season. Vidizzoni's seven saves also put the Italian inside the top 10 in career saves despite Vidizzoni having played just 18 career games with the Aces.

LAST TIME OUT

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. - A rocket off the foot of freshman Ola Arntsen and another clean sheet from graduate Alex Vidizzoni helped the University of Evansville men's soccer team to a 1-0 victory over Belmont in the MVC Championship semifinals on Thursday afternoon in Springfield, Mo.

Coming into the match seeing increased minutes over the second half of the season, Arntsen opened his college account, scoring for the first time in his UE career, on his only shot of the day. Graduate goalkeeper Alex Vidizzoni continued his top form, recording his third-straight shutout and the eighth clean sheet of his season, moving him into a tie for fourth in single-season shutouts at UE.

As had been true in the previous two meetings, the Aces and Bruins played a very closely matched contest in the first half. Playing to shutouts in both previous meetings this season, Evansville and Belmont recorded a combined six shots each in the opening 45 minutes with each team tallying three. Evansville was the only one to put a shot on goal, though, with sophomore Jose Vivas testing Belmont keeper in the 24th minute.

Much like the first half, the second period was evenly matched in shots, but two moments helped shape the outcome of the match. 10 minutes into the half, Belmont played the ball into the six and had a cross tipped away and knocked free from the box by the Aces defense, helping to avoid a Bruin breakthrough. Less than 10 minutes after Belmont's chance, a moment of brilliance gave the Aces the lead. A ball into the box was headed out and took two bounces before Arntsen smashed a volley into the upper 90 with plenty of pace, putting UE up 1-0. Evansville nearly doubled its advantage a few minutes later as junior Kai Phillip got the ball in the box, but had his shot miss just wide. Following Arntsen's goal, Belmont would take four shots, but put just one on-goal, an 82nd-minute attempt that Vidizzoni saved as the Aces captured the 1-0 win and a berth in the MVC Championship final.

COACH NOTES

- After nearly a decade on the sidelines as an assistant coach at the University of Evansville, Marshall Ray was announced as the sixth men's soccer coach in school history on Dec. 8, 2014.
- Ray, whose affiliation with the Aces program dates back more than 20 years, began his second season at the helm of the program in 2016. The Calvert City, Ky., native first stepped foot on campus as a player in 1995 before returning as the top assistant to former UE coach Mike Jacobs prior to the start of the 2006 season.
- As a player, Ray starred for the legendary former UE head coach Fred Schmalz, stepping into a starting centerback role for the team as it reached the 1995 MVC championship match against Creighton. Unfortunately, he would deal with injury issues in the middle part of his college career, which included a conference title in 1996, but he bounced back to score six goals and earn a Scholar-Athlete all-region honor as a senior in 1999.
- Since Ray stepped back on campus in 2006, UE players have been presented with more than 50 all-conference honors and 15 all-region designations. Two former Aces, Cory Elenio and Alec Dufty, have gone on to play in Major League Soccer, and most recently, Mark Anthony Gonzalez put together a stellar rookie season with Sporting KC-affiliated Swope Park Rangers in the the USL.
