# **GAMEDAY NOTES**

- · Evansville and Chicago State are meeting for the ninth time in series history with the Aces capturing all eight previous meetings.
- The Aces and Cougars were scheduled to meet last season on Dec. 19, 2021 in Chicago, but the game was canceled due to COVID-19.
- The last time UE and CSU met was back on Dec. 18, 2019 inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse with the Aces winning, 76-42.
- Evansville's 89-81 win over EKU last Monday evening was UE's first win in a season-opener on the road since Nov. 9, 2012 in a 54-45 victory at Ball State.
- Fifth-year guard Myia Clark was on fire last Monday at EKU. The St. Louis native finished with 25 points, tying the program record for most three-pointers in a single game with eight, going 8-for-9 from beyond the arc in the win.
- · Newcomer Barbora Tomancova has impressed in her first two games in white and purple. Against EKU, Tomancova recorded 16 points and 15 boards before adding 11 points and four rebounds on Thursday night at No. 4 Iowa.

#### **TEAM NOTES**

#### **USING THEIR FIFTH YEAR**

Returning for their fifth year of college basketball, Myia Clark and Anna Newman add to a veteran Aces squad. Combining to play in 219 collegiate games, Clark and Newman look to lead Evansville's backcourt in 2022-23.

#### RECRUITING INTERNATIONALLY

One of the hallmarks of head coach Robyn Scherr-Wells recruiting system has been finding international players. This year's Aces squad features players from five different countries, including additions from the Czech Republic and Spain to add to players from the USA, Australia, and The Netherlands.

#### 2020-21 vs. 2021-22

In Robyn Scherr-Wells first season leading the Purple Aces, Evansville saw a quick improvement in multiple statistical categories.

#### **IMPRESSIVE ADDITIONS**

In the offseason, the UE coaching staff set out to add impactful players to the roster and appear to have done just that. Two NCAA DI transfers in 6-3 center Barbora Tomancova (FIU and Minnesota) and 5-8 sophomore point guard Lexie Sinclair (Saint Bonaventure) bring collegiate experience, while Kynidi Mason Striverson (Sellersburg, Ind.) and Rayah Kincer (Indianapolis, Ind.) both enter as two of the best in the 2022 class from the state of Indiana, while Irene Hernanz Pacios (Spain) adds extra depth in the frontcourt for the Aces.

#### CHANGING LANDSCAPE OF THE VALLEY

Undergoing a massive transformation this offseason, the Missouri Valley Conference looks a lot different for the 2022-23 season. Loyola Chicago has left the league for the A-10 and Belmont, Murray State, and UIC have joined the conference, creating a 12-team league. From a women's basketball perspective, the MVC loses team 119 in the final NET rankings from last season and adds teams 45, 103, and 333, increasing the competitiveness of a league that has already proven to be one of the best mid-major leagues in the country.

## **INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

#### MAKING HISTORY

On Monday evening at Eastern Kentucky, fifth-year guard Myia Clark put on a show. The St. Louis native scored 25 points, hitting eight three-pointers, tying the program record for made 3s in a single game. The record was originally set by Courtney Felke, who hit eight of her 14 attempts against Morehead State on Nov. 19, 2007.

#### A CHANCE TO BECOME A LEGEND

Heading into her fourth season as an Ace, senior guard/forward has the opportunity to be remembered as one of the best players in program history. Through three season, Feit ranks 13th in career scoring, seventh in rebounding, and fourth in blocks with chances to rise through those all-time lists quickly. Feit was named all-MVC first team last season and was on the all-conference preseason team announced in October.

#### THE HOMETOWN HERO IS BACK

A leader for the Aces for four seasons, point guard Anna Newman turned-in her best season in 2021-22. Planning to finish her career and move onto coaching, Newman made the decision to come back for one more year as an Ace. In her career, Newman has accumulated 648 points, 328 assists, and has played in 107 career games with 88 starts.

#### SOME OF THE HOOSIER STATE'S BEST

Evansville welcomes a pair of freshman guards who stayed in-state to join the Aces. Kynidi Mason Striverson and Rayah Kincer were both named Indiana All-Stars during their high school careers with Kincer earning it her junior season before an injury ended her senior campaign early in the year and Mason Striverson captured all state honors as a senior, leading her team to the 2022 State Championship game.

#### **AUSTRALIAN DUO**

Joining Evansville for their first collegiate seasons last year, Elly Morgan and Kodie Myszka helped provide a spark in 2021-22 despite still adapting to the American collegiate game. The two combined to average seven points and three boards. Morgan showed plenty of promise in her ability to score, shooting 36.7 % from the field as a guard, while Myszka showed a penchant for rim protection with 13 blocks on the season.

# **LAST TIME OUT**

**IOWA CITY, Iowa -** Facing it's highest ranked opponent in program history, the University of Evansville women's basketball team dropped a road contest at No. 4 Iowa, 115-62, on Thursday night in Iowa City, Iowa.

For the second-straight game, fifth-year senior guard Myia Clark paced the Aces offensively, scoring 18 points with seven coming at the charity stripe. Also finishing in double-figures for Evansville were redshirt-junior center Barbora Tomancova and freshman guard Kynidi Mason Striverson both finished with 11 points, doing so in limited minutes with Tomancova playing just 19 minutes due to foul trouble and Mason Striverson coming off the bench to play 23 minutes. The Hawkeyes were led by preseason Big Ten Player of the Year Caitlin Clark, who tallied a double-double with 26 points and 12 assists.

In the first quarter, Evansville struggled to settle in to a rhythm in front of a crowd of 7,675. The Aces shot just 18.8% (3-16) in the first 10 minutes, while the Hawkeyes hit 10 of their 15 attempts from the field, allowing lowa to take a 26-7 lead after the first period.

Evansville's offense got going in the second quarter as UE knocked-down five field-goals and got to the free-throw line, where they hit five foul shots. Touting one of the most explosive offenses in the nation, lowa's attack ratcheted up as well, scoring 28 in the second with the Hawkeyes taking a 54-23 advantage to the half.

The second half revealed impressive performances from the aforementioned Myia Clark and Kynidi Mason Striverson. After tying the program record for threes against EKU, Clark cashed-in three more triples against lowa. In just her second collegiate game, Mason Striverson seemed to gain confidence in front of everyone's eyes, taking the ball to the rim and drawing four fouls and scoring five of her 11 points at the free-throw line. Evansville enjoyed multiple times in which Tomancova dominated the paint, backing-down her defender and laying it in against a tough Hawkeye front court. Shooting just 25% (8-32) from the field in the first half, Evansville finished the game with a much-improved shooting performance in the second 20 minutes, hitting 12 of its 28 attempts for 42.9%.

# **LAST MEETING**

**EVANSVILLE, Ind. -** Returning home to Meeks Family Fieldhouse, the University of Evansville women's basketball team dominated Chicago State, 76-42, in the final game on campus this decade on Wednesday evening.

Sophomore A'Niah Griffin led the Aces with 14 points, powered by two buckets and fouls late in the game. Redshirt junior Jada Poland also finished in double-figures with 10 points, while pullling down a team-high nine rebounds. For the Cougars, Tyeshia Bowers finished with a game-high 15 points.

Evansville jumped out to an early lead in the contest and never looked back. Just three-and-a-half minutes into the contest, the Aces held a 10-2 advantage as sophomore Anna Newman got to the basket for a layup. Chicago State got back within four soon after, but Evansville pulled away to take a 19-10 lead after the opening period.

The second quarter resembled the first through much of the early portions as Evansville methodically increased its lead to 15 with just over two minutes left in the half. The Aces closed the opening half on a 9-0 run, giving UE a 44-22 lead at the break.

A low scoring third period saw both teams combine for just 22 points, but Evansville controlled most of the scoring, building its lead as large as 30 in the quarter. In the final 10 minutes, Evansville cleared much of its bench and saw its lead swell to 35 twice, including on a three-pointer by sophomore Sydne Caddy, scoring the first points of her collegiate career, as Evansville secured the 34-point win.

The margin of victory is the largest for the Aces over an NCAA Division I opponent since an 86-46 blowout victory over Bradley on Jan. 12, 2015.

Robyn Scherr-Wells enters her second season at the helm of the Purple Aces women's basket-ball program and the rebuild is well underway.

On April 20, 2021, Scherr-Wells, who had shown a knack for revitalizing programs and developing talent, was named as the 11th head coach in Evansville women's basketball program history. Since then, Scherr-Wells has made plenty of progress in rebuilding the Aces program, beginning with the 2021-22 season.

In her first season, Scherr-Wells led the Aces to eight wins, the most by an Evansville team since winning 14 games in 2016-17. Capturing a pair of victories in MVC play, Scherr-Wells' side earned the no. 9 seed at Hoops in the Heartland, its highest seed since 2016-17.

One of the hallmarks of head coach RobynScherr-Wells system at UE has been playing fast. Installing a new system, Scherr-Wells achieved her goal of getting the Aces to play fast as Evansville finished 35th in the nation with 74.4 possessions per 40 minutes in her first season at the helm. The Aces averaged over 65 points per game in 2021-22, a nine-point increase from the 2020-21 campaign.

Scherr-Wells came to the River City with head coaching experience, coaching for seven seasons in the NAIA with Roosevelt University and Davenport University, winning six conference championships, while also helping rebuild programs at Florida International University and Davidson College as an assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level. Scherr-Wells spent the 2020-21 season as assistant coach at Florida International University, where she was part of a staff that helped lead the Panthers to their best record in nearly a decade.

A native of Glen Ellyn, Illinois, Scherr-Wells attended the University of Michigan where she joined the women's basketball team. With the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells started as a manager/practice player during her freshman season and eventually earned an athletic scholarship as a sophomore for her role in that capacity for the squad. As a member of the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells was part of a team that earned three NCAA Tournament berths and made the postseason in each of her four seasons.

A 2001 graduate of the University of Michigan, Scherr-Wells finished with distinction and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Movement Science and Athletic Training. She went on to earn a Master's Degree of Business Administration from Roosevelt in 2014. She is married to Ryan Wells and the two have one son, Jett.






