GAMEDAY NOTES

• Despite the proximity, the Aces and Illini have met just twice previously with Illinois capturing both previous meetings.

• Last facing-off on Dec. 15, 2019 inside the State Farm Center, Illinois edged the Aces, 59-44.

• Evansville comes into the weekend matchup fresh-off an 82-57 win over Chicago State on Education Day on Wednesday. In the win, senior guard/forward Abby Feit put on a show, filling-up the stat sheet with 27 points and 17 boards in just 25 minutes on the floor.

• Through three games this season, Evansville boasts four double-digit scorers, as the Illini do, with fifth-year guard Myia Clark leading the charge for the Aces, averaging 14.7 points per contest. Following Clark are Feit at 12 points per game, fellow fifth-year guard A'Niah Griffin also at 12 points per game, and redshirt junior center Barbora Tomancova with 11 points per contest.

• As was true a year ago, the Aces have continued to play at a break-neck pace so far this season. Evansville sits 13th in the nation in possessions per 40 minutes, averaging 82 per game after averaging 74.3 last year.

• Evansville is in search of its first ever win over a BIG opponent in 25 attempts.

TEAM NOTES

USING THEIR FIFTH YEAR

Returning for their fifth year of college basketball, Myia Clark and Anna Newman add to a veteran Aces squad. Combining to play in 219 collegiate games, Clark and Newman look to lead Evansville's back-court in 2022-23.

RECRUITING INTERNATIONALLY

One of the hallmarks of head coach Robyn Scherr-Wells recruiting system has been finding international players. This year's Aces squad features players from five different countries, including additions from the Czech Republic and Spain to add to players from the USA, Australia, and The Netherlands.

IMPRESSIVE ADDITIONS

In the offseason, the UE coaching staff set out to add impactful players to the roster and appear to have done just that. Two NCAA DI transfers in 6-3 center Barbora Tomancova (FIU and Minnesota) and 5-8 sophomore point guard Lexie Sinclair (Saint Bonaventure) bring collegiate experience, while Kynidi Mason Striverson (Sellersburg, Ind.) and Rayah Kincer (Indianapolis, Ind.) both enter as two of the best in the 2022 class from the state of Indiana, while Irene Hernanz Pacios (Spain) adds extra depth in the frontcourt for the Aces.

CHANGING LANDSCAPE OF THE VALLEY

Undergoing a massive transformation this offseason, the Missouri Valley Conference looks a lot different for the 2022-23 season. Loyola Chicago has left the league for the A-10 and Belmont, Murray State, and UIC have joined the conference, creating a 12-team league. From a women's basketball perspective, the MVC loses team 119 in the final NET rankings from last season and adds teams 45, 103, and 333, increasing the competitiveness of a league that has already proven to be one of the best mid-major leagues in the country.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

A RARE PERFORMANCE

Against Chicago State on Wednesday, senior guard/forward Abby Feit poured-in 27 points and grabbed 17 rebounds in an 82-57 win. Feit is one of just eight players since the 2009-10 season to have 27+ points and 17+ rebounds in 26-or-less minutes on the floor.

MAKING HISTORY

On Monday evening at Eastern Kentucky, fifth-year guard Myia Clark put on a show. The St. Louis native scored 25 points, hitting eight three-pointers, tying the program record for made 3s in a single game. The record was originally set by Courtney Felke, who hit eight of her 14 attempts against Morehead State on Nov. 19, 2007.

THE HOMETOWN HERO IS BACK

A leader for the Aces for four seasons, point guard Anna Newman turned-in her best season in 2021-22. Planning to finish her career and move onto coaching, Newman made the decision to come back for one more year as an Ace. In her career, Newman has accumulated 648 points, 328 assists, and has played in 107 career games with 88 starts.

SOME OF THE HOOSIER STATE'S BEST

Evansville welcomes a pair of freshman guards who stayed in-state to join the Aces. Kynidi Mason Striverson and Rayah Kincer were both named Indiana All-Stars during their high school careers with Kincer earning it her junior season before an injury ended her senior campaign early in the year and Mason Striverson captured all state honors as a senior, leading her team to the 2022 State Championship game.

AUSTRALIAN DUO

Joining Evansville for their first collegiate seasons last year, Elly Morgan and Kodie Myszkka helped provide a spark in 2021-22 despite still adapting to the American collegiate game. The two combined to average seven points and three boards. Morgan showed plenty of promise in her ability to score, shooting 36.7 % from the field as a guard, while Myszkka showed a penchant for rim protection with 13 blocks on the season.

LAST TIME OUT

EVANSVILLE - In front of nearly 3,000 raucous school children, the University of Evansville women's basketball team pulled-away early in an 82-57 win on Education Day inside the Ford Center in Evansville.

Senior guard/forward Abby Feit put together one of the best performances of her career. In just 26 minutes on the floor, Feit poured-in 27 points, while grabbing 17 boards, coming up just shy of a pair of career highs in the win. Fifth-year guard A'Niah Griffin (17 points) and freshman guard Kynidi Mason Striverson (14 points) also finished in double-figures with Mason Striverson's performance setting a new career-best. For Chicago State, the Cougars offense was powered primarily by Janiah Newell, who tallied a game-high 29 points to account for more than half of CSU's offense on the day.

Chicago State scored three of the first four baskets of the game, but Evansville response was quick and effective. After trailing 6-2 in the opening moments, Evansville went on an 18-2 run to close the quarter, owning a 21-8 advantage after the first 10 minutes. Feit was responsible for much of the early offense, scoring seven of UE's first eight points and finishing the period with 14 points.

The Aces continued to push their advantage in the second quarter, running their lead as large as 25 before the break. Evansville shot a scorching 57.1% (8-14) from the field in the second frame, while forcing 18 first-half turnovers from the Cougars as UE held a 48-23 lead at the half.

Evansville's lead would continue to swell into the second half, surpassing 30 in the third quarter before hitting its high point at 72-39 just two minutes into the fourth period on a layup by redshirt junior Barbora Tomancova. In all, 11 Aces saw the floor in the Aces win with 10 scoring in Evansville's 82-57 win.

LAST MEETING

CHAMPAIGN, Ill. - Battling all contest, the University of Evansville dropped a road game, 59-44, at Illinois on Sunday afternoon in Champaign, Ill.

Helping lead the Aces, freshman Abby Feit led Evansville with a team-best 19 points, hitting five threes, while recording eight boards and three steals. In just her second game in white and purple, junior Lola Bracy scored 15 points, following up her 25-point performance on Friday night. Leading the Illini was Petra Holesinska, who tallied 25 points, knocking down seven triples.

The contest opened in an ideal fashion for the Aces as Evansville jumped out to a 6-0 advantage on a pair of three-pointers by Feit. Illinois answered with five-straight points, but it was Feit who pushed the Aces' lead back to three on a layup with 6:31 left in the opening quarter. Evansville responded to Illinois' response, as Lola Bracy hit a triple and Jada Poland got to the rim for a layup to give UE a 13-8 lead. To close the period, Illinois hit two threes, going on a 6-0 run to take a 14-13 lead after 10 minutes of action.

The second quarter saw a better offensive rhythm for the Illini, while the defense for Illinois created turnovers. Despite that, Evansville continued to battle taking back the lead on two different occasions, including an important triple by Feit that earned a 22-20 advantage for the Aces. After the the Aces locked down on defense on the other end to cut their deficit to three at halftime.

A pair of three-pointers by Illinois' Holesinska helped the Illini take an eight-point advantage out of the break at 38-30. In the period, Evansville got down as large as 10, but cut a point off its deficit at 48-39 to close the third quarter.

A personal 5-0 run for Bracy helped fuel Evansville in the fourth quarter. Bracy out-scored the Illini single-handedly in the first six minutes of the quarter, while the Aces held Illinois scoreless. Bracy's final bucket of the run forced an Illinois timeout. Coming out of the timeout, the Illini took control, holding Evansville off the scoreboard and recording an 11-0 run to grab the 59-48 win.

Evansville was out-rebounded in the game, 53-38, but forced the Illini into 24 turnovers, a season-high for Illinois.

Robyn Scherr-Wells enters her second season at the helm of the Purple Aces women's basketball program and the rebuild is well underway.

On April 20, 2021, Scherr-Wells, who had shown a knack for revitalizing programs and developing talent, was named as the 11th head coach in Evansville women's basketball program history. Since then, Scherr-Wells has made plenty of progress in rebuilding the Aces program, beginning with the 2021-22 season.

In her first season, Scherr-Wells led the Aces to eight wins, the most by an Evansville team since winning 14 games in 2016-17. Capturing a pair of victories in MVC play, Scherr-Wells' side earned the no. 9 seed at Hoops in the Heartland, its highest seed since 2016-17.

One of the hallmarks of head coach Robyn Scherr-Wells system at UE has been playing fast. Installing a new system, Scherr-Wells achieved her goal of getting the Aces to play fast as Evansville finished 35th in the nation with 74.4 possessions per 40 minutes in her first season at the helm. The Aces averaged over 65 points per game in 2021-22, a nine-point increase from the 2020-21 campaign.

Scherr-Wells came to the River City with head coaching experience, coaching for seven seasons in the NAIA with Roosevelt University and Davenport University, winning six conference championships, while also helping rebuild programs at Florida International University and Davidson College as an assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level. Scherr-Wells spent the 2020-21 season as assistant coach at Florida International University, where she was part of a staff that helped lead the Panthers to their best record in nearly a decade.

A native of Glen Ellyn, Illinois, Scherr-Wells attended the University of Michigan where she joined the women's basketball team. With the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells started as a manager/practice player during her freshman season and eventually earned an athletic scholarship as a sophomore for her role in that capacity for the squad. As a member of the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells was part of a team that earned three NCAA Tournament berths and made the postseason in each of her four seasons.

A 2001 graduate of the University of Michigan, Scherr-Wells finished with distinction and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Movement Science and Athletic Training. She went on to earn a Master's Degree of Business Administration from Roosevelt in 2014. She is married to Ryan Wells and the two have one son, Jett.

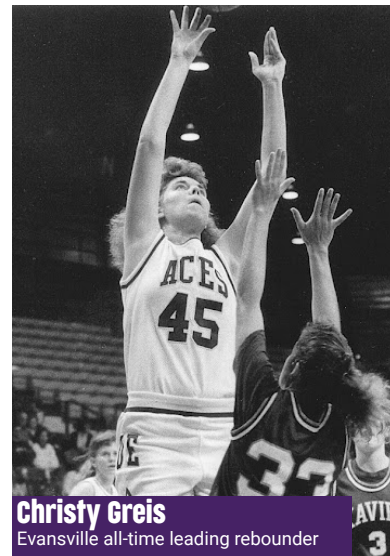
