GAMEDAY NOTES

• The Aces and Cougars are meeting for the third time this season with Evansville capturing victories in the two regular season meetings, 2-0 at McCutchan Stadium and 2-1 on the road in Edwardsville.

• Evansville and SIUE have only met once previously in the postseason, doing so in 2016 in the MVC Championship semifinals, with SIUE capturing a 2-1 win.

• A year ago, Evansville went on a magical run in the MVC Championship, winning its quarterfinal matchup with Drake, 4-2, before upsetting No. 2 seed Loyola and advancing to the championship match on PKs, before falling to the host Bears in the championship.

• The Aces are 7-13-2 all-time in first round matchups in the MVC Tournament.

• The MVC Championship semifinals will be re-seeded following Sunday's quarterfinal matchups with both the semifinals and finals being played in Springfield, Mo.

• Six different Aces have found the back of the net this season with freshman Nacho Diaz leading the way with nine goals, while junior Kai Phillip has added five. Spaniards Carlos Barcia and Jose Vivas have each scored three times, while Nkosi Graham and Oliver Hald have found the back of the net once a piece in 2022.

LAST TIME OUT

EVANSVILLE - Closing-out the regular season, the University of Evansville men's soccer team earned a scoreless draw with Belmont on Wednesday evening at Arad McCutchan Stadium, securing a top four seed in the 2022 MVC Championship.

On the attack, sophomore Jose Vivas led the way for the Aces, recording three of Evansville's nine shots on the night, while junior Tobias Bak finished with a pair of shots on the evening. In goal, graduate Alex Vidizzoni notched his sixth shutout of the season, the most by an Aces keeper since 2008 and tying Vidizzoni for the 10th-most in a single-season in program history.

Evansville's defense was stifling in the opening half on a night where offense was limited for both sides. The Aces held the Bruins without a shot in the first 45 minutes, while Evansville created a pair of opportunities. The first chance for Evansville came in the 34th minute as Vivas dribbled just inside the 18 and sent a shot towards goal that deflected off the post and out for a goal kick. In the 42nd minute, Evansville again created a chance as a foul was committed just outside the box and set-up for a free kick from 20 yards out and to the right of goal. Evansville took the free kick quickly as Belmont was still getting set and the ball just barely deflected off the Bruins wall and away as the match went to the break with UE owning a 5-0 advantage on shots.

In the second half, Vidizzoni came up clutch with a pair of saves as Belmont's attack got going. The Bruins out-shot the Aces 7-4 in the second half, but most chances resulted in relatively routine saves for Evansville's veteran keeper. Another opportunity off a free kick from just outside the box arose inside the match's final 10 minutes as freshman Nacho Diaz stood over the free kick and sent his dipping shot just over the crossbar as the match ended in a scoreless draw.

COACH NOTES

- After nearly a decade on the sidelines as an assistant coach at the University of Evansville, Marshall Ray was announced as the sixth men's soccer coach in school history on Dec. 8, 2014.
- Ray, whose affiliation with the Aces program dates back more than 20 years, began his second season at the helm of the program in 2016. The Calvert City, Ky., native first stepped foot on campus as a player in 1995 before returning as the top assistant to former UE coach Mike Jacobs prior to the start of the 2006 season.
- As a player, Ray starred for the legendary former UE head coach Fred Schmalz, stepping into a starting centerback role for the team as it reached the 1995 MVC championship match against Creighton. Unfortunately, he would deal with injury issues in the middle part of his college career, which included a conference title in 1996, but he bounced back to score six goals and earn a Scholar-Athlete all-region honor as a senior in 1999.
- Since Ray stepped back on campus in 2006, UE players have been presented with more than 50 all-conference honors and 15 all-region designations. Two former Aces, Cory Elenio and Alec Dufty, have gone on to play in Major League Soccer, and most recently, Mark Anthony Gonzalez put together a stellar rookie season with Sporting KC-affiliated Swope Park Rangers in the the USL.
