GAMEDAY NOTES

• The Aces and Bruins are meeting for the third time this season with both previous meetings in 2022 ending in scoreless ties.

• Evansville heads to its second-straight MVC Championship semifinal and its fourth in the last seven seasons. In the three previous semifinal trips, the Aces are one-for-three in reaching the championship match, doing so last season.

• Sophomore Jose Vivas scored his fourth goal of the season to lead the Aces over SIUE last Sunday. Vivas' goal marked Evansville's 23rd of the season and the 16th scored by players from Spain. In all, just one of Evansville's 23 goals in 2022 has been scored by a player from the US, coming from senior winger Nkosi Graham.

• The four losses for Evansville this season are the fewest for the Aces in a regular season since the 1996 campaign saw UE go 18-5, winning the MVC and advancing to the NCAA Tournament.

• Graduate goalkeeper Alex Vidizzoni is entering rare air in his first season in the white and purple. The Italian has recorded seven shutouts on the season and combined for one other, putting him in a tie for seventh in program history for most shutouts in a single season. Vidizzoni also sits 10th in career shutouts despite having played just 16 matches for UE.

LAST TIME OUT

EVANSVILLE - Sophomore forward Jose Vivas scored a 75th minute winner to lead the University of Evansville men's soccer team to a 1-0 win over SIUE in the Missouri Valley Conference Championship quarterfinals on Sunday afternoon at Arad McCutchan Stadium in Evansville.

Vivas got on the board for the fourth time this season with his late second half goal, giving the Spaniard his second game-winning goal of the season. For the seventh time this year, graduate goalkeeper Alex Vidizzoni shutout his opponent, moving him into a tie for seventh in single-season shutouts.

The opening half featured an eager Evansville side taking control possession as the Aces out-shot the Cougars, 9-4, in the first 45 minutes. Inside the first 10 minutes, Vidizzoni was forced to make one of his four saves, stopping a shot from SIUE's Myles Sophanavong in the ninth minute. Evansville created a string of opportunities near the quarter-hour mark of the first half, generating four corner kicks and recording three shots. One of those shots, coming off the head of senior Evan Dekker, appeared to have given the Aces the early lead, but was ruled to have been cleared off the line by a Cougar defender. The 24th minute saw another chance on-frame from Evansville as senior Ethan Garvey sent a shot on-goal that forced a save from SIUE keeper Sam Gomez. In the three minutes before the break, Evansville recorded three more chances, two coming from freshman Ola Arntsen, but the Aces could not get their breakthrough before the halftime whistle.

After controlling much of the possession in the opening 45 minutes, Evansville came rolling out of halftime and took control to the tune of another 9-4 advantage on shots. Senior Carlos Barcia tested Gomez in the 47th minute with a shot that the Cougar keeper saved. The Aces put two more shots on target in the 71st minute, but it would take four more minutes before Evansville was delivered its well-earned breakthrough. On another corner, Barcia slipped a cross in to Vivas just inside the 18 and the forward quickly struck the ball, going for the top center of goal and finding the back of the net to provide Evansville with a 1-0 lead. Following the opening goal, Evansville locked-in defensively, preventing the Cougars from any opportunities as the Aces secured the win to advance to the MVC Championship semifinals.

COACH NOTES

- After nearly a decade on the sidelines as an assistant coach at the University of Evansville, Marshall Ray was announced as the sixth men's soccer coach in school history on Dec. 8, 2014.
- Ray, whose affiliation with the Aces program dates back more than 20 years, began his second season at the helm of the program in 2016. The Calvert City, Ky., native first stepped foot on campus as a player in 1995 before returning as the top assistant to former UE coach Mike Jacobs prior to the start of the 2006 season.
- As a player, Ray starred for the legendary former UE head coach Fred Schmalz, stepping into a starting centerback role for the team as it reached the 1995 MVC championship match against Creighton. Unfortunately, he would deal with injury issues in the middle part of his college career, which included a conference title in 1996, but he bounced back to score six goals and earn a Scholar-Athlete all-region honor as a senior in 1999.
- Since Ray stepped back on campus in 2006, UE players have been presented with more than 50 all-conference honors and 15 all-region designations. Two former Aces, Cory Elenio and Alec Dufty, have gone on to play in Major League Soccer, and most recently, Mark Anthony Gonzalez put together a stellar rookie season with Sporting KC-affiliated Swope Park Rangers in the the USL.
