GAMEDAY NOTES

• The upcoming four-game homestand for the Aces represents Evansville's longest homestand since the 2020-21 season and the reworked scheduling during the COVID-19 pandemic.

• Sunday will represent the 12th all-time meeting in the series history between the Aces and Redhawks with SEMO owning an 8-3 advantage in the all-time series, including the last four matchups.

• The two sides have met four times in the last six years with the Redhawks capturing the last meeting, 83-60, on Nov. 10, 2019 in Cape Girardeau, Mo.

• SEMO enters Sunday's contest with a 4-5 mark on the season, coming off a 63-55 win over Western Illinois on Dec. 7.

• The Redhawks are led by sophomore forward Kennedy Watkins, who tops the team scoring chart for SEMO, averaging 10.7 points per game.

• Evansville has played just one true home game in the regular season so far this year; a 97-72 win over Miami (Ohio) on Nov. 26 inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse. The Aces also played a home game against Chicago State on Nov. 16, but it was played inside the Ford Center.

• A win for Evansville would mark its third this season against teams from the OVC and a 3-0 mark against the conference so far this season.

TEAM NOTES

BOUNCE BACK FROM BELLARMIN

It was a perfect storm that doomed the Aces on Dec. 8 at Bellarmine and resulted in a 60-40 Aces loss. Evansville shot just 28.6% (16-56) from the field, its lowest since Jan. 27, 2022, while getting to the free-throw line just 19 times, a season low. On top of that, senior guard/forward Abby Feit was held scoreless for the first time in her collegiate career, going 0-for-6 from the field in 31 minutes of action.

PRODUCING A POST PRESENCE

As much as the fast-paced, high-scoring offense has been lauded for the Aces this season, Evansville has also excelled at protecting the rim. UE has relied on four rim protectors this season in senior Abby Feit, redshirt juniors Barbora Tomancova and Celine Dupont, and fifth-year guard A’Niah Griffin. The group has combined for 23 of Evansville’s 28 blocks on the season and has helped UE to average four blocks per contest this year, the 77th-best average in the nation. Feit’s team-high nine blocks this season gives her 114 in her career and puts her just 17 from moving into third in program history in the category. leagues in the country.

HOME VS. AWAY

Evansville sits at 2-0 at home this season with an average margin of victory of 25 points per game. Meanwhile, UE has faced some stiff competition on the road, going just 2-3 in away games. Let’s take a more in-depth look at the splits between home and away contests for the Aces in 2022-23.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Despite a non-conference slate that featured road contests at a pair of Big Ten foes, Evansville has excelled in non-league play for the second-straight season. A pair of wins in the last two non-MVC matchups would help the Aces match their non-conference win total from a season ago.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

HOME SWEET HOME FOR ABBY

As described in the adjacent column, Evansville has been a slightly different team at home compared to how they have performed on the road. Senior guard/forward Abby Feit has been the same, averaging below 10 points per game in road contests, while putting on a show at home where she averages 23 points per game and 14.5 boards per contest.

CLARK EYE-ING 1,000

Entering Sunday’s matchup with SEMO, fifth-year guard Myia Clark is on the verge of a milestone. Playing in her second year for the Aces, Clark sits just three points away from reaching the 1,000-point mark and would become the third Ace to do so in the last five season, following teammate Abby Feit who reached the mark last season. In her career, Clark has scored 449 points at Evansville and 548 points in three previous seasons at SLU.

KNOCKING-DOWN SHOTS AT THE LINE

In her first season in white and purple, redshirt-junior center Barbora Tomancova has been a key addition for the Aces. Along with her scoring and rebounding ability and rim protection, Tomancova has also converted at the charity stripe at a high-rate. Tomancova is averaging a team-best 92.9% (26-28), good enough for 18th in the nation.

MAKING HISTORY

In the season opener at Eastern Kentucky, fifth-year guard Myia Clark put on a show. The St. Louis native scored 25 points, hitting eight three-pointers, tying the program record for made 3s in a single game. The record was originally set by Courtney Felke, who hit eight of her 14 attempts against Morehead State on Nov. 19, 2007.

SOME OF THE HOOSIER STATE’S BEST

Evansville welcomes a pair of freshman guards who stayed in-state to join the Aces. Kynidi Mason Striverson and Rayah Kincer were both named Indiana All-Stars during their high school careers with Kincer earning it her junior season before an injury ended her senior campaign early in the year and Mason Striverson captured all state honors as a senior, leading her team to the 2022 State Championship game.

LAST TIME OUT

LOUISVILLE - Doomed by cold-shooting, the University of Evansville women's basketball team dropped a road matchup with Bellarmine, 60-40, on the road in Louisville, Ky. on Thursday evening.

Back in her hometown, fifth-year guard A'Niah Griffin led the way, scoring 10 points, adding three steals and a pair of assists. Also making her return near home, freshman guard Kynidi Mason Striverson added nine points off the bench. Redshirt junior Celine Dupont helped off the bench as well, finishing with six points, five rebounds, and a team-best three blocks. Bellarmine was led by a pair of double-figure scorers in Hayley Harrison (17 points) and Gracie Merkle (15 points and 11 boards).

A cold shooting start to open the game proved difficult for Evansville to overcome early on as the Aces trailed by as many as 10 in the opening quarter. A'Niah Griffin had much of Evansville's early offense, scoring five points in the first frame, including a late-quarter triple as UE trailed 19-9 after the first.

Evansville's defense improved in the second period, limiting the Knights to just 5-of-19 (26.3%) shooting in the second 10 minutes, but the Aces offense struggled to get jump started. A 29-19 advantage on the boards in the opening half, including nine offensive rebounds for Bellarmine, helped the Knights own a 30-15 lead at the break.

A quick 6-0 run for the Aces keyed by buckets from Tomancova, Newman, and Griffin to get UE back within nine less than two minutes into the third quarter. As was true for much of the night, Bellarmine had a response for the Aces, returning the favor with a 10-1 run to go in front 40-22. Evansville finally broke-out of its shooting slump in the fourth quarter, hitting seven of their 12 attempts in the final 10 minutes as Bellarmine captured the 60-40 win.

LAST MEETING

CAPE GIRARDEAU, Mo. - Keeping pace through the opening half, the University of Evansville saw Southeast Missouri State use a third quarter run to pull away in the Aces' 83-60 loss to the Redhawks on Sunday afternoon in Cape Girardeau, Mo.

For the second-straight game, the Aces were led by freshman Abby Feit, who scored a team-best 16 points and added six rebounds. Sophomore Anna Newman reached double-digits with 12 points along with five boards, while redshirt sophomore NaTaya Partee scored nine points and tallied a team-high seven rebounds.

The Aces opened the game with a 4-1 lead after bakets by freshmen Jossie Hudson and Abby Feit. After the early lead, SEMO mounted an 11-2 lead that helped the Redhawks jump in front, 12-6, midway through the first quarter. Evansville battled and stayed within six at the end of the quarter as Partee found Feit cutting to the basket to trim the deficit to six in the closing 40 seconds of the first period.

The second quarter saw another strong run from Evansville as the Aces began the quarter with a 9-3 run to tie the game at 19 on a bucket by Partee. SEMO crept back out in front as the quarter progressed, using free throws to take a 34-29 advantage to the break.

To open the second half, Evansville scored the first four points to cut its deficit to just one at 34-33 with 9:10 left in the third quarter. After the Aces' half-opening run, the Redhawks sprinted away on a 19-2 run that saw SEMO's lead grow as large as 18 at 53-35 with under four minutes remaining in the third period. The Redhawks saw their lead grow to 21 in the final minute of the quarter before Evansville hit a basket to cut it to 61-42 with one quarter to play. Evansville battled its way back as close as 14 on two separate occasions in the fourth quarter, but the Aces could draw no closer in the 83-60 loss.

The story of the game were free throws and three pointers as the Redhawks went 29-44 from the line to 13-16 for Evansville. The Aces struggled from beyond the arc, hitting just three of their 23 attempts from beyond the arc.

Robyn Scherr-Wells enters her second season at the helm of the Purple Aces women's basketball program and the rebuild is well underway.

On April 20, 2021, Scherr-Wells, who had shown a knack for revitalizing programs and developing talent, was named as the 11th head coach in Evansville women's basketball program history. Since then, Scherr-Wells has made plenty of progress in rebuilding the Aces program, beginning with the 2021-22 season.

In her first season, Scherr-Wells led the Aces to eight wins, the most by an Evansville team since winning 14 games in 2016-17. Capturing a pair of victories in MVC play, Scherr-Wells' side earned the no. 9 seed at Hoops in the Heartland, its highest seed since 2016-17.

One of the hallmarks of head coach Robyn Scherr-Wells system at UE has been playing fast. Installing a new system, Scherr-Wells achieved her goal of getting the Aces to play fast as Evansville finished 35th in the nation with 74.4 possessions per 40 minutes in her first season at the helm. The Aces averaged over 65 points per game in 2021-22, a nine-point increase from the 2020-21 campaign.

Scherr-Wells came to the River City with head coaching experience, coaching for seven seasons in the NAIA with Roosevelt University and Davenport University, winning six conference championships, while also helping rebuild programs at Florida International University and Davidson College as an assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level. Scherr-Wells spent the 2020-21 season as assistant coach at Florida International University, where she was part of a staff that helped lead the Panthers to their best record in nearly a decade.

A native of Glen Ellyn, Illinois, Scherr-Wells attended the University of Michigan where she joined the women's basketball team. With the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells started as a manager/practice player during her freshman season and eventually earned an athletic scholarship as a sophomore for her role in that capacity for the squad. As a member of the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells was part of a team that earned three NCAA Tournament berths and made the postseason in each of her four seasons.

A 2001 graduate of the University of Michigan, Scherr-Wells finished with distinction and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Movement Science and Athletic Training. She went on to earn a Master's Degree of Business Administration from Roosevelt in 2014. She is married to Ryan Wells and the two have one son, Jett.

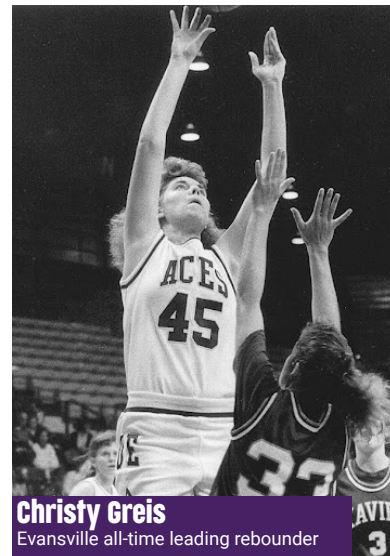
