GAMEDAY NOTES

· Thursday night marks the fifth all-time meeting between the Aces and Knight with each side capturing two matchups in series history.

- The two sides are meeting for the third straight year with Evansville having won the last two contests, including last year's meeting in Freedom Hall. 89-83.
- · Evansville and Bellarmine enter Thursday night's matchup coming-off of playing the same opponent last. UE earned a 75-65 win over Morehead State on Friday evening, while Bellarmine dropped a road game with the Eagles, 63-59, on Sunday afternoon.
- · Through six games, Evansville has recorded a pair of road wins, tied for the most in a single-season by the Aces since the 2016-17 season when UE captured five road victories.
- · Senior guard/forward Abby Feit has been on a tear of late, jumping to the top of the Aces scoring list. Feit leads the team averaging 15.8 points per game after scoring in double-figures in fourstraight games, including 19+ in three of the last
- · Redshirt junior Barbora Tomancova has been a force in the paint for Evansville, recording her third double-double in six games with 11 points and 12 boards in UE's win over

TEAM NOTES

USING THEIR FIFTH YEAR

Returning for their fifth year of college basketball, Myia Clark and Anna Newman add to a veteran Aces squad. Combining to play in 219 collegiate games, Clark and Newman look to lead Evansville's backcourt in 2022-23.

RECRUITING INTERNATIONALLY

One of the hallmarks of head coach Robyn Scherr-Wells recruiting system has been finding international players. This year's Aces squad features players from five different countries, including additions from the Czech Republic and Spain to add to players from the USA, Australia, and The Netherlands.

IMPRESSIVE ADDITIONS

In the offseason, the UE coaching staff set out to add impactful players to the roster and appear to have done just that. Two NCAA DI transfers in 6-3 center Barbora Tomancova (FIU and Minnesota) and 5-8 sophomore point guard Lexie Sinclair (Saint Bonaventure) bring collegiate experience, while Kynidi Mason Striverson (Sellersburg, Ind.) and Rayah Kincer (Indianapolis, Ind.) both enter as two of the best in the 2022 class from the state of Indiana, while Irene Hernanz Pacios (Spain) adds extra depth in the frontcourt for the Aces.

CHANGING LANDSCAPE OF THE VALLEY

Undergoing a massive transformation this offseason, the Missouri Valley Conference looks a lot different for the 2022-23 season. Loyola Chicago has left the league for the A-10 and Belmont, Murray State, and UIC have joined the conference, creating a 12-team league. From a women's basketball perspective, the MVC loses team 119 in the final NET rankings from last season and adds teams 45, 103, and 333, increasing the competitiveness of a league that has already proven to be one of the best mid-major leagues in the country.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

A RARE PERFORMANCE

Against Chicago State last Wednesday, senior guard/forward Abby Feit poured-in 27 points and grabbed 17 rebounds in an 82-57 win. Feit is one of just eight players since the 2009-10 season to have 27+ points and 17+ rebounds in 26-or-less minutes on the floor.

MAKING HISTORY

In the season opener at Eastern Kentucky, fifth-year guard Myia Clark put on a show. The St. Louis native scored 25 points, hitting eight three-pointers, tying the program record for made 3s in a single game. The record was originally set by Courtney Felke, who hit eight of her 14 attempts against Morehead State on Nov. 19, 2007.

THE HOMETOWN HERO IS BACK

A leader for the Aces for four seasons, point guard Anna Newman turned-in her best season in 2021-22. Planning to finish her career and move onto coaching, Newman made the decision to come back for one more year as an Ace. In her career, Newman has accumulated 648 points, 328 assists, and has played in 107 career games with 88 starts.

SOME OF THE HOOSIER STATE'S BEST

Evansville welcomes a pair of freshman guards who stayed in-state to join the Aces. Kynidi Mason Striverson and Rayah Kincer were both named Indiana All-Stars during their high school careers with Kincer earning it her junior season before an injury ended her senior campaign early in the year and Mason Striverson captured all state honors as a senior, leading her team to the 2022 State Championship game.

AUSTRALIAN DUO

Joining Evansville for their first collegiate seasons last year, Elly Morgan and Kodie Myszka helped provide a spark in 2021-22 despite still adapting to the American collegiate game. The two combined to average seven points and three boards. Morgan showed plenty of promise in her ability to score, shooting 36.7 % from the field as a guard, while Myszka showed a penchant for rim protection with 13 blocks on the season.

LAST TIME OUT

MOREHEAD, Ky. - Pulling away in the second half, the University of Evansville women's basketball team picked-up its second road victory of the season, 75-65, over Morehead State on Friday evening in Morehead, Ky.

For the second-time this year, senior guard/forward Abby Feit scored 27 points, narrowly missing a double-double with eight boards in the win. Capturing a second-straight double-double, redshirt junior Barbora Tomancova tallied 11 points and 12 boards on the night, while fifth-year guard Myia Clark also finished in double-figures with 12 points. The Eagles were led by Veronica Charles, who finished with 19 points to pace Morehead State.

Much like Saturday's matchup with Miami (Ohio), it took a minute or two for the Aces to settle into the contest. Morehead State grabbed an early lead at 11-7, but Evansville battled back with the help of Tomancova. The Eagles lead would grow as large as six in the first quarter, but Tomancova continued to assert herself in the post, getting to the line to score eight of UE's first 12 points. Following Tomancova's early strong form, Feit stepped up, going on a personal 8-0 run to close the opening period and giving Evansville the 19-18 lead after 10 minutes of play.

The lead stayed with the Aces for much of the second period before the home side battled back to retake the lead inside the final four minutes of the half. As the opening half waned, Feit again went on her own run, scoring the last six points of the half to give UE a four-point lead going to the half.

Out of the break, Evansville continued to hold its lead, but Morehead State had another challenge in it. After the Eagles came back to tie the game at 36 with 7:44 left in the third, the Aces used a key stretch to take the lead and open up their advantage. A 13-2 Evansville run gave the Aces a double-digit lead, spurred by triples from A'Niah Griffin and Kynidi Mason Striverson. In all, the Aces out-scored Morehead State 25-12 in the third period as UE held a 59-42 lead.

The Eagles pushed UE one final time, cutting the Aces advantage as low as six with 4:10 left in the game. Evansville responded immediately with a bucket of its own as Newman hit a layup to answer the Eagles. Over the final minutes, the Aces got another important three from Feit and converted at the free-throw line to secure the 10-point victory.

LAST MEETING

LOUISVILLE, Ky. - Once it got rolling, the University of Evansville women's basketball team was tough to slow down in an 89-83 road victory at Bellarmine inside Freedom Hall on Tuesday night in Louisville, Ky.

An impressive night on the offensive end was led by junior Je'Naiya Davis, who finished just one point shy of her second 30-point performance for the Aces with 29 points on the night, including a career-high 12 made free throws. Turning-in a classic performance, junior Abby Feit tallied her sixth double-double of the season, this time tying a career-high with 18 rebounds to go along with 15 points, five assists, four steals, and three blocks in the Aces win. Also reaching double-figures for Evansville was senior A'Niah Griffin, who tallied 10 points in her return to her hometown. The Knights were led by Mackenzie Keelin and Sheniqua Coatney, who each finished with 17 points on the night.

A fast start for Evansville propelled the Aces out to a 9-0 lead inside the first two minutes of the contest, punctuated by a three from Celine Dupont that forced a Bellarmine timeout. Right out of the break, Evansville added another basket, coming from Davis as the lead grew to 11-0. The Knights would begin to slowly crack the Aces defense, creeping back into the contest throughout the opening stanza. In the final seconds of the quarter, a driving layup from the Knights' Jaela Johnson cut the Evansville lead to just two heading into the second period.

Bellarmine's new found rhythm continued into the second quarter as the Knights took the lead and built it as large as seven at 33-26 with just over three minutes left in the half. Evansville responded as both teams combined for 26 points in the final 3:30, fueled by eight points by Gala Camarena, including a pair of made triples as the Aces rallied to take a one-point 43-42 lead at the break.

Evansville quickly asserted itself coming out of the break to the tune of a 24-13 advantage in the third quarter, powered by a 13-3 run to close the period. A consistent force on the offensive end, Davis continued her all out effort in the third, scoring eight of her 29 points in the period, including a pair of three pointers as Evansville built its lead to 67-55 heading into the final 10 minutes.

After being contained for much of the opening 30 minutes, Feit finally broke free in the fourth quarter, helping to see the road victory. Entering the fourth, Feit had just eight points, but the Normal, Ill. native changed the course of the contest just minutes into the fourth. After Bellarmine had decreased the Aces advantage to 10, it was Feit who stood tall, scoring seven-straight points run over the course of just over a minute, capped-off by a three that handed Evansville back a 12-point advantage. Inside the final two minutes, Bellarmine scrapped back within single digits, getting as close as seven with less than a minute to play, but Evansville converted its free throws to capture the 89-83 win.

Robyn Scherr-Wells enters her second season at the helm of the Purple Aces women's basket-ball program and the rebuild is well underway.

On April 20, 2021, Scherr-Wells, who had shown a knack for revitalizing programs and developing talent, was named as the 11th head coach in Evansville women's basketball program history. Since then, Scherr-Wells has made plenty of progress in rebuilding the Aces program, beginning with the 2021-22 season.

In her first season, Scherr-Wells led the Aces to eight wins, the most by an Evansville team since winning 14 games in 2016-17. Capturing a pair of victories in MVC play, Scherr-Wells' side earned the no. 9 seed at Hoops in the Heartland, its highest seed since 2016-17.

One of the hallmarks of head coach RobynScherr-Wells system at UE has been playing fast. Installing a new system, Scherr-Wells achieved her goal of getting the Aces to play fast as Evansville finished 35th in the nation with 74.4 possessions per 40 minutes in her first season at the helm. The Aces averaged over 65 points per game in 2021-22, a nine-point increase from the 2020-21 campaign.

Scherr-Wells came to the River City with head coaching experience, coaching for seven seasons in the NAIA with Roosevelt University and Davenport University, winning six conference championships, while also helping rebuild programs at Florida International University and Davidson College as an assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level. Scherr-Wells spent the 2020-21 season as assistant coach at Florida International University, where she was part of a staff that helped lead the Panthers to their best record in nearly a decade.

A native of Glen Ellyn, Illinois, Scherr-Wells attended the University of Michigan where she joined the women's basketball team. With the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells started as a manager/practice player during her freshman season and eventually earned an athletic scholarship as a sophomore for her role in that capacity for the squad. As a member of the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells was part of a team that earned three NCAA Tournament berths and made the postseason in each of her four seasons.

A 2001 graduate of the University of Michigan, Scherr-Wells finished with distinction and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Movement Science and Athletic Training. She went on to earn a Master's Degree of Business Administration from Roosevelt in 2014. She is married to Ryan Wells and the two have one son, Jett.




