TEAM NOTES

SUPERLATIVES VERSUS THE GOVS

In an offensive explosion in a 20-4 win over Austin Peay last Wednesday night, the Aces rewrote much of its "Last Time" page. The 20 runs were the most scored by Evansville since March 8, 2016 and the 12-run sixth inning was the highest-scoring inning for the Aces since April 5, 2011. The Aces also tallied 20 hits in the game, its most since March 8, 2016.

STRIKEOUTS BY THE BUNCHES

Over the last handful of games, Evansville has relied on strikeouts to get its opponent's out. Over the last six contests, the Aces have recorded seven or more strikeouts in each contest, including 13 against No. 18 Tulane in game one of the series.

LIVING BY THE LONG BALL

With a bevy of big hitters in the lineup, Evansville has shown its ability to thrive on home runs this season. Entering Tuesday's contest against WKU, the Aces have hit a home run in four-straight games, including four in the series finale at No. 18 Tulane. Each player in Evansville's typical lineup has hit at least one home run this season.

SWEEPING TULANE

Evansville's sweep of #18 Tulane featured a handful of impressive feats. The doubleheader sweep on Saturday earned the Aces their first back-to-back wins over a ranked opponent since taking a pair of games from No. 21 Wichita State in 2006. UE's series sweep from the 18th-ranked Green Wave is believed to be the first in Evansville's baseball history.

WE ARE UE

There are several ways to reference the University of Evansville. Generally, the first reference should always be "University of Evansville" or "Purple Aces". Later references to our team may be "Aces" as well as just using the word "Evansville".

Our school abbreviation is "UE". Under no circumstances is it acceptable to use "EU".

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

MARK'S STREAK CONTINUES

Over a strong start to his junior campaign, Mark Shallenberger has racked-up an impressive streak. Following last week's three contest, Shallenberger pushed his reached base streak to 18 games. Shallenberger has gotten a hit in all but two games this season and leads the team with a .384 batting average.

MEYER CONTINUES SPOTLESS SPRING

Junior Jakob Meyer heads into the fifth week of the season in impressive form. In nine innings of work, Meyer has yet to allow a run this season. The Columbus, Ind. native has allowed just three hits and struck-out 15 batters, while recording a pair of saves.

CRAIG EYES CAREER RECORD

In his four seasons with the Aces, Tanner Craig has proven to be one of the most impactful hitters in the MVC. Craig enters the week just three home runs shy of the Evansville program record, set by Jeff Starks in 1982 with 40 homers. Craig currently sits in a tie for second in program history with 37 homers, hitting seven so far this season.

RUMSEY ON THE CHARGE

A highly coveted addition to the Aces roster this season, freshman outfielder Ty Rumsey has begun to find his footing. After a bit of a slow start out of the gate, which is to be expected for a first-year player, Rumsey has found his rhythm, sitting fourth on the team with a .271 average and generating seven walks.

BERKEY GOES YARD

Coming in to the season with tons of hype, third baseman Evan Berkey has started to show flashes of his potential. The transfer smashed his second home run of the season on Sunday against Northwestern as part of a 3-for-4 game at the plate, helping boost his average to .217.

SCHULTZ TAKES THE MOUND

Tuesday's starter for Evansville is lefty Donovan Schultz, who got plenty of experience as a freshman for the Aces. Schultz spent most of the 2021 season as the Aces Sunday starter, seeing 40 innings of action with 36 strikeouts and a 2-3 record and an 8.55 ERA.

COACH NOTES

- Evansville alum Wes Carroll heads into his 14th season as head baseball coach at the University of Evansville as the Aces have ushered in a new era of Evansville Baseball.
- In July 2019, the Aces announced that German American Bank had made a financial commitment to University of Evansville athletics that will result in an impressive renovation to the Aces baseball stadium, which will now be named "German American Bank Field at Charles H. Braun Stadium." Included in the renovations will be a full Astroturf field, padded walls throughout the entire stadium with new fence lines down the first and third base lines, dugout and bullpen renovations as well as a new LED scoreboard.
- In 2019, Carroll led the Aces to a strong start to the season, en route to 24 wins, including series victories over Iowa and Creighton. After the season, Carroll saw another player graduate to professional baseball after being under his tutelage as pitcher Adam Lukas was selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 12th round of the MLB Amateur Player Draft.
- Carroll learned the game "the Purple Aces' way" growing up just minutes from the UE campus in near-by Newburgh, Indiana. He watched his older brother and current Major League infielder, Jamey Carroll, excel at shortstop for UE, and later got to experience the success the program is capable of first-hand as a four-year starter for the Purple Aces and a member of UE's 2000 NCAA Tournament team.
- Wes Carroll became UE's first Freshman All-America selection in 1998, thanks to a rookie campaign in which he hit .355 with 18 doubles, two home runs, and 39 runs batted in. Carroll went on to hit .299 or better in each of his four years at UE, and finished his career by setting the school's all-time career record for doubles (74), while also ranking in the school's career top 10 in six different categories. He still holds the record for career doubles, has the second-most base hits in school history with 308, and ranks 10th all-time in UE history with a .339 career batting average. Carroll earned all-conference and all-region honors on the UE infield during his four-year career, before being named to the Missouri Valley Conference's All-Centennial Team in 2007 as one of the top players in league history.
