GAMEDAY NOTES

• The Aces and Salukis renew a long-standing rivalry this weekend with Friday night's matchup marking the 161st meeting between the two schools as SIU owns a 96-64 advantage in the all-time series.

• A year ago, Evansville and SIU met eight times, doing so in both conference and non-conference play. In the final series of the season between the two, UE and SIU split a four-game set at German American Bank Field.

• SIU enters the weekend with the best record in the MVC, having amassed 21 wins to just eight losses so far this season, coming off a 2-1 series victory over Bradley to open MVC play and a midweek victory over Murray State on Tuesday.

• Evansville's win over Indiana on Tuesday marked the Aces fourth-straight victory over Power 5 opponents.

TEAM NOTES

PITCHING IS HOT

Facing some of the top teams in the nation to open the season, Evansville's pitching staff has settled in and shown its ability as of late. In the last five contests, the Aces arms have combined for a 3.72 average with 37 strikes and 24 walks. Over the last five games, five pitchers have a sub-2.00 ERA with starters Shane Gray and Shane Harris both falling in that category.

TURNING TWO

As has been true over the past two seasons, the Aces middle infield has been one of its most consistent strong points. Evansville has turned 26 double plays on the season, many orchestrated by short-stop Simon Scherry, second basemen Brent Widder and Evan Berkey, and first baseman Tanner Craig. The 26 double plays in 2022 put Evansville 14th in the nation in the category.

BIG SWEEP

Evansville's three-game series sweep over Michigan State notched a couple of first for the Aces. The sweep marks the first time Evansville has swept a three-game series from a Big Ten opponent in program history. It also marks the first sweep of a series from a power five opponent in program history.

LOOKING AHEAD

Evansville goes on the road for the first time in two weeks with a trip to take on Butler in a midweek contest in Indianapolis on Tuesday evening.

WE ARE UE

There are several ways to reference the University of Evansville. Generally, the first reference should always be "University of Evansville" or "Purple Aces". Later references to our team may be "Aces" as well as just using the word "Evansville".

Our school abbreviation is "UE". Under no circumstances is it acceptable to use "EU".

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

WIDDER'S HOT STREAK

In his third season with the Aces, third baseman Brent Widder has caught fire. Over the last five games, Widder is the best hitter on the team, batting .476 with a pair of homers and seven RBI. Widder has done his best work at the plate in night games this season where the junior has hit a scorching .591 and reached base 62.5% of the time.

CRAIG CLOSES IN

The chase for the top of the Evansville record book is winding to a close for Tanner Craig. Over the weekend, Craig smashed two more home runs, bringing his season total to nine, putting him just one away from tying the program's all-time record of 40 homers, set by Jeff Starks from 1979-82.

BERKEY WEARS IT

At the plate, Evan Berkey has had an eventful season. The La Quinta, Calif. native has been hit by a pitch 12 times this season, placing him in 17th in the nation in the category. On average, Berkey has been hit every other game this season. A year ago, Evansville's Troy Beilsmith finished the season in sixth in total hit by pitch, being hit 23 times.

GRAY BACK ON THE MOUND

After a lights out performance last Friday night, Shane Gray heads back onto the mound to open the series against SIU. This season, Gray has recorded four outings where he allowed three or less runs with three coming at home. Gray has been elite at home, recording a 3-0 record with a 1.83 ERA and striking-out 22 batters, while walking just five.

CRAIG VERSUS THE SALUKIS

A difficult batter for any opponent to face, Tanner Craig has stepped it up to a whole different level against SIU. Last season in eight games against the Salukis, Craig hit .406, while smashing four homers and driving in 10 runs.

CAN'T BE KEPT HIM OFF THE BASES

Putting together an incredible all-around season, Mark Shallenberger's most impressive stat might be his on-base percentage. Shallenberger sits inside the top 50 in the nation in OB%, reaching base exactly 50% of the time, the best percentage in The Valley.

COACH NOTES

- Evansville alum Wes Carroll heads into his 14th season as head baseball coach at the University of Evansville as the Aces have ushered in a new era of Evansville Baseball.
- In July 2019, the Aces announced that German American Bank had made a financial commitment to University of Evansville athletics that will result in an impressive renovation to the Aces baseball stadium, which will now be named "German American Bank Field at Charles H. Braun Stadium." Included in the renovations will be a full Astroturf field, padded walls throughout the entire stadium with new fence lines down the first and third base lines, dugout and bullpen renovations as well as a new LED scoreboard.
- In 2019, Carroll led the Aces to a strong start to the season, en route to 24 wins, including series victories over Iowa and Creighton. After the season, Carroll saw another player graduate to professional baseball after being under his tutelage as pitcher Adam Lukas was selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 12th round of the MLB Amateur Player Draft.
- Carroll learned the game "the Purple Aces' way" growing up just minutes from the UE campus in near-by Newburgh, Indiana. He watched his older brother and current Major League infielder, Jamey Carroll, excel at shortstop for UE, and later got to experience the success the program is capable of first-hand as a four-year starter for the Purple Aces and a member of UE's 2000 NCAA Tournament team.
- Wes Carroll became UE's first Freshman All-America selection in 1998, thanks to a rookie campaign in which he hit .355 with 18 doubles, two home runs, and 39 runs batted in. Carroll went on to hit .299 or better in each of his four years at UE, and finished his career by setting the school's all-time career record for doubles (74), while also ranking in the school's career top 10 in six different categories. He still holds the record for career doubles, has the second-most base hits in school history with 308, and ranks 10th all-time in UE history with a .339 career batting average. Carroll earned all-conference and all-region honors on the UE infield during his four-year career, before being named to the Missouri Valley Conference's All-Centennial Team in 2007 as one of the top players in league history.
