GAMEDAY NOTES

- Thursday represents the 24th meeting between the Aces and Beacons all-time with Valparaiso owning a 14-9 advantage in the series.
- · The Beacons took both of last season's matchups, including the most recent meeting in a 75-70 overtime thriller.
- Valparaiso brings a 2-8 overall record into the Thursday clash, falling in both of its opening MVC duels last week to Belmont and Murray State. The Beacons are powered by a trio of double-digit scorers with senior Olivia Brown leading the way with 12.4 points per game. Valpo looks to snap an eight-game losing streak after starting the year 2-0 with wins over Central Michigan and Southern Miss.
- · Evansville comes into the road weekend following a pair of hard-fought battles last weekend against SIU and Missouri State.
- · In the opening two games of Valley action, the Aces were led by fifth-year guard Myia Clark, who averaged 21.5 points per game and tied a season-high with 25 points against SIU.
- · Battling through an injury, senior guard/forward Abby Feit tallied nine points a piece in each of the weekend's contests, coming up just one point and rebound shy of a double-double facing one of the nation's best rebounding teams in Missouri State.

TEAM NOTES

GETTING TO THE LINE

Continuing what has been a trend this season, Evansville again pulled away in a game thanks to its ability to get to the free-throw line. Against SEMO on Dec. 18, the Aces attempted 41 free throws, the most by an Evansville team since at least 2012-13 and the second time this season UE has attempted 40-or-more free throws in a game. The Aces are number one in the nation in free-throw attempts, averaging just shy of 30 per game and also sit first in free-throw makes at nearly 21 per game.

PRODUCING A POST PRESENCE

As much as the fast-paced, high-scoring offense has been lauded for the Aces this season, Evansville has also excelled at protecting the rim. UE has relied on four rim protectors this season in senior Abby Feit, redshirt juniors Barbora Tomancova and Celine Dupont, and fifth-year guard A'Niah Griffin. The group has combined for 24 of Evansville's 29 blocks on the season and has helped UE to average 3.6 blocks per contest this year, the 105thbest average in the nation. Feit's team-high 10 blocks this season gives her 115 in her career and puts her just 16 from moving into third in program history in the category. leagues in the country.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Evansville has continued to find success in non-conference play this season. The Aces secured a winning record in non-conference play for the third-straight season with the win over SEMO, tying the program record for most consecutive season with a winning record in non-conference action, most recently done in 2006-07, 2007-08, and 2008-09.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

CLARK EXCELS IN MVC PLAY

Opening MVC play, fifth-year guard Myia Clark continued to show her consistency between non-conference and MVC play. Through two Valley games, Clark is averaging 21.5 points per game, compared to her 13.2 point per game average overall. Last season, Clark saw little drop-off in her scoring once entering MVC action, averaging 12.4 points per game in non-conference and 12.0 points per game in MVC play.

ANNA TIES CAREER HIGH

In her final MVC opener, graduate point guard Anna Newman rose to the occassion. Against the Salukis, Newman tied her career high with 17 points against the Salukis, providing an efficient performance for UE, making six of her eight attempts from the field and dishing out seven assists.

CLARK REACHES 1.000

Against SEMO on Dec. 18, fifth-year guard Myia Clark reached a career milestone. With her five points against the Redhawks, Clark surpassed the 1,000-point mark, becoming the third Ace to do so in the last five seasons, following teammate Abby Feit who reached the mark last season. In her career, Clark has scored 454 points at Evansville and 548 points in three previous seasons at SLU.

KNOCKING-DOWN SHOTS AT THE LINE

In her first season in white and purple, redshirt-junior center Barbora Tomancova has been a key addition for the Aces. Along with her scoring and rebounding ability and rim protection, Tomancova has also converted at the charity stripe at a high-rate. Tomancova is averaging a team-best 90.6% (29-32), good enough for 23rd in the nation.

KYNIDI MAKES EARLY IMPACT

Making the transition from prep basketball to the college game has seemed to be relatively smooth for freshman point guard Kynidi Mason Striverson. Just 10 games into her collegiate career, Mason Striverson is averaging nearly eight points and three rebounds, while sitting second on the team with almost two assists per game.

AST TIME OUT

EVANSVILLE - Powered by another impressive scoring performance from fifth-year guard Myia Clark, the University of Evansville women's basketball team battled with Missouri State, but saw its early lead fade in a 73-61 loss to the Lady Bears on Saturday afternoon inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse in Evansville.

For the second-straight contest, the Aces were led by Clark in scoring as the Schaumburg, III. native tallied a team-best 18 points, shooting 50% (6-of-12) from the field in the game. Fellow fifth-year A'Niah Griffin joined her backcourt mate in double-figures, scoring 11 points on the afternoon. Coming up just shy of her 28th-career double-double, senior guard/forward Abby Feit finished with nine points and nine boards in a strong effort against one of the best rebounding teams in the nation. The Lady Bears were led by Aniya Thomas, who tallied a gamebest 27 points for the visitors.

Evansville got off to a quick start in the opening period, but the Aces efficient offense was matched by that of the Lady Bears. The Aces lead grew as large as three in the opening quarter as Clark scored nine of UE's 15 first-quarter points to help Evansville own a 15-14 advantage after one quarter of play.

A guick 4-0 run from the Lady Bears to open the second period handed Missouri State back the lead, but Evansville provided an answer. In a back-and-forth first half, Evansville tied the game at 23 on a layup from sophomore Elly Morgan with just over five minutes left in the second frame. Missouri State retook the lead nearly a minute later and would hold on to it for the remainder of the half, building its advantage to seven at the break.

Offensive rebounds and second-chance points proved to be the difference in the game and specifically the third quarter as the Lady Bears began to stretch their advantage. In the game, Missouri State won the rebounding battle 46-29, including 16 offensive boards for MSU that led to 11 second chance points. helping the Lady Bears lead 56-45 going into the final 10 minutes.

A resilient Evansville bunch that has shown to not give up in games this season did just that in the fourth. Inside the first minute of the fourth period, Clark received the ball on the right wing and buried a triple that fueled the Meeks Family Fieldhouse crowd and got the Aces back within seven. In striking range to make a late rally, Evansville could not draw any closer as MSU responded with a run to take the 73-61 win.

AST MEETING

EVANSVILLE - Putting on one of its best offensive performances of the season, the University of Evansville women's basketball battled, but fell in an overtime heartbreaker, 75-70, to Valparaiso on Friday night inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse.

On a top notch night for the offense, Evansville was led by a pair of 20-plus point scorers in senior A'Niah Griffin and junior Je'Naiya Davis. Griffin recorded a new career-high with 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting, while Davis recorded her fifth game of 20-or-more points this season, matching Griffin's 21 points for team-high. Junior Abby Feit also finished in double-digits on the evening, hitting a pair of important triples late en route to 10 points. The Beacons were powered by three double-figure scores, led by Shay Frederick, who finished with 18 points.

On a night that saw the largest crowd of the year all decked-out in orange, the Aces got off to a solid start in the first period. After falling behind 12-4, Evansville put together a 7-0 run to get within a point, eventually trailing just 14-13 after the opening 10 minutes of action.

After shooting 38% from the field in the first period, Evansville upped its efficiency in the second quarter, hitting six of its 13 attempts (46.2%). The Beacons matched the Aces efficiency, hitting 53.9% from the field in the guarter, but neither side could gain much separation in the period as Valpo went to the break with a 30-28 lead on a layup by Frederick in the closing seconds of the half.

Out of the break it was the Beacons who took control of the contest, opening up a 39-28 lead on a quick 9-0 run out of the halftime locker room. As has become the modus operandi for the Aces as of late, a double-digit lead was ripe for a comeback. Evansville mounted a 14-2 spree that pushed the Aces in front with a 42-41 advantage with 3:20 left in the quarter. A back-and-forth finish to the period concluded with a layup by Carie Weinman at the buzzer that earned the Beacons a twopoint advantage with a quarter of regulation left to play.

Multiple times in the final 10 minutes, Evansville looked to have grabbed control, holding four-point leads on more than one occasion, but the Beacons battled back from each. With 1:37 left in regulation, Feit knocked-down an important three that broke a tie and pushed Evansville in front 68-65. A bevy of missed opportunities for both sides unfolded in the final minutes with Valpo having possession with under 30 seconds left. The ball found Frederick on the right wing who drained a three to tie the game and send it to over time tied at 68.

Early in the overtime period, the Aces were able to drive to the basket and get to the free-throw line, where Evansville twice split a pair to hold a 70-68 lead. Shooting woes over the final five minutes would prove to be the difference as Valpo edged in front on a Frederick's free throws, holding on for the 75-70 win.

Robyn Scherr-Wells enters her second season at the helm of the Purple Aces women's basket-ball program and the rebuild is well underway.

On April 20, 2021, Scherr-Wells, who had shown a knack for revitalizing programs and developing talent, was named as the 11th head coach in Evansville women's basketball program history. Since then, Scherr-Wells has made plenty of progress in rebuilding the Aces program, beginning with the 2021-22 season.

In her first season, Scherr-Wells led the Aces to eight wins, the most by an Evansville team since winning 14 games in 2016-17. Capturing a pair of victories in MVC play, Scherr-Wells' side earned the no. 9 seed at Hoops in the Heartland, its highest seed since 2016-17.

One of the hallmarks of head coach RobynScherr-Wells system at UE has been playing fast. Installing a new system, Scherr-Wells achieved her goal of getting the Aces to play fast as Evansville finished 35th in the nation with 74.4 possessions per 40 minutes in her first season at the helm. The Aces averaged over 65 points per game in 2021-22, a nine-point increase from the 2020-21 campaign.

Scherr-Wells came to the River City with head coaching experience, coaching for seven seasons in the NAIA with Roosevelt University and Davenport University, winning six conference championships, while also helping rebuild programs at Florida International University and Davidson College as an assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level. Scherr-Wells spent the 2020-21 season as assistant coach at Florida International University, where she was part of a staff that helped lead the Panthers to their best record in nearly a decade.

A native of Glen Ellyn, Illinois, Scherr-Wells attended the University of Michigan where she joined the women's basketball team. With the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells started as a manager/practice player during her freshman season and eventually earned an athletic scholarship as a sophomore for her role in that capacity for the squad. As a member of the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells was part of a team that earned three NCAA Tournament berths and made the postseason in each of her four seasons.

A 2001 graduate of the University of Michigan, Scherr-Wells finished with distinction and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Movement Science and Athletic Training. She went on to earn a Master's Degree of Business Administration from Roosevelt in 2014. She is married to Ryan Wells and the two have one son, Jett.




