GAMEDAY NOTES

• Saturday's matchup will be the 15th all-time meeting between Evansville and UIC, but the first as conference foes, as UE owns a 9-5 advantage in the series.

• The two sides last met inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse on Dec. 5, 2018 with the Flames capturing a 62-54 win.

• UIC enters the weekend with an 8-6 overall mark, while still searching for their first MVC win with an 0-3 record in Valley play.

• The Flames are coming off a 59-48 loss to Indiana State on Thursday evening.

• The home side UIC is led by three double-figure scorers in Josie Filler, Jaide McCloud, and Ky Dempsey-Toney, who all average 10-or-more points and over five rebounds per game.

Evansville comes into the weekend finale following a 57-45 win over Valparaiso on Thursday, Evansville's first road win in MVC play since defeating Valpo on the road during the 2020-21 campaign.

• Senior guard/forward Abby Feit looked to be back to her regular self after battling an injury last weekend. Feit finished with a game-high 18 points and nearly another double-double with nine boards in UE's win over Valpo.

TEAM NOTES

GETTING TO THE LINE

Continuing what has been a trend this season, Evansville again pulled away in a game thanks to its ability to get to the free-throw line. Against SEMO on Dec. 18, the Aces attempted 41 free throws, the most by an Evansville team since at least 2012-13 and the second time this season UE has attempted 40-or-more free throws in a game. The Aces are number one in the nation in free-throw attempts, averaging just shy of 30 per game and also sit first in free-throw makes at nearly 21 per game.

PRODUCING A POST PRESENCE

As much as the fast-paced, high-scoring offense has been lauded for the Aces this season, Evansville has also excelled at protecting the rim. UE has relied on four rim protectors this season in senior Abby Feit, redshirt juniors Barbora Tomancova and Celine Dupont, and fifth-year guard A’Niah Griffin. The group has combined for 24 of Evansville’s 29 blocks on the season and has helped UE to average 3.6 blocks per contest this year, the 105th-best average in the nation. Feit’s team-high 10 blocks this season gives her 115 in her career and puts her just 16 from moving into third in program history in the category. leagues in the country.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Evansville has continued to find success in non-conference play this season. The Aces secured a winning record in non-conference play for the third-straight season with the win over SEMO, tying the program record for most consecutive season with a winning record in non-conference action, most recently done in 2006-07, 2007-08, and 2008-09.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

CLARK EXCELS IN MVC PLAY

Opening MVC play, fifth-year guard Myia Clark continued to show her consistency between non-conference and MVC play. Through two Valley games last weekend, Clark is averaging 21.5 points per game, compared to her 13.2 point per game average overall. Last season, Clark saw little drop-off in her scoring once entering MVC action, averaging 12.4 points per game in non-conference and 12.0 points per game in MVC play.

ANNA TIES CAREER HIGH

In her final MVC opener, graduate point guard Anna Newman rose to the occasion. Against the Salukis, Newman tied her career high with 17 points against the Salukis, providing an efficient performance for UE, making six of her eight attempts from the field and dishing out seven assists.

CLARK REACHES 1,000

Against SEMO on Dec. 18, fifth-year guard Myia Clark reached a career milestone. With her five points against the Redhawks, Clark surpassed the 1,000-point mark, becoming the third Ace to do so in the last five seasons, following teammate Abby Feit who reached the mark last season. In her career, Clark has scored 454 points at Evansville and 548 points in three previous seasons at SLU.

KNOCKING-DOWN SHOTS AT THE LINE

In her first season in white and purple, redshirt-junior center Barbora Tomancova has been a key addition for the Aces. Along with her scoring and rebounding ability and rim protection, Tomancova has also converted at the charity stripe at a high-rate. Tomancova is averaging a team-best 90.6% (29-32), good enough for 23rd in the nation.

KYNIDI MAKES EARLY IMPACT

Making the transition from prep basketball to the college game has seemed to be relatively smooth for freshman point guard Kynidi Mason Striverson. Just 10 games into her collegiate career, Mason Striverson is averaging nearly eight points and three rebounds, while sitting second on the team with almost two assists per game.

LAST TIME OUT

VALPARAISO, Ind. - Behind an efficient offense and a stifling defense, the University of Evansville women's basketball team earned a 57-45 road win in Missouri Valley Conference action on Thursday evening in Valparaiso, Ind.

"Any time you can get on the road and pick-up a road win is a big deal in this conference," said Aces head women's basketball coach Robyn Scherr-Wells. "I just thought we were solid from start to finish. It certainly would have been nice if a few more buckets had dropped, we might have been able to make things a little bit easier in that sense, but it felt like we had control basically the whole game and felt it was one of our most complete games we've played from start to finish in that aspect."

Bouncing back from an injury that limited her last weekend, senior guard/forward Abby Feit turned in a vintage performance, scoring 18 points on 8-of-11 shooting and grabbing nine boards to power the Aces. Fifth-year guard Myia Clark notched her third-straight game in double-figures with 11 points on the night, while redshirt junior Barbora Tomancova pulled-down 10 boards and added eight points. In all, seven Aces scored four-or-more points in the Evansville win. For the Beacons, Ali Saunders led the way, scoring a team-best 14 points off the bench.

A quick 7-2 spurt from Valpo to open the contest earned an early lead for the home side, but Evansville quickly responded. The first quarter was marked by consistent offense for both teams with the Aces answering nearly every Beacon basket through much of the quarter. Trailing 15-11 with exactly three minutes left in the opening period, Evansville went on a 7-2 run to grab the lead, an advantage the Aces would not relinquish.

Evansville continued its run to begin the second quarter, scoring the first four points of the frame on a pair of layups by Feit to grow its lead to five. The offenses of both sides struggled to get their footing in the second period with the Aces shooting 29% (4-14) and the Beacons hitting just one field-goal (1-for-8) as Evansville's lead sat at seven at 26-19 at the break.

It was another string of Aces points that lifted UE's lead in double-digits to open the second half as Evansville sprinted out of halftime with an 8-2 run. Buckets from A'Niah Griffin, Tomancova, Clark, and Feit allowed the Aces to take a 34-21 before the midway point of the third quarter. Valparaiso would get a pair of shots to fall in the final three minutes of the quarter to take the Beacons within nine going into the final 10 minutes of action.

Emphasized as a point of focus by head coach Robyn Scherr-Wells following last weekend's contests, Evansville demonstrated its ability to hold an opponent at bay in the fourth. The Beacons got as close as eight in the final frame, but could draw no closer as Evansville's efficient offense provided and answer for every Beacon bucket as the Aces earned the 57-45 win.

LAST MEETING

EVANSVILLE, Ind. - In its first home game in over two weeks, the University of Evansville women's basketball team could not quite complete the comeback in a 62-54 setback to UIC on Wednesday evening inside Meeks Family Fieldhouse.

Senior Kerri Gasper poured-in a season-high 22 points while playing all 40 minutes in the contest as the veteran also gathered five rebounds on the evening. Continuing her shooting streak, redshirt junior Marley Miller hit three triples for the third-straight game for nine points, while freshman Makayla Wallace joined Miller with nine points, adding seven rebounds and ofur assists while going 9-12 from the charity stripe.

UIC was led by the duo of Brittany Byrd and Taylor Toney who combined for 41 of the Flames' 62 points on the evening and shot 13-28 from the field. Byrd and Toney only scored 13 combined points in the first half, but each tallied 14 points to help lead UIC to the victory in the second half.

Battling back from a 7-0 deficit to open the game, the Purple Aces held a 14-13 lead after the first quarter, but Evansville hit a cold stretch during the second period. As both teams struggled to find their rhythm in the second quarter, UIC took the lead from UE less than two minutes into the quarter and went on an 11-3 run to earn a 24-19 lead at the break.

Evansville trimmed its deficit to a single possession six times in the third quarter, including tying the game at 34 on a jumper by freshman Tayzha Buck, but it was the Flames who again went on a run to close the half, using an 8-2 spree to push out to a 42-36 advantage heading into the final 10 minutes. In the fourth, UIC saw its lead pushed to 10 early on, but the Aces responded, cutting the Flames' lead to just three at 53-50 with 2:29 remaining on the clock. As was the story on the night, UIC manufactured another run to secure the win, ending the game in a 9-2 run as the Flames' picked up the 62-54 win.

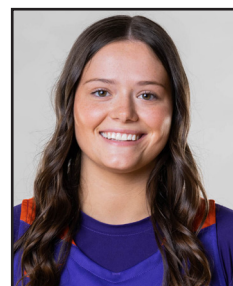

Robyn Scherr-Wells enters her second season at the helm of the Purple Aces women's basketball program and the rebuild is well underway.

On April 20, 2021, Scherr-Wells, who had shown a knack for revitalizing programs and developing talent, was named as the 11th head coach in Evansville women's basketball program history. Since then, Scherr-Wells has made plenty of progress in rebuilding the Aces program, beginning with the 2021-22 season.

In her first season, Scherr-Wells led the Aces to eight wins, the most by an Evansville team since winning 14 games in 2016-17. Capturing a pair of victories in MVC play, Scherr-Wells' side earned the no. 9 seed at Hoops in the Heartland, its highest seed since 2016-17.

One of the hallmarks of head coach Robyn Scherr-Wells system at UE has been playing fast. Installing a new system, Scherr-Wells achieved her goal of getting the Aces to play fast as Evansville finished 35th in the nation with 74.4 possessions per 40 minutes in her first season at the helm. The Aces averaged over 65 points per game in 2021-22, a nine-point increase from the 2020-21 campaign.

Scherr-Wells came to the River City with head coaching experience, coaching for seven seasons in the NAIA with Roosevelt University and Davenport University, winning six conference championships, while also helping rebuild programs at Florida International University and Davidson College as an assistant coach at the NCAA Division I level. Scherr-Wells spent the 2020-21 season as assistant coach at Florida International University, where she was part of a staff that helped lead the Panthers to their best record in nearly a decade.

A native of Glen Ellyn, Illinois, Scherr-Wells attended the University of Michigan where she joined the women's basketball team. With the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells started as a manager/practice player during her freshman season and eventually earned an athletic scholarship as a sophomore for her role in that capacity for the squad. As a member of the Wolverines, Scherr-Wells was part of a team that earned three NCAA Tournament berths and made the postseason in each of her four seasons.

A 2001 graduate of the University of Michigan, Scherr-Wells finished with distinction and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Movement Science and Athletic Training. She went on to earn a Master's Degree of Business Administration from Roosevelt in 2014. She is married to Ryan Wells and the two have one son, Jett.

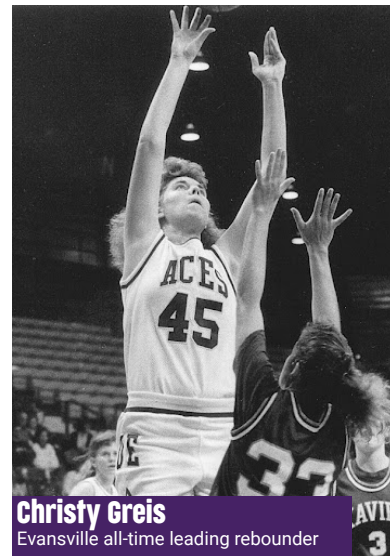
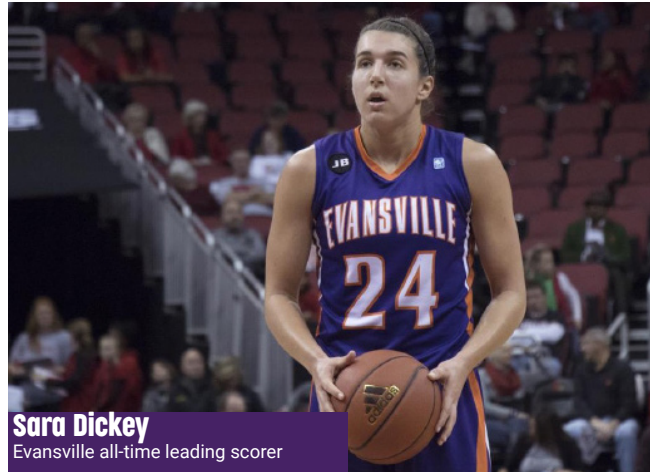
