THE GAME

Coming off a big road win at South Dakota State, No. 7 ranked Illinois State returns home for its final regular-season contest at Hancock Stadium when the Redbirds host the Missouri State Bears on Senior Day.

THE SERIES

The Redbirds and Bears will meet for the 40th time, with Illinois State holding a 21-17-1 advantage in the series that dates back to 1971. ISU has won four of the last five contests overall, but Missouri State picked up a win at home last season. Overall, the 'Birds have won the last two contests at Hancock Stadium and are 7-3 against the Bears since 2009 when Brock Spack took over the program.

THE COACHES

Illinois State: Brock Spack (Purdue, 1983) is in his 11th season as the head coach at Illinois State (81-48). Spack led the Redbirds to three-straight FCS playoff appearances from 2014-16 and guided the Redbirds to back-to-back shares of the MVFC title in 2014-15. He is the second winningest coach in ISU football history, trailing only Edwin Struck (86).

Missouri State: Dave Steckel (Kutztown, 1982) is in his 5th season as the head coach at Missouri State (13-40). Last year, the Bears registered dramatic signs of improvement, particularly on the offensive side of the football. MSU's ground attack, led by dual-threat quarterback Peyton Huslig, led the Missouri Valley Football Conference in rushing during league play throughout most of the Valley season.

HEAD COACH BROCK SPACK

When **Brock Spack** was named the 20th head coach in Illinois State football history prior to the 2009 season, it did not just mark the beginning of a new era in Redbird Football, but it also signaled the beginning of an entirely new belief system for the type of football program that Illinois State could field. Since that time, the Redbirds have posted eight .500 or better campaigns, including a 13-2 record in 2014 on way to the FCS National Championship game. Spack guided the Redbirds to three-straight playoff appearances from 2014-16 and four in the past seven seasons overall. Spack heads into his 11th season ranked second in ISU program history in wins (81) and has the best winning percentage among coaches with more than one year.

CLEAR BAG POLICY

The Illinois State Athletics Department will continue its clear bag safety policy for fans and patrons attending games at Hancock Stadium during the 2019 season. Ensuring the safety of Redbird fans and guests is a top priority for ISU Athletics, and this new policy falls in line with similar safety measures instituted all over the country in collegiate and professional athletic venues. Media members MAY STILL BRING IN BAGS, however they MUST check in at the designated GATE 5 media entrance on game day and have their bag checked and tagged.

REDBIRD SPORTS NETWORK

WJBC (AM 1230, FM 93.7), the flagship station of Illinois State athletics, will serve as the host of the Redbird Sports Network.

REQUESTING CREDENTIALS

Credentials (game and parking) can be obtained by contacting the Athletics Communications Office, Campus Box 7130, Normal, IL, 61790-7130. Requests must be received on official letterhead at least two days prior to the game. Passes that are not mailed will be available at the Will Call window at the main ticket gate on the East side of the stadium 90 minutes prior to kickoff.

PRACTICE PROCEDURES

Most practices are open to the media, but only the first 15 minutes are available to photographers/videographers. For all other media, it is recommended that an advance call be made to the athletics communications office to check on the status of practice for a particular day.

REGULAR-SEASON INTERVIEW POLICIES

- **Head Coach:** Brock Spack will do general interviews following practice Tuesday-Thursday. All other requests for interviews must be submitted to the athletics communications office at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled interview.
- **Assistant Coaches:** Arrangements should be made through the athletics communication office. Most interviews will be conducted after practice Tuesday-Thursday.
- **Players:** All interviews with players will take place at the media luncheon or after practice Tuesday and Wednesday. Media should request players at least 24 hours in advance. Players who attend the Tuesday luncheon will not be available following practice that day.
- **Postgame:** The Illinois State locker room is closed at all times. Head coach Brock Spack and requested players will be brought to the designated interview area. At home, the postgame media conference will take place on the fourth floor of the Hancock Stadium press box.

POST GAME INTERVIEW PROCEDURES

Postgame interviews following home contests are conducted in the Hancock Stadium press box (fourth floor). A golf cart is available to transport representatives from the visiting team to the interview area. TV lighting is also provided and there is wireless Internet access in the room.

After road games, representatives will be brought to a designated area. The locker room is closed at all times.

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT

- Missouri State University is located in Springfield, Missouri, and has an enrollment of 26,182 students. The Bears are members of the Missouri Valley Football Conference and play their home games at Robert W. Plaster Stadium (17,500).
- Missouri State (1-8, 1-5 MVFC) fell behind 30-0 midway through last Saturday's matchup at Southern Illinois which proved to be the difference in a 37-14 defeat at the hands of the Salukis.
- After a slow start, Bears' starting quarterback Peyton Huslig was 11-for-17 in the second half with a pair of touchdown passes to finish the game with 193 passing yards and no picks. He has completed 56.8 percent of his passes on the season and has thrown for 1,877 yards and 14 touchdowns.
- McNeece Egbim, who leads all MVFC players in tackles per game in league contests, logged his 15th career double-figure tackle game with 10 stops, including seven in the second half against SIU. He leads the Bears defense with 83 total tackles, 8.5 TFLs and one sack on the year.

LAST TIME VS. THE BEARS (9/29/18)

The Bears took a 24-14 lead with 7:56 remaining in the game, but quarterback Brady Davis got the Redbirds within a field goal goal, when he found running back James Robinson out of the backfield for a 43-yard touchdown pass, cutting the MSU advantage to 24-21 with 3:15 remaining. The Redbirds had a chance to tie the game with four seconds left, but Sam Fenlason's 32-yard field goal was blocked and the Bears came away with the victory at Plaster Stadium.

ROAD WARRIORS

If a team wants to have a chance at winning a conference championship or making the playoffs, it will have to win some tough road games. After a season-opening defeat at the hands of Northern Illinois, the Redbirds have bounced back with four-straight road wins to improve to 7-3 on the season. ISU has averaged over 24 points per contest in those games and have limited their hosts to an average of just 10.5 points per game. The last time ISU had a streak of four or more road wins in a row came in 2012, when the Redbirds started the season 6-0 on the road before suffering a loss in the quarterfinals of the FCS playoffs at Eastern Washington.

TAKING THE EARLY ADVANTAGE

Getting out to an early lead has been very beneficial for the Redbirds this season and is a big reason why the team is 7-3 on the year. Overall, the Redbirds are 6-0 on the year when scoring first in the game, and they are now 5-0 when scoring on their first possession of the contest after getting a touchdown on their first drive against South Dakota State. The 'Birds are also 5-0 when leading after the first quarter of play, and those quick starts have often resulted in scoring outputs of 20 points or more. When ISU scores 20 or more, they are now 7-0 on the season.

TURNOVERS TURN INTO POINTS

The last two wins for the Redbirds have happened because the 'Birds took advantage of turnovers and turned them into scoring opportunities. In ISU's last two wins, it has collected nine turnovers and turned those into 29 points in a pair of road victories. At Western Illinois, the Redbirds took advantage of five takeaways and scored half of their 28 points thanks to the Leathernecks blunders. Against South Dakota State, four turnovers resulted in 15 of ISU's 27 points and helped the Redbirds pick up their third-straight MVFC road victory.

PROTECTING THE NEST

Opposing teams coming to Hancock Stadium have not felt very welcome in the past 11 seasons, as Redbird teams led by Brock Spack have not been very accommodating in the win column to visitors. ISU is a combined 51-14 at home during Spack's tenure and have gone 34-8 at Hancock Stadium since the renovation of the facility in 2013.

**DRAKA GARNERS NATIONAL HONORS**

After being named the Missouri Valley Football Conference Defensive Player of the Week Sunday, Illinois State linebacker Dylan Draka picked up another accolade Monday as he was named one of the STATS FCS National Players of the Week for Week 11. The junior linebacker did it all for the Redbirds in their victory over No. 4 SDSU. He recorded five tackles, including four solo stops, and tallied three TFLs in the victory over the Jackrabbits. The Wheeling, Illinois, native was also credited with a forced fumble, a pass breakup and recovered a pair of fumbles for the Redbirds. His sack, forced fumble and fumble recovery late in the fourth quarter set up Sam Fenlason's fourth field goal make of the contest to make the score 27-18. Draka and the Redbird defense forced four turnovers on the day and limited the Jackrabbits to just 81 yards rushing and 260 yards of total offense, who came into the contest averaging 234 yards on the ground and 422 total yards per game.

BIRDS OWN THE RED ZONE

They say that games are won and lost in the Red Zone, and one look at the Redbirds' stats inside the 20 yard line will show there may be something to that. Opponents are scoring just 54.5 percent of the time when inside the Redbirds' 20 yard line, which is the No. 1 mark for a defense in all of FCS football. On the other side of the football, the Redbird offense has scored 93.5 percent of the time in the red zone, which ranks No. 3 in FCS football.

FLYING HIGH IN NATIONAL POLLS

Illinois State currently sits at No. 7 in the STATS FCS Top 25 and No. 8 in the FCS Coaches Poll following its big road win over No. 4 South Dakota State. Four MVFC teams are ranked again in the polls this week, including North Dakota State (No. 1), Northern Iowa (No. 4), Illinois State (7) and South Dakota State (8). The Redbirds have been ranked in every poll so far this season, with a high ranking of No. 6 in the FCS Coaches Poll.

REDBIRD DUO BRING HOME VALLEY FOOTBALL WEEKLY HONORS

With exceptional performances that aided No. 11 Illinois State in a road defeat of No. 4 South Dakota State, junior linebacker Dylan Draka and senior placekicker Sam Fenlason were each named Missouri Valley Football Conference Players of the Week by the league office. The MVFC Defensive Player of the Week honors are the first for Draka in his career at ISU and Fenlason was named the league's Special Teams Player of the Week for the second time this season. Draka's day was highlighted by three TFLs and two fumble recoveries, while Fenlason was 4-for-4 on field goal attempts with a career-long make of 46 yards against the Jacks.

NO FLY ZONE

Redbird cornerback Devin Taylor had a strong sophomore campaign for the Redbirds in 2018, and has certainly built upon that success in 2019. Taylor currently ranks fourth on the team with 45 tackles, including 33 solo stops, and leads the Redbirds with 11 pass breakups. With 13 passes defended, Taylor is tied for the league lead and ranks No. 18 in the FCS proving once again why he was worthy of All-MVFC honors a year ago.

SIMON SAYS

When he joined the Redbirds this summer after transferring from Iowa, Brandon Simon knew he would have an opportunity to make an immediate impact in a strong ISU defense. Mostly playing in a reserve role, Simon has racked up three sacks and 5.5 TFLs on the season from his outside linebacker position. The majority of that production has come in the past four games, with sacks in back-to-back wins at Southern Illinois and Western Illinois and TFLs in three out of the last four games, including one in his first career start against UNI.

MR. ROBINSON'S NEIGHBORHOOD

James Robinson has already cemented his legacy as one of the best running backs in school history, and his performances of late have only added to his resume. With his 98 yards rushing against South Dakota State, Robinson went over the 1,000 yard mark for the second year in a row. He also increased his career rushing total to 3,624 yards, just 78 yards short of catching Toby Davis at No. 2 with 3,702 yards, well within his reach with two games left to play in the season. The Rockford, Illinois, native also ranks No. 2 in the ISU career record books in yards per carry (5.63) and rushing touchdowns (41).

80 FOR SPACK

Brock Spack's resume as the head coach at Illinois State includes four FCS playoff appearances, a MVFC Coach of the Year honor and a FCS Championship Game appearance. Thanks to his team's win over Indiana State, Spack was able to add another accolade with his 80th career win as the head coach at Illinois State. With a career record of 81-48 (.628), Spack is the second-winningest coach in program history and is just 5 wins away from tying Edwin Struck for the career wins record at ISU.

HIMMELMAN DOES IT AGAIN

For the second time this season, Illinois State offensive lineman Drew Himmelman was named the Missouri Valley Football Conference Offensive Lineman of the Week. Steady rain and wind played havoc on the Illinois State and Indiana State game, forcing most of the offensive action to the ground. That seemed to play in the favor of the Redbirds, as the ISU rushing attack led by Drew Himmelman and the offensive line amassed 287 yards on the ground in a 24-7 victory over the Sycamores. Himmelman graded out at 92 percent and was instrumental in the success of James Robinson, who rushed for 180 yards and two scores on the ground in the adverse conditions.

HAPPY HOMECOMING

Welcoming back alumni for Homecoming each year is something every college football team looks forward to, however the Redbirds may enjoy it just a little bit more than others. Since 2009 when Brock Spack took over as head coach, the Redbirds are 9-2 in Homecoming contests. The 'Birds have won the last three in a row and are 51-41-6 overall on Homecoming dating back to 1916.

HE CAN DO IT ALL

With so much attention paid to James Robinson by opposing defenses, there has been room for other Redbird offensive players to take charge. Against Western Illinois, it was transfer running back Jeff Proctor's turn, as he was the change of pace the Redbirds needed in their defeat over the Leathernecks. Proctor led the Redbirds in rushing (81 yards) and receiving (46 yards) to account for 127 yards of total offense in the game. His one-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter capped off the scoring for the Redbirds and a career day for Proctor, who set personal bests in rushing and receiving against WIU with his first career score as a Redbird.

STATE CHAMPS

For the second-straight year, Illinois State completed a season sweep of its fellow FCS Land of Lincoln foes to take home the unofficial state title. The Redbirds picked up road wins at Eastern Illinois, Southern Illinois and Western Illinois, with the last two coming in the past two weekends. With ISU's win at Western Illinois, the team improved to 10-2 against the Leathernecks under the leadership of Brock Spack and the team has now won 9 of the last 10 games against WIU. Had it not been for a loss at NIU, the Redbirds would have had a clean sweep of state of Illinois foes.

■ OCT. 2, 1971

Billy Lewis gained 141 yards on 27 attempts and third-string quarterback **Steve Hagenbruch** scored the game-winning touchdown with 40 seconds left in the game to give ISU a 21-18 win over MSU in the first game in the series.

■ SEPT. 28, 1974

Dennis Law racked up 118 yards on the ground on Lettermen's Night, as the Redbirds shut out the Bears 28-0 at Hancock Stadium.

■ NOV. 5, 2005

Pierre Rembert rushed for a school-record 272 yards and six touchdowns to lead the Redbirds to a 48-23 road victory over the Bears at Plaster Stadium.

■ SEPT. 25, 2010

Kicker **Steven Fetzer** nailed a 39-yard field goal in double overtime to give the Redbirds a 44-41 win over the Bears. Running back **Ashton Leggett** scored four times on the ground and quarterback Matt Brown threw for 391 yards.

■ OCT. 17, 2015

Wide receiver **Anthony Warrum** exploded for seven catches, totaling a then career-best 194 yards with three touchdowns as the Redbirds were dominant throughout the day, finishing with a 38-2 victory over the Bears.
