Only 24 head coaches in NCAA Division I softball can claim to have won 1,000 games in their coaching career with at least 10 years of Division I head coaching experience. Only 13 of those coaches can claim 1,000 wins at one institution. Illinois State head coach Melinda Fischer, who enters her 37th season at the helm of the Redbird softball program during the 2021-22 academic year, can claim both honors, in addition to many others.

The all-time winningest coach in Illinois State Athletics history. Missouri Valley Conference All-Centennial Head Softball Coach. A combined nine Missouri Valley Conference and Gateway Athletic Conference regular-season championships. A 2010 NFCA Hall of Fame inductee. A 2016 ISU College of Applied Science and Technology (CAST) Hall of Fame Inductee. Had the NFCA's Distinguished Service Award named after her in 2018. All of that and more define Illinois State head softball coach Melinda Fischer.

Fischer's 1,135 career victories, spread out among 38 previous seasons as a collegiate head coach, at both Eastern Illinois (1979-80) and Illinois State (1986-present), rank her as the 19th-winningest coach in NCAA Division I softball history and the 10th-winningest active head coach. She's continued her historical rise through the career coaching ranks with her 1,000th-career win in an 8-2 victory over Northern Iowa in the MVC Tournament on May 8, 2015. In April 15, 2017, Fischer became the 20th coach in NCAA Softball history to earn 1,000 wins at one school and only the 10th Division I coach reach this mark at the time.

Since 1986, during her previous 36 seasons leading the Illinois State softball program, Fischer has directed the Redbirds to national prominence, most recently with their ninth NCAA Regional appearance in 2012. Fischer had led her teams to 11 regular-season Valley titles, the most recent coming in 2021 season. She also has two Gateway regular-season championships to her credit, as well as four Valley Tournament titles.

Fischer began her coaching career in 1974 after a four-year stint as an ISU student-athlete. She became a graduate assistant coach for ISU's softball and basketball teams while completing a master's degree in physical education. As an athlete at Illinois State, Fischer helped lead the Redbirds to the 1969 Women's College World Series, coming in as runner-up to join the ISU Atheltics Hall of Fame in 1993.

ILLINOIS STATE SOFTBALL STAFF



TINA KRAMOS - SENIOR ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

Beginning her 22nd season at Illinois State during the 2021-22 school year, senior associate head coach Tina Kramos has taken the knowledge and skills she earned while playing shortstop for Missouri State from 1990-95 and transferred that into an ability to coach the Redbird hitters and outfielders into some of the finest in The Valley. Kramos was promoted to senior associate head coach on July 24, 2017. As an assistant coach at ISU, Kramos has coached three All-Americans (Amber Smith - 2006; Kara Nelson - 2007, 2010; Abby Olson - 2010), and played a role in then-freshman Kara Nelson earning the 2007 Valley Player of the Year Award. Kramos has continued her softball career beyond coaching, as she was selected to the Greek National Team in the summer 2002. Earning multiple championships, Kramos played for the team that won the 2003 European Championship in Italy.



ELAINE HEFLIN - ASSISTANT COACH

Elaine Heflin enters her first season as an assistant coach for the Redbirds in the 2021-22 season and will primarily focus on developing pitchers and recruiting. Heflin comes to Illinois State after a two year coaching stint at University of Illinois at Chicago, her alma mater. Heflin helped coach the UIC Flames to 2021 Horizon League Tournament Champions. Under her tutelage, pitcher Marley Hanlon was named 2021 Horizon League Tournament MVP. Prior to beginning her coaching career, Heflin had a stellar four years at UIC as a pitcher. In her career at UIC, she was a three-year recipient of the Horizon League Pitcher of the Year award (2015, 2016, 2017). She also earned NFCA All-Great Lakes Region Third Team twice and NFCA All-Great Lakes Regional Second Team once. Following her outstanding senior season, posting a 2.08 ERA with 151 K in 141.1 IP, Heflin was nominated for NCAA Woman of the Year in 2017.



MARGIE WRIGHT - VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH

Margie Wright will serve as a volunteer assistant coach at home games for the Redbirds in 2022.

Wright, who was a pitcher for the Redbirds from 1971-74, returned to her alma mater from 1980-85 to lead the Redbirds, before finishing her collegiate coaching career at Fresno State (1986-12). The Hall of Fame coach directed the Bulldogs to a national title in 1998, while guiding the program to the NCAA Women's College World Series 10 times out of the program's 12 appearances. She became the NCAA's all-time winningest softball coach in 2000 and currently sits third (1,457), behind Michigan's Carol Hutchins (1,631) and Arizona's Mike Candrea (1,633).

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

OHIO UNIVERSITY



History: The Ohio Bobcats and Illinois State Redbirds will face off for the sixth time in program history, with the Redbirds' holding the advantage in the all-time series record (4-1). The last time these two teams met was on March 7, 2014 and Illinois State topped Ohio 7-3.

2021 Recap: In 2021, the Bobcats had an overall record 21-26 and were 17-21 in conference play. The Mid-American Conference disbanned its conference tournament, so the Bobcats ended up 7th in the MAC after regular-season play.

2022 Summary: The Bobcats have one weekend of games under their belt and currently sit at 1-4 overall. Their only win is over Lamar University.

UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON



History: The Flyers and the Redbirds will meet for the sixth time in program history. Illinois State holds a 3-2 advantage in the all-time series record which dates back to 2000. The Flyers and the Redbirds met twice last season, each team taking a game. The last time these two teams squared off was on March 13, 2021 with Illinois State winning the contest 1-0 in walk-off fashion on a Jayden Standish solo home run.

2021 Recap: Dayton was 21-26 overall last season and posted a 14-8 record in conference play. The Flyers participated in the Atlantic 10 tournament, winning their first two games and losing the next two, both at the hands of George Washington.

2022 Summary: The Flyers are currently 1-4 overall, earning a lone win over Sam Houston.

WESTERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY



History: The Hilltoppers and the Redbirds will play their 12th matchup in program history with the 'Birds leading 6-5 in the all-time series. These two teams last met for a pair of contests in the shortened 2020 season, Western Kentucky winning both those contests. The last matchup was on March 1, 2020 and the Hilltoppers won 12-1 in five innings. In fact, WKU has won the last four of five contests over the Redbirds, dating back to March of 2006.

2021 Recap: The Hilltoppers posted a 32-15 overall record in 2021 and were 10-6 in conference. They won the Conference USA tournament, earning a bid to an NCAA Regional. WKU beat UNC Greensboro, but lost to Georgia and Duke to end its 2021 campaign.

2022 Summary: Western Kentucky is currently 8-1 with its only loss to (RV) Texas A&M.

PITCHERS' WORST KNIGHT-MARE

True freshman **Abby Knight** put on a show at the Littlewood Classic. She was 4-for-8, blasting her first home run against No. 23/21 Arizona State to break up the Sun Devil's no-hitter. She also hit a two-run shot against Portland State in the first inning and helped propel the Redbirds to their first win of the 2022 season. Knight collected six RBI over the course of four games, making three starts as the designated player. She was named the Missouri Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week heading into the Redbirds' third week of action. Knight is currently tied for first in the conference in home runs (2) and is second in the conference in slugging percentage (.909).

GARDNER STEPPING UP

Sophomore **Reili Gardner** seems to be trending in the right direction after a start her freshman season. In 2021, Gardner collected 20 hits through 39 games and had a season average of .233. Currently, she leads the team in batting average, hitting .417, which also places her fifth in the conference. Through the first nine games, Gardner has already collected 10 hits and scored four runs, which are both tied for most on the team in their respective categories. She also ranks second on the team in RBI, collecting five already. Gardner has really stepped up as a leader on the offense and defense, making eight starts in center field with 13 putouts and no errors.

REDBIRD ROOKIES

Four freshmen made their collegiate debuts in the Redbirds' first weekend of action (Feb. 10-12) at USF, including **Delainey Bryant**, **Addison Masching**, **Bella Wilkerson and Abby Knight**. Bryant started at shortstop against USF, but didn't collect her first hit until the game against UMKC where her hard hit and speed propelled her to a triple. Masching was 2-for-6 on the weekend recording two doubles. Wilkerson was solid behind the plate and registered her first collegiate hit on a smoked single up the middle. Knight made a start at first base, and got hit by a pitch against No. 16/13 Michigan.

The Redbird rookies posted another solid weekend at the Littlewood Classic in Tempe, Ariz. Masching started all five games, including two against ranked opponents, and collected five hits including a triple, two walks, and scored four runs. Wilkerson saw action in two games and went 3-for-5 with a double and home run. Bryant was 3-for-9 with a home run, triple and four RBI.

STAFF EFFORT

Going into the 2022 season, Coach Fischer emphasized that pitching would be a "staff effort" which has proven to be true through the first nine games of the season. Illinois State has relied on juniors **Amanda Fox** and **Hannah Ross** to lead them in the circle. Neither has pitched a complete game yet, but they have combined to throw 31 K in 55.1 IP. Freshmen **Annie Volkers** and **Emma Hicks** have both made one appearance as well.

REDBIRDS PICKED TO FINISH 6TH

The Redbirds were the Missouri Valley regular season champions a season ago, posting an overall record of 31-10 and were 17-5 in conference. After losing multiple key players/starters in the offseason, Illinois State has been chosen to finish sixth in the MVC in the 2022 season.

PRESEASON ALL-MVC

Senior 2B/UT **Emme Olson** was named to the Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference team prior to the 2022 season. Last season, Olson played in and started all 41 games for the Redbirds, ending third on the team in batting average. She is a second year team captain for the Redbirds and is currently tied for the team lead in hits (10) and ranks second in batting average (.385). She is the only player on Illinois State's roster that has started and played in every game so far in 2022 (9).

MAGIC NUMBER: 1,100

Head coach **Melinda Fischer** is approaching her 1,100 win at Illinois State. She currently has 1,095 wins under her belt since taking over the Redbirds' program in 1986. Fischer needs just five wins to reach this milestone. She is the winningest head coach in Illinois State history as well as leads the conference for most overall softball wins at a Valley school (second highest is 844 by Missouri State head coach, Holly Hesse). Fischer also leads the Valley with 511 conference wins during her time with the Redbirds.

Coach Fischer earned her 1,100 career win with an 11-4 decision against Austin Peay on Feb. 28, 2020. Fischer's 1,135 career victories, spread out among 38 seasons as a collegiate head coach, at both Eastern Illinois (1979-80) and Illinois State (1986-present), rank her as the 26th-winningest coach in NCAA Division I softball history and the 11th-winningest active head coach.

FAMILY TIES

The Illinois State softball team has had several sets of sisters come through the softball program in recent years, all playing at least one season together, including sisters **Hanna and Emma Hicks** on the current roster.

The last pair to play together was **Brandi LaFountaine and Brittni LaFountaine**. Brandi is currently on the Illinois State roster while Brittni played four seasons for the Redbirds and graduated in 2021.

Senior infielder **Emme Olson** is the first to have had a sister play for Melinda Fischer and not been able to share a season playing together, as Emme is the younger sister of Redbird All-American **Abby Olson**, who played for Fischer from 2008-11.

CONFERENCE ADDITIONS

The Missouri Valley Conference will look a little bit different in 2022-23 as Belmont, Murray State and UIC have accepted invitations to join the conference. The Bruins (OVC), Racers (OVC), and Flames (Horizon) will begin competiting in the conference in the fall of 2022.

Illinois State has a connection to UIC as assistant coach **Elaine Heflin** is a UIC alumna and was an assistant coach for the Flames last season. Heflin was a three-time Horizon League Pitcher of the Year award winner in her time with the Flames. She helped coach the Flames to an NCAA Regional last season after the Flames went 29-23 overall.

The conference has not yet announced how it plans to accommodate 12 teams as opposed to 10 in terms of scheduling for the upcoming 2023 season.

DYNAMIC DUO

Only two of the Redbirds' returners, **Emme Olson and Kaili Cvhal**, can claim to have started and played in all 41 games during the 2021 season. They are also Illinois State's top two offensive returners with Chval and Olson ending the season with the second and third highest team batting averages, respectively.

Chval ended 2021 with a .336 average. She finished second on the team in batting average, runs scored (22), doubles (5) and walks (23). She also reached base safely in 15 straight games from March 5-21, 2021.

Olson averaged .318 during the 2021 season. She tied Chval for second on the team in runs scored (22), tied for the team lead in doubles (8), and hit four home runs. She was also a perfect 4-for-4 in stolen bases during the 2021 season.

FRESH FACES

Illinois State welcomes six freshmen to the Birdhouse in 2022. The class is highlighted by four utility players - adding depth both offensively and defensively. **Abby Knight** is a local player from Bloomington, Ill., who played at University High School. The other three utility assets are **Emma Hicks**, **Delainey Bryant and Addison Masching**, and all three are Illinois natives. Rounding out the incoming freshman class is LHP **Annie Volkers** from Elk River, Minn. and catcher/first-baseman **Bella Wilkerson** from Mokena, Ill.

NEVER THE SAME

The Redbirds have not had the same starting lineup for any game this season. Coach Fischer has put a different combination on the field for each of the nine games, trying to figure out the best lineup and defensive layout for the Redbirds. Illinois State lost five players listed on the 2021 overall stats - allowing for plenty of opportunity this season for new players to fill those roles.
