FRESHMAN FIRING IN THE CIRLCE

True freshman Hannah Meshnick threw a nohitter against Weber State in her first career start for the Redbirds. Illinois State won 9-0 in six innings as Meshnick went the distance and only faced the minimum (18 batters) as her two walks issued were both erased by double plays. She started again the next day against BYU and tossed 8.0 innings in a 2-1 extra-innings loss. She did not give up a run in her first 11.0 IP and only one of the two runs the Cougars scored was earned. (more in notes section on Meshnick)

ON-BASE OLSON

Fifth-year senior Emme Olson continues to lead the Redbird offense in many categories. She currently holds a reached base safely streak of 11 games (all 9 this season + last two games of 2022) and a hit streak of 7 games.

Tina Kramos was announced as the head coach of Redbird Softball on August 28, 2022, after long-time head coach Melinda Fischer announced her retirement. She enters her 23rd season at Illinois State and her first at the helm of the program.

Prior to being handed the reins of the program, Kramos had been promoted to her previous title of senior associate head coach on July 24, 2017, entering her 17th season with Illinois State.

As an assistant coach at ISU, Kramos has coached three All-Americans (Amber Smith - 2006; Kara Nelson - 2007, 2010; Abby Olson - 2010), and played a large role in then-freshman Kara Nelson earning the 2007 Valley Player of the Year Award, the first time in conference history that a freshman had that award bestowed upon her. Nelson went on to claim a second MVC Player of the Year honor in 2011 under Kramos' guidance, while catchers Elizabeth Kay won the award in 2013 and Jordan de los Reyes won the award in 2017.

Kramos has also mentored 10 NFCA All-Region selections since 2017, one of them this past season when Emme Olson earned First Team All-Region honors. During the 2022 season, Olson and junior Dayna Kennedy thrived at the plate under Kramos' tutelage. Olson earned a spot in the Redbird record book with 16 single-season doubles, which is fifth in program history, and Kennedy hit a team leading 12 home runs, the most by a Redbird since de los Reyes hit 19 in 2017.

In her 22 previous seasons as a Redbird, Kramos has been part of seven regular season MVC Championships, two MVC Tournament Titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances, and ISU's lone National Invitational Softball Championship appearance.

Before arriving at Illinois State, Kramos coached softball from 1995-97 at Colorado-Colorado Springs before she spent three years on the coaching staff at Nicholls State.

Prior to her coaching career, Kramos was a member of the Missouri State softball team from 1990-95 and was a two-time All-Valley First-Team selection. Kramos has continued her softball career beyond coaching, as she was selected to the Greek National Team in the summer of 2002. Earning multiple championships, Kramos played for the team that won the 2003 European Championship in Italy, while the Greek National Team took second-place honors in 2005 at the European Championships in Prague. She played with the Greek Olympic softball team in the 2004 Athens Olympic Games and the 2006 Women's Softball World Championships.

In 2015, she was selected as the head coach for the Greek National Team that competed at the European Championships in Rosemalen, Netherlands. Kramos also played for the East Peoria Avanti's (1995) and Michigan Cruise (1996-2000), with both teams part of the ASA Women's Majors.

ASSISTANT COACH - ELAINE HEFLIN (2ND SEASON)



Elaine Heflin enters her second season as an assistant coach for the Redbirds in the 2022-23 season with her duties focused on pitching and recruiting. In her first season as an assistant/pitching coach for ISU, Heflin developed two inexperienced arms in juniors Hannah Ross and Amanda Fox. Ross went on to pitch a perfect game against UT Martin (3/10/22) while Fox led the team in strikeouts and earned All-MVC Second Team honors.

Heflin came to Illinois State after a two year coaching stint at University of Illinois at Chicago, her alma mater. Heflin helped coach the UIC Flames to 2021 Horizon League Tournament Champions. Prior to beginning her coaching career, Heflin had a stellar four years at UIC as a pitcher and was a three-year recipient of the Horizon League Pitcher of the Year award. Heflin was also nominated for NCAA Woman of the Year in 2017.

The Downers Grove, III. native graduated from UIC with a degree in Criminal Justice and continued her education at the University of Arkansas. Heflin was a graduate assistant for the softball team as well as the Center for Community Engagement as she worked towards her master's degree in Public Administration.

ASSISTANT COACH - HAILEY COLE (1ST SEASON AS AC | 2ND SEASON AT ISU)



Hailey Cole enters her first season as an assistant coach for the Redbirds in the 2022-23 season and will primarily be working with the Illinois State hitters. Cole joined Illinois State Athletics in June 2021 as a graduate assistant for the softball team and was promoted to assistant coach in September 2022.

Previously, she attended University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and had a four-year softball career with the Tar Heels. Cole earned her bachelor's degree in Communication Studies with a minor in Education and is currently working towards her master's in Sport Management at Illinois State University. Prior to ISU, Cole worked as a private softball instructor and for the Ashley Burkhardt Training, LLC.

She is originally from Welcome, North Carolina and currently resides in Normal, Ill.

GRADUATE MANAGER - APRYL SMITH (2ND SEASON)



Apryl Smith enters her second season as a graduate manager for Illinois State in the 2022-23 season.

Smith previously attended Indiana University in Bloomington, Ind., where she was student manager for the softball team and was part of the Student Athletic Board, participating in both activities for all four years at IU. Smith became a director for SAB her final two years.

Smith, a native of Fort Wayne, Ind., spent four summers working in food and beverage for the Fort Wayne TinCaps, a minor league affiliate of the San Diego Padres, during her undergraduate years.

She is currently working towards her master's in Sport Management at Illinois State University and is expected to graduate in May 2023.

ATHLETIC TRAINER - OLIVIA YORK (1ST SEASON)



Olivia York enters her first years as an Assistant Athletic Trainer at Illinois State, specifically working with the softball team.

Prior to Illinois State, York was a graduate assistant athletic trainer for Bowling Green State University, working with the women's volleyball and softball teams, but also assisted with other athletic programs such as football, baseball, men's & women's soccer, and cross country. While at BGSU, she earned a Masters of Education in Sport Administration.

York, a native of Damariscotta, Maine, received her undergraduate degree in Athletic Training from the University of New Hampshire while also working as an athletic training student assistant for UNH and Exeter High School.

PLAYERS TO WATCH

EMME OLSON

Olson, a 2023 Preseason All-MVC selection, has been off to a hot start so far in 2023. She has reached base safely in all nine contests plus her final two games of the 2022 season to have a reached base safely streak of 11 games. Her hit streak stands at seven games and she currently leads the 'Birds in a number of offensive categories.

HANNAH ROSS

Ross has been a steady starter in the circle for the Redbirds to begin the 2023 season. She has started in all five of her appearances and has only give up four walks over 28.0 innings pitched. Ross is currently at 15 strikeouts, averaging three per game. She seems to be the go-to arm to start games early in the season.

HANNAH MESHNICK

Meshnick, a true freshman, has made two starts and has appeared in relief four times for the Redbirds. Between her two starts, Meshnick has tossed 14.0 innings and only gave up two runs, one earned. Her first career start against Weber State was a no-hitter bid that including three strikeouts. Her career-high four strikeouts came against BYU in her second career start. Meshnick seems to be emerging as another true starter in the circle for the Redbirds.

DELAINEY BRYANT

Bryant is currently second on the team in batting average (.318) and has started all nine games at shortstop. She has a pair of extra base hits (double, HR) and is leading the team in walks with seven. Bryant is also tied with Abby Knight for the team lead in runs scored at five. Bryant had a breakout weekend at the Littlewood Classic that included a home run against No. 22/RV Arizona State, her first of the season. Hopefully Bryant will be able to take that momentum into next weekend at the Hilltopper Spring Fling.

ABBY KNIGHT

Knight has played multiple roles for the Redbirds to start the 2023 season. She has been a consistent first baseman, but has also seen action in the designated player role. Offensively, she has been Illinois State leadoff hitter for the past four games. She has reached base safely three of four times to start games. Her consistency to reach base safely at the top of the lineup has provided Illinois State with the opportunity to score first and take an early lead against opponents.

CHLOE JEFFERSON

Jefferson has also seen time at both first place and in the designated player role. She hit her first career home run and is currently on a four-game hit streak. Hopefully she is able to continue her success in Bowling Green, Ky.

GAME NOTES

NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK HONORS

True freshman Hannah Meshnick was named the Missouri Valley Conference's Newcomer of the Week on Feb. 21 for her performance at the Littlewood Classic in Arizona. Despite a rough outing against No. 22/RV Arizona State, Meshnick had a solid weekend for the Redbirds. She made four appearances with two starts in the circle. Her two starts were both complete game efforts, the first being a no-hitter against Weber State. In her second start, she tossed 8.0 complete innings against BYU in an extra-innings loss.

FRESHMAN FIRING IN THE CIRCLE

True freshman Hannah Meshnick threw a no-hitter against Weber State in her first career start for the Redbirds. Illinois State won 9-0 in six innings as Meshnick went the distance and only faced the minimum (18 batters) as her two walks issued were both erased by double plays. She started again the next day against BYU and tossed 8.0 innings in a 2-1 extra-innings loss. She did not give up a run in her first 11.0 IP and only one of the two runs the Cougars scored was earned. Through her first 18.0 IP, Meshnick only allowed two runs (only one earned), five hits (only one XBH), and collected nine strikeouts.

ON-BASE OLSON

Fifth-year senior Emme Olson continues to lead the Redbird offense in many categories. She currently holds a reached base safely streak of 11 games. She has reached base safely in all nine contests in 2023, but her streak dates back to the final two games of the 2022 season. Olson also holds a hit streak of seven games that includes two doubles that have moved her up to third in program history in career doubles (42) - see below.

TOUGH COMPETITION

Illinois State's weekend at the Littlewood Classic will feature some tough competition. Four of the five teams the Redbirds will face made an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2022, and the one that did not was BYU - a 40-win team last season. Oregon State and Arizona State are both receiving votes in the top 25 national polls. Oregon State will also be the second team the Redbirds face that made it to the Women's College World Series in 2022, the other being Florida. It will be a challenging weekend for Illinois State at the Littlewood Classic.

THE FIRST OF MANY

First-year head coach Tina Kramos picked up her first career win as a head coach against St. Joseph's in an 8-3 victory for the Redbirds on Friday, Feb. 10, 2023. Former head coach Melinda Fischer was in attendance and was able to present Kramos with a game ball from that win.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

Fifth-year senior Emme Olson was recognized prior to the start of the 2023 season by *Extra Inning Softball* as the 11th best second baseman in the nation.

PRESEASON PREDICITIONS

Illinois State was picked to finish fifth in the new 12-team field in the Missouri Valley Conference. UNI was selected as the preseason favorite, followed by Murray State, Southern Illinois, Missouri State and then the Redbirds. ISU finished sixth in 2022, but returns eight starters and a ton of experience to the 2023 squad giving them a chance to compete in a talented conference.

NEW ERA IN REDBIRD SOFTBALL

After 37 years at the helm of Illinois State Softball, legendary head coach Melinda Fischer announced her retirement in the fall of 2022, launching Redbird Softball into a new era in 2023 led by head coach Tina Kramos. This is Kramos' first season as a head coach and her 23rd at Illinois State. She retains second year assistant coach, Elaine Heflin, who leads the Redbird pitching staff as well as assists with recruiting. Hailey Cole enters her first season as an assistant coach mainly working with hitters. Cole was a graduate assistant with ISU in 2022.

EXPERIENCE IS KEY

Illinois State returns eight starters from the 2022 roster, which is very different as compared to a season ago, the Redbirds relying on many young players to start the 2022 season. Delainey Bryant and Abby Knight assumed starting roles in ISU's infield as freshmen in 2022, both ending the season with 100+ at-bats and played in nearly every game. Returning pitchers Amanda Fox and Hannah Ross pitched a combined 313 innings of the team's 333 in 2022 which should yield an increased composure in the circle for the seniors. The Redbirds 2023 roster lists seven seniors, including fifth-year Emme Olson who led the team in multiple offensive categories in 2022.

IN THE RANKINGS

The last time Illinois State beat a ranked opponent was on March 2, 2019 at the Purple and Gold Challenge in Baton Rouge, La. hosted by LSU. Illinois State defeated No. 16/15 Indiana in a 3-0 decision highlighted by former Redbird pitcher Morgan Day throwing a complete game, only giving up three hits and striking out seven.

The 2023 schedule features four teams who are receiving votes in the current national polls: Florida (#3/#3), Arizona State (RV/RV) and BYU (RV/RV). Rankings are based on two national polls. Listed first is the ranking from *USA Today*/NFCA Division I Coaches Poll and the second ranking is from ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25.

COMPETITIVE SCHEDULE

The Redbirds will play nine teams that made an NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022, and two that made it all the way to the Women's College World Series. The nine teams include: Grand Canyon, Arizona State, Weber State, Florida, Oregon State, Murray State, Illinois, Missouri State and South Florida. Arizona State, Florida and Oregon State advanced to Super Regionals while Florida and Oregon State went on to the WCWS.

Illinois State's 2023 schedule features four brand new opponents. The Redbirds will face Saint Joseph's, Weber State, Grand Canyon, and Penn for the first time in program history.

HANNA(H) GALORE

The Redbirds' 2023 roster features five players with the name "Hannah", four of them spell it the same way and two have the same last initial. Hannah Ross, Hannah Meeks and Hannah Meshnick are all pitchers while Hanna Hicks is a utility player and Hannah Tomlianovich is a first baseman.

NEW THREADS

Illinois State Softball will wear three new uniform combinations during the 2023 season. The Redbirds have a new classic red jersey that features a script font that reads "Redbirds" across the chest. This jersey can be paired with regular white pants or new white/red pinstripe pants. The Redbirds will also wear a full pinstripe uniform that is white with red pinstripes and has "Illinois State" written across the chest in a script font.

SMARTY 'BIRDS

Illinois State Softball earned the second highest cumulative team grade point average among NCAA Division I softball programs for the 2021-22 academic year as announced by the National Fastpitch Coaches Association and Easton Fastpitch. The team finished the year with a 3.716 GPA, second only to Harvard who had a team GPA of 3.76.

2023 CAPTAINS

Senior outfielder Kaili Chval and junior third baseman Jayden Standish have been selected as Illinois State Softball's 2023 captains. Chval is a second-year captain while Standish assumes the role for the first time. Both were chosen for their leadership on field, in the classroom and in their communities.

FRESH FACES

Five freshmen have been added to the Birdhouse this season. Left-handed pitcher Hannah Meeks and right-handed pitcher Hannah Meshnick look to provide depth in the circle while first baseman Hannah Tomlianovich, utility player Abby Horton and catcher Bailah Bognar round out the 2023 freshman class.
