QUICK KICKS

• The Redbirds are coming off their first loss of the season, falling to Loyola Chicago 2-0 on Sunday.

• Last Thursday, the Redbirds earned a 1-1 draw with Northwestern of the Big Ten.

• The draw with the Wildcats marks the Redbirds' first tie or win against a Power Four opponent since a 1-0 shutout over Pittsburgh on Sep. 3, 2017.

• The Redbirds started the season unbeaten through four games for the first time since 2012.

• With Madi Valenti's four saves in goal against UT Martin, she moved into fifth place in program history with 176 career saves.

• Rylann Law is the first Redbird to score in consecutive games to start the season since Riley O'Brien scored in the first three games in 2021.

• Illinois State returns 22 players from the 2025 roster. Among the 22 returning Redbirds, seven logged over 1000 minutes across the 22 games played a year ago.

SERIES BREAKDOWN

• Sunday's match will be the Redbirds' ninth all-time meeting with the Billikens.

• Saint Louis holds a 4-2-2 advantage in the series and has won three of the last four against ISU.

• The Redbirds' last victory against the Billikens came in a 4-1 win at home on Sep. 17, 2013.

• Saint Louis has a 3-1-1 record this season with wins over Lindenwood, Missouri and Indiana.

• 38.2% of the Redbirds' 55 shot attempts this season have been on goal, compared to 56.3% of the Billikens 55 total shot attempts.

• The Billikens have made the NCAA Tournament in seven of the last eight years, along with being both A-10 Tournament and regular season champions in six of the last eight seasons.

GARY'S FORMER SQUAD

Illinois State senior defender Jordan Gary will reunite with her former team on Thursday when the Redbirds host Saint Louis. After spending her first three collegiate seasons with the Billikens, Gary entered the transfer portal and found home in Bloomington-Normal. Gary played in 61 total games at SLU while starting five matches last season and helping the Billikens register a 0.90 GAA and 11 shutouts.

POINT AGAINST A POWER OPPONENT

Illinois State's 1-1 draw with Northwestern marks the Redbirds' first tie or win against a Power Four opponent since a 1-0 shutout over Pittsburgh on Sep. 3, 2017. It is the first tie or win against a Big Ten foe since the Redbirds shutout Illinois 1-0 on Aug. 27, 2017.

UNBEATEN THROUGH FOUR

With Illinois State's 1-1 draw with Northwestern last Thursday, the Redbirds improved to 2-0-2, starting a season unbeaten through four games for the first time since 2012.

ROWANN'S FIRST AS A REDBIRD

The Wildcats opened the scoring in the 39th minute on Thursday, but Illinois State continued to battle and found its equalizer in the 73rd minute. Ava Watson sent a ball in from near the sideline to Eve Gricius, who played it to sophomore transfer Rowann Law. Law finished with her left foot into the bottom center of the net to tie the game and record her first goal as a Redbird.

- She now has two goals in her career, scoring one last season as a freshman for Missouri State, which also came against a Big Ten opponent in Nebraska.

GRACE'S FIRST GOAL

Sophomore defender Grace Petrie tallied her first career goal against UT Martin.

- Petrie opened the scoring in the 24th minute, heading home a corner kick from Eve Gricius at the far post to give Illinois State an early 1-0 advantage.

TWO GAMES, TWO GOALS FOR RYLANN

Through the first two games, Rylann Law scored two goals, already half as many goals as she had in all 22 contests last season.

- The sophomore is the only MVC player to score in the first two games of their team's season this year and the first in the conference to score in back-to-back matches.
- She is the first Redbird to score in consecutive games to start the season

since Riley O'Brien scored in the first three games in 2021.

RALLYING FROM BEHIND

Illinois State fell behind early in the season opener, as Northern Illinois scored in the 18th minute and carried that 1-0 advantage into halftime. The Redbirds, however, regrouped and answered in the second half. Sophomore forward Rylann Law scored the equalizer in the 63rd minute off an assist from senior transfer Mikayla Carkhuff. Just four minutes later, junior forward Eve Gricius delivered the go-ahead goal, heading a pass from sophomore Grace Petrie to put Illinois State ahead 2-1.

APPLYING PRESSURE

The Redbirds dominated possession and pressed hard in the attacking third against Northern Illinois, tallying 10 corner kicks and allowing the Huskies to get just seven shots off. Ten corner kicks is the most in a game for the Redbirds since Sep. 8, 2024, against Western Illinois.

TEJADA JERSEY RETIREMENT

Illinois State soccer legend Rachel Tejada will have her No. 14 jersey retired on Oct. 4 when the Redbirds host UNI, alongside ISU's annual Julie Heidecke/Alumni celebration.

- Tejada's No. 14 will be the second number in Illinois State soccer history to be retired, alongside the twelfth Redbird on the field, Heidecke's No. 13.
- The four-year letterwinner for the Redbirds is the only player in Missouri Valley Conference history to be named Conference Player of the Year four times.
- In her Redbird career, Tejada helped

Illinois State earn three MVC regular-season championships and secure four straight MVC tournament titles.

- Tejada still holds the Redbird and MVC career records for goals (74), assists (42) and points (190).

SUPER MADI

Goalkeeper Madi Valenti posted a standout season in 2025, becoming the first Redbird to earn MVC Goalkeeper of the Year since 2013. Along the way, she etched her name into the Illinois State and MVC record books.

- Valenti recorded 12 shutouts last season, which is the most in MVC and Illinois State history.
- Valenti recorded the seventh-best save percentage in a season in program history with a .853 mark.
- Valenti tallied 86 saves, a career-best and seventh most in a season by a Redbird. She is just the third goalkeeper in school history with two or more seasons with at least 80 saves. The Redbirds' 87 total saves last season tied for the 10th most in a season in school history.
- Valenti logged 1958 minutes in 2025, which is the most played by a goalie in a season in program history.

CHAMPIONSHIP RUN

Last season, as the No. 4 seed, the Redbirds made a run to their first MVC Tournament Title game since 2019 and hosted the championship game for the first time since 2016, ultimately falling to No. 6 seed UIC on penalties.

- ISU downed Southern Illinois 2-1 in the opening round before upsetting top-seeded Drake 1-0 on penalties in the semifinals.

BIRDS WITH EXPERIENCE

- Illinois State returns 22 players from the 2025 roster. Among the 22 returning Redbirds, seven logged over 1000 minutes across the 22 games played a year ago.
- Four players tallied at least 1900 minutes played last season, which is the most players in a season with at least 1900 minutes played since 2016.
- Sammi Cenek, Madi Valenti and Ava Watson lead the team in playing time, each with over 3,000 career minutes played in a Redbird uniform.

THE NEWEST REDBIRDS

- In the offseason, third year head coach Raleigh DeRose made six additions

to the Redbird roster, including two freshman and four transfers.

- For the third consecutive year, DeRose has made at least three additions through the transfer portal, adding seniors Jordan Gary (Saint Louis) and Mikayla Carkhuff (North Dakota State) and sophomores Rowann Law (Missouri State) and Sosi Dadekian (Illinois), ahead of the 2026 season.
- Rowann Law is the twin sister of current Redbird Rylann Law.
- Both freshmen – Bailey Leach and Brooklyn Luwdwig – hail from Illinois. Leach is the career goal holder at Pleasant Plains High School.

REPRESENTING THE PRAIRIE STATE

- The Redbirds will have nine Illinois natives represent the Prairie State in 2026.
- Nine marks the highest total of Illinois natives on the roster since 2021 (11).

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

After making a run to the Missouri Valley Conference title game in 2025, Illinois State is rated second in the conference preseason poll, recieving two first-place votes.

- Grace Petrie, a 2025 All-Freshman team selection, and Madi Valenti, the conference's reigning Goalkeeper of the Year, both made the preseason All-MVC team.
- Valenti was also named to the United Soccer Coaches NCAA Division I Women's Players to Watch List.
- This comes after being named to the USC NCAA Division I Women's All-Midwest Region Third Team in 2025.

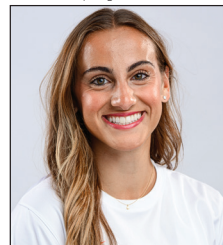

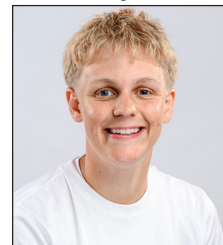
