RHODE ISLAND VS. TULSA - SERIES NOTES

- Saturday night's game is the third meeting all time between Rhode Island and Tulsa, with the Golden Hurricanes winning each of the first two meetings.
- The last meeting was exactly 21 years ago, when Tulsa won 89-80 on Nov. 20, 2000.
- A year earlier, the Golden Hurricanes defeated the Rams 91-66 on Nov. 21, 1999 at the Providence Civic Center.
- Rhode Island enters the game on a three-game winning streak, while Tulsa is fresh of a 64-58 win over Oregon State.
- The winner of Saturday's game will advance to the championship game of the Sunshine Slam and play the winner of the Boston College-Utah game.
- The losers of both games will play in the consolation game Sunday.
- In its first game of the Sunshine Slam, Rhode Island defeated Bryant, 83-64, on Nov. 12 at home.
- The Rams are coming off a 57-49 victory over Boston College on Wednesday night, though that contest was not part of the Sunshine Slam, which is being produced by the Gazelle Group of Princeton, N.J.
- A sports marketing firm specializing in event production and management, client representation and sponsorship consulting, the Gazelle Group produces numerous nationally-recognized events, such as the Empire Classic benefiting Wounded Warrior Project, the Legends Classic presented by Old Trapper, the Gotham Classic, the Holiday Face-Off, and the College Basketball Invitational.

MAKHEL MITCHELL SECOND IN THE NATION IN BLOCKED SHOTS

- Through Nov. 17, center **Makhel Mitchell** ranked second in the country in both total blocked shots (15) and blocked shots per game (5.0). Only San Diego's **Terrell Brown** (19) had more blocks through Wednesday, and only Florida's **Colin Castleton** (6.0) was averaging more per game.
- In Wednesday's win over Boston College, Mitchell had a career-high eight blocks, the most by any URI player since **Hassan Martin** set the program's single-game record of 10 against La Salle on Jan. 19, 2015
- Mitchell has 13 blocks over his last two games, and he has had at least two in each game so far.
- Last season, Mitchell was fourth in the Atlantic 10 and 48th in the country with 42 blocked shots
- His 1.68 blocked shots per game was fourth in the Atlantic 10 and 51st nationally.
- Rhode Island has had 10 or more blocks in all three games to start the season.
- The 13 against Boston College were the most blocks in a single game for URI since Feb. 16, 2019, when it matched the program record with 15 against Fordham.
- The Rams are second nationally as a team with 11.7 blocks per game, behind only Memphis (12.7).
- Forwards **Makhi Mitchell** and **Antwan Walker** both have five blocked shots through the first three games, while guard **Malik Martin** has three.
- Already nine different Rhode Island players have at least one blocked shot this season.

DEFENSE LIMITING SCORING CHANCES FOR OPPOSITION

- Head coach **David Cox** has stressed that defense will be a calling card for the Rams, and the first three games have been indicative of such.
- Rhode Island ranks second in the nation in opposing field goal percentage, limiting teams to 28.9 percent from the floor overall and 28.2 percent from the arc.
- Teams are scoring just 58.3 points per game against Rhode Island.
- URI has held its opponents to 27 points or less in four of the six halves it has played this season.
- Through three games, the Rams have forced 15.33 turnovers per game and have blocked 11.7 shots per game.

DISCIPLINED APPROACH LEADS TO EFFICIENT OFFENSE

- On the other end of the floor, Rhode Island is shooting 48.0 percent from the field.
- The Rams have recorded assists on 56.3 percent of its field goals (40-of-71), an indication of solid ball movement.
- In Wednesday's win over Boston College, the team recorded 16 assists on 19 field goals.
- The Rams have shot 50.0 percent or better in four of its six halves of play thus far.
- While the Rams are not attempting many 3-point shots (11.7 per game), Rhode Island is taking quality shots from the arc.
- Rhody is shooting 37.1 percent (13-for-35) from long range.
- Last season, Rhode Island averaged 18.3 3-point attempts per game and made just 31.2 percent.

RHODE ISLAND TURNS INTO ROAD ISLAND

- With three games already under its belt, URI is in the midst of a stretch in which it has six games in a 15-day span.
- Saturday begins a run for Rhode Island that features five of six games being played away from the Ryan Center.
- URI plays two games in the Sunshine Slam on Nov. 20-21, playing Tulsa and then either Boston College again or Utah.
- Rhode Island travels to Florida Gulf Coast on Nov. 23.
- After a home game against Georgia State on Saturday, Nov. 27, the Rams play back-to-back road games against Harvard (Dec. 1) and Providence (Dec. 4).

BACKCOURT DELIVERING AT THE FREE THROW LINE

- Graduate student guards **Jeremy Sheppard** and **Ishmael El-Amin** have been perfect at the free throw line.
- The duo is a combined 21-for-21 at the stripe, with El-Amin going 11-for-11 and Sheppard hitting all 10 of his attempts.
- Sophomore guard **Ishmael Leggett** - the third starter in the backcourt - is 12-of-17 at the line (70.6 percent).
- Three of his misses came in Wednesday's win over BC.
- The three primary ball handlers in the starting lineup have combined for 21 assists and just 10 turnovers.

THOMAS CONTRIBUTING KEY MINUTES OFF THE BENCH

- Freshman guard **Sebastian Thomas** was initially expected to redshirt this year, but he is now the team's backup point guard.
- He has earned the trust of the coaching staff and his teammates, committing zero turnovers in 35 minutes of playing time.
- The Providence native is averaging 3.0 points, 1.0 rebound and has a 2.0 assist/turnover ratio in 11.6 minutes per game.

COX OFF TO BEST START AS A HEAD COACH

- Rhode Island head coach **David Cox** has started a season 3-0 for the first time in his career.
- Wednesday's win over Boston College improved his overall record at Rhode Island to 52-39.
- Cox won more games in his first three seasons than any previous Rhode Island head coach.
- He is the third-fastest URI head coach to 50 wins.
- The fastest to 50 for Rhode Island was **Bob "Red" Haire**, who reached the mark in 83 games from 1948-51. Haire reached 50 in his fourth year.
- Basketball Hall of Famer **Frank Keaney** reached 50 victories in his 86th game with the Rams, posting a record of 50-36 in that span.
- Among his 52 wins, Cox has defeated 36 different programs, including five wins against Atlantic 10 rival VCU (5-2) and four wins in as many games against both La Salle and Saint Joseph's.
- The Rams are looking to start 4-0 for the first time since the open of the 2016-17 season.
- That season, Rhode Island won the Atlantic 10 Championship tournament and reached the second round of the NCAA Championship.

MAKHI MITCHELL GIVING RAMS CONSISTENT SCORING IN THE PAINT

- Sophomore forward **Makhi Mitchell** has scored in double figures in each of the first three games this year, averaging 11.3 points and 10.3 rebounds per game.
- Last time out against Boston College, he was 4-for-4 from the floor, including his first career 3-point shot.
- Mitchell also is proven to be an adept passer from the post. He has seven assists on the season, recording at least two in every game thus far.
- Mitchell was limited to just seven games last season due to a knee injury suffered at Western Kentucky.
- At the time of the injury, he was averaging 5.9 points and 4.9 rebounds per game.

BOZEMAN ADDS VETERAN PRESENCE TO STAFF

- Rhode Island head coach **David Cox** added veteran coach and URI alumnus **Todd Bozeman** to his staff in May.
- Bozeman, who played for Rhode Island from 1982-86, has more than 20 years as a Division I coach to his credit, including 16 seasons as a head coach.
- His teams have been to five NCAA Championship tournaments, including one Sweet 16 appearance.
- Most recently, Bozeman was the head coach at Morgan State for 13 seasons from 2006-19.
- He is Morgan State's all-time leader in wins with 195.
- He led the Bears to their only two NCAA Championship appearances and was a three-time MEAC Coach of the Year, winning three regular-season and two tournament titles.
- In 2009, he was the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year as the nation's top mid-major head coach.
- Bozeman also spent six seasons as the head coach at Cal, leading the Golden Bears to three NCAA Championship appearances, including a Sweet 16 run in 1993.
- At the time, he was youngest coach ever to reach the Sweet 16, doing so when he was 29 years old.
- At Cal, he coached **Jason Kidd** and he was 63-35 overall and 37-26 in the PAC-10.
- In between his two head coaching stints, Bozeman spent four years as a scout in the NBA, working for both the Vancouver Grizzlies and Toronto Raptors.

CAREY STRONG IN RETURN TO RAMS

- After missing one game with a foot injury, guard **Jalen Carey** gave Rhode Island strong minutes off the bench Wednesday against Boston College.
- He scored eight points on 3-for-3 shooting from the floor and made both of his free throw attempts.
- So far this season, Carey is scoring 7.0 points per game while shooting 83.3 percent from the field.
- He also is perfect at the free throw line (4-for-4) and is grabbing 3.5 rebounds per contest.

MARTIN SHOWING VERSATILITY IN HIS GAME

- Guard **Malik Martin** has been a classic glue player off the bench for Rhode Island.
- Despite not starting, Martin is averaging 23.7 minutes per game on the wing, averaging 7.0 points and 4.3 rebounds per game.
- He has three blocked shots and three steals while playing both guard and forward at various times.
- His next steal will be the 100th of his career.

SHEPPARD, MAKHEL MITCHELL EARN PRESEASON NODS

- Guard **Jeremy Sheppard** and center **Makhel Mitchell** both earned spots on the 2021-22 Atlantic 10 Men's Basketball Preseason Team.
- Sheppard earned third-team honors after averaging 11.3 points, 2.8 assists and 1.2 steals per game in 2020-21.
- A starter in all 24 games he played, he gave the Rams 30.4 minutes per game.
- Sheppard shot 39.4 percent from the 3-point arc, making 37-of-94 from long range. He also hit 76.7 percent from the free throw line.
- Mitchell was one of five named to the all-defensive team.
- On defense, he averaged 1.7 blocked shots and 4.0 rebounds per game.
- He ranked fourth in the league and 51st nationally in blocked shots per contest.
- Mitchell scored 9.6 points and grabbed 5.6 boards, giving the Rams an impact presence on both ends of the floor.

LEGGETT MATCHES CAREER HIGH IN SCORING

- Guard **Ishmael Leggett** picked up where he left off at the end of the 2020-21 season.
- With 18 points in the season opener against Boston University, Leggett matched his career high for points.
- He also had 18 against Dayton on Feb. 18 of last season.
- Leggett - who still has four seasons of eligibility since last season did not count as one - started eight of the team's final 10 games last season, scoring in double figures five times during the stretch.
- In his first 15 career games, he reached double figures twice, scoring 11 in back-to-back games against San Francisco and Seton Hall.

EL-AMIN JOINS RAMS FOR 2021-22 SEASON

- A four-year player at Ball State, transfer **Ishmael El-Amin** gives Rhode Island a 1,000-point scorer who has averaged 10.4 points per game over 106 career contests.
- In 2020-21, he averaged 16.2 points per game while earning All-MAC honors for the second straight season.
- El-Amin earned second-team All-Mac honors in 2020-21 after being a third-team selection the year before.

RYAN CENTER IS HOME SWEET HOME

- Rhode Island has won more than 80 percent of its games at the Ryan Center over the last six seasons.
- URI is 85-21 at home (.802 winning percentage) over the last six years.
- Last season, URI was 6-3 when playing in Kingston.
- The Rams have won 203 games in the Ryan Center, going 203-90 overall since the facility opened before the 2002-03 season.
- Four times since 2014-15, the Rams have won at least 12 games at the Ryan Center.
- Last season, the team was limited to nine home games due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- This year's slate includes 15 regular-season home games.
- In the first 12 seasons at the Ryan Center, Rhode Island had 12 wins four times.

David Cox was named the 20th head coach in Rhode Island men's basketball history on April 4, 2018.

Now in his fourth season, Cox is 52-39 giving him a .571 winning percentage. In 2019-20, Cox was one of 20 coaches included on HereSports.com's list of candidates for National Coach of the Year. With a record of 13-5 in league play, Cox tied for the third-most conference wins in a season in Rhode Island history. Junior Fatts Russell earned Atlantic 10 First Team All-Conference and All-Defensive Team honors, while senior Jeff Dowtin was a third team selection. Dowtin also earned Academic All-Conference honors for the third straight season.

Despite inheriting a team that had lost six seniors who went on to play professional basketball, Cox led Rhode Island to an 18-15 record, including a 9-9 mark in Atlantic 10 action. He was named as one of 12 national finalists for the 2019 Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I. The Rams advanced to the A-10 semifinals, upsetting top-seeded VCU in the quarterfinals. Junior forward Cyril Langevine earned Second Team All-Conference honors and a spot on the league's All-Defensive Team. Junior Jeff Dowtin was named to the Academic All-Conference Team.

Cox was named as head coach after four seasons as an assistant coach on Dan Hurley's staff with URI. The final two of those seasons were spent as the team's associate head coach. Cox joined the Rhody staff in May, 2014 after spending the previous four seasons as an associate head coach at Rutgers.

Since Cox came to URI in May of 2014, the Rams have made two NCAA Championship appearances and one NIT appearance, advancing to the second round all three times. Rhode Island also claimed the program's first Atlantic 10 regular season title in 2018 and its second conference tournament title in 2017.

In November of 2017, Cox was ranked as the No. 23 assistant coach in the country by LockDraft.com. Over his first three seasons with the Rams, the team had gone 65-35 with a pair of postseason appearances. In 2016-17, Rhode Island made its first NCAA Championship appearance since 1999, upsetting Creighton in the opening round before falling just short against eventual Final Four participant Oregon in the second round. In Cox' first season in Rhode Island, the Rams went to the 2015 NIT and made it to the second round.

During his time at URI, Cox has been instrumental in the recruitment of Indiana transfer Stanford Robinson, Jeff Dowtin, Michael Tertsea and Fatts Russell. He was the primary recruiter for two members of the 2018 class - Jermaine Harris and Tyrese Martin. That class was ranked as a top 25 class nationally.

While at Rutgers, Cox was the Scarlet Knights' associate head coach, helping the program recruit the 15th-best class in 2011. He served as the interim head coach for a three-game stint in December 2012, guiding RU to a 3-0 record.

From 2007-10, Cox served as an assistant at Georgetown, helping to guide the Hoyas to a trio of post-season appearances. In 2007-08, Georgetown compiled a 28-6 overall record en route to winning the Big East Championship and earning a #1 seed in the NCAA Tournament. The 2009-10 Hoya squad also won 28 games and en route to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Cox entered the college ranks as the director of basketball operations at Pittsburgh for the 2006-07 season and was part of the Panthers' staff that went 29-8 and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.

A native of Landover, Md., Cox first coached at the high school level at Archbishop Carroll in Washington, D.C. from 1996-99. He spent the next seven years as an assistant principal at his alma mater, St. John's Prep in Washington, D.C. from 1999-2006, where he oversaw the school's athletic department, supervised all extra-curricular activities, and served as the school's head of discipline.

Cox began his coaching career as an assistant coach with the Washington D.C. Assault AAU program. He helped guide the team to the under-16 national championship in 2004. Several of his players earned college scholarships, including Tre Kelley (South Carolina), Chris McCray (Maryland), Michael Beasley (Kansas State/Miami Heat), Nolan Smith (Duke), Dante Cunningham (Villanova/Portland Trail Blazers), Arinze Onuaku (Syracuse) and Adrian Bowie (Maryland).

A 1995 graduate of William & Mary with a degree in sociology, Cox was a four-year letterwinner and three-year starter at point guard for the Tribe for head coaches Chuck Swenson and Charlie Woollum. He finished his collegiate career with 670 points, 216 rebounds, 336 assists and a .352 3-point field goal percentage and his name is located throughout the Tribe's record book. Cox still ranks among school leaders in several statistical categories, including 3-point field goals made (sixth, 137), total assists (eighth, 336); and 3-point field goal percentage (ninth, .352). His career-high 12 assists against George Mason in 1995 still ranks third among all-time single-game performances in W&M basketball history.

In 1996, Cox earned his master's degree in education from William & Mary. He and his wife Tasha have two children - Leila and Jacob.

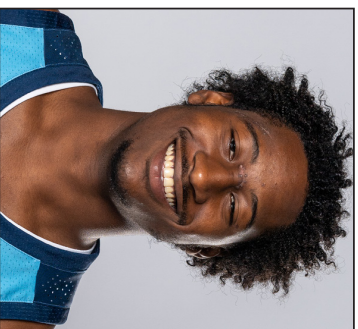

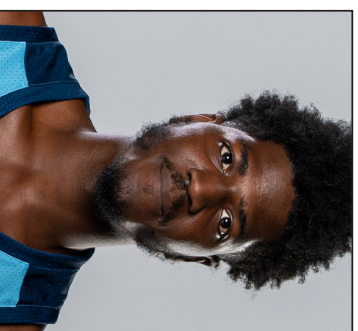
