RHODE ISLAND VS. KANSAS STATE - SERIES NOTES

- Monday's game will be the first between Rhode Island and Kansas State.
- Rhode Island is 19-31 all time against teams currently in the Big 12, with the most frequent opponent being West Virginia (13-21). URI and the Mountaneers used to be in the Atlantic 10 together.
- The Rams have won two of their last three contests against Big 12 schools.
- One of those victories was a 73-68 first-round win over Oklahoma in the 2018 NCAA Championship.
- Kansas State enters the week with a perfect 3-0 record, while Rhode Island is coming off its first win of the season, a 74-64 victory over Stony Brook.
- Monday's game is the first of the season for Rhode Island away from the Ryan Center.

RAMS PLAYING ON FOREIGN SOIL FOR THE THIRD TIME

- This week's trip to the Cayman Islands Classic is URI's second regular-season overseas trip in four years.
- During the 2019-20 season, Rhode Island split two games at the Jamaica Classic in Montego Bay, Jamaica. The Rams defeated North Texas 60-47 before falling to LSU, 96-83.
- During the 2015-16 season, the Rams played two games in Cancun, Mexico. They defeated TCU, 66-60, and fell to Maryland, 86-63, at the Cancun Challenge that year.

THOMAS RECORDS FIRST CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Sophomore point guard **Sebastian Thomas** set new career highs with 13 points and 10 assists in Rhode Island's 74-64 victory over Stony Brook last time out.
- It was the first career double-double for Thomas. No other member of the Rams has a double-double.
- The 10 assists by Thomas was one shy of the Ryan Center record, which was 11 by Dustin Hellenga in an 82-53 win over New Hampshire during the 2003-04 season.
- Through the first three games of the season, Thomas has 17 assists and eight turnovers, giving him a 2.12 assist-turnover ratio.
- For his career, he has 79 assists and 36 turnovers in 34 career games.
- This season Thomas is averaging 9.0 points per game, scoring 10 in the opener against Quinnipiac and 13 last time out against Stony Brook.
- As a freshman, Thomas did not score in double figures once in 31 games.
- He averaged 2.74 points per game in his first year.

LEGGETT LEADS TEAM IN SCORING AGAIN

- Sophomore guard **Ishmael Leggett** has led Rhode Island in scoring in each of the first three games of the season.
- He is averaging 17.7 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game while also shooting .870 (20-of-23) at the free throw line.
- Despite being in his third season with URI, Leggett still has two seasons of eligibility after this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- He matched his career high with 21 points against Texas State on Nov. 12, shooting 14-of-15 from the free throw line that game.
- Leggett has started 34 consecutive games and was the only player to start all 31 games for the Rams last season.
- He has played in all 59 possible games in career, making 42 starts.
- Last season, Leggett averaged 8.3 points, 3.1 rebounds and 1.6 assists per game.

HUTCHINSON BREAKS OUT AGAINST SEAWOLVES

- Freshman **Louis Hutchinson** is coming off the best game of his young career, as he had 15 points and three rebounds in 25 minutes off the bench against Stony Brook.
- Hutchinson was efficient, hitting 6-of-8 from the field, including 2-of-3 from the 3-point arc.
- He was the first incoming recruit to sign with first-year head coach **Archie Miller**.
- After missing his junior season at Long Island Lutheran due to an injury, Hutchinson served as a team captain for the nationally-ranked program in his senior season.
- He led the school to an 18-5 record.

ARCHIE MILLER ERA UNDERWAY IN KINGSTON

- **Archie Miller** is in his first season at Rhode Island, and his 11th season overall as a head coach.
- Familiar to the Atlantic 10, Miller's career as a head coach includes six seasons at Dayton (2011-17) and four more with Indiana (2017-2021).
- Over the course of his career, Miller has averaged more than 20 wins per season.
- In six seasons with Dayton, Miller won two Atlantic 10 titles and made the NCAA Championship field four years in a row from 2014-17.
- The conference Coach of the Year in 2017, Miller led the Flyers to titles in 2016 and 2017.
- He also had one NIT bid each with Dayton (2012) and Indiana (2019).
- Miller has reached six national postseason tournaments in nine possible chances.
- When the 2020 postseason was canceled by the COVID-19 pandemic, Miller had Indiana positioned for an at-large bid to the tournament.
- Miller has six 20-win seasons and was a finalist for the 2015 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award.

STONY BROOK BECOMES 100TH VICTIM FOR MILLER

- With the victory over Stony Brook, Head Coach **Archie Miller** has now claimed wins over 100 different opponents in his career.
- Miller is 207-123 in 330 games as a head coach.
- Kansas State will be the fourth consecutive opponent URI plays to open the season that Miller has never faced.
- Miller will face at least seven other programs for the first time this season. They are Army, Brown, Dayton, Georgia State, Loyola Chicago, Milwaukee, and UMass Lowell.

SAMB SHINES AGAINST TEXAS STATE

- One of the early bright spots for Rhode Island has been redshirt freshman **Abdou Samb**.
- Last time out against Texas State, Samb had 14 points and seven rebounds.
- He was 6-of-9 from the field and is now 9-for-12 (.750) on the young season.

FREEMAN WITH TEAM IN CAYMAN

- Sophomore guard **Brayon Freeman** was held out of last week's win over Stony Brook, though he was with the team on the bench.
- In announcing the decision to keep him out of the game, head coach **Archie Miller** said, "Right now the best thing for Brayon is to take a step back and recalibrate. We brought Brayon in to be a cornerstone piece for what we are building at Rhode Island. We want and need the best version of him, and we will get there."
- "That also has to fit within what is best for the program as a whole. Everything we are doing is with the best long-term intentions for both the men in the program and for the team overall."
- Freeman is with the team at the Cayman Islands Classic and may return game action during the tournament, though no decision has been made.
- He was named to the Atlantic 10 Preseason All-Conference Team, earning a spot on the third team.
- Freeman transferred to Rhode Island from George Washington, where he was named to the A-10 All-Rookie Team in 2021-22.
- As a freshman with the Colonials, Freeman averaged 10.3 points, 3.6 assists and 1.3 steals per game.

MARTIN EYES 1,000 CAREER POINTS

- Guard **Malik Martin** is chipping away at 1,000 career points.
- The redshirt senior has 895 points between his time at Charlotte and Rhode Island, leaving him 105 points shy of the milestone.
- Martin has 468 rebounds, just 32 shy of 500.
- Martin's brother is former Rhode Island forward and two-time Atlantic 10 Defensive Player of the Year **Hassan Martin** (2013-17).
- **Hassan Martin** is currently playing professionally in Europe.

BALANCE HELPS RAMS PICK UP FIRST WIN

- Four players scored in double digits for Rhode Island in its win over Stony Brook.
- Ishmael Leggett** led the way with 18, followed by **Louis Hutchinson** (15), **Sebastian Thomas** (13) and **Malik Martin** (12).
- It was the first time in 12 games dating back to a Feb. 8 loss at VCU (74-63) last season in which Rhode Island had four players score 10 or more points.
- The Rams had five double-digit scorers in the first two games combined.

BALL CONTROL A FOCUS FOR RHODY

- After two turnover-filled games, URI took much better care of the ball against Stony Brook.
- The Rams had 10 turnovers for the game, including just two in the second half against the Seawolves.
- Rhode Island had 41 turnovers in the first two games of the year, giving it away 19 times in the opener against Quinnipiac and 22 times against Texas State.
- As a result, opponents are averaging 18.3 points per game off turnovers, compared to just 12.0 for the Rams.

FOUMENA EXPECTED TO REDSHIRT

- Center **Jeremy Fomuna** is not expected to play this season.
- He will practice with the team all year while using a redshirt to preserve the season of eligibility.
- The Montreal native arrived in Kingston just before the start of the fall semester and dealt with medical issues that delayed his transition.
- The 6-11 Fomuna chose the Rams over Georgetown and UCF, while also getting interest from Oklahoma, Indiana, Marquette and Xavier.

MILLER ONE OF SEVERAL CHANGES IN ATLANTIC 10

- Archie Miller** is just one of six new head coaches in the Atlantic 10.
- The other new coaches are **Chris Caputo** (George Washington), **Fran Dunphy** (La Salle), **Frank Martin** (Massachusetts), **Matt McKillop** (Davidson) and **Keith Urgo** (Fordham).
- Loyola Chicago's second-year head coach **Drew Valentine** is new to the Atlantic 10. The Ramblers moved over from the Missouri Valley Conference.
- Like Miller, Dunphy had a previous stint as a head coach in the A-10 while he was with Temple.
- Dunphy is the first person to serve as head coach at three Big 5 schools, as he also was at Penn.

DUBSKY, ESTEVEZ SIGN ON FOR 2023-24

- Guards **Connor Dubsky** and **Cam Estevez** each signed a National Letter of Intent with Rhode Island.
- A 6-4 guard out of St. Stephen's St. Agnes in Virginia and Putnam Science in Connecticut, Dubsky is a pure shooter from the perimeter as well as mid-range.
- He competed for ProspectU's AAU program.
- This winter he is competing for Putnam Science, which won a prep national title last season.
- An elite defender with excellent footwork, Dubsky chose URI over George Washington, George Mason, Kansas State, Maryland, Rice and Wichita State.
- Estevez is a three-star guard who can be productive both with the ball in his hands or off the ball.
- A solid shooter who finishes well at the rim, Estevez flourishes in an uptempo style.
- A strong campaign with the Riverside Hawks club program helped raise his recruiting profile, as the 6-4 Estevez chose URI over Mississippi State, UCF, Miami (Ohio) and fellow Atlantic 10 schools St. Bonaventure and VCU, among others.

Archie Miller was named as the 21st head coach in Rhode Island history on March 18, 2022.

Miller came to Kingston with a storied pedigree in the Atlantic 10. He won two conference titles and had four NCAA Championship appearances in six seasons at Dayton. With a record of 206-121 over the course of 10 seasons as a head coach with the Flyers and Indiana, Miller averaged more than 20 wins per year and had six national postseason appearances before arriving in Rhode Island.

Nationally ranked during three of his six seasons at Dayton, Miller won A-10 titles in 2016 and 2017, earning conference Coach of the Year honors in the latter. He led the Flyers to four straight NCAA appearances from 2014-17, including a run to the Elite 8 in 2014. Miller also reached the NIT with Dayton in 2012 and with Indiana in 2019, when the Hoosiers reached the quarterfinals.

Miller has six 20-win campaigns in his 10 years as a head coach and was a 2015 finalist for the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award.

In four seasons at Indiana (2017-21) Miller had a record of 67-58. He made an immediate impact through recruiting, bringing nine Indiana natives in his first three classes, including Indiana Mr. Basketball winners Romeo Langford (2018), Trayce Jackson-Davis (2019) and Anthony Leal (2020). Langford and Jackson-Davis were named McDonald's All-Americans and Khristian Lander earned All-American honors from MaxPreps in 2020. The 2020 recruiting class was ranked 13th in the country

In 2019-20, Miller led the Hoosiers to a 20-12 mark and was poised to return to the NCAA Tournament before the COVID-19 Pandemic hit. The Hoosiers also finished with a winning record against nationally ranked teams with five victories including wins over Florida State, Ohio State, Michigan State, Penn State and Iowa, which was tied for 7th most in the country. IU also improved to 26th in the country in adjusted defense according to KenPom. The team also posted a 3.398 grade point average in the spring semester.

IU also led the Big Ten in free throw attempts and defensive rebounding percentage. Freshman Trayce Jackson-Davis was named third team All-Big Ten by the coaches and media and also selected to the All-Freshman team and was just one of four freshman nationally to lead his team in scoring, rebounds, field goal percentage, free throws made and free throws attempted and blocked shots. In the Big Ten, Jackson-Davis was the top freshman scorer overall and led first-year players in field goal percentage and blocked shots.

In addition, Langford, who was a lottery pick by the Boston Celtics and Juwan Morgan who earned a contract with the Utah Jazz, both began their NBA careers.

In 2018-19, the Hoosiers earned their first national ranking under Miller and were rated as high as 21st in the country in early January. IU earned nationally ranked wins over Michigan State (twice), Marquette and Wisconsin and notched triumphs against Louisville and Butler.

IU finished with 19 wins and won two post season games in the NIT. Morgan and Langford would go on to earn All-Big Ten honors and Langford was named to the USBWA All-District team. Morgan would finish his career 24th on the IU all-time scoring list and also finished eighth in career blocks and 10th in career rebounds. The Hoosiers also improved to 32nd in adjusted defense after finishing 65th in 2017-18. IU also finished 36th in the country in blocked shots.

In his first season at IU, Miller saw the Hoosiers improve dramatically. After seeing IU allow 76 points per game on 45.9 percent shooting and 41.7 percent accuracy from 3-point range in the month of November, IU limited teams to 65.4 points on 41.3 percent shooting from the floor and 33.1 percent from long distance in the month of February.

He saw junior forward Juwan Morgan emerge as the most improved player in the Big Ten adding more than 10 points per game scoring in Big Ten play during the 2017-18 season. Morgan earned second-team All-Big Ten honors and was named All-District by the USBWA and NABC in 2018. Senior Rob Johnson averaged a career-best 14.0 points per game earned honorable mention All-Big-Ten honors his senior year.

Miller is a tireless recruiter, noted developer of talent, and a gifted tactician whose teams are known for their stout defense and efficient offense. His 2018 recruiting class at IU was ranked 7th in the nation after a successful haul of players from the Big Ten footprint.

A native of Beaver Falls, Pa., Miller spent six seasons as head coach at Dayton, where he won Atlantic 10 Conference regular season championships in 2016 and 2017. He guided the Flyers to a 139-63 record (69.8) and a 68-34 mark (66.7) in the Atlantic 10. He took Dayton to the NCAA Tournament each of the last four years with the Flyers advancing to the Elite Eight in the 2014 Tournament. UD was nationally ranked in three of Miller's six seasons.

During its elite eight run, UD topped Ohio State (60-59), Syracuse (55-53) and Stanford (82-72) before falling to Florida (62-52) in the regional finals. In 2015, they defeated Boise State (56-55) and Providence (66-53) and were eliminated by Oklahoma (72-66) in the Sweet Sixteen. In 2016, they were defeated by Final Four participant Syracuse (70-51) in the second round and by Wichita State (64-58) in their first tournament game this season.

Miller had five NCAA tournament wins in his first four seasons. With three NCAA wins in 2014 and another two in 2015, Dayton was one of just six teams to have at least five NCAA tournament wins in those two years. The others were Arizona, UConn, Kentucky, Michigan State and Wisconsin.

For his efforts during the 2016-17 season, he was named Atlantic 10 and NABC District Coach of the Year. He led UD to perform at a championship level despite playing a 2016-17 campaign where the team's top six scorers missed a total of 32 games during the year due to injury. He also was a finalist for the 2015 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award.

He comes from a family of coaches with his father, John, having guided Archie and his brother Sean at Blackhawk High School in Beaver Falls. His brother Sean has been the head coach at the University of Arizona and also was the head coach at Xavier University. John was one of the country's top high school coaches when he retired in 2005, with 657 wins in a 35-year coaching career. Archie, Sean and their sister Lisa all played Division I college basketball.

Miller is regarded as a top recruiter — Arizona's 2011 recruits were a Top 10 class — and game strategist — he was the architect of the Wildcats upset of eighth-ranked Texas to get them to the Sweet 16. He was reunited with his brother during the summer of 2015 on the coaching staff of USA Basketball's U19 World Championship. When Sean was elevated to the team's head coach, he turned to his brother to help USA basketball win the gold at the 2015 FIBA U19 World Championship that was held June 27-July 5 in Heraklion, Crete, Greece.

He was a four-year letterwinner at North Carolina State from 1998-2002. A point guard, he is currently third at NC State in career FT% (.846, 165-195), sixth in career 3-pt. FG% (.429, 218-509), and fourth in career threes (218). As a senior, he helped lead the Wolfpack to the finals of the ACC championship game and was named to the all-tournament team. That was coach Herb Sendek's first NCAA team at NC State.

As an assistant, Miller coached in the Big Ten, Pac-12 and ACC, where he honed his craft under some of the most respected coaches in the country. He began his coaching career at NC State, serving as a coaching intern under Sendek in 2002-03. Miller then went to Western Kentucky as a full-time member of Darrin Horn's staff for one season. He returned to NC State, first as Director of Basketball Operations (2004-05), and then as a full-time assistant coach (2005-06). When Sendek went to Arizona State in 2006-07, Miller remained on his coaching staff before joining Thad Matta at Ohio State for two seasons (2007-09). As a coach, he has been part of 20-plus win and NCAA seasons at NC State (2005-06), Ohio State (2008-09), Arizona (2010-11), and Dayton (2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17).

In April, 2015, he joined his father and brother in the Beaver County Sports Hall of Fame. Other greats in the Beaver County Hall include Mike Ditka, Tony Dorsett, Terry Francona, Pete and Press Maravich, Joe Namath, Babe Parilli and Norm Van Lier.

Miller earned his bachelor's degree in Parks, Recreation and Tourism from NC State in 2002. He is married to the former Morgan Nicole Cruse and they have a daughter, Leah.

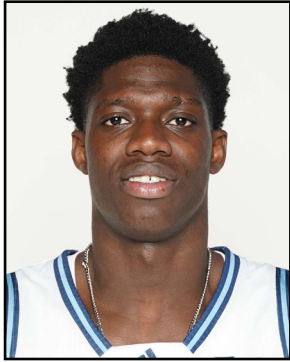

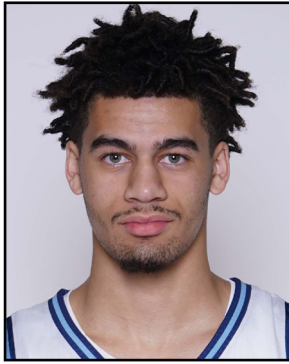
