OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Ross Dausin, CSU-Pueblo, Senior, Quarterback, 6-6, 223
San Antonio, Texas/Butler County (KS) CC/Warren HS

A unanimous selection as RMAC Football Offensive Player of the Year... In three seasons, his career record as a starter at CSU-Pueblo is 31-3... Dausin set seven CSU-Pueblo single season passing records, including total offensive yards, most touchdown passes, most passing yards, total touchdowns (rushing and passing), passing attempts, completions and completion percentage ... Is the CSU-Pueblo career leader in every possible passing category except quarterback rating ... Broke the CSU-Pueblo single game passing record with five touchdown passes at Fort Lewis ... Broke the CSU-Pueblo single game passing yardage record with 390 yards vs. Black Hills State.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Kevin Lindholm, Chadron State, Senior, Outside Linebacker, 6-2, 220
Eads, Colo./Eads HS

Through 11 games, Lindholm has accumulated 111 tackles and 19.5 tackles for loss... He's had two games of at least 17 tackles and is averaging 10 stops a game... Lindholm's tackle total is already the highest total a CSC defender has posted since Aric Lopez had 94 in 2002 and he is the first player to eclipse 100 since Kevin Homer had 126 following the 1998 season... For his career, Lindholm has played in 44 consecutive games... He's started 33 straight of them and has accumulated 288 career tackles, which makes him two tackles shy of 10th place all-time... He's a three-time all-RMAC first team choice and a two-time team captain.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Taylor Accardi, Colorado Mines, Senior, 6-2, 205
Littleton, Colo./Dakota Ridge HS

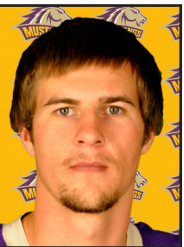
Set NCAA Division II Career Record with 46.1 punting average (broke record set by Jeff Williams of Adams State (2002-05), 44.9)... New NCAA Division II single season record holder on minimum of 30 punts with 51.1 punting average in 2012 (broke record set by Steve Ecker of Shippensburg that was set in 1965 (49.1)...29 punts for 2,505 yards... 26 punts of 50 or more yards in 2012... 15 punts inside opponent 20 yard line in 2012... Season long of 81 yards... 74 career punts of 50 or more yards... Career long of 88 yards.



COACH OF THE YEAR

John Wristen, CSU-Pueblo

Wristen coached the ThunderWolves to an 11-0 regular season record and #1 national ranking for the second year in a row. CSUP is just the sixth school in RMAC history to go undefeated in the regular season. It's also the second undefeated regular season in school history. Wristen has a 42-13 career coaching record (.782) win percentage. CSU-Pueblo is the top seed in the NCAA Division II Super Region 4 playoffs.



OFFENSIVE FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

Mitch Glasmann, Western New Mexico, Quarterback, 6-3, 220
Temecula, Calif./Chaparral HS

Is third in the RMAC with 3139 passing yards, 27 touchdown passes, 249 completions and 426 attempts. Glasmann set WNMU Division II era (since 1993) records for passing yards and touchdowns. He broke the previous marks that were set last year by David Ingram who amassed 2,927 yards passing and 24 touchdowns



DEFENSIVE FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

Kevin Cuff, CSU-Pueblo, Inside Linebacker, 6-0, 222
San Diego, Calif./Torrey Pines HS

Recorded 66 tackles, which is second best on the CSU-Pueblo roster, and 30th in the RMAC... Cuff had three quarterback sacks to tie for the Pack's team lead and is 14th in the conference... Cuff picked off a pass and ran it back 74 yards for a touchdown in win over West Texas A&M, earning RMAC/Rawlings Defensive Player of the Week honors.
