Johnny Cox, one of Fort Lewis College's all-time greats, looks to maintain the Skyhawks upward trend in his fourth season in the fall of 2025. Hired as the 16th head coach in program history, Cox returned to Durango on Jan. 10, 2022, to rebuild his alma mater into a quality program within the daunting Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The 2024 season was a turning point for Fort Lewis as Cox guided the program to a 3-8 overall record and a 2-7 mark against RMAC competition and snapped the then-longest losing streak in college football at 40 games. The Skyhawks got back on track with a win over Arizona Christian (Sept. 14) before later handling Adams State (Nov. 2) and New Mexico Highlands (Nov. 9) on back-to-back weekends to earn the program's first conference wins since 2019. In addition, Fort Lewis finished in seventh place in the RMAC among ten conference teams.

Since his arrival, Cox has emphasized student-athlete success both on and off the field and saw 18 Skyhawks named to the RMAC Academic Honor Roll and 24 Skyhawks to the National Football Foundation Colorado Chapter (NFFCC) Academic All-Colorado team in 2024. Four players then advanced to earn College Sports Communicators Academic All-District honors. On the gridiron, however, Fort Lewis boasted two Second-Team All-RMAC selections in Jacob Penney (LB) and Orlando Guevara (KR). Penney finished fifth in NCAA Division II with 122 total tackles (11.1 tackles per game), while Guevara finished second in the RMAC and 34th in DII with 536 return yards and owned one of nine 99+ yard kickoff returns for a touchdown in the nation. The duo later earned First-Team All-Colorado honors from the NFFCC. Jacob LaCroix (OL), Cheilotam Udengwu (OL), Kalib Davis (FS), and Hunter Villavicencio (P) were all named Honorable Mention All-RMAC as well.

In his second season with Fort Lewis in 2023, the Skyhawks improved in various statistical categories across the board including rushing yards per game (+21.7), passing yards per game (+52.31), total offense (+74.1), posted six games with 300+ yards of total offense for the first time since 2016, and scored the most points in a single season since 2018 with 146.

Cox coached two-year Skyhawk Braden Wingle (QB) to one of the most statistically significant careers at Fort Lewis as Wingle hung up his cleats ranking eighth all-time in career passing yards (3,724), first in average yards per pass (9.7), second in career completion percentage (59.5%), sixth in completions (384), and seventh in attempts (645).

Fort Lewis saw Villavicencio (P) capture Second-Team All-National Football Foundation Colorado Chapter honors: he's the first to secure any such honor since 2018. Villavicencio was also named Second-Team All-RMAC, while Peyton Monson (WR) and Lacroix (OL) each earned an All-RMAC honorable mention. In addition, nine Skyhawks were tabbed with RMAC Academic Honor Roll nods, while Julio Romo (OL) and Tristen Williams (LB) were named to the College Sports Communicators Academic All-District Team.

In 2022, Fort Lewis improved its total offense by 42.9 yards per game under the direction of Cox and his new coaching staff's offensive scheme. Most notably, Max Hyson (DE) – a First-Team Academic All-RMAC selection – was named the NFFCC All-Colorado Scholar-Athlete of the Year over Colorado football athletes across the Division I and Division II landscape, including 2022 Harlon Hill Award Winner John Matocha from Colorado School of Mines.

17 additional Skyhawks earned Academic All-Colorado honors in 2022 alongside Hyson. Fort Lewis also captured three All-RMAC Honorable Mentions through the regular season, including Ryan Barkley (OL), Dylan Holt (WR), and Zach

Russell (TE). Three additional Skyhawks were named to the RMAC Academic Honor Roll: Barkley, Williams, and Matthew Waid (P).

A 28-year coaching veteran, Cox is a 1994 graduate and two-time All-American at FLC. He rejoins the Skyhawks after spending eight seasons at the University of North Carolina at Pembroke, an NCAA Division II program competing in the Mountain East Conference.

Inducted into the FLC Athletics Hall of Fame in 1999, Cox was a four-year star for FLC at the wide receiver position from 1990-93. Cox earned First Team All-American honors in 1992 and 1993 while being named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) Player of the Year for the 1993 season.

Cox still owns FLC school records in receiving yards (3,611) and receiving touchdowns (33), while his 220 career catches are the second most in program history. His dominance on the field made him a two-time finalist for the Harlon Hill Trophy, which is awarded to the best player in NCAA Division II football.

He continued his playing career in 1994-95 when he was invited to training camp with the Green Bay Packers in 1994. Cox also played one season with the Orlando Predators of the Arena Football League in 1995.

It was during that time when Cox also got his coaching career off the ground as he served as the defensive backs coach at FLC in 1994. After earning his master's degree and serving as a graduate assistant at the University of Texas from 1997-99, Cox returned to FLC to serve as the offensive coordinator in 1999 and interim head coach in 2000.

Following a four-year stint as an assistant coach at North Dakota State, Cox served four seasons (2000-03) as head coach at Rex Putnam High School in Milwaukie, Oregon, before making his return to the college ranks as special teams coordinator and wide receivers coach at Holy Cross for the 2007 season.

Cox made his NFL coaching debut as a part of former Dallas Cowboys defensive coordinator Monte Kiffin's defensive staff (quality control) with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers for the 2008 season. He also spent time as both the wide receivers and offensive quality control coach for the Jacksonville Jaguars under defensive coordinator Jack Del Rio's staff from 2009-11.

Following a two-year stop at North Carolina A&T as the wide receivers coach and recruiting coordinator, Cox began his time at UNC Pembroke in 2014 as the offensive coordinator and, most recently, as the Braves' associate head coach.

The Braves made tremendous strides during Cox's tenure, going from a 2-8 overall record in 2014 to posting a record of 10-2 overall in 2016. UNCP set school records in wins, was ranked as high as No. 12 in the country, and won the program's first-ever playoff game that season en route to reaching the second round of the NCAA Division II playoffs.

Grinde is heading into his fourth season as the offensive coordinator for Fort Lewis College in 2025. Grinde joined the Skyhawks in 2022 after spending two seasons as the Offensive Coordinator at Hastings College in Hastings, Nebraska.

Skyhawks football turned a corner in 2024, as the program earned a 3-8 overall record and a 2-7 mark against RMAC competition. Fort Lewis got back on track with a win over Arizona Christian (Sept. 14) before later handling Adams State (Nov. 2) and New Mexico Highlands (Nov. 9) on back-to-back weekends to earn the program's first conference wins since 2019. In addition, Fort Lewis finished in seventh place in the RMAC among ten conference teams.

The offense took a more balanced approach last year, improving its rushing game to 125.8 yards/game from its 65.5 yards/game the year prior. While the passing game supplied 154.6 yards/game, down 68.3 yards from the year before, the balanced approach maintained 280.5 yards of offense per game, leading to 201 total points (18.27 pts/game), the most for the program since 2018. Senior Jacob LaCroix (OL) and sophomore Cheilotam Udengwu (OL) were key figures up front for Fort Lewis, and the duo were rewarded with their second and first nods, respectively, to the All-RMAC Honorable Mention teams.

Fort Lewis' offense showed glimpses of its old self in 2023 as the Skyhawks tallied 300 or more yards of offense on six occasions for the first time since 2016 and scored the most points in a season since 2018 with 146. At the line of scrimmage, FLC improved in

key offense metrics, including rushing yards per game (+21.7), passing yards per game (+52.31), and yards of total offense per game (+74.1).

Grinde's guidance in the trenches lifted LaCroix to his first All-RMAC Honorable Mention on the offensive line after losing three-year conference veteran and 2022 All-RMAC Honorable Mention Ryan Barkley. In addition, senior Peyton Monson (WR) also received an All-RMAC Honorable Mention nod. With Grinde's protection at the line, senior Braden Wingle (QB) was able to throw for the fifth-most yards (2,276) and completions (207) in the league.

Senior Julio Romo (OL) was also named to the College Sports Communicators Academic All-District Team; Romo – alongside linebacker Tristen Williams – was not only the Skyhawks first All-District honoree since 2011 but the first offensive lineman since 2003 to earn any Academic All-District/Region honor.

In 2022, Grinde's offense helped Fort Lewis improve its total offense by 42.9 yards per game and provided all three of the Skyhawks' All-RMAC Honorable Mention award winners: Zach Russell (TE), Ryan Barkley (OL), and Dylan Holt (WR).

Grinde has previous working experience with FLC head football coach Johnny Cox from their time together at UNC Pembroke (2016-2020). During his time with UNC Pembroke, Grinde coached seven All-Conference Academic Honor Roll recipients, an All-American while helping guide the team to the 2016 NCAA DII playoffs, making it to the second round.

As a graduate assistant at the University of Central Missouri, where he helped coach the offensive line, tight ends, and running backs over three years, he saw plenty of success with an appearance in the Live United Texarkana Bowl, along with coaching two All-Region and All-American performers.

Grinde brings a wealth of experience, having coached four different positions while also competing in the NCAA DII playoffs as a wide receiver at the University of Central Missouri. He knows the game very well and also comes from a quality football background as his father is a former college offensive line coach and is currently the Head Football Coach at Air Academy High School in Colorado Springs, CO.

A four-year dean's list honoree, Grinde earned his bachelor's degree in Kinesiology from Central Missouri and went on to earn his master's degree in Kinesiology from UCM in 2015.

Spencer Brown is heading into his fourth season as defensive coordinator for Fort Lewis in the fall of 2025. Brown joined the Skyhawks in 2022 after spending three years at Southern Illinois University as the Defensive Run Game Coordinator and Linebackers Coach.

Brown's defensive scheme made its biggest improvement in 2024, cutting down 126.5 yards of offense and 11.91 points per game off of its opponents' averages. The difference helped the Skyhawks top Arizona Christian in the second game of the season to end the program's 40-game losing streak. It also led to a pair of back-to-back conference wins later in the season, including a 27-17 victory over Adams State (Nov. 2) in the inaugural Clash for the Pass rivalry game, and a 44-22 thumping over New Mexico Highlands (Nov. 9), in the home finale.

Fort Lewis' defense was led by standout inside linebacker Jacob Penney, who Brown brought in back in 2022. With 122 tackles on the season, and an average of 11.1 per game, Penney finished 5th in NCAA Division II in both categories, leading the RMAC as well. In addition, through his three seasons, Penney already owns 202 career tackles, just 66 shy of cracking the program's all-time top 10 list. For his efforts on the season, Penney was named Second-Team All-RMAC

and First-Team All-Colorado by the National Football Foundation Colorado Chapter (NFFCC), marking him as one of the best linebackers in the state across the NCAA Division II and Division I levels.

Penney wasn't the only all-conference selection, however, as Brown also aided in the development of free safety Kalib Davis, who also earned an Honorable Mention All-RMAC distinction. Davis racked up 69 tackles, the second-most on the roster, while also hauling in four interceptions, breaking up two passes, forcing one fumble, forcing one quarterback hurry, and picking up a fumble as well.

The defense made steady progress under Brown's tutelage in his first two seasons, shaving off yards of total offense and points per game from its opponents over both seasons. With Brown's schemes in place, the Skyhawks steadily came closer to getting back into ballgames, coming within roughly two scores of their opponents on five occasions.

While at Southern Illinois, Brown helped the Salukis defense hold opponents to just 154 rushing yards per game, a 67-yard improvement from previous seasons. Additionally, the Salukis held the No. 1 Kickoff return defense in the Missouri Valley Conference and No. 3 Kickoff return defense in all of the FCS in 2019.

Prior to Southern Illinois, Brown had stops at North Carolina State University as Senior Defensive Analyst and at The University of South Dakota as a Linebackers Coach and Video Coordinator. While at NC State, Brown helped coordinate the Top 25-rated defense that included former National Football League players Dravious Wright and Shawn Boone.

Brown completed his Master of Business Administration in Marketing from the University of North Texas while serving as a graduate assistant for the football team. While assisting the Green, Brown helped coach future NFL athletes Zach Orr and Derek Akunne.

Brown earned his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from Southern Methodist University in 2010.

NO MORE GHOSTS

• Since 2017, there has been one thing on the minds of Skyhawks football fans - the streak. On Nov. 11, 2017, a 13-23 loss in the season-finale to then Division II Utah Tech University kick-started what would be the fifth-longest losing streak in all of DII. The Skyhawks' 40-game winless mark from Nov. 11, 2017, to Sept. 14, 2024, trails only Cheyney (43 games), Minnesota-Morris (46 games), Shorter (48 games), and Lock Haven (52 games).
 • In addition, the Skyhawks later topped Adams State, 27-17, on Nov. 2 and New Mexico Highlands 44-22 the following week on Nov. 9 to give Fort Lewis its first conference wins since the same 2017 season when the program went 5-6 overall and 5-5 in RMAC play.

PRESEASON POLL

• With 17 total points, Fort Lewis football was picked to finish ninth in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference, ahead of only Adams State (9 points).

BUILDING THE FOUNDATION

• Head coach Johnny Cox has been committed to one thing since taking the reins of the Skyhawks football program in 2022 - building a foundation for the future. Over the past few seasons, FLC has seen large recruiting classes dedicated to bolstering size, speed, and talent to last years. Last offseason, the Skyhawks continued to build on and nearly solidify the foundation for the future, adding 61 new student-athletes, including 13 talented transfers from various levels.

INVESTING IN STUDENT-ATHLETES

• To those who have visited Durango, one thing is clear: Fort Lewis College's commitment to its student-athletes is clear. With a redesigned floor in Whalen Gymnasium in 2021, the addition of an auxiliary gym and additional locker rooms for female sports in 2023, a new state-of-the-art video board on Ray Dennison Memorial Field in 2024, and its newest \$6 million CommonSpirit Sports Performance Center, Fort Lewis is dedicated to elevating the student-athlete experience to the highest level.

STICK TO YOUR GUNS

• In the ever-changing world of collegiate athletics, student-athletes and coaches are becoming quick to hit the transfer portal. Coach Cox, however, has built his program from the ground up and has maintained a near 90%+ retention rate of his student-athletes. Additionally, all three coordinators (offense, defense, special teams) have been on Cox's staff since his tenure began, and four additional coaches are entering their third and fourth seasons.

RETURNING 2024 ALL-RMAC SKYHAWKS

• **#2 Orlando Guevara (RB/R, 5-8, 165, Denver South, Denver, Colo.) - Second-Team** Guevara made quite the showing in his inaugural season with the Skyhawks, torching defenders as the lead return man with additional appearances from the backfield... played in all 11 games... most notably made 21 returns on kickoff for 536 yards, the second-most in the conference and the 33rd-most in NCAA Division II... also ranked second in the RMAC and 31st in NCAA Division II, averaging 25.5 yards per return, good for the fourth-best career average in program history... joined elite company in the Skyhawks record book with a 99-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against New Mexico Highlands (Nov. 9) which is just the 10th in program history and the 9th in NCAA Division II in 2024... his efforts garnered Second-Team All-RMAC honors as a kick returner... was also named the best return-man in the State of Colorado by the National Football Foundation Colorado Chapter...returned two punts for 15 yards...tied for the most rushing touchdowns among running backs with two... racked up 283 yards rushing on 52 attempts to average 5.4 yards per carry and 25.73 rushing yards per game... ran for a career-long 88-yard touchdown against South Dakota Mines (Sept. 28) en route to his first-career 100-yard rushing performance...caught 22 passes for 133 yards and two touchdowns and averaged 6.05 yards per catch and 12.09 receiving yards per game.

• **#9 Kalib Davis (FS, 5-10, 185, Cherokee Trail HS, Aurora, Colo.) - Honorable Mention** Davis took command of the Skyhawks secondary, starting in all 11 games for Fort Lewis across the year... finished second on the roster and 13th in the RMAC with 69 total tackles, including 48 solo and 21 assisted tackles... also went in the trenches and made 2.5 tackles for seven total yards lost... led Fort Lewis and tied for the RMAC lead with four interceptions on the year while also breaking up two passes and forcing one quarterback hurry... forced and recovered one fumble each... made a career-high 12 tackles on the road at #13/12 Western Colorado (Oct. 5)... scampered for a career-long 42-yard interception return at #24/NR Colorado School of Mines... registered 1.5 tackles for six yards lost and brought down an interception against New Mexico Highlands (Nov. 9)... recorded 7+ tackles on six occasions... only finished with fewer than four tackles in one game... his efforts garnered his first nod as an All-RMAC Honorable Mention safety.

• **#0 Jake Penney (ILB, 6-0, 205, Spanish Springs HS, Sparks, Nev.) - Second-Team** Penney electrified the Skyhawks defense and quickly became a leader on the gridiron, starting in all 11 games for Fort Lewis... led the Skyhawks, the RMAC, and ranked 5th in NCAA Division II in both total tackles (122 tackles) and tackles per game (11.1 tackles/game)... finished just outside of the program's top-10 for single-season tackles... also led the RMAC and tied for the 3rd-most solo tackles in DII with 75... ranked third in the league with 47 assisted tackles... ranked 22nd in the conference in tackles for loss (seven solo, two assisted) with 8.0 tackles for a combined loss of 25 yards... registered one sack for a loss of six yards... led the Skyhawks and tied for the RMAC lead with three forced fumbles... recovered one fumble and forced four quarterback hurries... reached 202 career tackles (141 solo, 61 assisted) in just two seasons and 22 games... already ranks 10th all-time in program history for solo tackles... had a career-performance against Black Hills State (Sept. 21), recording 18 tackles (11 solo, seven assisted), two tackles for a combined six yards lost, and two quarterback hurries... his 18 tackles against the Yellow Jackets is tied for the fourth-most in a single game in program history... also had a 17-tackle (five solo, 12 assisted) performance against Arizona Christian (Sept. 14), leading to his first-ever RMAC Defensive Player of the Week (Sept. 16) award... recorded 10+ tackles seven times and 15+ tackles on two occasions... ABOUT FORT LEWIS COLLEGE

AN UNCOMMON WAY TO LEARN: Bring your curiosity, sense of adventure, and love of life. Your classes are small in numbers but as wide as the world. Learning rarely ends at the classroom door. FLC faculty are guides and mentors as much as teachers of academic subjects. Your peers are collaborators in coursework and co-conspirators in adventure. Campus on the mesa overlooks our iconic Colorado town. It is a space that brings together mountains and desert, concepts and reality, and people and their landscape.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF FORT LEWIS COLLEGE: The first Fort Lewis army post was constructed in Pagosa Springs, Colorado, in 1878, and was relocated in 1880 to Hesperus, Colorado, on the southern slopes of the La Plata Mountains. In 1891, Fort Lewis was decommissioned and converted into an off-reservation federal Indian boarding school. In 1911, the fort's property and buildings in Hesperus were transferred to the state of Colorado to establish an "agricultural and mechanic arts high school." That deed came with two conditions: that the land would be used for an educational institution, and was "to be maintained as an institution of learning to which Indian students will be admitted free of tuition and on an equality with white students" in perpetuity (Act of 61st Congress, 1911). Both conditions have been the Fort Lewis school's missions and guides over the past century.

In the 1930s, the Fort Lewis high school expanded into a two-year college, and in 1948 became Fort Lewis A&M College, under control of State Board of Agriculture. The "Aggies" studying at the Fort Lewis Branch of the Colorado State College of Agriculture & Mechanics could choose from courses including agriculture, forestry, engineering, veterinary science, and home economics. Fort Lewis underwent another period of growth and changes starting in 1956, when the college moved from its long-time home in Hesperus to its present location, 18 miles east, atop what was then known as Reservoir Hill, overlooking Durango. Here, Fort Lewis College became a four-year institution, awarding its first baccalaureate degrees in 1964.

Also in 1964, the college separated from the State Board of Agriculture and dropped the "A&M" moniker. At that time, the new Fort Lewis College also changed its mascot from "Aggies" to the "Raiders," and changed the school's colors from the green and yellow of the Colorado State University system it had been affiliated with to the blue and gold it still sports today. In 1994, the college's mascot became the Skyhawks, retaining the blue and gold. In 1995, Fort Lewis College joined the Council of Public Liberal Arts Colleges, and in 2002, the College became independent of the Colorado State University system, and formed its own governing Board of Trustees. In 2005, the Colorado state legislature raised the college's admission standards, making it a "selective" college.

In 2008, Fort Lewis was designated as one of six Native American-serving, non-tribal colleges by the U.S. Department of Education. Because of its unique origins as a military fort turned federal Indian boarding school turned state public school, and following the 1911 mandate to provide a tuition-free education for students from any federally recognized Native American tribe, Fort Lewis College today awards more degrees to Native American students than any other four-year, baccalaureate-granting institution in the nation—about 26% of all degrees awarded.



LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

We acknowledge the land that Fort Lewis College is situated upon is the ancestral land and territory of the Nuuchiu (Ute) people who were forcibly removed by the United States Government. We also acknowledge that this land is connected to the communal and ceremonial spaces of the Jicarilla Abache (Apache), Pueblos of New Mexico,

Hopi Sinom (Hopi), and Diné (Navajo) Nations. It is important to acknowledge this setting because the narratives of the lands in this region have long been told from dominant perspectives, without full recognition of the original land stewards who continue to inhabit and connect with this land.
