Kyle Snyder, QB, 6-1, 225, Barberton, Ohio/Barberton H.S./Ohio University
Appeared in five games with the Bobcats in 2011...Completed 5-of-8 passes for 38 yards, completing 62.5 percent of his attempts...Garnered All-State honors as a senior at Barberton High School...Two-time All-District and four-time All-Conference honoree...Set school records in career passing yards (6,553) and touchdowns thrown (64)...Finished his prep career with 85 touchdowns and 8,233 yards of total offense.

Darrius Darden-Box, ATH, 5-10, 170, Nashville, Tenn./Pearl-Cohn H.S.
Led Pearl-Cohn High School to the Tennessee State quarterfinals...Named First-Team All-Memphis and earned All-District accolades...Recorded 63 tackles, including 20 solo stops...Assisted on 43 others and had two interceptions...Rushed for 1,017 yards and six touchdowns on 159 carries, averaging 6.4 yards per attempt...Registered 59 tackles, two interceptions and nine pass breakups en route to All-Memphis honors as a junior.

Lawrence Hills, DE, 6-3, 230, Jacksonville, Fla./West Nassau H.S.
All-District, All-County and All-State selection at West Nassau High School...Finished with 80 tackles in 2011...Also ranked sixth in Division 4A with 13 sacks...Recorded three sacks in a game on two occasions as a senior...Averaged nearly seven (6.9) tackles per contest...Collected 12.5 sacks on his way to garnering All-District and All-County laurels as a junior...All-County selection in basketball.

Garret Baker, OT, 6-2, 270, Owensville, Mo./Owensville H.S.
Attended Owensville High School, where he was named First-Team All-Area by *The Missourian*...Central Missouri First-Team All-District selection...All-Four River Conference honoree...Third-Team All-State pick as a junior.

Paul McRoberts, WR, 6-3, 185, St. Louis, Mo./Soldan H.S.
Was ranked 20th on the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch* Super 30 List at Soldan High School...Named the Public High Small Schools Offensive Player of the Year...First Team All-Metro selection...Led the metro region with 1,607 receiving yards and 23 touchdowns...Averaged 25.1 yards per catch...Rushed for two touchdowns and threw for another...Also a standout basketball player.

Terrance Hill, LB, 6-1, 205, Kansas City, Mo./Raytown H.S.
Second-Team All-State linebacker at Raytown High School...First-Team Suburban Conference White Division and All-District selection...Recorded 106 tackles, six sacks and one interception as a senior...Garnered Second-Team All-Conference and All-District honors as a junior...Also plays basketball.

BJ Buckner, WR, 6-1, 180, St. Louis, Mo./Kirkwood H.S.
Led Kirkwood High School to the State Championship game in 2011...Second-Team All-State pick...First-Team All-Suburban South Conference honoree...Completed 58-of-99 passes for 1,202 yards and 16 touchdowns...Recorded over 2,000 yards of total offense as a senior...Threw for 1,535 yards and 20 touchdowns, and ran for 398 yards and nine TDs his junior year.

Selwyn Carrol, DL, 6-2, 255, Jacksonville, Fla. Trinity Christian Academy
Garnered 3A All-State honors in 2011...Led his team to a district title...Recorded 25 tackles as a senior and added as a junior...Had five tackles for loss as both junior and senior, and recorded five sacks his junior year...Member of the Spirit Student Leadership Team.

Dashune Barlow, DB, 5-8, 170, Cedar Hill, Texas/Cedar Hill H.S.
Unanimous All-District selection in 2011...Collected 86 tackles, one interception and two fumble recoveries, leading Cedar Hill High School to a district championship...Registered 103 tackles and three pass breakups en route to Second-Team All-District honors as a junior...State qualifier in the triple jump and as a power lifter...Academic All-District honoree.

Jon Slania, DL, 6-2, 270, Chicago, Ill./South Elgin H.S.
Two-time All-Upstate Eight Conference pick at South Elgin High School...Named All-Area as a senior...Averaged 3.2 tackles per game and finished with a total of 29 tackles as a senior...Added two sacks and one interception in 2011.

Terry Grigsby, WR, 6-1, 170, Omaha, Neb./North H.S.
Rated a two-star athlete by *Rivals.com* at North High School, the same high school Southeast fullback Ron Coleman attended...Named All-Nebraska by the *Omaha World Herald*...Second-Team All-State pick by the *Lincoln Journal Star*...Hauled in 48 catches for 907 yards and 12 touchdowns as a senior...Member of the track & field team, competing in the 400-meter run.

Travis Sanders, DE, 6-3, 220, St. Clair, Mo./St. Clair H.S.
Garnered Four Rivers Conference Defensive Player of the Year and Eastern Missourian Player of the Year accolades as a prep at St. Clair High School...First-Team All-Conference and All-Area honoree...Second-Team All-State selection...Registered 39 tackles and seven sacks as a senior...Honorable Mention All-Conference pick as a junior...Earned All-Conference honors in baseball.

Colby Baker, QB, 5-11, 175, Hardee, Fla./Hardee H.S.
Led Hardee High School to the second round of the State Playoffs...Completed 39-of-73 passes for 618 yards and six touchdowns as a senior...Rushed for 466 yards and six touchdowns on 49 carries...Threw for five touchdowns and ran for 437 yards and four TDs as a junior.

Austin Black, DL, 6-0, 255, Warrenton, Mo./Warrenton H.S.
Ranked 16th on the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch* Super 30 List...Most Valuable Player of the North/South St. Louis All-Star Game...Ranked 42nd in the metro area with 108 tackles as a senior...Rushed for 542 yards and five touchdowns his final prep season...Ranked 10th in the area with 140 tackles, had six sacks and added four fumble recoveries as a junior...Also ran for 1,016 yards and 17 touchdowns that year.

Averaged 172 rushing yards per game...Completed 84-of-172 passes for 1,196 yards...Racked up 4,000 all-purpose yards and 47 touchdowns as a senior...Was equally impressive on defense, recording 60 tackles, four interceptions and three fumble recoveries...Earned Honorable Mention All-State honors after rushing for 1,364 yards with 26 touchdowns as a junior...Also plays basketball.
