Series History

The Redhawks lead the all-time series with Belmont, 15-9; however, since the Bruins joined the OVC in 2012-13, Southeast is 10-6 against the Nashville team. The Redhawks fell in the final series of the regular season last year at Capaha. The Redhawks won game one but dropped the next two by one run each. SEMO dropped the regular season series in Nashville in 2015 as well.

Scouting the Bruins

Belmont enters the weekend with a 24-24 overall record and sits third in the OVC with a 15-12 clip. The Bruins will wrap conference play this weekend against the Redhawks as their bye week is the final weekend of the regular season. Catcher Nick Egli is having terrific senior season, hitting .374 and slugging a whopping .761. He leads the team in hits (61), doubles (17), home runs (14), and RBI (46). He has also drawn a team-best 28 walks to contribute to a .480 on-base percentage. On the mound, Dylan King leads the staff with a 3.84 ERA (second in the OVC) in 72.2 innings and 12 starts. His 95 strikeouts leads the OVC, 14 more than his teammate Tyler Vaughn's 81, which is tied for second in the league. Vaughn's 76.2 innings of work leads the conference. The pen is also strong with Dom Veltri's eight saves (second in OVC) and 3.86 ERA. Kyle Klotz's 35 appearances is most in the OVC this season. The Bruins are fresh off five-straight days of games from Saturday to Wednesday.

Coaching Connection

Southeast Volunteer Assistant Coach Matthew Kinney will return to his undergraduate alma mater this weekend. Kinney played three seasons for the Bruins culminating in a stellar season out of the pen in 2015. Kinney was named Second Team All-OVC as well as earning All-OVC Tournament honors that season. He faced the Redhawks in game two of the regular season series, earning his sixth save pithing three scoreless, hitless innings while striking out four and allowing no base runners. Kinney faced the Redhawks in the OVC Tournament, pitching a trio of innings in two appearances. He finished his career as a student-athlete out of the pen last season at Florida State.

Heating Up Down the Stretch

Justin Murphy will be the Friday night starter this weekend against Belmont. In his last six starts, he has pitched past the seventh in five of them. In those starts, Murphy is 3-1 with a 3.30 ERA. The string also includes a complete-game shutout of Jacksonville State on Apr. 14. When Murphy takes the mound this season, Southeast is 8-4.

All the Wright Stuff

Freshman second baseman Danny Wright has put together a stellar rookie campaign. His .338 batting average ranks third on the team and 19th in the league while he is tied for third with 11 doubles to slug .490. His .434 on base percentage ranks third on the team. He's made 39 starts, 35 of which coming at second base. The rookie has 16 multi-hit games including five three-hit games.

But Does He Get on Base?

Senior outfielder Dan Holst led the squad last season with a .475 on base percentage and currently leads this season with a .518 clip. His .494 career on base percentage ranks fourth among active Division I players. His .518 average ranks third nationally this season. He extended his on base streak to 34 games over the weekend at Western Michigan. His 31-game streak is a career long for the senior and is currently the longest active on-base streak in the OVC. His 42 walks this season has cracked the single-season top 10 for the second straight season and ranks 11th in the country. His career 97 walks ranks seventh all-time, tied with teammate Trevor Ezell.

There's No Place Like Home

In 22 games at Capaha Field this season, Southeast is 15-7 including a 7-2 OVC clip. The Redhawks are hitting .315 at Capaha and holding opponents to a .276 average while outscoring them, 179-120. Individually, Dan Holst is hitting .419 while Tristen Gagan has hit eight homers and driven in 33 runs.

Hang In There, Slugger

Chris Osborne not only finished as the team and conference leader in slugging last season, he was the national slugging champion with a .741 slugging percentage. So far this season, he is slugging .608 and his career .670 slugging percentage ranks second among active Division I players. His career .366 batting average ranks seventh in Division I. Osborne recorded three three-hit game against Tennessee Tech.

'Show Me' Baseball

The four Division I baseball teams in the state of Missouri are a combined 115-74 (.608) this season. The Redhawks have beaten all three of the other teams in the state this season but finished 3-1 with the lone loss coming on a walk off at Saint Louis May 2. This is the first season the Redhawks have defeated the three other teams in a single season.

Lees Added to Johnny Bench Watch List

Senior catcher Brian Lees is one of 85 catchers nationally to be named to the 2017 Johnny Bench Award watch list presented by The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission and BaseballSavings.com. Lees, a native of Brunswick, Ohio, makes his second appearance on the list in as many years. The OVC is represented by Lees, Hunter Fain (Morehead State), Tyler Lawrence (Murray State), Clay Payne (Belmont), and Logan Starnes (Eastern Kentucky) on the watch list.



Taming the Tigers

Southeast Missouri defeated in-state rival Missouri on Tuesday, Mar. 28, 6-5. Since the series was rekindled in 2013 after a six-year hiatus, the Redhawks have won four of the six total meetings, all in Columbia. Four of the six games have been decided by three runs or less with Tuesday's game being the second one-run game.

A New Era of SEMO Baseball

Andy Sawyers was appointed the sixth head coach of the Southeast Missouri baseball program on July 29, 2016. Sawyers brings 18 years of collegiate coaching experience with him to Southeast Missouri, Sawyers' first Division I head coaching job. Sawyers most recently served two seasons as the Associate Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator at Kansas State. Sawyers has been to two College World Series, three NCAA Super Regionals, and 10 Regional Tournaments. He has mentored 39 Major League Baseball draft picks including two first-round picks and eight top-10 round picks.

Redhawks Picked as OVC Favorites

2017 is the third-straight year the Redhawks have been picked to win the league in the preseason voting. It's the first time in league history that a team has been tabbed first in the preseason poll three consecutive times. The Redhawks are coming off three-straight OVC regular season titles and most recently won its third all-time OVC Tournament to punch their ticket to the NCAA Tournament. Southeast set a program record for wins a season ago, finishing 39-21 with a 22-8 conference record.

SEMO Lands Three Preseason All-OVC Picks

Outfielder Chris Osborne and starting pitchers Robert Beltran and Clay Chandler were chosen as Preseason All-OVC Team members. Southeast returns 21 total players to the 34-man roster. The roster is comprised of a formidable group of 11 seniors including the three Preseason All-OVC members in Osborne, Beltran, and Chandler.

NCBWA Preseason All-American

Senior outfielder Chris Osborne was named to the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Third Team All-America heading into the 2017 season. Osborne emerged as the national slugging percentage champion with a .741 slugging clip. He was named First Team All-Ohio Valley Conference and was an OVC All-Tournament team selection. The outfielder from Edmonds, Washington blasted a team-leading 15 home runs and led the squad with a .367 batting average. He appeared in 40 games including making 36 starts in right field. He finished third on the team with 44 runs batted in.

Makeup of the Roster

The 33-man roster is comprised of 20 returning players and 13 newcomers. Of the returners, four made a significant amount of starts including Chris Osborne, Trevor Ezell, Dan Holst, and Brian Lees.

Already a Stellar Career

In just two seasons as a Redhawk, Trevor Ezell enters his junior season having already cracked three career top-10 categories at SEMO and will soon crack a fourth. His 94 walks ranked eighth, eight career triples ranks tied for ninth, and his 34 stolen bases ranked tied for 10th. He is 15 runs away from cracking the top-10 runs category. His 118 starts is already a team-high, topping redshirt-senior Clayton Evans' 112 career starts.

Back in the Saddle

After missing last season due to injury, redshirt-senior Clayton Evans will look to work his way back into a starting role in the outfield this season. Evans made 30 starts in 2015 and finished the season hitting .352 and driving in 23 runs. Evans was a Freshman All-American in 2013.

Final National Stat Rankings

As a team, Southeast finished in the top-10 in five national statistical categories including drawing walks (fifth, 335), runs (sixth, 474), on base percentage (seventh, .409), strikeouts per nine innings (seventh, 9.2), and scoring (eighth, 7.9 runs per game).

A Facelift for the Home Field

Southeast Missouri baseball has called Capaha Field home since the program's inception in 1959.

Southeast Missouri signed 10 student-athletes to the 2018 baseball roster during the early signing period. 2017 OVC Baseball Championship

The 2017 OVC Baseball Championship will be held for the first time at Choccolocco Park in Oxford, Alabama. The format of the tournament will also be changed to an eight-team tournament. The No. 7 and 8 seeds will begin the tournament with a single-elimination play-in game before the double-elimination format begins. The only time the OVC Tournament field featured eight teams was in 1996 when the format featured preliminary rounds at the top two seeds and a championship round at the highest remaining seed.

HEAD COACH **ANDY SAWYERS**

Andy Sawyers was appointed the sixth head baseball of Southeast Missouri baseball on July 29, 2016.

Sawyers brings 18 years of collegiate coaching experience with him to Southeast Missouri, Sawyers' first Division I head coaching job. Sawyers most recently served two seasons as the Associate Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator at Kansas State out of the Big 12 Conference. He oversaw the hitters and catchers defensively as well as helped coordinate recruiting at K-State.

"I am very excited to welcome Andy and his family to the Southeast Missouri State community," Barke said. "Throughout the search process there were three main things I was looking for in our next head coach: great character, ability to recruit the region, and a talent to develop quality student-athletes. Andy excels in each of these areas. His postseason experience proves he knows how to win and compete on the national level."

"I would like to thank Brady and President Vargas for the opportunity to become the head baseball coach at Southeast Missouri," Sawyers said. "This is an incredible honor and I am appreciative of this wonderful opportunity."

"SEMO is a program on the rise. The conference championships, regional appearance, and upcoming facility enhancements speak volumes about the administration's commitment to baseball. Coach Bieser and his staff did a marvelous job and I am looking forward to contributing to the progress that is already happening in our program."

In his 18 years of coaching, Sawyers has been to two College World Series, three NCAA Super Regionals, and 10 Regional Tournaments. He has mentored 39 Major League Baseball draft picks including two first-round picks and eight top-10 round picks.

The Wildcats ranked fourth in the Big 12 offensively with a .284 team batting average in 2016. The Wildcat offense registered a .400 slugging percentage, .372 on base clip, scored 335 runs, scattered 550 hits, knocked 100 doubles, 17 triples, and 30 home runs while driving in 300 runs.

Sawyers mentored freshman Josh Rolette to earning Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American honors in 2016. He also helped guide Jake Scudder to the title of Big 12 Newcomer of the Year. In all, the Wildcats posted three student-athletes to All-Big 12 Teams last season.

The 2015 and 2016 seasons were Sawyers' second stint at Kansas State, serving as an assistant coach for the Wildcats in 2009 and 2010. K-State went 80-30-1 over those two seasons and made consecutive NCAA Regional appearances, the first two in school history.

The 2009 campaign was a year of power for the Wildcats under Sawyers. The team hit 22 triples and 58 home runs, the most in both categories since 1997. The offense shined when it came to stolen bases as the 149 steals were the second-most in the nation and two shy of breaking the Big 12 record. Overall, the team finished among the Big 12 leaders in on-base percentage (second, .399), runs scored (second, 458), hits (second, 675), RBI (second, 420), doubles (third, 123), and fewest strikeouts (fourth, 393).

Six Wildcats earned All-Big 12 honors in 2009, including outfielder Nick Martini, who also garnered Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American



honors, and Justin Bloxom and Carter Jurica, who finished fourth and eighth, respectively, in the Big 12 in batting average.

The 2010 squad matched the success of 2009 by also reaching the NCAA postseason, but the offense topped the previous season's totals in batting average (.323 in 2010; .317 in 2009), runs per game (7.6 vs. 7.4) and OBP (.426 vs. .399).

Prior to his most recent stop at Kansas State, Sawyers spent four seasons as the Associate Head Coach at Texas A&M (2011-14). Those four seasons at Texas A&M represented the conclusion of Sawyers' five total campaigns with the Aggies after he spent 2008 as a volunteer assistant coach.

In each of those five seasons, Sawyers helped Texas A&M reach an NCAA Regional while also winning two Big 12 championships. In addition, he coached standouts Tyler Naquin - 2011 Big 12 Player of the Year, All-American and a first round pick by the Cleveland Indians in 2012 - and Krey Bratson, a 2011 Freshman All-American.

Prior to his appointment at Texas A&M in 2008, Sawyers worked with current Aggie head coach Rob Childress as an assistant coach and the recruiting coordinator at Nebraska from 2003-07. While in Lincoln, he helped the Huskers earn four trips to the NCAA Tournament, including an appearance at the 2005 College World Series. Sawyers, who lettered two years at Nebraska, worked with 12 Huskers who were selected in the MLB Draft, including Alex Gordon, a two-time Big 12 Player of the Year. In 2005, Gordon won five national player of the year awards before being taken as the second overall pick by the Kansas City Royals.

Sawyers took on all hitting coach responsibilities at Nebraska



beginning with the 2006 season, when the team batted .310 - its best mark in four years - and ranked in the top three of the Big 12 in home runs, stolen bases, OBP and slugging.

Also during his time in Lincoln, Sawyers served as the academic coordinator and worked with the catchers. Additionally, Sawyers helped the Huskers recruit their then-highest-rated class in school history, as the 2004 recruiting class was ranked 16th nationally by Collegiate Baseball.

After serving as the volunteer assistant at Nebraska in 2000, Sawyers spent the 2001 and 2002 seasons as the head coach at Hutchinson Community College, compiling an 87-30 record and two postseason berths. In 2001, the Dragons went 40-16 and won the Jayhawk West Sub-Regional, while the 2002 squad set a school record with 47 wins and was ranked as high as seventh by the NJCAA.

Sawyers' coaching career began at Northwestern (La.) State in 1999 as a volunteer assistant coach, helping the Demons finish second in the Southland Conference.

Sawyers first played collegiately at Point Loma (Calif.) Nazarene College in 1994. Following a year off, he played at Mendocino (Calif.) Junior College in 1996 before finishing up his playing career at Nebraska.

A native of Willits, California, Sawyers received his bachelor's (1998) and master's (2000) degrees from Nebraska. He is married to the former Dena Lindeblad and the couple have one child, Andrew James (A.J.) who is six years old.
