Southeast Missouri (5-7) wraps up its non-conference schedule when it hosts Abilene Christian (9-2) Friday. Tip-off is set for 6:30 p.m., CT, at the Show Me Center.

Series History

Southeast Missouri owns a 3-0 lead in its all-time series against Southland Conference member Abilene Christian. All three of those matchups were played when SEMO was an NCAA Division II school. The Redhawks and Wildcats last met 33 years ago in the NCAA Division II South Central Regional. SEMO won that game, 94-72, on Mar. 7, 1986 in Cape Girardeau. The Redhawks finished as the NCAA Division II national runner-up after coming up short in a 93-87 loss to Sacred Heart in the title game that year.

Non-Conference Finale

The Redhawks look to end non-conference play with a victory for the third time in four years under head coach Rick Ray. Southeast Missouri wrapped up non-league action with a 94-84 win over Harris-Stowe on Dec. 27, 2015 and an 89-75 victory over Henderson State on Dec. 29. 2016.

Merry Christmas

Friday's matchup with Abilene Christian is Southeast Missouri's final game before the Christmas holiday. The Redhawks will take a 12-day break before opening their 18-game Ohio Valley Conference slate at SIU Edwardsville on Jap. 3.

Looking to Regroup

The Redhawks are looking to snap a three-game losing streak Friday. Southeast Missouri is 1-4 in December with its lone win of the month coming at Mississippi Valley State on Dec. 4 (77-57).

Strong Showing in Tallahassee

Southeast Missouri led #10 Florida State for almost 22 minutes in its 85-68 loss on Dec. 17. SEMO led by double figures twice when a Gabe McGlothan layup gave the Redhawks an 18-8 advantage and a Skyler Hogan 3-pointer put SEMO ahead, 21-10, in the first half.

Draining 3s

The Redhawks matched a season-high 14 three-pointers at Florida State (Dec. 17). SEMO shot 14-of-37 behind the arc with seven treys in each half. Skyler Hogan paved the way with four 3-pointers made marking the second time he has made four or more threes in a game this year.

More from the Arc

Southeast Missouri leads the Ohio Valley Conference in 3-pointers made and 3-pointers attempted through 12 games this season. The Redhawks drained 114 three-pointers in 329 attempts. In the last three games alone, SEMO shot an average of 35.6 threes per contest. The Redhawks rank 17th in the nation in 3-point field goal attempts and 24th in 3-point field goals made.

Brewer Nets Season-High

Ledarrius Brewer resumed his position as Southeast Missouri's top scorer this season following a season-high 24-point performance at The Citadel (Dec. 15). Brewer shot 9-of-17 from the field and knocked down a season-best 5-of-10 three-pointers against the Bulldogs. He also dished out two assists and had a pair of blocks. Brewer leads the team with 13.4 points per game.

Hogan Shines

Guard Skyler Hogan is Southeast Missouri's second-leading scorer with 12.5 points a game. Hogan tops the Redhawks with 26 three-pointers made and is SEMO's best free throw shooter with a 92.3 percent clip. He scored double figures in eight of his previous 10 contests. Additionally, Hogan buried multiple 3-pointers in each of his last six games.

OVC Play is Next

Southeast Missouri officially begins its 18-game Ohio Valley Conference slate at SIU Edwardsville on Jan. 3. The Redhawks were picked to finish ninth in this year's OVC Preseason Poll. Belmont was tabbed the preseason-favorite and is currently 9-1 this year.

Caldwell Sees Double

Freshman guard Alex Caldwell finished with double-digit points off the bench for the fifth time this season when he scored 14 against The Citadel (Dec. 15). A native of Columbia, South Carolina, Caldwell hit 6-of-10 field goals and drained a pair of 3-pointers. He scored seven points in the first six minutes he played. Hogan Does it Again

Junior guard Skyler Hogan picked up his second Ohio Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week award on Dec. 10. A transfer from Embry-Riddle, Hogan averaged 19.5 points, three rebounds, 2.5 assists and one block a game while hitting 53.6 percent (15-of-28) from the field and 53.3 percent (8-of-15) from 3-point range in two games last week. He scored a season-best 25 points in the team's 77-57 win at Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4). In that game, Hogan made 10-of-16 field goals (5-of-8 three-pointers), dished out four assists, blocked two shots, grabbed two rebounds and had a steal in 35 minutes of action. Despite a stomach illness that forced him to come off the bench and play limited minutes against Southern Illinois (Dec. 8), Hogan still managed 14 points, four rebounds and an assist in 25 minutes versus the Salukis He currently ranks sixth in the OVC in 3-point percentage (45.5 pct.) and seventh in 3-pointers made (2 per game). Eastern Kentucky forward Nick Mayo (Player of the Week) and Belmont center Nick Muszynski (Freshman of the Week) rounded out the week's honorees.

Russell Logs First Start

Freshman guard Nygal Russell logged his first career start against Southern Illinois (Dec. 8). Russell started in place of Skyler Hogan who came off the bench due to a stomach illness. Russell scored two points and had two rebounds in 17 minutes. He is the fourth different Redhawk to get his first career Division I start this year.

Defending the Three

Southeast Missouri enters the weekend ranked 22nd in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage defense. Opponents are shooting 28 percent against the Redhawks from behind the arc. The Redhawks rank third in the Ohio Valley Conference behind Murray State (21.6 percent) and Austin Peay (27.8 percent) in that category.

Winning November

The Redhawks wrapped up their first month of the season with a record of 4-3. It was the first winning record in November since the Redhawks went 5-2 in their first seven games of 2013-14.

Brewer Regroups

After scoring a combined eight points in his previous two starts, Ledarrius Brewer bounced back to lead Southeast Missouri with 17 points

<u>Preseason Player of the Year</u> Dylan Windler, G/F, Belmont against Southern Illinois (Dec. 8). Brewer shot 6-of-15 from the field, knocked down two 3-pointers and made 3-of-4 free throws. He also grabbed three rebounds and had two steals in 31 minutes. Brewer has scored in double figures during 10 of his 12 starts this season.

Brewer On a Roll

After scoring five points or less in two-straight games, Ledarrius Brewer averaged 19 per contest in his last three starts. Brewer shot 46.6 percent (21-of-45) from the field, buried nine 3-pointers, grabbed 10 rebounds, dished out six assists and had four steals in that span.

Home Record

Southeast Missouri is 2-2 at home this season. Both of those wins came against non-Division I opponents. SEMO beat Quincy, 102-66, on Nov. 12 and Missouri S&T, 72-69, on Nov. 27. The Redhawks lost to Western Illinois, 70-63, on Dec. 1 and Southern Illinois, 83-73, on Dec. 8.

Nice Defense

Southeast Missouri ranks third in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring defense allowing 69.6 points per game in 11 contests.

Chattanooga's 42 points were the fewest allowed by SEMO this season. Murray State leads the league in that category with 56.5 points per game allowed. The Redhawks are also third in field goal percentage defense (.411).

About Abilene Christian

Abilene Christian comes to Cape Girardeau with a 9-2 record this season. ACU leads the Southland Conference in scoring (77.2 ppg), scoring defense (63.3 ppg allowed), scoring margin (+13.9), 3-point field goal percentage (41.4), rebounding defense (29.1 rpg), turnover margin (+5.2) and assist/turnover ratio (1.39). Jaren Lewis leads the Wildcats with 14.6 points per game as one of three players averaging double figures in the scoring column. Payten Ricks leads the team with 27 steals and is 19th in the nation with 2.45 per game. ACU is ninth nationally in 3-point field goal percentage and 11th in turnover margin.

Against the Southland Conference

Southeast Missouri is 20-8 all-time against Southland Conference schools. That includes a 9-6 record vs. Central Arkansas, a 0-1 record vs. Nicholls State, a 6-0 mark vs. Southeastern Louisiana, a 2-0 record vs. Texas-Arlington, a 2-0 record vs. New Orleans and a 1-1 mark vs. McNeese State.

On the Way to 100

Ledarrius Brewer is making his way closer to the 100 mark in career free throws and 3-pointers made. Brewer has drained 94 three-pointers and 92 free throws through 43 games and 39 starts as a Redhawk.

Starting Streak

Ledarrius Brewer has started 38-consecutive games dating back to last season. Brewer has scored in 32-straight starts. He also pitched in double figures in 28 of his last 33 contests. Meanwhile, Jonathan Dalton started 39-consecutive games at point guard.

Gable and McGlothan Take a Bow

Sophomore Isaiah Gable and freshman Gabe McGlothan each reached double-digits in the scoring column for the first time in their careers. Gable scored 11 points with nine coming from 3-point range, while McGlothan finished with 11 points, eight rebounds and four blocks in a narrow miss of a double-double at Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4).

On Guard

The Redhawks put together a nice defensive performance in their 77-57 win over Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4). Southeast Missouri held the Delta Devils to just 31 percent (18-of-58) from the field and 13.3 percent (2-of-15) from 3-point range. The .133 three-point field goal percentage was the lowest by any opponent SEMO has faced through 11 games this season.

Swat Team

Southeast Missouri registered a season-high nine blocks at Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4), the Redhawks most in any game with Rick Ray as their head coach. SEMO had no more than three blocks in its first 101 games under Ray. The nine blocks were the Redhawks most since they had nine at UT Martin on Feb. 16, 2013.

Tolbert Strong Underneath

Freshman Sage Tolbert leads Southeast Missouri with 6.4 rebounds per game. Tolbert grabbed 10 or more rebounds a team-high three tims this season. His 11 rebounds at Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4) marked a season-high. Tolbert ranks 13th in the Ohio Valley Conference in that category.

Free Throw Margin

Southeast Missouri has been outscored at the free throw line in 10 of its first 12 games this season. In the last six games alone, opponents held a 95-34 advantage at the free throw line. SEMO is attempting 13.5 free throws per game, fewest in the Ohio Valley Conference of the teams that have played 10 or more games.

Tolbert Notches Double-Double

Freshman forward Sage Tolbert notched the first double-double of his career when he scored 11 points and grabbed 10 rebounds against Western Illinois (Dec. 1). Tolbert shot 4-of-8 from the field in 26 minutes. He became the second Redhawk to get a double-double in as many games.

Brewer Sinks Missouri S&T

Ledarrius Brewer turned in a double-double 20 points and career-high 11 rebounds, and made three free throws in the final seven seconds to send Southeast Missouri to a 72-69 victory over Missouri S&T (Nov. 27). Brewer picked up his first double-double of the season and second of his career. He shot 7-of-13 from the field, knocked down three 3-pointers, dished out one assist and had two steals in 34 minutes. Brewer became SEMO's first player to score 20 points in a game this season.

Where They Rank

Ledarrius Brewer ranks among Ohio Valley Conference leaders in scoring (13th, 13.4 ppg), rebounding (17th, 5.6 ppg), defensive rebounds (11th, 5.0 rpg), 3-point field goals made (9th, 1.9) and minutes played (27th, 27.8 mpg). Sage Tolbert is 13th in the conference in rebounding (6.4 rpg) and 11th in offensive rebounds (2.3 rpg). Alex Caldwell ranks 11th in 3-point field goal percentage (.391) and Jonathan Dalton is sixth in assists (3.6 apg) and eighth in assist/turnover ratio (1.6). Skyler Hogan ranks 18th in scoring (12.5 ppg), fifth in 3-point field goal percentage (.448) and eighth in 3-point field goals made (2.2 per game).

Same Starting Five

The Redhawks have gone with the same five starters in 11 of their first 12 games of the 2018-19 season. Guards Jonathan Dalton, Ledarrius Brewer and Skyler Hogan, and forwards Isaiah Gable and Sage Tolbert started each of the first nine contests. It marked the first time Southeast Missouri went with the same five starters through its first nine games of a season under head coach Rick Ray. The Redhawks used a different starting combination for the first time when Nygal Russell started at guard in place of Hogan who had a stomach illness vs. Southern Illinois (Dec. 8).

First Win

Southeast Missouri picked up its first win of the season with a 102-66 pasting of NCAA Divsion II member Quincy (Nov. 12). Freshman Alex Caldwell scored 15 points to lead six Redhawks in double figures. Eleven different players ended up in the scoring column for SEMO, which drained 14 three-pointers and shot a blazing 62.9 percent (39-of-62) from the field. The Redhawks also finished with 22 assists and turned the ball over seven times, including only twice in the second half.

Solid Alabama Tournament

The Redhawks wrapped up the Ungar Classic in Mobile, Alabama with a 2-1 record and second-place finish behind tournament host South Alabama. Southeast Missouri beat

Jacksonville, 77-71, on Nov. 16, Chattanooga, 63-42, on Nov. 17 and fell to South Alabama, 79-58, on Nov. 19. SEMO had a three-game winning streak prior to its loss against the Jaguars.

Hogan Named OVC Newcomer of the Week

Southeast Missouri guard Skyler Hogan was named Ohio Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week on Nov. 19. Hogan won the first OVC weekly award of his career. A transfer from Embry-Riddle, Hogan led SEMO to three victories last week, including two at the South Alabama Ungar Classic. He averaged 13.7 points and 5.3 rebounds per game, while shooting 48.4 percent (15-of-31) from the field, 58.3 percent (7-of-12) from 3-point range and a perfect 4-of-4 at the free throw line. The redshirt-junior scored in double figures all three contests. He had 12 points and three rebounds in 21 minutes against Quincy (Nov. 12) and followed that up with 14 points and seven rebounds against Jacksonville (Nov. 16). Hogan then ended the week by scoring 15 points, grabbing six rebounds and gathering two blocks in a 21-point win over Chattanooga (Nov. 17). Additionally, he committed only one turnover in 76 minutes of playing time. Austin Peay's Terry Taylor (Player) and Belmont's Nick Muszvnski (Freshman) rounded out this week's honorees.

Redhawks Win Home-Opener

With its 102-66 victory over Quincy (Nov. 12), Southeast Missouri improved to 21-6 all-time in home-openers since joining the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92. The Redhawks opened their home slate with a win in six of the last seven years and posted victories in 13 of their last 16 home-opening dates.

Century Mark

The Redhawks scored 100 points for the first time with Rick Ray as their head coach when they beat Quincy, 102-66, on Nov. 12. It was Southeast Missouri's most points in a game since it put up 118 in a 118-115 double overtime win over Murray State on Mar. 1, 2014. SEMO's previous high in points under Ray was 95 in a 96-95 overtime loss at Louisiana Tech on Nov. 13, 2017.

Brewer Clears 500 Career Points

Sophomore guard Ledarrius Brewer cleared 500 career points at the Ungar Classic in Mobile, Ala. (Nov. 16, 17 & 19). Brewer, who has scored double figures 10 of 12 games this season, enters the weekend with 610 points and a career 14.2 points per game average.

Cuffee and Laros Nab Career-Highs

In his first career Division I game, Khalil Cuffee scored a career-high 12 points in eight minutes off the bench against Quincy (Nov. 12). Cuffee knocked down two 3-pointers and shot 5-of-6 from the field. He also dished out one assist and had two steals. Cuffee scored the basket that gave SEMO 100 points and followed with another bucket to put the Redhawks over that mark. Laros, meanwhile, notched a career-high 13 points on 6-of-8 field goals and 1-of-2 free throws off the bench. He added three rebounds and one assist in 21 minutes.

Caldwell of to a Good Start

Freshman point guard Alex Caldwell is off to a strong start in his rookie campaign. Caldwell scored double figures in three of his first four games at Southeast Missouri. He is third on the team in scoring with 9.6 points a game. Caldwell is also SEMO's second-best free throw shooter with a 78.9 percent clip (15-of-19).

Give it Up for the Freshmen

Freshmen Alex Caldwell (115), Khalil Cuffee (25), Sage Tolbert (76), Nygal Russell (51) and Gabe McGlothan (72) combined for 339 of Southeast Missouri's 849 points through 112 games. SEMO's freshmen have accounted for just under 40 percent (39.9) of the scoring in that stretch.

First Career Starts

Sophomore Isaiah Gable, junior Skyler Hogan and freshman Sage Tolbert made their first career starts at Saint Louis (Nov. 6). Gable scored six points, Tolbert added seven points and five rebounds, and Hogan added four points and four boards. Nygal Russell became the fourth Redhawk to make his first career start vs. Southern Illinois (Dec. 8).

Division I Debuts

Six different Redhawks, including Sage Tolbert, Skyler Hogan, Alex Caldwell, Oscar Kao, Nygal Russell and Gabe McGlothan played their first NCAA Division I game at Saint Louis (Nov. 6). Caldwell (14), Tolbert (7) and McGlothan (7), all freshmen, combined for 28 points.

Non-Conference Play

The Redhawks have 20 non-conference wins with Rick Ray as their head coach. Southeast Missouri's most non-conference victories in a season under Ray stand at six during both the 2016-17 and 2017-18 campaigns. SEMO ended a four-game losing streak against non-conference opponents with a 102-66 victory over Quincy (Nov. 12).

Laros Steps Up

Mark Laros scored double figures in back-to-back games for the first time in his NCAA Division I career. Laros pitched in a career-high 13 points off the bench against Quincy (Nov. 12) and followed that up with 11 points and eight rebounds four days later vs. Jacksonville (Nov. 16). He is averaging 4.3 points and 3.3 rebounds per game through 10 contests this season. Laros also went over 100 career rebounds (139).

Brewer Lands Preseason All-OVC Honors

Sophomore guard Ledarrius Brewer was named to the 2018-19 Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference Team on Oct. 23. A native of Meridian, Mississippi, Brewer averaged 14.5 points per game as SEMO's second-leading scorer as a freshman. He played in 31 games, made 27 starts and led the Redhawks with 71 three-pointers made. Brewer ranked 14th in the OVC in scoring, 15th in free throw percentage (.740), sixth in 3-point field goals made (2.3 per game) and 21st in minutes played (29.4 mpg). third in steals (29) as an OVC All-Newcomer selection during his rookie campaign.

Welcome to Division I

This season marks the first year of NCAA Division I basketball for nine players on Southeast Missouri's roster. Skyler Hogan, Khalil Cuffee, Alex Caldwell, Jordan Love, Oscar Kao, Nygal Russell, Jack Lake, Sage Tolbert and Gabe McGlothan are new to the NCAA Division I scene this year. Hogan, Caldwell, Kao, Russell, Tolbert and McGlothan saw action in their first Division I game at Saint Louis (Nov. 6).

Fourth Year

Rick Ray is in his fourth year as Southeast Missouri's head coach. From top to bottom, SEMO has its most talented roster with Ray at the helm. The Redhawks finished their 2017-18 season with an overall record of 14-17 and 8-10 in the Ohio Valley Conference. SEMO finished seventh in the OVC standings, three spots ahead of where it was picked in the league's Preseason Poll (10th).

Eligible for Postseason Play

The NCAA's academic and membership affairs granted Southeast Missouri full relief from all practice and competition restrictions for the 2018-19 academic year related to the team's four-year Academic Progress Rate score. Having improved their score and put in place a number of departmental enhancements, the Redhawks will be able to compete in the postseason and there will be zero restrictions this upcoming season. In 2017-18, SEMO was unable to compete in the postseason due to a NCAA Academic Progress Rate historic penalty.

Roster Breakdown

Southeast Missouri's 15-man roster includes seven returnees and eight newcomers. The Redhawks return two starters in guards Ledarrius Brewer and Jonathan Dalton. Brewer ranked second on the team in scoring with 14.5 points per game in 31 games and 27 starts as a freshman, while Dalton started 30 games at point guard, leading the team in assists (168) and steals (38) a year ago.

Season 112

The 2018-19 campaign marks the 112th season of Southeast Missouri basketball. It is also SEMO's 28th season at the NCAA Division I level. The Redhawks are 330-467 overall and 184-270 in the Ohio Valley Conference as a NCAA Division I program. SEMO also has 15 OVC Tournament appearances, one OVC regular-season championship (2000), one OVC

Tournament title (2000) and one NCAA Tournament berth (2000) in its Division I era.

3-Point Record Again

Southeast Missouri drained a single-season school record 289 three-pointers in 2017-18, averaging 9.3 per game. SEMO made 10 or more 3-pointers in 15 contests. The Redhawks buried a season-best 16 three-pointers at Eastern Kentucky (Feb. 26). SEMO's 289 threes surpassed its previous record of 263 the year before. The Redhawks topped the OVC with a .392 three-point field goal percentage.

Big Freshman Year

Guard Ledarrius Brewer is looking to build on his big rookie season. Brewer is Southeast Missouri's top returning scorer, who averaged 14.5 points in 31 contests and 27 starts as a freshman. He ranked second on the team in scoring and led the Redhawks with 71 three-pointers made. Brewer ranked first on the team in blocks (16), third in steals (29) and second in assists (57) He rated 14th in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring, 15th in free throw percentage (.740), sixth in 3-point field goals made (2.3 per game) and 21st in minutes played (29.4 mpg). Brewer scored double figures in 24 of his 27 starts.

Running Point

Senior Jonathan Dalton is back as Southeast Missouri's starting point guard. Dalton, who hails from New Orleans, Louisiana, started 30 games and led the Redhawks in assists (168) and steals (38) last season. He also surpassed 200 assists in his career. Dalton is one of four players on this year's roster who are capable of playing the point guard spot. Fellow returnee Donnie Lewis and newcomers Oscar Kao and Alex Caldwell are the others. It's the first time under head coach Rick Ray where there have been this many players available to play point guard.

Season Sweeps

The Redhawks recorded three sweeps of Ohio Valley Conference opponents in 2017-18. Southeast Missouri swept SIU Edwardsville, Morehead State and Eastern Illinois. The Redhawks now have a total of five season sweeps of league opponents under head coach Rick Ray.

OVC Preseason Poll

Southeast Missouri was picked ninth in the 2018-19 Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll. The Redhawks collected 82 points in the overall voting by OVC Head Coaches and Sports Information Directors. Belmont (227 pts., 8 first-place votes) was tabbed the preseason-favorite followed by Murray State (221 pts., 9 first-place votes), Jacksonville State (211 pts., 7 first-place votes), Austin Peay (188 pts.), Tennessee Tech (135 pts.), Eastern Kentucky (118 pts.), Eastern Illinois (116 pts.), Tennessee State (101 pts.), SEMO, Morehead State (78 pts.), UT Martin (77 pts.) and SIU Edwardsville (30 pts.). Belmont guard/forward Dylan Windler was voted Preseason OVC Player of the Year.

Rick Ray has the Southeast Missouri men's basketball program moving in the right direction as the Redhawks continue to show significant improvement under his leadership.

SEMO finished its 2017-18 season with an overall record of 14-17 and 8-10 mark in the Ohio Valley Conference. The Redhawks finished seventh in the league standings, three spots ahead of where they were picked in the preseason poll.

The Redhawks drained a single-season school record 289 three-pointers in Ray's third year as head coach last season. SEMO made 10 or more 3-pointers in 15 contests and led the

OVC with a .392 three-point field goal percentage.

Guards Denzel Mahoney and Ledarrius Brewer represented SEMO on the 2017-18 All-Ohio Valley Conference teams. Mahoney earned first-team honors, while Brewer secured All-Newcomer accolades. Brewer, who ranked second on the team in scoring as a freshman, returns to the perimeter this upcoming season.

A year before that, Ray led SEMO to a +10 increase in the win column as the Redhawks were the 22nd Most Improved Team in NCAA Division I Basketball. SEMO finished at 15-18 overall and second in the Ohio Valley Conference West Division with a 9-7 mark after going 5-24 and placing last in the OVC in 2015-16.

SEMO made its 15th all-time OVC Tournament appearance with Ray winning the first game he coached at the event when the Redhawks erased a 14-point deficit to beat Tennessee State in overtime.

Statistically, SEMO made huge strides from the previous season. The Redhawks ranked among the top-five in the OVC in several categories, including steals (1st, 7.7), assist/turnover ratio (5th, 1.1) and 3-point field goals made (5th, 8.0). SEMO made its biggest jump from the 2015-16 season in turnover margin (8th to 1st), 3-point field goal percentage (last to 2nd) and free throw percentage (last to 2nd). Nationally, the Redhawks went from 331st to 49th in free throw percentage and 336th to 59th in total 3-point field goals made, while improving in many

other areas during the 2016-17 campaign.

Additionally, Ray coached a pair of All-OVC selections in guards Antonius Cleveland and Denzel Mahoney. Cleveland, who earned first-team honors, became the first SEMO player to make the national College Slam Dunk Championship and initially agreed to a deal with the Golden State Warriors. He played with both the Dallas Mavericks and Atlanta Hawks before joining the Chicago Bulls on July 23, 2018

Mahoney was the league's Freshman of the Year, a second-team pick, All-Newcomer selection and OVC All-Tournament Team honoree. It was the first time the Redhawks had multiple All-OVC selections since 2013-14 (Tyler Stone, Jarekious Bradley).


Following the 2016-17 campaign, Ray received a two-year contract extension that runs through the 2020-21 season.

Ray was introduced as the 20th head coach in SEMO men's basketball history on April 13, 2015. He is the first African-American head coach in the 111-year history of the program.

A tireless worker, Ray is structuring his program to achieve success both on the court and in the classroom.

In his first summer on the job, Ray challenged his players to excel academically and they did so by accumulating a 3.38 grade point average, the program's highest in a summer term.

Twelve of the 15 players enrolled in summer classes posted a 3.0 or higher GPA. To





take it even further, Ray convinced other players to remain on campus and finish what they started. As a result, seven players graduated. Nino Johnson, Jarekious Bradley, Darrian Gray and J.J. Thompson, along with former players Corey Wilford, Waylon Jones and Dainmon Gonner all earned their bachelor degrees.

The next summer, the Redhawks recorded a 3.33 GPA with six players achieving a 4.0 and 11 notching a 3.0 or higher GPA.

In Fall, 2017, SEMO's men's basketball team made the biggest improvement of all Redhawk athletic teams from the previous Fall, 2016 semester when it raised its grade point average .613 points to a 3.08. That fall, the basketball team was the only men's sport that registered a 3.0 GPA.

Ray's 2015-16 team was the first to play in a newlyrenovated Show Me Center, which has served as home to Redhawk Basketball since 1987.

One of the best basketball arenas in the OVC, the Show Me Center received a new state-of-the-art center-hung video board, brand new telescopic seating, a new exterior roof and additional improvements to lighting and sound systems. All renovations were completed for the 2015-16 campaign.

Prior to SEMO, Ray spent three seasons as head coach at Mississippi State. He led the Bulldogs to a 2-2 mark in the SEC Tournament, including an upset win against Vanderbilt in 2013-14. Ray helped the development of two All-SEC freshmen in Craig Sword and Gavin Ware, as his recruiting classes received national attention. In addition, Ray had a 100 percent graduation rate during his tenure at MSU.

Certainly no stranger to NCAA postseason play, Ray has been an assistant at three different institutions that enjoyed success at the highest level.

Before arriving in Starkville, Mississippi, Ray spent two seasons at Clemson, where he was associate head coach to Brad Brownell. Ray also spent four successful years on the staff of Matt Painter at Purdue. He began his Division I coaching career at Indiana State, serving seven seasons.

All three programs participated in the NCAA Tournament. While at Clemson coaching in the highly-competitive Atlantic Coast Conference, the Tigers won 38 games during Ray's two-year stint as associate head coach. In 2010-11, the Tigers finished the year with a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 mark in the ACC en route to making the NCAA Tournament for the fourth-straight season. Clemson advanced to the second round of the tournament that year.

Ray was an assistant coach from 2006-10 under Painter at Purdue, where the Boilermakers won 103 games during his first four years on staff, including 15 victories over Top 25 competition. During his tenure, Purdue advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season and made the Sweet 16 his last two years there.

In 2009, the Boilermakers won the Big Ten Tournament and secured a No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. A year later, Ray helped the Boilermakers to 29 wins, tied for the most in Purdue history for a single season. Purdue earned a No. 4 seed and lost in the round of 16 to eventual NCAA champion Duke during the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

Ray was part of the 2006-07 Purdue staff that signed arguably the top class in school history, a group that was rated No. 5 nationally by Scout.com and No. 6 by Rivals.com. That class included All-Americans Robbie Hummel and JaJuan Johnson and current NBA player E'Twaun Moore.

While at Purdue, Ray was on Painter's staff that also included Cuonzo Martin, who recently completed his second season at Cal, and Paul Lusk, who is head coach at Missouri State.

Ray coached at Missouri Valley Conference member Indiana State for a period of seven years (1997-2004), helping ISU to consecutive 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament appearances in 1999-2000 and 2000-01. In 1999-2000, the Sycamores compiled a 14-4 record in the MVC and won the regular season title. ISU then won the MVC Tournament the following season. The Sycamores later upset No. 4 seed Oklahoma in the first round of the 2001 NCAA Tournament. In addition, Ray was part of the ISU staff that defeated perennial power Indiana in back-to-back seasons.

Following his time at ISU, Ray spent two seasons (2004-06) as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Northern Illinois. In 2005-06, the Huskies were regular season Western Division champions in the Mid-American Conference for the first time in school history with a 17-11 overall record and 12-6 ledger in the MAC.

Ray began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Nebras-ka-Omaha, a Division II program. He helped orchestrate a seven-win turnaround during his second season in 1996-97.

A standout player for Grand View College (Iowa), Ray was an All-American Scholar-Athlete and honorable mention allconference performer in 1993.

He earned his undergraduate degree in applied mathematics and secondary education from Grand View in 1994. Ray received his master's degree in athletic administration from Nebraska-Omaha in 1997.

Those type of heralded credentials helped Ray make the transition to head coach.

In 2013, he was the recipient of Grand View's Distinguished Alumni Award.

Born in Gardena, California, Ray moved to Kansas City, Kansas with his family when he was six years old.

Ray and his wife, Breyana, have two sons, Deacon and Mason, and a daughter, Katriece.


