#### **Series History**

Southeast Missouri and Southern Illinois meet for the 116th time on the hardwood Saturday. SIU holds a 69-46 lead in the all-time series which goes all the way back to 1914. The Redhawks won two of the last three meetings between the teams, including a 55-54 victory on a buzzer-beater in Cape Girardeau (Dec. 10, 2014) and a 75-69 win in Carbondale (Dec. 9, 2017). SIU, however, owns a 13-3 record in the previous 16 matchups between these teams.

#### **Against the Missouri Valley**

Southern Illinois is the second Missouri Valley Conference team Southeast Missouri faces this season. The Redhawks dropped a 68-57 decision at Bradley (Nov. 10) during the opening week of the 2018-19 campaign. SEMO holds an all-time record of 110-191 against the MVC. That record includes a 46-69 mark against SIU, 0-1 record vs. Drake, 5-10 record vs. Evansville, 2-9 mark vs. Bradley, 1-8 record vs. Illinois

State, 0-2 record vs. Indiana State and 55-92 mark vs. Missouri State.

#### **Home Record**

Southeast Missouri is 2-1 at home this season. Both of those wins came against non-Division I opponents. SEMO beat Quincy, 102-66, on Nov. 12 and Missouri S&T, 72-69, on Nov. 27. The Redhawks lost to Western Illinois, 70-63, on Dec. 1.

#### **Final Exams**

After Saturday's matchup with Southern Illinois, Southeast Missouri will take a week off for final exams. The Redhawks will return to action with a two-game road trip to The Citadel (Dec. 15) and Florida State (Dec. 17). SEMO will then wrap up non-conference play with a home game against Abilene Christian (Dec. 21) four days before Christmas.

#### **Winning November**

The Redhawks wrapped up their first month of the season with a record of 4-3. It was the first winning record in November since the Redhawks went 5-2 in their first seven games of 2013-14.

#### It's Been Awhile

If Southeast Missouri beats Southern Illinois Saturday, it will mark the first time since 1963 where SEMO recorded consecutive wins in its series against the Salukis. That year, the Redhawks won, 72-68, in Carbondale (Jan. 16) and, 67-60, in Cape Girardeau (Feb. 13).

#### **Familiar with the MVC**

Rick Ray's first NCAA Division I coaching job was at Indiana State. Ray was an assistant coach there from 1997-2004, helping ISU to consecutive 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament appearances in 1999-2000 and 2000-01. In 1999-2000, the Sycamores compiled a 14-4 record in the Missouri Valley Conference and won the regular-season title. ISU then won the MVC Tournament the following season. The Sycamores upset No. 4 seed Oklahoma in the first round of the 2001 NCAA Tournament. In addition, Ray was part of the ISU staff that defeated perennial power Indiana in back-to-back seasons. Ray was also on Purdue's coaching staff with former Southern Illinois coaches Matt Painter and Paul Lusk. He is 2-8 against MVC schools as a head coach (0-3 vs. Bradley; 0-2 vs. Evansville; 1-2 vs. Missouri State: 1-1 vs. Southern Illinois).

#### First True Road Win

Southeast Missouri picked up its first true road win with a 77-57 victory over Southwestern Athletic Conference member Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4). The Redhawks beat the Delta Devils for the first time in four meetings. It was the first matchup between the teams in 17 years.

#### **Hogan to the Top**

Guard Skyler Hogan took over as Southeast Missouri's top scorer after a career-high 25-point effort at Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4). Hogan shot 10-of-16 (62.5 pct.) from the field and knocked down five 3-pointers against the Delta Devils. He boosted his average to 12.7 points a game this season and has scored double figures in six of his last seven starts. The 25 points are the most scored in a game by any Redhawk this year.

#### **Gable and McGlothan Take a Bow**

Sophomore Isaiah Gable and freshman Gabe McGlothan each reached double-digits in the scoring column for the first time in their careers. Gable scored 11 points with nine coming from 3-point range, while McGlothan finished with 11 points, eight rebounds and four blocks in a narrow miss of a double-double at Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4).

#### **On Guard**

The Redhawks put together a nice defensive performance in their 77-57 win over Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4). Southeast Missouri held the Delta Devils to just 31 percent (18-of-58) from the field and 13.3 percent (2-of-15) from 3-point range. The .133 three-point field goal percentage was the lowest by any opponent SEMO has faced through nine games this season.

#### **Swat Team**

Southeast Missouri registered a season-high nine blocks at Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4), the Redhawks most in any game with Rick Ray as their head coach. SEMO had no more than three blocks in its first 101 games under Ray. The nine blocks were the Redhawks most since they had nine at UT Martin on Feb. 16, 2013.

#### **Starting Streak**

Ledarrius Brewer has started 35-consecutive games dating back to last season. Brewer has scored in 29-straight starts. He also pitched in double figures in 25 of his last 30 contests. Meanwhile, Jonathan Dalton started 36-consecutive games at point guard.

#### **About the Salukis**

Southern Illinois, winners in six of its last seven games, carries a four-game winning streak to Cape Girardeau this weekend. The Salukis are coming off a 61-56 home win over Preseason Atlantic 10 favorite Saint Louis (Dec. 5). Armon Fletcher leads five players averaging double figures in the scoring column with 13.5 points per game. Aaron Cook (11.2), Sean Lloyd (10.6), Kavion Pippen (10.6) and Eric McGill (10.0) follow. Fletcher, Lloyd, Pippen and Cook were SIU's top four scorers a year ago.

#### **Return to the Show Me Center**

Former Southeast Missouri guard and currently Southern Illinois' top reserve, guard Eric McGill returns to the Show Me Center Saturday. McGill averages 10 points a game as one of five Salukis averaging double figure sin the scoring column. He also leads SIU with nine steals and is second on the team with 24 assists. McGill was initially part of Rick Ray's first recruiting class at SEMO in 2015-16. He

<u>Preseason Player of the Year</u> Dylan Windler, G/F, Belmont averaged seven points and 2.4 rebounds in 27 games and 13 starts that year.

#### **Tolbert Strong Underneath**

Freshman Sage Tolbert leads Southeast Missouri with just under seven (6.9) rebounds per game. Tolbert grabbed 10 or more rebounds in back-to-back games and three of his last five starts. His 11 rebounds at Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 4) marked a season-high. Tolbert ranks 11th in the Ohio Valley Conference in that category.

#### **Another Strong Week for Hogan**

Skyler Hogan averaged 16 points per game in two starts last week. A native of Melbourne, Florida, Hogan began the week by scoring 14 points in 26 minutes in the Redhawks win over Missouri S&T (Nov. 27). Four days later, he dropped in a season-high 18 points in 28 minutes against Western Illinois (Dec. 1). For the week, Hogan shot 52 percent (13-of-25) from the field and 44.4 percent (4-of-9) from 3-point range, while dishing out four assists and collecting one steal. He ranks second on the team in scoring with 11.1 points per game and has scored double figures in five of his last six starts.

#### **Tolbert Notches Double-Double**

Freshman forward Sage Tolbert notched the first double-double of his career when he scored 11 points and grabbed 10 rebounds against Western Illinois (Dec. 1). Tolbert shot 4-of-8 from the field in 26 minutes. He became the second Redhawk to get a double-double in as many games.

#### **Brewer Sinks Missouri S&T**

Ledarrius Brewer turned in a double-double 20 points and career-high 11 rebounds, and made three free throws in the final seven seconds to send Southeast Missouri to a 72-69 victory over Missouri S&T (Nov. 27). Brewer picked up his first double-double of the season and second of his career. He shot 7-of-13 from the field, knocked down three 3-pointers, dished out one assist and had two steals in 34 minutes. Brewer became SEMO's first player to score 20 points in a game this season.

#### **Defending the Three**

Southeast Missouri enters the weekend ranked 13th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage defense. Opponents are shooting 26.3 percent against the Redhawks from behind the arc. The Redhawks rank second in the Ohio Valley Conference behind Murray State (21.2 percent) in that category.

#### **Where They Rank**

Ledarrius Brewer ranks among Ohio Valley Conference leaders in scoring (23rd, 11.6 ppg), rebounding (13th, 6.3 ppg), defensive rebounds (8th, 5.8 rpg) and minutes played (30th, 27.6 mpg). Sage Tolbert is 11th in the conference in rebounding (6.9 rpg), 13th in defensive rebounds (4.2 rpg) and tied for eighth in offensive rebounds (2.7 rpg). Alex Caldwell ranks eighth in 3-point field goal percentage (.400) and Jonathan Dalton is eighth in assists (3.4 apg) and fifth in assist/turnover ratio (1.7). Skyler Hogan ranks tied for 15th in scoring (12.7 ppg), 15th in field goal percentage (.478), fourth in 3-point field goal percentage (.459) and 11th in 3-point field goals made (1.9 per game).

#### **Same Starting Five**

The Redhawks have gone with the same five starters through their first nine games of the 2018-19 season. Guards Jonathan Dalton, Ledarrius Brewer and Skyler Hogan, and forwards Isaiah Gable and Sage Tolbert have started every contest. It is the first time Southeast Missouri went with the same five starters each of its first nine games of a season under head coach Rick Ray.

#### **First Win**

Southeast Missouri picked up its first win of the season with a 102-66 pasting of NCAA Divsion II member Quincy (Nov. 12). Freshman Alex Caldwell scored 15 points to lead six Redhawks in double figures. Eleven different players ended up in the scoring column for SEMO, which drained 14 three-pointers and shot a blazing 62.9 percent (39-of-62) from the field. The Redhawks also finished with 22 assists and turned the ball over seven times, including only twice in the second half.

#### **Strong Showing in Alabama**

The Redhawks wrapped up the Ungar Classic in Mobile, Alabama with a 2-1 record and second-place finish behind tournament host South Alabama. Southeast Missouri beat Jacksonville, 77-71, on Nov. 16, Chattanooga, 63-42, on Nov. 17 and fell to South Alabama, 79-58, on Nov. 19. SEMO had a three-game winning streak prior to its loss against the Jaguars.

#### **Hogan Named OVC Newcomer of the Week**

Southeast Missouri guard Skyler Hogan was named Ohio Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week on Nov. 19. Hogan won the first OVC weekly award of his career. A transfer from Embry-Riddle, Hogan led SEMO to three victories last week, including two at the South Alabama Ungar Classic. He averaged 13.7 points and 5.3 rebounds per game, while shooting 48.4 percent (15-of-31) from the field, 58.3 percent (7-of-12) from 3-point range and a perfect 4-of-4 at the free throw line. The redshirt-junior scored in double figures all three contests. He had 12 points and three rebounds in 21 minutes against Quincy (Nov. 12) and followed that up with 14 points and seven rebounds against Jacksonville (Nov. 16). Hogan then ended the week by scoring 15 points, grabbing six rebounds and gathering two blocks in a 21-point win over Chattanooga (Nov. 17). Additionally, he committed only one turnover in 76 minutes of playing time. Austin Peay's Terry Taylor (Player) and Belmont's Nick Muszvnski (Freshman) rounded out this week's honorees.

#### On the Way to 100

Ledarrius Brewer is making his way closer to the 100 mark in career free throws and 3-pointers made. Brewer has drained 85 three-pointers and 86 free throws through 40 games and 36 starts as a Redhawk.

#### **Redhawks Win Home-Opener**

With its 102-66 victory over Quincy (Nov. 12), Southeast Missouri improved to 21-6 all-time in home-openers since joining the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92. The Redhawks opened their home slate with a win in six of the last seven years and posted victories in 13 of their last 16 home-opening dates.

#### **Century Mark**

The Redhawks scored 100 points for the first time with Rick Ray as their head coach when they beat Quincy, 102-66, on Nov. 12. It was Southeast Missouri's most points in a game since it put up 118 in a 118-115 double overtime win over Murray State on Mar. 1, 2014. SEMO's previous high in points under Ray was 95 in a 96-95 overtime loss at Louisiana Tech on Nov. 13, 2017.

#### **The Defense Rests**

Southeast Missouri ranks second in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring defense allowing 66.3 points per game in nine contests. Chattanooga's 42 points were the fewest allowed by SEMO this season. Murray State leads the league in that category with 60.2 points per game allowed. The Redhawks are also second in field goal percentage defense (.396).

#### **Brewer Clears 500 Career Points**

Sophomore guard Ledarrius Brewer cleared 500 career points at the Ungar Classic in Mobile, Ala. (Nov. 16, 17 & 19). Brewer, who has scored double figures seven of nine games this season, enters the weekend with 553 points and a career 13.8 points per game average.

#### **Cuffee and Laros Nab Career-Highs**

In his first career Division I game, Khalil Cuffee scored a career-high 12 points in eight minutes off the bench against Quincy (Nov. 12). Cuffee knocked down two 3-pointers and shot 5-of-6 from the field. He also dished out one assist and had two steals. Cuffee scored the basket that gave SEMO 100 points and followed with another bucket to put the Redhawks over that mark. Laros, meanwhile, notched a career-high 13 points on 6-of-8 field goals and 1-of-2 free throws off the bench. He added three rebounds and one assist in 21 minutes.

#### **Caldwell of to a Good Start**

Freshman point guard Alex Caldwell is off to a strong start in his rookie campaign. Caldwell scored double figures in three of his first four games at Southeast Missouri. He is third on the team in scoring with 9.7 points a game. Caldwell is also SEMO's top free throw shooter with a 93.8 percent clip (15-of-16).

#### Give it Up for the Freshmen

Freshmen Alex Caldwell (87), Khalil Cuffee (19), Sage Tolbert (66), Nygal Russell (41) and Gabe McGlothan (52) combined for 246 of Southeast Missouri's 634 points through nine games. SEMO's freshmen have accounted for 39 percent of the scoring in that stretch.

#### **Brewer Time**

Sophomore guard Ledarrius Brewer is Southeast Missouri's second-leading scorer with 11.6 points a game through nine starts this season. Brewer boasts a second-best 6.3 rebounds per contest and ranks second in 3-pointers made (14) and second in assists (19). He is presently 23rd in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring.

#### **First Career Starts**

Sophomore Isaiah Gable, junior Skyler Hogan and freshman Sage Tolbert made their first career starts at Saint Louis (Nov. 6). Gable scored six points, Tolbert added seven points and five rebounds, and Hogan added four points and four boards.

#### **Division I Debuts**

Six different Redhawks, including Sage Tolbert, Skyler Hogan, Alex Caldwell, Oscar Kao, Nygal Russell and Gabe McGlothan played their first NCAA Division I game at Saint Louis (Nov. 6). Caldwell (14), Tolbert (7) and McGlothan (7), all freshmen, combined for 28 points.

#### **Brewer Leads the Way**

Ledarrius Brewer began the season with a team-high 18 points against Saint Louis (Nov. 6). Brewer shot 7-of-17 from the field, knocked down a pair of 3-pointers, made two free throws and grabbed seven rebounds in a team-best 33 minutes. He dished out two assists and collected two steals, as well.

Brewer followed that performance up with 11 points and eight rebounds at Bradley (Nov. 10) and 10 points and four boards against Quincy (Nov. 12). Brewer has a total of 29 career double figure scoring games.

#### **Non-Conference Play**

The Redhawks have 20 non-conference wins with Rick Ray as their head coach. Southeast Missouri's most non-conference victories in a season under Ray stand at six during both the 2016-17 and 2017-18 campaigns. SEMO ended a four-game losing streak against non-conference opponents with a 102-66 victory over Quincy (Nov. 12).

#### **Laros Steps Up**

Mark Laros scored double figures in back-to-back games for the first time in his NCAA Division I career. Laros pitched in a career-high 13 points off the bench against Quincy (Nov. 12) and followed that up with 11 points and eight rebounds four days later vs. Jacksonville (Nov. 16). He is averaging 5.1 points and 3.7 rebounds per game through nine contests this season. Laros also went over 100 career rebounds (127).

#### **Brewer Lands Preseason All-OVC Honors**

Sophomore guard Ledarrius Brewer was named to the 2018-19 Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference Team on Oct. 23. A native of Meridian, Mississippi, Brewer averaged 14.5 points per game as SEMO's second-leading scorer as a freshman. He played in 31 games, made 27 starts and led the Redhawks with 71 three-pointers made. Brewer ranked 14th in the OVC in scoring, 15th in free throw percentage (.740), sixth in 3-point field goals made (2.3 per game) and 21st in minutes played (29.4 mpg). third in steals (29) as an OVC All-Newcomer selection during his rookie campaign.

#### **Welcome to Division I**

This season marks the first year of NCAA
Division I basketball for nine players on
Southeast Missouri's roster. Skyler Hogan,
Khalil Cuffee, Alex Caldwell, Jordan Love, Oscar Kao, Nygal Russell, Jack Lake, Sage Tolbert
and Gabe McGlothan are new to the NCAA
Division I scene this year. Hogan,

Caldwell, Kao, Russell, Tolbert and McGlothan saw action in their first Division I game at Saint Louis (Nov. 6).

#### **Fourth Year**

Rick Ray is in his fourth year as Southeast Missouri's head coach. From top to bottom, SEMO has its most talented roster with Ray at the helm. The Redhawks finished their 2017-18 season with an overall record of 14-17 and 8-10 in the Ohio Valley Conference. SEMO finished seventh in the OVC standings, three spots ahead of where it was picked in the league's Preseason Poll (10th).

#### **Eligible for Postseason Play**

The NCAA's academic and membership affairs granted Southeast Missouri full relief from all practice and competition restrictions for the 2018-19 academic year related to the team's four-year Academic Progress Rate score. Having improved their score and put in place a number of departmental enhancements, the Redhawks will be able to compete in the postseason and there will be zero restrictions this upcoming season. In 2017-18, SEMO was unable to compete in the postseason due to a NCAA Academic Progress Rate historic penalty.

#### **Roster Breakdown**

Southeast Missouri's 15-man roster includes seven returnees and eight newcomers. The Redhawks return two startersin guards Ledarrius Brewer and Jonathan Dalton. Brewer ranked second on the team in scoring with 14.5 points per game in 31 games and 27 starts as a freshman, while Dalton started 30 games at point guard, leading the team in assists (168) and steals (38) a year ago.

#### Season 112

The 2018-19 campaign marks the 112th season of Southeast Missouri basketball. It is also SEMO's 28th season at the NCAA Division I level. The Redhawks are 330-464 overall and 184-270 in the Ohio Valley Conference as a NCAA Division I program. SEMO also has 15 OVC Tournament appearances, one OVC regular-season championship (2000), one OVC Tournament title (2000) and one NCAA Tournament berth (2000) in its Division I era.

#### **OVC Top Five**

The Redhawks ranked among the top five Ohio Valley Conference leaders in six categories last season. Southeast Missouri led the OVC in 3-point field goal percentage (.392), was second in 3-point field goals made (9.3), third in both scoring offense (76 ppg) and field goal percentage (.460), fourth in assist/turnover ratio (1.1) and fifth in assists (13.6 per game). In league games only, the Redhawks rated second in 3-point field goals made (10 per game) and third in scoring offense (76.8 ppg).

#### **3-Point Record Again**

Southeast Missouri drained a single-season school record 289 three-pointers in 2017-18, averaging 9.3 per game. SEMO made 10 or more 3-pointers in 15 contests. The Redhawks buried a season-best 16 three-pointers at Eastern Kentucky (Feb. 26). SEMO's 289 threes surpassed its previous record of 263 the year before. The Redhawks topped the OVC with a .392 three-point field goal percentage.

#### **Big Freshman Year**

Guard Ledarrius Brewer is looking to build on his big rookie season. Brewer is Southeast Missouri's top returning scorer, who averaged 14.5 points in 31 contests and 27 starts as a freshman. He ranked second on the team in scoring and led the Redhawks with 71 three-pointers made. Brewer ranked first on the team in blocks (16), third in steals (29) and second in assists (57) He rated 14th in the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring, 15th in free throw percentage (.740), sixth in 3-point field goals made (2.3 per game) and 21st in minutes played (29.4 mpg). Brewer scored double figures in 24 of his 27 starts.

#### **Running Point**

Senior Jonathan Dalton is back as Southeast Missouri's starting point guard. Dalton, who hails from New Orleans, Louisiana, started 30 games and led the Redhawks in assists (168) and steals (38) last season. He also surpassed 200 assists in his career. Dalton is one of four players on this year's roster who are capable of playing the point guard spot. Fellow returnee Donnie Lewis and newcomers Oscar Kao and Alex Caldwell are the others. It's the first time under head coach Rick Ray where there have

been this many players available to play point quard.

#### **Season Sweeps**

The Redhawks recorded three sweeps of Ohio Valley Conference opponents in 2017-18. Southeast Missouri swept SIU Edwardsville, Morehead State and Eastern Illinois. The Redhawks now have a total of five season sweeps of league opponents under head coach Rick Ray.

#### **Happy Birthday**

A total of five players will celebrate their birthdays during the 2018-19 basketball season. Alex Caldwell (Nov. 18), Mark Laros (Dec. 10), Nygal Russell (Feb. 2), Gabe McGlothan (Mar. 3) and Donnie Lewis (Mar. 7) form that group. Here is the Redhawks entire birthday ledger.

#### **OVC Preseason Poll**

Southeast Missouri was picked ninth in the 2018-19 Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll. The Redhawks collected 82 points in the overall voting by OVC Head Coaches and Sports Information Directors. Belmont (227 pts., 8 first-place votes) was tabbed the preseason-favorite followed by Murray State (221 pts., 9 first-place votes), Jacksonville State (211 pts., 7 first-place votes), Austin Peay (188 pts.), Tennessee Tech (135 pts.), Eastern Kentucky (118 pts.), Eastern Illinois (116 pts.), Tennessee State (101 pts.), SEMO, Morehead State (78 pts.), UT Martin (77 pts.) and SIU Edwardsville (30 pts.). Belmont guard/forward Dylan Windler was voted Preseason OVC Player of the Year.

#### **OVC Tournament**

The Ohio Valley Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Championships will be held Mar. 6-9 at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana. This marks the second-straight year the event will be held at the venue. The Ford Center, which opened in 2011, is a 11,000-seat arena located in the core of Evansville's downtown district. The 290,000-square foot facility serves as home of the Evansville Thunderbolts of the Southern Professional Hockey League. The Ford Center serves as host to numerous sporting events and concerts on an annual basis. Last year No. 1 Murray State topped No. 2 Belmont on the men's side to capture its 16th OVC Tournament crown and first since 2012.

#### **Redhawks in the Professional Ranks**

Guard Antonius Cleveland (2013-17) is with the NBA G-League's Santa Cruz Warriors. On Oct. 13, 2018, the Chicago Bulls waived Cleveland who re-joined the Golden State Warriors' G-League affiliate. Cleveland played NBA games with the Dallas Mavericks and Atlanta Hawks before returning to the NBA G-League. Forward Tyler Stone (2011-14) is in his fifth professional season overseas. Stone recently signed with BC Enisey in Krasnoyarsk, Russia.

Rick Ray has the Southeast Missouri men's basketball program moving in the right direction as the Redhawks continue to show significant improvement under his leadership.

SEMO finished its 2017-18 season with an overall record of 14-17 and 8-10 mark in the Ohio Valley Conference. The Redhawks finished seventh in the league standings, three spots ahead of where they were picked in the preseason poll.

The Redhawks drained a single-season school record 289 three-pointers in Ray's third year as head coach last season. SEMO made 10 or more 3-pointers in 15 contests and led the

OVC with a .392 three-point field goal percentage.

Guards Denzel Mahoney and Ledarrius Brewer represented SEMO on the 2017-18 All-Ohio Valley Conference teams. Mahoney earned first-team honors, while Brewer secured All-Newcomer accolades. Brewer, who ranked second on the team in scoring as a freshman, returns to the perimeter this upcoming season.

A year before that, Ray led SEMO to a +10 increase in the win column as the Redhawks were the 22nd Most Improved Team in NCAA Division I Basketball. SEMO finished at 15-18 overall and second in the Ohio Valley Conference West Division with a 9-7 mark after going 5-24 and placing last in the OVC in 2015-16.

SEMO made its 15th all-time OVC Tournament appearance with Ray winning the first game he coached at the event when the Redhawks erased a 14-point deficit to beat Tennessee State in overtime.

Statistically, SEMO made huge strides from the previous season. The Redhawks ranked among the top-five in the OVC in several categories, including steals (1st, 7.7), assist/turnover ratio (5th, 1.1) and 3-point field goals made (5th, 8.0). SEMO made its biggest jump from the 2015-16 season in turnover margin (8th to 1st), 3-point field goal percentage (last to 2nd) and free throw percentage (last to 2nd). Nationally, the Redhawks went from 331st to 49th in free throw percentage and 336th to 59th in total 3-point field goals made, while improving in many

other areas during the 2016-17 campaign.

Additionally, Ray coached a pair of All-OVC selections in guards Antonius Cleveland and Denzel Mahoney. Cleveland, who earned first-team honors, became the first SEMO player to make the national College Slam Dunk Championship and initially agreed to a deal with the Golden State Warriors. He played with both the Dallas Mavericks and Atlanta Hawks before joining the Chicago Bulls on July 23, 2018

Mahoney was the league's Freshman of the Year, a second-team pick, All-Newcomer selection and OVC All-Tournament Team honoree. It was the first time the Redhawks had multiple All-OVC selections since 2013-14 (Tyler Stone, Jarekious Bradley).


Following the 2016-17 campaign, Ray received a two-year contract extension that runs through the 2020-21 season.

Ray was introduced as the 20th head coach in SEMO men's basketball history on April 13, 2015. He is the first African-American head coach in the 111-year history of the program.

A tireless worker, Ray is structuring his program to achieve success both on the court and in the classroom.

In his first summer on the job, Ray challenged his players to excel academically and they did so by accumulating a 3.38 grade point average, the program's highest in a summer term.

Twelve of the 15 players enrolled in summer classes posted a 3.0 or higher GPA. To





take it even further, Ray convinced other players to remain on campus and finish what they started. As a result, seven players graduated. Nino Johnson, Jarekious Bradley, Darrian Gray and J.J. Thompson, along with former players Corey Wilford, Waylon Jones and Dainmon Gonner all earned their bachelor degrees.

The next summer, the Redhawks recorded a 3.33 GPA with six players achieving a 4.0 and 11 notching a 3.0 or higher GPA.

In Fall, 2017, SEMO's men's basketball team made the biggest improvement of all Redhawk athletic teams from the previous Fall, 2016 semester when it raised its grade point average .613 points to a 3.08. That fall, the basketball team was the only men's sport that registered a 3.0 GPA.

Ray's 2015-16 team was the first to play in a newlyrenovated Show Me Center, which has served as home to Redhawk Basketball since 1987.

One of the best basketball arenas in the OVC, the Show Me Center received a new state-of-the-art center-hung video board, brand new telescopic seating, a new exterior roof and additional improvements to lighting and sound systems. All renovations were completed for the 2015-16 campaign.

Prior to SEMO, Ray spent three seasons as head coach at Mississippi State. He led the Bulldogs to a 2-2 mark in the SEC Tournament, including an upset win against Vanderbilt in 2013-14. Ray helped the development of two All-SEC freshmen in Craig Sword and Gavin Ware, as his recruiting classes received national attention. In addition, Ray had a 100 percent graduation rate during his tenure at MSU.

Certainly no stranger to NCAA postseason play, Ray has been an assistant at three different institutions that enjoyed success at the highest level.

Before arriving in Starkville, Mississippi, Ray spent two seasons at Clemson, where he was associate head coach to Brad Brownell. Ray also spent four successful years on the staff of Matt Painter at Purdue. He began his Division I coaching career at Indiana State, serving seven seasons.

All three programs participated in the NCAA Tournament. While at Clemson coaching in the highly-competitive Atlantic Coast Conference, the Tigers won 38 games during Ray's two-year stint as associate head coach. In 2010-11, the Tigers finished the year with a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 mark in the ACC en route to making the NCAA Tournament for the fourth-straight season. Clemson advanced to the second round of the tournament that year.

Ray was an assistant coach from 2006-10 under Painter at Purdue, where the Boilermakers won 103 games during his first four years on staff, including 15 victories over Top 25 competition. During his tenure, Purdue advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season and made the Sweet 16 his last two years there.

In 2009, the Boilermakers won the Big Ten Tournament and secured a No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. A year later, Ray helped the Boilermakers to 29 wins, tied for the most in Purdue history for a single season. Purdue earned a No. 4 seed and lost in the round of 16 to eventual NCAA champion Duke during the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

Ray was part of the 2006-07 Purdue staff that signed arguably the top class in school history, a group that was rated No. 5 nationally by Scout.com and No. 6 by Rivals.com. That class included All-Americans Robbie Hummel and JaJuan Johnson and current NBA player E'Twaun Moore.

While at Purdue, Ray was on Painter's staff that also included Cuonzo Martin, who recently completed his second season at Cal, and Paul Lusk, who is head coach at Missouri State.

Ray coached at Missouri Valley Conference member Indiana State for a period of seven years (1997-2004), helping ISU to consecutive 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament appearances in 1999-2000 and 2000-01. In 1999-2000, the Sycamores compiled a 14-4 record in the MVC and won the regular season title. ISU then won the MVC Tournament the following season. The Sycamores later upset No. 4 seed Oklahoma in the first round of the 2001 NCAA Tournament. In addition, Ray was part of the ISU staff that defeated perennial power Indiana in back-to-back seasons.

Following his time at ISU, Ray spent two seasons (2004-06) as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Northern Illinois. In 2005-06, the Huskies were regular season Western Division champions in the Mid-American Conference for the first time in school history with a 17-11 overall record and 12-6 ledger in the MAC.

Ray began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Nebras-ka-Omaha, a Division II program. He helped orchestrate a seven-win turnaround during his second season in 1996-97.

A standout player for Grand View College (Iowa), Ray was an All-American Scholar-Athlete and honorable mention allconference performer in 1993.

He earned his undergraduate degree in applied mathematics and secondary education from Grand View in 1994. Ray received his master's degree in athletic administration from Nebraska-Omaha in 1997.

Those type of heralded credentials helped Ray make the transition to head coach.

In 2013, he was the recipient of Grand View's Distinguished Alumni Award.

Born in Gardena, California, Ray moved to Kansas City, Kansas with his family when he was six years old.

Ray and his wife, Breyana, have two sons, Deacon and Mason, and a daughter, Katriece.


