#### **Redhawks Head to Kentucky**

Southeast Missouri (25-16, 9-5) travels to Morehead State (22-12, 3-5) and Eastern Kentucky (25-14, 7-1) for its final Ohio Valley Conference road games this weekend. The Redhawks face the Eagles in a 11 a.m., CT, doubleheader Saturday and take on the Colonels in a Noon, CT, twin bill Sunday.

#### **Series History**

Southeast leads its all-time series against Morehead State, 57-21. The Redhawks are 24-12 all-time in Morehead. Southeast last won there in 2011 when it swept the Eagles, 14-7, 4-3. The Redhawks also lead their all-time series with Eastern Kentucky, 37-33. Southeast won three of its last five meetings against the Colonels.

#### **Where They Stand**

The Redhawks enter the weekend at fifth in the Ohio Valley Conference standings with a 9-5 league mark. Morehead State is ninth with a 3-7 conference record and Eastern Kentucky is presently second at 7-1 behind league leader Jacksonville State (11-1). The Colonels are 10-2 in Richmond this season.

#### **Countdown to 250**

Mark Redburn is one win away from getting 250 in his career as a head coach. Redburn is 249-330 all-time in his 14-year head coaching tenure. That record includes an 83-103 mark as the Redhawks head coach.

## 25 Wins

Southeast is 25-16 through 41 games this season. The Redhawks and Eastern Kentucky have the second-most overall wins in the Ohio Valley Conference behind Eastern Illinois (28). Southeast's nine OVC victories are second-most behind league leader Jacksonville State (11). The 25 wins are the most in a season under Mark Redburn during his nine years as an NCAA Division I head coach.

#### 30 in Sight

Oxford Ala

The Redhawks are five wins away from reaching 30 this year with 10 games remaining on their regular-season schedule. The last time Southeast won 30 games was also the last time it finished a season with a winning record. Southeast went 31-30 overall and placed fifth in the Ohio Valley Conference at 17-12 in 2011. The Redhawks have won 30 or more games a total of 15 seasons during their program's history.

#### **Final Road Stretch**

Southeast plays away from home for its next six games, its final road stretch of the season. After this weekend's doubleheaders at Morehead State (Apr. 21) and Eastern Kentucky (Apr. 22), the Redhawks visit Saint Louis (Apr. 25).

#### **Bandy Delivers Walk-Off Hit**

Second baseman Parker Bandy delivered a walk-off single with one out in the bottom of the eighth inning to give the Redhawks a 1-0 victory over UT Martin (Apr. 17). Bandy's game-winning hit to center helped Southeast split a doubleheader with the Skyhawks. She went 3-for-4, matching a season-high three hits in that contest.

#### **Conference Race**

Second-place Eastern Kentucky is the last team the Redhawks face that ranks ahead of them in the Ohio Valley Conference standings. Southeast is presently 4-4 against the five teams in front of it in this year's conference race. The Redhawks went 1-1 against league-leader Jacksonville State, 0-2 against Eastern Illinois, 2-0 against SIU Edwardsville and 1-1 against Austin Peay.

#### **Major Defensive Improvement**

In 2017, Southeast committed a total of 59 errors and finished eighth in the Ohio Valley Conference with a .960 fielding percentage. Through 41 games this season, the Redhawks have been charged with just 34 errors and stand tied for second in the league in fielding percentage (.969). If the season were to end today, the Redhawks 34 errors would be the lowest committed in a season by any Southeast softball team.

#### **Looking Ahead to Eastern Kentucky**

A day after facing Morehead State, the Redhawks will square off against a tough Eastern Kentucky team. EKU is presently second in the Ohio Valley Conference behind Jacksonville State with a 7-1 league mark. The Colonels have won three in a row and hold a 10-2 record at home this season. As a team, EKU leads the conference in slugging percentage (.495), runs scored (211), RBI (199), home runs (53) and total bases (495). Paige Murphy is the Colonels top offensive threat, hitting .435 with 41 runs, 37 RBI and 13 home runs this year.

#### **Team Single-Season Rankings**

The 2018 Southeast softball team currently ranks among the school's top 10 single-season leaders in nine different categories. The Redhawks are among program's top 10 teams in fewest errors (1st, 34), fielding percentage (2nd, .969), strikeouts looking (t2nd, 69), slugging percentage (3rd, .439), on-base percentage (t5th, .356), opponent batting average (5th, .274), saves (t7th, 4), home runs (t8th, 32) and strikeouts (10th, 202).

#### 100 Hits for Anderson

Sophomore center fielder Rachel Anderson got her 100th career hit on a single in the first inning of game one at Eastern Illinois (Apr. 11). Anderson leads the team with 41 hits, six triples and seven stolen bases. She is also third in doubles (5) and second in batting average (.357).

#### **Anderson Second in Career Triples**

Sophomore center fielder Rachel Anderson hit her team-high sixth triple of the season vs. SIU Edwardsville (Apr. 8). As a result, Anderson moved into second all-time in career triples at Southeast. She ranks first in the Ohio Valley Conference and fifth in the nation in triples. Anderson presently has 14 triples in her career. Kathy Rediger (1981-84) holds the school's all-time career triples record with 18. As a team, Southeast is sixth in the nation in triples per game (0.39).

#### 100 Games Played

Catcher Abby Tillotson played in her 100th career game as a Redhawk during game two of Southeast's doubleheader at Eastern Illinois (Apr. 11). Tillotson has played in 104 games and made 85 starts for the Redhawks. She is currently Southeast's fourth-leading hitter with a .302 average. Tillotson is second on the team in home runs (6) and RBI (29), as well.

#### **Home Run Count**

Southeast ranks third in the Ohio Valley Conference with 32 home runs as one of three teams in the league with 30 or more this year. A total of 10 different Redhawks have homered through 41 games in 2018. Sarah Messex leads the team with seven home runs, while Abby Tillotson and Addison Barnouski follow with six apiece.

#### **Five Over 100**

Southeast has five active players who have played over 100 games in their careers. Claire Wernig has seen action in 144 games, Riley Hayes has played in 142, Sarah Messex has participated in 140, Darby Pruett has played in 139 and Abby Tillotson has logged 104 games played. Of that group, Messex is the only one who has started every game of her career.

#### **Four-Hit Games**

Infielders Sarah Messex and Darby Pruett each went 4-for-4 in Southeast's doubleheader sweep of Murray State (Apr. 8), becoming the team's first players to get four hits in a game this season. Messex finished game one at 4-for-4 with two runs scored and two RBI, while Pruett went 4-for-4 with two runs scored, a home run and four RBI. The four hits were a career-high for both Messex and Pruett. Claire Wernig was the last Redhawk to get four hits in a game vs. Austin Peay on Apr. 30, 2016.

#### **Thogmartin Strong in the Circle**

Haley Thogmartin recorded 25 strikeouts in 25.2 innings over her last five Ohio Valley Conference starts. Thogmartin also went 2-1 in that stretch. Her eight strikeouts against SIU Edwardsville (Apr. 13) marked a career-high.

#### **Barnouski Named OVC Player of the Week**

Sophomore third baseman Addison Barnouski was named the adidas® Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Week on Mar. 26. A native of O'Fallon, Illinois, Barnouski hit safely in five of six games for Southeast last week. She went 6-for-15 at the plate for a .400 batting average. Barnouski scored five runs, hit two doubles, had a pair of home runs and five

Barnouski also recorded a .993 slugging percentage and a .400 on-base percentage. The OVC honor marks the first of Barnouski's career. Eastern Illinois' Jessica Wireman was voted this week's OVC Pitcher of the Week.

#### **What a Relief**

Freshman pitcher Rachel Rook leads the Ohio Valley Conference in games finished (14) and games in relief (16). Rook has not allowed a run in seven-straight relief appearances. She also did not give up a hit in six-straight innings out of the bullpen.

#### **Arellanes Returns**

Right fielder Mykaela Arellanes returned in Southeast's doubleheader against UT Martin (Apr. 17). Arellanes missed nine games with a concussion. She doubled and scored the winning run on a single by Parker Bandy to give the Redhawks a 1-0 victory in the bottom of the eighth inning of game two.

#### **Redhawks Beat Missouri**

Southeast ended an 18-game losing streak against in-state foe Missouri when it upended the Tigers, 8-2, in game two of a doubleheader Wednesday. The Redhawks last beat Missouri on Apr. 20, 2000 (5-0). It was the first time Mark Redburn beat the Tigers since he left Missouri in 2009. Redburn previously worked as an assistant coach at Missouri from 2007-09.

#### **Home Record**

Southeast is 9-3 at the Southeast Softball Complex this season. The Redhawks swept Indiana State (Mar. 13), Tennessee Tech (Mar. 23) and SIU Edwardsville (Apr. 13) in doubleheaders and and split two games with Missouri (Mar. 21), Jacksonville State (Mar. 25) and UT Martin (Apr. 17). Southeast is 150-139 all-time on its home diamond.

#### **Krumrey Reaches 10 Wins**

Madeline Krumrey became the fourth pitcher in the Ohio Valley Conference to get 10 wins this season when she beat Jacksonville State (Mar. 25). Krumrey is 10-6 overall and 2-3 in OVC play inside the circle this year. It is the third time in her four-year career that she has collected 10 or more wins in a season.

#### Away from Home

Southeast is 16-13 in games outside of Cape Girardeau this season. The Redhawks are 6-9 in true road games this year.

#### **Everyday Starters**

A total of three Redhawks have started all 41 games this season. Rachel Anderson started every contest in center field, Ashley Ellis started every game at first base and Sarah Messex started every contest at short.

### **On Target**

Madeline Krumrey leads the Redhawks with 85 strikeouts through 22 games and 21 starts this season. Krumrey is on pace to reach 100 strikeouts in a season for the first time in her career. She fell four strikeouts shy of that mark in 2017 and six strikeouts short of 100 as a freshman in 2015. Krumrey has struck out six or more in each of her last three starts.

#### **Gallo Hits First Career Home Run**

Claudia Gallo hit her first career home run in the bottom of the fourth inning of Southeast's 7-2 win over Jacksonville State (Mar. 25). Gallo homered over the right center wall with two outs. She hit the first pitch of her pinch-hit at-bat. Gallo is the ninth Redhawk to hit a home run this season.

## Complete Package

Madeline Krumrey tossed her team-high ninth complete game when she lost against UT Martin (Apr. 17). The most complete games Krumrey has pitched in a season during her career stands at 13 during her freshman campaign in 2015.

#### **Getting Ahead Early**

Southeast scored first in 25 games this season. The Redhawks are 20-5 when they score first. In all, Southeast has scored 45 times in the first inning this year.

#### **Nicely Done**

The Redhawks are a perfect 16-0 in games with a lead after six innings this season. Southeast is also 18-0 when it outhits opponents and 11-0 when it scores at least six runs.

#### **Double-Digit Runs**

For the first time this season, the Redhawks scored double-digit runs in back-to-back games when they beat South Dakota (10-2) and SIU Edwardsville (10-7). Southeast last put up double-digit runs in consecutive games at the beginning of the 2017 campaign when it throttled both Jarvis Christian College (17-2) and Jackson State (13-2). The Redhawks have scored 10 or more runs a total of six times this season.

#### **Memphis Tiger Classic Champions**

The Redhawks wrapped up tournament play with a perfect 4-0 record to win the Memphis Tiger Classic on Mar. 17-18. Southeast beat host Memphis, 8-7, South Dakota, 10-2, and fellow Ohio Valley Conference opponents Tennessee Tech (7-3) and SIU Edwardsville (10-7). The Redhawks played in four different tournaments this season and compiled a 12-7 record in those appearances.

#### **Doubleheader Sweeps**

The Redhawks have four doubleheader sweeps this season. Southeast beat Indiana State (Mar. 13), 5-1, 4-1, in their home-opener defeated Tennessee Tech (Mar. 23), 5-1, 4-3, upended Murray State (Apr. 8), 8-7, 11-8, and took down SIU Edwardsville (Apr. 13), 6-2, 7-5.



## **MARK REDBURN**

The 2018 season marks the fourth year for Southeast Missouri head coach Mark Redburn.

Mark Redburn has the Southeast Missouri softball program moving in the right direction entering his fourth year at the helm.

Redburn coaches the 42nd team in Southeast softball history in 2018.

Last season, Southeast increased its win total by a +7 margin as the Redhawks went 23-27 overall and finished ninth in the Ohio Valley Conference with an 8-14 mark.

Redburn coached his first OVC Freshman of the Year and third First-Team All-OVC selection in Rachel Anderson. Anderson, also a National **Fastpitch Coaches Association** Second-Team All-Region pick, led the team in batting average (.412), at-bats (153), hits, doubles (10), triples (8), home runs (7), RBIs (33), total bases (110), slugging percentage (.719), on-base percentage (.483), multi-hit games (21), multi-RBI performances (10) and games started (50), Anderson ended her freshman campaign on an 11-game hitting streak, helping lift the Redhawks to victory in six of their final nine contests of 2017.

The 2017 club finished among

the school's top single-season teams in slugging percentage (6th, .427), on-base percentage (5th, .356), triples (t4th, 21), home runs (9th, 31), total bases (9th, 567), stolen bases (2nd, 65), stolen base attempts (1st, 88), opponent batting average (7th, .282), strikeouts/7 innings (7th, 4.17), strikeouts (10th, 194), strikeouts looking (3rd, 61) fewest doubles allowed (8th, 49), fielding percentage (8th, .960), fewest errors (t7th, 59) and fewest stolen bases against (3rd, 38).

Pitcher Madeline Krumrey surpassed 200 career strikeouts for Redburn's 2017 squad. Krumrey sets to begin her fourth and final season as the Redhawks top starting pitcher this year.

Redburn picked up his 200th career victory when Southeast beat Austin Peay, 7-4, on Apr. 30, 2016. His 2016 club ranked among the school's top-10 teams in doubles (6th, 69), stolen bases (3rd, 58), walks (8th, 138), home runs (6th, 35) and slugging percentage (6th, .412). Additionally, Redburn coached one All-OVC pick (Savannah Carpenter) that year.

In his first season, Redburn led the Redhawks to an overall record of 19-27 and 12-12 in OVC play during the 2015 campaign. His 19 victories came after Southeast won no more than 15 games in each of the previous two seasons. Redburn's first

club at Southeast also had 12 OVC wins, a +9 increase from the 2014 campaign. In addition, the Redhawks made the OVC Tournament, snapping a streak of three years where they missed the event.

Not only did Redburn earn his 100th career NCAA Division I win in his inaugural season with the Redhawks, but he coached three All-OVC selections and one NFCA All-Region honoree.

Statistically, Southeast finished among the top-five OVC teams in batting average (3rd), slugging percentage (5th), on-base percentage (5th) and hits (5th). The 2015 Redhawks also broke two single-season records with Kayla Fortner establishing new marks in home runs and walks. Southeast tied the OVC single-game mark and set a single-game school record with six home runs, as well. Academically, the Redhawks accumulated a 3.35 grade point average during the 2014-15 academic year as a total of nine players earned NFCA AllAmerica Scholar-Athlete status for achieving a 3.5 or higher GPA.

The fourth head coach in Redhawk softball history, Redburn won 90 games in five years as head coach at the University of Evansville before accepting the job at Southeast on June 26, 2014.

In 2014, Redburn coached a UE team with five starters that were underclassmen, including four freshmen and one sophomore. The Purple Aces achieved their highest batting average since 2007. Additionally, UE had a freshman lead the team in stolen bases and home

Despite a season that allowed 53 games, the 2013 team had its best season in Redburn's five years at UE. Entering the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament as the No. 7 seed, the Purple Aces beat the No. 6, No. 3 and No. 2 seeds to make their first MVC Championship appearance since 2003. UE finished second with



three players garnering All-Tournament team honors.

The 2013 campaign resulted in the most overall wins in a season since 2008 and the best regular-season and conference tournament finish since Redburn's arrival. UE continued its aggressive baserunning with 89 stolen bases, ranking second in the MVC. The pitching staff also rated fourth in the conference.

Redburn's 2012 club saw improvement as well, winning more games than it had the previous season. The Purple Aces stole 79 bases and had two all-conference and one National **Fastpitch Coaches Association** All-Region selection that year. In 2011, Redburn exposed a young and inexperienced team to some of the top programs in the nation as UE played one of its most difficult schedules. Tennessee, Georgia Tech, Missouri, Ohio State, Texas Tech, South Alabama and Chattanooga were among the stiff competition.

Redburn quickly started to transform the UE program during his first year in 2010. The Purple Aces secured a berth in the MVC Tournament after winning 10 conference games. UE led the MVC with 31 doubles and hit 36 home runs, while producing two all-conference picks.

Academically, Redburn's teams consistently enjoyed success. In fact, each of his last four UE teams accumulated a 3.1 or higher grade point average. He had several student-athletes obtain over a 3.5 GPA and earn academic recognition along the way.

Prior to UE, Redburn spent three years as an assistant coach at the University of Missouri working primarily with the pitchers and catchers, and serving as recruiting coordinator.

He was part of a coaching staff that compiled an overall record of 137-53. The Tigers registered a school record for victories (50), won the Big 12 Conference Tournament, won their Regional and defeated host UCLA in the Super Regional to advance to the College World Series in 2009. Overall, Redburn coached four all-conference pitchers, including USA National Team Pitcher Chelsea Thomas at Missouri.

Redburn began his collegiate coaching career as head coach at St. Charles (Mo.) Community College from 2001-04. He led the 2003 team to its first Region 16 championship and a seventh-place finish at the National Junior College Athletic Association Division I National Tournament. His 2004 squad set a school record with 33 victories.

Following his stay at St. Charles CC, Redburn spent two seasons as head coach of the new softball program at Jefferson College. In the program's first year of competition, 2006, he led Jefferson to a 49-16 record, Region 16 championship and ninth-place finish at the NJCAA Division I National Tournament. Redburn was honored as the Midwest Community College Athletic Conference Coach of the Year following that season. A native of St. Charles, Missouri, Redburn graduated from the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1993 and received his master's degree in Athletics/ Activities Administration from William Woods University.

He and his wife, Tracy, have two sons, Joe and Jack.
