Series History

Southeast Missouri and Southern Illinois meet for the 117th time on the hardwood Saturday. SIU holds a 70-46 lead in the all-time series that goes back to 1914. The Salukis own a 14-3 record in the previous 17 matchups between the teams. SEMO last beat SIU in Carbondale on Dec. 9, 2017 (75-69).

Against the MVC

Southern Illinois is the second Missouri Valley Conference opponent on Southeast Missouri's schedule this season. SEMO holds an all-time record of 110-193 against the MVC. The Redhawks fell to Drake, 78-73, on the road on Dec. 7. Here are the Redhawks records vs. MVC schools.

Road Weary Redhawks

The Redhawks close out their rugged eight-game road stretch when they cross the Mississippi River to face Southern Illinois Saturday. The Redhawks are searching for their first true road win of the season. SEMO is 0-6 in such games and has dropped eight-straight road contests dating back to last year. The Redhawks last road win was an 88-79 victory at Eastern Illinois on Feb. 16, 2019. The road trip, which logged 6,824 miles across six different states (California, Texas, Ohio, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana), is SEMO's longest in program history.

Non-Conference Winding Down

Including Saturday, Southeast Missouri has two games left on its non-conference schedule. After the Redhawks face Southern Illinois, they will host NAIA member Missouri Baptist on Dec. 29. It will be SEMO's fourth home game this season and first since Nov. 22. Meanwhile, Saturday's matchup marks the final non-conference tilt for SIU.



Strong MVC Ties

Rick Ray's first NCAA Division I coaching job was at Indiana State. Ray was an assistant coach there from 1997-2004, helping ISU to consecutive 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament appearances in 1999-2000 and 2000-01. In 1999-2000, the Sycamores compiled a 14-4 record in the Missouri Valley Conference and won the regular-season title. ISU then won the MVC Tournament the following season. The Sycamores upset No. 4 seed Oklahoma in the first round of the 2001 NCAA Tournament. In addition, Ray was part of the ISU staff that defeated perennial power Indiana in back-to-back seasons. Ray was also on Purdue's coaching staff with former Southern Illinois coaches Matt Painter and Paul Lusk. He is 2-10 against MVC schools as a head coach (0-3 vs. Bradley; 0-2 vs. Evansville; 1-2 vs. Missouri State; 1-2 vs. Southern Illinois; 0-1 vs. Drake).

Ohio Recap

Southeast Missouri dropped two games in Ohio falling, 65-50, at Youngstown State (Dec. 15) and, 80-48, at #5 Ohio State (Dec. 17). The fifth-ranked Buckeyes were the highest-ranked opponent SEMO has ever faced. The Redhawks forced 21 turnovers against OSU, most committed by the mighty Buckeyes in 11 games this season.

Redhawks vs. Ranked Opponents

With its loss to #5 Ohio State (Dec. 17), Southeast Missouri dropped to 0-15 all-time against ranked opponents. Eight of those matchups were against Top-10 foes. SEMO's highest ranked opponent prior to this year was also from the Big Ten Conference -- #6 Illinois on Dec. 28, 2005.

Quite the Experience

Although Southeast Missouri suffered its biggest loss of the season at #5 Ohio State (Dec. 17), the Redhawks did get the opportunity to play in the ninth-largest college basketball arena in the country. Value City Arena has a seating capacity of 19,049 and is the largest arena in the Big Ten Conference. Nationally, it ranks behind Syracuse's Carrier Dome (34,616), Kentucky's Rupp

Arena (23,000), Louisville's KFC Yum! Center (22,090), North Carolina's Dean Smith Center (21,750), Tennessee's Thompson-Boling Arena (21,678), Georgetown's Capital One Arena (20.356), St. John's Madison Square Garden (19.812) and North Carolina State's PNC Arena (19,722). No SEMO basketball team had played in a bigger arena prior to this year. Tuesday's game drew an attendance of 13,177, the largest crowd the Redhawks played in front of since Dec. 4, 2016 -- 17,222 at Indiana's Assembly Hall.

Current Road Trip

The Redhawks, who are on the road for over a month, hold a 1-6 record during their stretch which began on Nov. 27. Southeast Missouri went 1-2 at the Cable Car Classic in Santa Clara, California and lost at Abilene Christian (74-63, Dec. 5), Drake (78-73, Dec. 7), Youngstown State (65-50, Dec. 15) and #5 Ohio State (80-48, Dec. 17). SEMO's lone win came against Denver (66-51, Nov. 30) at a neutral site in California.

Agnew Cracks Starting Lineup

East Mississippi Community College transfer Darrious Agnew scored double figures in two of his first three starts since joining the starting lineup on on Dec. 7 (at Drake). Agnew scored 11 points and had four rebounds in his first start against the Bulldogs. Eight days later, he dropped in a season-high 17 points and pulled down six rebounds at Youngstown State (Dec. 15). He is part of SEMO's third different starting lineup combination through 11 games.

Another Former Redhawk

Current Southern Illinois senior guard Eric McGill was initially part of Rick Ray's first recruiting class at Southeast Missouri in 2015-16. McGill averaged seven points and 2.4 rebounds in 27 games and 13 starts that year. He is SIU's fourth-leading scorer with 8.9 points per game this season. McGill will be the third former SEMO player the Redhawks face in 2019-20. Tahj Eaddy (2016-17) and Ray Kowalski (2016-18) were the others. Eaddy presently plays at Santa Clara and Kowalski is at Denver.

Strong Trip Home

Forward Isaiah Gable, the only player from Ohio on Southeast Missouri's roster, performed well in front of a large group of family and friends in his home state. Gable scored 10 points off the bench against both Youngstown State (Dec. 15) and #5 Ohio State (Dec. 17). He knocked down five 3-pointers in those contests, including a season-high three against the Penguins. Gable is from Greenville, Ohio which is just under 100 miles from Columbus.

December Woes

Southeast Missouri is on a four-game losing streak and has dropped six of its last seven contests. The Redhawks are 0-4 in December and have averaged just 49 points in their last two games. Opponents are outscoring SEMO by a 15.2 margin in December.

Assist/Turnover Ratio

The Redhawks are 12th in the Ohio Valley Conference in assist/turnover ratio. Southeast Missouri has assisted 103 of its 252 made field goals this year. SEMO also committed 161 turnovers through its first 11 games.

Nicholas Nabs First OVC Honor

Southeast Missouri guard DQ Nicholas was named Ohio Valley Conference Co-Freshman of the Week on Dec. 9. A native of Atlanta, Georgia, Nicholas had a strong week for the Redhawks averaging 14 points and 4.5 rebounds in two games. He scored 21 points and made a perfect 14-of-14 free throws at Abilene Christian (Dec. 5). Nicholas scored 16 points and made all 14 of his free throws in the second half of that game. He then added seven points and five rebounds two days later at Drake (Dec. 7). Nicholas has scored over 20 points a team-high two times this year.

Strong Showing

After averaging under five 3-pointers made per game (4.6) through its first eight contests of the 2019-20 campaign, Southeast Missouri drained a season-best 10-of-19 treys at Drake (Dec. 7). The Redhawks heated up to shoot 52.6 percent from long range for the game and 54.5 percent (6-of-11) in the first half alone.

Perfect at the Free Throw Line

Freshman DQ Nicholas went a perfect 14-of-14 at the free throw line at Abilene Christian (Dec. 5). Nicholas led the Redhawks with a game-high 21 points, his second 20-point performance this season. He scored 16 of his points in the second half. Nicholas was the first Southeast Missouri player to make 14 free throws in a game since Denzel Mahoney went 14-of-15 and scored 34 points vs. Tennessee State (Mar. 1, 2017).

Solid Offense

Southeast Missouri scored the most points against Drake in the Knapp Center of any opponent this season when it dropped in 73 on Dec. 7. The Bulldogs, who were Co-Missouri Valley Conference Champions in 2018-19, did not allow more than 58 points in their first five home games before hosting the Redhawks. SEMO led Drake for over 30 minutes in that game.

Knocking Them Down

The Redhawks made 21-of-22 free throws in the second half against Abilene Christian (Dec. 5). Southeast Missouri finished shooting a season-best 85.7 percent (24-of-28) at the free throw line in that game. The 24 free throws made were SEMO's second-most this year.

Double-Digit Scorers

Southeast Missouri enters Saturday's matchup with no active players averaging double figures in the scoring column. Alex Caldwell is averaging 9.7 points a game behind guard Chris Harris (15.5 ppg), who is currently out with a knee injury.

Caldwell Named to Cable Car Classic All-Tournament Team

Sophomore guard Alex Caldwell was named to this year's Cable Car Classic All-Tournament Team. Caldwell averaged 14.3 points, two rebounds, two assists and 3.3 steals per game in three starts during the tournament. He also went a perfect 10-of-10 at the free throw line and scored double figures in all three contests.

November Wrap

Southeast Missouri closed out its first month of the season with a 66-51 win over Denver on Nov. 30. It marked the third year in a row where the Redhawks ended November with a victory.

Nice Defense

The Redhawks held Denver to just 51 points in their 66-51 victory on Nov. 30. It was the lowest point total Southeast Missouri held an opponent to since Chattanooga scored 42 against the Redhawks on Nov. 17, 2018. SEMO



also limited the Pioneers to only 1-of-16 from 3-point range.

Harris Out for Saturday

Guard Chris Harris will not play in Southeast Missouri's game at Southern Illinois due to a knee injury. Harris sustained his injury during practice prior to the Redhawks matchup with The Citadel (Nov. 19). He missed SEMO's last seven contests. Harris leads the Redhawks in scoring with 15.5 ppg.

Double-Doubles

Southeast Missouri is second in the Ohio Valley Conference with three double-doubles this season. Quatarrius Wilson has two and Sage Tolbert has one for the Redhawks thus far.

Double Figure Games

Guards Skyler Hogan, Alex Caldwell and Sage Tolbert each lead the team with five double-digit games in 2019-20. Hogan (21), Caldwell (13) and Tolbert (10) have combined for a total of 44 double figure scoring games during their careers.

3-Point Difference

Southeast Missouri has made 58 three-pointers through 11 games. The Redhawks are averaging 5.3 three-pointers per contest and made 30.7 percent (58-of-189) for a 10th-place ranking in the Ohio Valley Conference. SEMO has shot under 30 percent from beyond the arc a total of seven times this year. The Redhawks shot under 20 percent twice. Opponents have made 92 threes and hold a 276-174 (+102) advantage in points behind the 3-point line.

Down to the Wire

Southeast Missouri won two of its first three games at home by one point. Chris Harris buried a 3-pointer with 27 seconds left to send SEMO to a 79-78 victory over Purdue

Fort Wayne on Nov. 10. Twelve days later, Alex Caldwell drained a 3-pointer with 17 seconds on the clock to grab SEMO a 72-71 win over Missouri S&T (Nov. 22).

Redhawks Get First Win

Southeast Missouri picked up its first win of the season with a gritty performance against Purdue Fort Wayne (Nov. 10). SEMO saw a 15-point lead disappear, but made some big defensive stops and a clutch shot down the stretch to beat the Mastodons, 79-78.

Nicholas Drops in 24

Freshman guard DQ Nicholas became the first Southeast Missouri player to score over 20 points in a game when he dropped in a game-high 24 against The Citadel (Nov. 19). Nicholas made 9-of-16 field goals and 5-of-6 free throws. He ranks fourth on the team with 9.7 points per game.

Home-Opening Win

With their 79-78 victory over Purdue Fort Wayne (Nov. 10), the Redhawks improved to 23-6 all-time in home-openers since joining the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92. Southeast Missouri opened its home slate with a win for the seventh time in eight years and has posted victories in 14 of its last 17 home-opening dates. The Redhawks won their fourth-straight home-opener under head coach Rick Ray.

About Southern Illinois

Southern Illinois is 5-7 under first-year head coach and SIU Hall of Famer Bryan Mullins. The Salukis recently snapped a two-game losing skid when it rolled over Hampton, 75-53, on Dec. 18. SIU is last in the Missouri Valley Conference in scoring offense (64.3 ppg), but leads the MVC in scoring defense (62.1 ppg allowed). The Salukis are also currently the worst 3-point shooting team in the MVC (.331). Aaron Cook is SIU's top scoring threat with 15 points per game in six starts. Marcus Domask (14.2 ppg) and Barret Benson (10.3 ppg) are the other Salukis averaging double figures in the scoring column.

Strong Start for Harris

Chris Harris opened his Southeast Missouri career with back-to-back double-digit scoring games and drained a game-winning 3-pointer to give the Redhawks their first victory of the season. A native of Antioch, Illinois, Harris averaged 15.5 points per game and was SEMO's leading scorer in each of the first two games of the 2019-20 campaign. All of his points came off the bench as he scored 15 at SEC member Vanderbilt (11/6) and followed that up with 16 vs. Purdue Fort Wayne (11/10). Harris put the Redhawks ahead by one with his 3-pointer with 27 seconds left against the Mastodons. For the week, Harris shot 60 percent (9-of-15) from the field, 80 percent (8-of-10) at the free throw line and a scorching 71.4 percent (5-of-7) from 3-point range.

Mr. Double-Double

Quatarrius Wilson registered the 16th double-double of his college career and second in a Southeast Missouri uniform when he finished with 10 points and 11 rebounds vs. Denver (Nov. 30). Wilson previously had a Southland Conference leading 14 double-doubles during the 2017-18 season at McNeese State.

Division I Debuts

Five players, including guard Chris Harris, forwards Darrious Agnew and Evan Morrison, and guards DQ Nicholas and Jordan Love made their NCAA Division I debuts in 2019-20. Harris, who is currently out with a knee injury, averaged 15.5 points per game in his first two contests.

Big Stops

Southeast Missouri's defense locked down to draw a charge and get two stops in the final 35 seconds to secure its 79-78 win over Purdue Fort Wayne (Nov. 10). Isaiah Gable stepped in front of Dylan Carl to draw a big foul with 35 seconds on the clock. The Mastodons then had two chances in the final six seconds, but SEMO forced a missed 3-pointer and layup to come away with the win.

Welcome to Division I Basketball

Six of the 15 players on Southeast Missouri's 2019-20 roster never played NCAA Division I basketball. DQ Nicholas, Jordan Love, Chris Harris, Evan Morrison, Jakob Medina and Darrious Agnew formed that group entering the year. Nicholas, Harris, Agnew, Love and Morrison have played so far this season.

Owens and Crump Join Coaching Staff

Southeast Missouri added assistant coaches
Tarrance Crump and Jason Owens to its staff
in June. Crump spent three years as an
assistant coach at fellow Ohio Valley
Conference member SIU Edwardsville
(2016-18). SEMO head coach Rick Ray coached
Crump when he was a student-athlete at
Purdue. Owens joined the Redhawks after
working two years as an assistant coach on
Kim Anderson's staff at Pittsburg State.

Worth Noting

Of the 353 NCAA Division I men's basketball programs in the nation and discounting the Historically Black Colleges and Universities, Southeast Missouri is one of only five programs that have full-time coaching staffs comprised entirely of African-Americans. SEMO joins Georgetown, North Carolina State, Houston and Detroit Mercy

Ready to Go

McNeese State transfer forward Quatarrius Wilson sat out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA Division I transfer regulations. He had surgery on his right thumb in early July and missed six weeks before returning to the court in mid-August. Wilson earned Third-Team All-Southland Conference honors after averaging a double-double 10.9 points and 10.2 rebounds per game in 28 starts for McNeese State in 2017-18. Wilson was projected to be a Second-Team All-Ohio Valley Conference selection in Athlon Sports' preseason picks.



Fifth Year for Ray

Rick Ray is in his fifth year as head coach at Southeast Missouri. The Redhawks finished their 2018-19 season with an overall record of 10-21 and 5-13 Ohio Valley Conference mark. Prior to his first head coaching job at Mississippi State, Ray made the NCAA Tournament as an assistant coach with three different programs, including Purdue, Clemson and Indiana State.

Returning Scorers

Southeast Missouri has three of its top four scorers back from last season. Skyler Hogan (10.6 ppg), Alex Caldwell (8.7 ppg) and Isaiah Gable (8.1 ppg) ranked second, third and fourth on the team in 2018-19, respectively. The trio accounted for 35 percent of the Redhawks scoring output.

Roster Makeup

The Redhawks 2019-20 roster consists of 15 players, including two seniors, six juniors, four sophomores and three freshmen. Southeast Missouri has a total of six newcomers on this year's squad. SEMO's roster is comprised of players from nine different states (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, Ohio, South Carolina).

Season 113

Southeast Missouri is in its 113th season of basketball. This year marks SEMO's 29th as an NCAA Division I program. The Redhawks are 338-489 all-time at the Division I level. SEMO joined the Division I ranks in 1991-92.

Redhawks 11th in OVC Preseason Poll

Southeast Missouri was picked 11th in the 2019-20 Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Preseason Poll announced Oct. 22 during the league's annual media day at the Double Tree Hotel. SEMO tallied 49 points in the overall voting by the OVC Head Coaches and Communication Directors. Belmont, which received 17 of the 24 first-place votes, was tabbed this year's favorite. Murray State followed with 223 points and seven first-place nods. The Bruins and Racers shared the OVC regular-season title last season. MSU won the OVC Tournament crown and both teams

advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

Jacksonville State (187 pts.), Austin Peay (180 pts.), UT Martin (154 pts.), Eastern Kentucky (128 pts.), Eastern Illinois (124 pts.), Morehead State (113 pts.), Tennessee State (90 pts.) and SIU Edwardsville (63 pts.) were also picked ahead of SEMO. Tennessee Tech completed the poll with 36 points. Austin Peay guard/forward Terry Taylor was selected Preseason OVC Player of the Year.

Redhawks in Professional Basketball

Antonius Cleveland, who was at Southeast Missouri for four years from 2013-17, plays for the Dallas Mavericks and is on a two-way contract with the Texas Legends of the NBA G League. Cleveland re-signed with the Mavericks on July 25, 2019. He has played in a total of 17 NBA games between his time with Dallas (13) and Atlanta (4). Cousins Tyler Stone and Jarekious Bradley, once teammates at Southeast Missouri, are both playing overseas. Stone is with New Basket Brindisi of the Italian Lega Basket Serie A (LBA) and Bradley is with Joensuun Kataja Basket in Finland. Stone also played professionally in Turkey, Greece, Japan, Israel and Russia before joining his current team in Italy. Meanwhile, Bradley played in Slovakia and Germany before joining his current team in Finland.

Redhawks Sign Highly Talented Duo

Southeast Missouri signed point guard Phil Russell and forward Ramean Hinton for the 2020-21 season during the opening day of the NCAA early signing period on Nov. 13. Russell (5'10", 165) comes to SEMO from Vashon High School (St. Louis) and Hinton (6'4", 180) joins the Redhawks from Curie High School (Chicago). Russell started at point guard the last two seasons leading Vashon to 47 wins over that span. The Wolverines won a Class 3 State Championship in March, Vashon's third in four years. In the semifinal matchup against Charleston High School, Russell drained four 3-pointers and scored 20 points. Along with his ability to score, Russell also dished out nearly 180 assists during his junior campaign. Hinton averaged 15 points and seven rebounds for Curie High School, which went 35-2 overall and didn't lose to a Chicago-area school last

season. In the Chicago Public League championship game against Morgan Park, Hinton turned in a double-double 21 points and 13 rebounds. UAB, Saint Louis, Kent State, Green Bay, Kansas State, New Mexico, Colorado State and Tulsa were other schools that recruited Hinton in addition to SEMO. Hinton and Russell fashioned an impressive combined record of 61-6 in their games as juniors.

The Coaches vs. Cancer program is a nationwide collaboration between the American Cancer Society and the National Association of Basketball Coaches. This initiative leverages the personal experiences, community leadership, and professional excellence of coaches nationwide to increase cancer awareness and promote healthy living through year-round awareness efforts, fundraising activities, and advocacy programs. Since 1993, coaches have raised over \$100 million for the American Cancer Society.

ick Ray is in his fifth year as head coach at Southeast Missouri.
SEMO concluded its 2018-19 campaign with an overall record of 10-21 and 5-13 in the Ohio Valley Conference.

The Redhawks return three starters from last year's team which ranked second in the OVC in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.320), third in 3-point field goals made (8.6 per game) and fourth in 3-point field goal percentage (.370). SEMO also tied for fourth in defensive rebounding percentage (.717) and rated fifth in defensive rebounds (25.7 rpg).

The year before, SEMO finished its 2017-18 season with an overall record of 14-17 and 8-10 mark in the OVC. The Redhawks were seventh in the league standings, three spots ahead of where they were picked in the preseason poll.

The Redhawks drained a single-season school record 289 three-pointers in Ray's third year as head coach. SEMO made 10 or more 3-pointers in 15 contests and led the OVC with a .392 three-point field goal percentage.

Guards Denzel Mahoney and Ledarrius Brewer represented SEMO on the 2017-18 All-Ohio Valley Conference teams. Mahoney earned first-team honors, while Brewer secured All-Newcomer accolades.

Ray led SEMO to a +10 increase in the win column as the Redhawks were the 22nd Most Improved Team in NCAA Division I Basketball during the 2016-17 season. SEMO finished at 15-18 and second in the OVC West Division with a 9-7 record after going 5-24 and placing last in the league in 2015-16.

SEMO made its 15th all-time OVC Tournament appearance with Ray winning the first game he coached at the event when the Redhawks erased a 14-point deficit to beat Tennessee State in overtime.

Statistically, SEMO made huge strides from the previous season. The Redhawks ranked among the top-five in the OVC in several categories, including steals (1st, 7.7), assist/turnover ratio (5th, 1.1) and 3-point field goals made (5th, 8.0). SEMO made its biggest jump from the 2015-16 season in turnover margin (8th to 1st), 3-point field goal percentage (last to 2nd) and free throw percentage (last to 2nd). Nationally, the Redhawks went from 331st to 49th in free throw percentage and 336th to 59th in total 3-point field goals made, while improving in many other areas during

the 2016-17 campaign.

Additionally, Ray coached a pair of All-OVC selections in guards Antonius Cleveland and Mahoney. Cleveland, who earned first-team honors, became the first SEMO player to make the national College Slam Dunk Championship. Cleveland most recently re-signed with the Dallas Mavericks on a two-way contract with the Texas Legends (NBA G League).

Mahoney was the league's Freshman of the Year, a second-team pick, All-Newcomer selection and OVC All-Tournament Team honoree. It was the first time the Redhawks had multiple All-OVC selections since 2013-14 (Tyler Stone, Jarekious Bradley).

Following the 2016-17 campaign, Ray received a two-year contract extension that runs through the 2020-21 season.

Ray was introduced as the 20th head coach in SEMO men's basketball history on April 13, 2015. He is the first African-American head coach in the 112-year history of the program.

A tireless worker, Ray is structuring his program to achieve success both on the court and in the classroom.

SEMO posted a 3.31 GPA during Summer, 2019. The Redhawks had seven players obtain a 4.0 GPA and 12 achieve a 3.0 or higher mark.

In his first summer on the job, Ray challenged his players to excel academically and they did so by accumulating a 3.38 grade point average, the program's highest in a summer term.

Twelve of the 15 players enrolled in summer classes

posted a 3.0 or higher GPA. To take it even further, Ray convinced other players to remain on campus and finish what they started. As a result, seven players graduated. Nino Johnson, Jarekious Bradley, Darrian Gray and J.J. Thompson, along with former players Corey Wilford, Waylon Jones and Dainmon Gonner all earned their bachelor degrees.

The next summer, the Redhawks recorded a 3.33 GPA with six players achieving a 4.0 and 11 notching a 3.0 or higher GPA.

In Fall, 2017, SEMO's men's basketball team made the biggest improvement of all Redhawk athletic teams from the previous Fall, 2016 semester when it raised its grade point average .613 points to a 3.08. That fall, the basketball team was the only men's sport that registered a 3.0 GPA.

Ray's 2015-16 team was the first to play in a newlyrenovated Show Me Center, which has served as home to Redhawk Basketball since 1987.

One of the best basketball arenas in the OVC, the Show Me Center received a new state-of-the-art center-hung video board, brand new telescopic seating, a new exterior roof and additional improvements to lighting and sound systems. All renovations were completed for the 2015-16 campaign.

Prior to SEMO, Ray spent three seasons as head coach at Mississippi State. He led the Bulldogs to a 2-2 mark in the SEC Tournament, including an upset win against Vanderbilt in 2013-14. Ray helped the development of two All-SEC

freshmen in Craig Sword and Gavin Ware, as his recruiting classes received national attention. In addition, Ray had a 100 percent graduation rate during his tenure at MSU.

Certainly no stranger to NCAA postseason play, Ray has been an assistant at three different institutions that enjoyed success at the highest level.

Before arriving in Starkville, Mississippi, Ray spent two seasons at Clemson, where he was associate head coach to Brad Brownell. Ray also spent four successful years on the staff of Matt Painter at Purdue. He began his Division I coaching career at Indiana State, serving seven seasons.

All three programs participated in the NCAA Tournament. While at Clemson coaching in the highly-competitive Atlantic Coast Conference, the Tigers won 38 games during Ray's two-year stint as associate head coach. In 2010-11, the Tigers finished the year with a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 mark in the ACC en route to making the NCAA Tournament for the fourth-straight season. Clemson advanced to the second round of the tournament that year.

Ray was an assistant coach from 2006-10 under Painter at Purdue, where the Boilermakers won 103 games during his first four years on staff, including 15 victories over Top 25 competition. During his tenure, Purdue advanced to the NCAA Tournament each season and made the Sweet 16 his last two years there.

In 2009, the Boilermakers won the Big Ten Tournament and

secured a No. 5 seed in the NCAA Tournament. A year later, Ray helped the Boilermakers to 29 wins, tied for the most in Purdue history for a single season. Purdue earned a No. 4 seed and lost in the round of 16 to eventual NCAA champion Duke during the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

Ray was part of the 2006-07 Purdue staff that signed arguably the top class in school history, a group that was rated No. 5 nationally by Scout.com and No. 6 by Rivals.com. That class included All-Americans Robbie Hummel and JaJuan Johnson and current NBA player E'Twaun Moore.

While at Purdue, Ray was on Painter's staff that also included Cuonzo Martin (Missouri head coach), and Paul Lusk (former Missouri State head coach).

Ray coached at Missouri Valley Conference member Indiana State for a period of seven years (1997-2004), helping ISU to consecutive 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament appearances in 1999-2000 and 2000-01. In 1999-2000, the Sycamores compiled a 14-4 record in the MVC and won the regular season title. ISU then won the MVC Tournament the following season. The Sycamores later upset No. 4 seed Oklahoma in the first round of the 2001 NCAA Tournament. In addition, Ray was part of the ISU staff that defeated perennial power Indiana in back-to-back

Following his time at ISU, Ray spent two seasons (2004-06) as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Northern

Illinois. In 2005-06, the Huskies were regular season Western Division champions in the Mid-American Conference for the first time in school history with a 17-11 overall record and 12-6 ledger in the MAC.

Ray began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Nebras-ka-Omaha, a Division II program. He helped orchestrate a seven-win turnaround during his second season in 1996-97.

A standout player for Grand View College (Iowa), Ray was an All-American Scholar-Athlete and honorable mention allconference performer in 1993.

He earned his undergraduate

degree in applied mathematics and secondary education from Grand View in 1994. Ray received his master's degree in athletic administration from Nebraska-Omaha in 1997.

Those type of heralded credentials helped Ray make the transition to head coach.

In 2013, he was the recipient of Grand View's Distinguished Alumni Award.

Born in Gardena, California, Ray moved to Kansas City, Kansas with his family when he was six years old.

Ray and his wife, Breyana, have two sons, Deacon and Mason, and a daughter, Katriece.
