OPENING STATEMENT

"Excited that we are going to have another opportunity to play Louisiana. I know it was a tough loss earlier this afternoon, but we're excited about being in Italy Blue tomorrow and getting another opportunity. We got to win two, it's not like we haven't played a doubleheader on a Sunday, it's just nothing new for us. So we're excited about having that opportunity. The team played well today."

OPENING STATEMENT

"We just took the same approach and wanted to come in and obviously win game one and give ourselves a chance to continue on with the day, and we had to kick and scratch there a little bit and fight in that first game. But we got the job done and gave ourselves a chance and that was really kind of the goal on the day, so thats what we wanted to do."

ON GETTING DOWN EARLY VS. OLE MISS

"We knew it was gonna be tough, and sometimes you try some things that can get you a couple innings. We knew our backs were against the wall. I told our players we've been in situations, even last week. And we're playing the home team on their field, so to speak, and still go out there and do the same things we always do and take it one pitch at a time. We tried some things that maybe were a little bit different that they weren't prepared for. Kaylee [Anderson] hasn't pitched a lot for us this year, but we thought maybe keeping the ball down in the zone and some changeups a little bit there for a couple innings maybe would give us a little bit of a chance. We were gonna throw everything at them, including the kitchen sink, and that was our attempt."

ON WHAT THIS SEASON HAS MEANT

"I don't know if I've had a better team, all around, on and off the field, and how great of teammates they are with each other. We told our returning players, we're not gonna be one hit wonders. And they've got a lot of responsibility in trying to continue on with what they've learned and what they've observed with our seniors in what we're trying to develop. They've lifted this program so high."
