Southeast Missouri (1-2) closes out its season-long three-game homestand when it welcomes NAIA affiliate Missouri Baptist (5-3) Monday. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m., CT at the Show Me Center.

Series History

Southeast Missouri and Missouri Baptist square off for the 20th time on the hardwood in a pre-Thanksgiving matchup Monday. SEMO is a perfect 19-0 against MBU and last met the Spartans on Dec. 29, 2019. This year marks the sixth-straight game between the teams in Cape Girardeau. The Redhawks are 14-0 against MBU at the Show Me Center.

Against Non-Division I

Missouri Baptist is the only non-Division I opponent on Southeast Missouri's 31-game schedule this season. SEMO has a 30-game winning streak against non-Division I foes. The Redhawks ran their winning streak to 30 games with a 74-59 victory over Missouri Baptist on Dec. 29, 2019.

Monday Double Feature

Southeast Missouri's only non-conference basketball doubleheader of the season is Monday. SEMO's women's team hosts Arkansas State at 5 p.m., CT with the men hosting Missouri Baptist at 7 p.m. on the backend of the doubleheader.

Reed, Jr. Starts Strong

Guard Eric Reed, Jr. led Southeast Missouri in scoring in each of his first three starts this season. Reed, Jr. leads the Redhawks and ranks fourth in the Ohio Valley Conference with 17 points a game. He leads the team with 18-of-21 free throws for a 85.7 percent clip and is averaging a league-best 33.3 minutes per contest. He scored double figures in four-straight games dating back to last season.

Freshman Power

Freshman point guard Phillip Russell dropped in a season-high 13 points vs. Arkansas State (Nov. 19). Russell made three field goals and a near-perfect 5-of-6 free throws en route to his second double-digit scoring game in three starts.

Redhawks Get First Loss of the Season

Southeast Missouri fell victim to a big second half run and couldn't recover in a 97-79 loss to Youngstown State in its home-opener on Nov. 13. SEMO held a 39-37 lead at halftime, but things quickly slipped away from the Redhawks in the final 20 minutes. YSU went on a 15-0 run to build a 17-point advantage (69-52) and led by as many as 24 en route to its win. SEMO dropped to 23-8 all-time in

preferred reference for Southeast Missouri State University athletic teams. Southeastern Missouri State is not an acceptable reference. its home-openers since moving to the NCAA Division I ranks in 1991-92.

Looking to Bounce Back

Southeast Missouri is looking to end a two-game losing streak after dropping back-to-back home games by double figures. SEMO fell to Youngstown State, 97-79, on Nov. 13 and lost to Arkansas State, 72-60, six days later (Nov. 19).

Free Throws for Everyone

The Redhawks shot 69 free throws for an average of 34.5 per game in their first two games this season. Southeast Missouri made 27-of-34 free throws at Missouri State (Nov. 9) and 25-of-35 vs. Youngstown State (Nov. 13). SEMO is currently second in the Ohio Valley Conference in free throw percentage with a 73.9 percent clip (65-of-88). Only SIU Edwardsville has shot more free throws (113) than SEMO in the OVC.

About Missouri Baptist

NAIA and American Midwest Conference member Missouri Baptist comes to Cape Girardeau at 5-3 overall. The Spartans won three of their last four contests and are led by RJ Pair's 12.7 points a game. Pair is one of three MBU players averaging double figures. Brandon Hardy (11.5 ppg) and John Yaeger (10.4 ppg) are the others. Monday's game against Southeast Missouri is an exhibition matchup for the Spartans.

Nice Improvement

If there is one statistical area Southeast Missouri wants to improve this season, it's turnovers. SEMO committed 415 turnovers for an average of 15.4 per game in 2020-21. Through three games this year, the Redhawks have turned the ball over 33 times. As a result, rank 27th in the nation in fewest turnovers.

First Double-Double

Nygal Russell recorded the first double-double of his career when he finished with 11 points and 11 rebounds in 25 minutes off the bench against Youngstown State (Nov. 13). Russell and Nana Akenten are the only Redhawks on this year's roster currently with at least one double-double in their careers.

Season-Opening Win

The Redhawks tipped off their 2021-22 campaign with a big 99-94 road win at Missouri Valley Conference foe Missouri State (Nov. 9). Southeast Missouri won a season-opener on the road in back-to-back years for the first time in its NCAA Division I history. With a win Saturday, SEMO will start a season at 2-0 for the first time in 18 years. The Redhawks last 2-0 start was in 2003-04 and involved a win against a Horizon League team (63-62, vs. Green Bay).

High Scoring Affair

Southeast Missouri (99) and Missouri State (94) combined for 193 points in their season-opening slugfest on Nov. 9. The 99 points marked SEMO's most in a season-opener since it scored 120 in a win over Missouri Baptist on Nov. 19, 1990. Both the Redhawks and Bears also combined to shoot 69 free throws. SEMO made 27-of-34 and MSU hit 25-of-35.

Three-Game Homestand

The Redhawks wrap up a season-long threegame homestand against Missouri Baptist Monday. SEMO is 0-2 during the homestand following a 97-79 loss to Youngstown State (Nov. 13) and 72-60 setback against Arkansas State (Nov. 19).

Redhawks at Home

Southeast Missouri is 7-8 at home under Head Coach Brad Korn. Last year's 7-6 mark was SEMO's first home winning record in four seasons.

Reed, Jr. Leads the Way

Eric Reed, Jr. scored 21 points and nailed a huge 3-pointer with 11 seconds left to lead Southeast Missouri to its 99-94 season-opening victory over Missouri State (Nov. 9). Reed, Jr. shot 6-of-13 from the field and did not miss a free throw (7-of-7) in 35 minutes. It was the fourth 20-point game of his career.

Balanced Attack

At least four players scored in double figures during each of Southeast Missouri's first two games of the season. Eric Reed, Jr. and Nygal Russell scored double-digits in both of those contests

Keep Up the Good Work

The Redhawks have won five of their last nine games dating back to the end of the 2020-21 season. Southeast Missouri scored 86 or more points in four of those contests.

Nice Shooting

Southeast Missouri shot 57.1 percent (32-of-56) from the field against Missouri State (Nov. 9). Ten of the 11 Redhawks who played scored at least three points. The .571 field goal percentage marked SEMO's best in 23 years. The Redhawks last shot over 57 percent from the field in a season-opener vs. Western Carolina on Nov. 19, 1999. SEMO made 60 percent (36-of-60) of its field goals in that game. The .571 field goal percentage is the Redhawks highest in non-conference play under Head Coach Brad Korn.

Knocking Them Down

The Redhawks made 27-of-34 free throws for just under 80 percent (794) against Missouri State (Nov. 9). Southeast Missouri made 21-of-26 free throws in the second half alone. Nine players went to the free throw line for SEMO. Eric Reed, Jr. and Manny Patterson each made a perfect 7-of-7 free throws to lead the way.

First Career Starts

Freshmen Phillip Russell and Sam Thompson made their first career starts at Missouri State (Nov. 9). Russell had three points, three rebounds and two assists in 25 minutes at point guard, while Thompson scored five points in 10 minutes of action.

Second Half Manny

Forward Manny Patterson scored 11 points and added a team-high seven rebounds, all in the second half against Missouri State (Nov. 9). Patterson scored seven of those points at the free throw line where he did not miss (7-of-7). It was the fourth time he finished with double-digit points in his career.

Season 115

The Redhawks are in their 115th season of basketball. This year is Southeast Missouri's 31st as an NCAA Division I program. The Redhawks are 355-523 since joining the Division I ranks in 1991-92. SEMO has a total of eight winning seasons as an NCAA Division I program with its last coming in 2013-14 (18-14).

Mr. Experience

Guard Nygal Russell is Southeast Missouri's most experienced player on this year's roster. Russell has played in a total of 89 games and logged 23 starts in his career. He is in his fourth year with the Redhawks and averages 5.4 points and 3.3 rebounds per game for his career.

Redhawks Tabbed Fourth in OVC Preseason Poll

Southeast Missouri, after being picked to finish no higher than ninth in the Ohio Valley Conference Preseason Poll each of the last five seasons, was selected fourth in 2021-22. The Redhawks tallied 101 points in the overall voting by OVC Head Basketball Coaches and Communication Directors. The Redhawks achieved their highest OVC preseason ranking in seven years. SEMO was selected third overall (second in the West) ahead of the 2014-15 campaign when the conference was split in divisions. Belmont is this year's preseason favorite after garnering 161 points and all but three of the first-place votes. Morehead State, which represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament last season, collected 141 points and three first-place nods, while Murray State (136 pts.) took third. Tennessee State (84 pts.), Austin Peay (76

pts.), SIU Edwardsville (65 pts.), Tennessee Tech (62 pts.), Eastern Illinois (43 pts.) and UT Martin (34 pts.) complete the 10-team preseason poll.

Harris Garners OVC Preseason Honors

Guard Chris Harris earned Preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference honors for the first time in his career. Harris returns as the team's top scorer. One of five returning starters, Harris averaged 12.3 points per game in 26 starts a year ago. He led the Redhawks in assists (88) and minutes played (30.2 per game), while ranking fourth in steals (25), third in 3-point field goals made (38) and second in free throw percentage (.735). Harris scored double figures in 18 of his starts. Belmont guard Grayson Murphy and Morehead State forward Johni Broome shared the OVC Preseason Player of the Year honor.

Big Step Forward

In Brad Korn's first season as head coach in 2020-21, Southeast Missouri made the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament for the first time in four years. The Redhawks finished with an overall record of 11-16 and seventh in the league with a 9-11 mark. SEMO saw a +4 improvement in total wins and a +6 jump in OVC victories from the 2019-20 campaign. The Redhawks' nine conference wins matched their most in a season in 20 years.

Roster Talk

Southeast Missouri's 14-man roster consists of players from eight different states (Missouri, Florida, Geogia, Illinois, Louisiana, Nebraska, Texas, Wisconsin). SEMO has 10 returning players, including all five of its starters from 2020-21. Four freshmen (Phillip Russell, Adam Larson, Chase Thompson, Sam Thompson) complete this year's roster.

Top Scorers

Southeast Missouri brings back its top five scorers from last season in Chris Harris (12.3 ppg), Eric Reed, Jr. (11 ppg), Nana Akenten (9.3 ppg), DQ Nicholas (8.8 ppg) and Nolan Taylor (8.8 ppg). Reed, Jr. is the Redhawks top 3-point shooter after draining a team-high 61 in 27 games and 22 starts. He led the Ohio Valley Conference with a .459 (61-of-133) three-point field goal percentage.

Welcome Back

St. Louis native Phillip Russell is back with Southeast Missouri this season. Russell initially signed with the Redhawks out of high school, but decommitted and went to Saint Louis University as a walk-on. He saw action in eight games off the bench and averaged 2.1 points per contest with the Billikens. Prior to that, he helped lead Vashon High School to a state title. Russell will make his first career start as SEMO's point guard at Missouri State Tuesday.

2021-22 Preview

Backcourt

SEMO has a talented tandem at point guard in DQ Nicholas (Atlanta, Ga.) and Phillip Russell (St. Louis, Mo.). Nicholas was the only player who started all 27 games last season. He ranked fourth on the team in scoring (8.8 ppg) and second in both assists (86) and steals (30). Nicholas scored double figures on 12 occasions, as well, Russell, who initially signed with SEMO out of high school, instead decommitted and spent the 2020-21 campaign as a walk-on at Saint Louis. He played in eight games off the bench and averaged 2.1 points per contest with the Billikens before re-joining the Redhawks. Both Nicholas and Russell complement each other well and are a tough two-headed monster at the point.

Perimeter

The Redhawks bring back their top two scoring threats on the perimeter. SEMO's top 3-point shooter, Eric Reed, Jr. (Baton Rouge, La.), was a pleasant surprise as a newcomer in 2020-21. In his first year of NCAA Division I basketball, Reed, Jr. led the team and ranked first in the OVC in both 3-point field goals made (61) and 3-point field goal percentage (.459). He ranked second on the team with 11 points per game as one of two Redhawks averaging double figures in the scoring column. Reed, Jr.'s .459 three-point field goal percentage was good for fifth among the school's all-time single-season leaders Opposite Reed, Jr. at the three-quard position is Chris Harris (Antioch, III.). Harris earned Preseason All-OVC accolades after putting together a year that saw him lead SEMO in scoring (12.3 ppg), minutes (30.2 mpg), assists (88) and free throws made (97). He started 26 games and rated 10th among league leaders in assist/turnover ratio. All of Harris' success in 2020-21 came after he recovered from a knee injury that limited him to only two games the year before. Nana Akenten (Bolingbrook, III.), Nygal Russell (Houston, Texas), Dylan Branson (St. Louis, Mo.) and Parker Long (Sikeston, Mo.) are the rest of the returning perimeter players. Akenten started 24 of 27 games and led the Redhawks in rebounds per game (5.8) and steals (34), while ranking third on the team in scoring with 9.3 points per contest. His .744 free throw percentage was the best among SEMO starters last season Similar to Akenten is Russell, who stretches the perimeter depth. In his fourth year at SEMO, Russell is the most experienced player on the 2021-22 roster. He played in 27 games and made seven starts, averaging 3.9 points and four rebounds last season. Branson, who played strictly at the four spot as a true freshman last season, can play either of the one, two, three or four positions. He appeared in 25 games, while averaging three points and 2.4 rebounds per game a year ago. Long was ruled eligible to play by the NCAA in mid-January of 2020-21 and played in 15 games, all off the bench. Rounding out the perimeter is newcomer Adam Larson (Fennimore, Wis.). Larson joins the Redhawks from Fennimore High School, where he polished off his prep career averaging a double-double 24.2 points and 10.4 rebounds.

Frontcourt

SEMO's frontcourt will be centered around Manny Patterson (Chicago, III.), Nate Johnson (Broward County, Fla.) and Sam Thompson (St. Charles, Mo.). Patterson started 12 of the 22 games he played during his first year in a Redhawk uniform last season. He shot 50.6 percent (44-of-87) from the field and led the team with 19 blocks. Patterson ended the year with an average of 5.5 points and 2.8 rebounds a game. Johnson is presently out with a knee injury and is expected to return when the Redhawks head to the Incarnate Word Tournament during Thanksgiving week (Nov. 26-28). He contributed 2.6 points and 2.1 rebounds in nine minutes per game last season. Expected to make an immediate impact underneath is Thompson. Thompson led Francis Howell High School with 18.4 points and 8.4 rebounds as a senior. He gathered a team-high 49 blocks for an average of 2.6 per

game. Nolan Taylor (Keller, Texas) and Chase Thompson (Omaha, Neb.) complete the squad. Taylor, who has dealt with a lingering knee injury during his time at SEMO, played in 18 games and made 15 starts in 2020-21. He tied for fourth on the team in scoring with 8.8 points per game and rated third on the team with 4.1 boards per contest. Thompson enters his first year of NCAA Division I basketball after transferring from Western Nebraska Community College. There, he was WNCC's top scorer with 19.4 points per game in 2019-20. Thompson shot 48 percent from the field and 34 percent from 3-point range that season.

2021-22 Schedule

A 31-game schedule with 14 matchups at the Show Me Center is in store for the Southeast Missouri men's basketball team this 2021-22 season. SEMO tips off its season against instate foe Missouri State on Nov. 3. This year marks the 147th meeting between the schools The Redhawks non-conference home slate features games against Youngstown State (Nov. 13), Arkansas State (Nov. 19), Missouri Baptist (Nov. 23), Webster University (Dec. 4) and Evansville (Dec. 8). SEMO will travel to San Antonio, Texas for a tournament at Incarnate Word University over Thanksgiving weekend. The Redhawks face Portland (Nov. 26), host Incarnate Word (Nov. 27) and Montana State (Nov. 28) as part of the four-team event. The Redhawks close out non-league action on a four-game road stretch with trips to Purdue Fort Wayne (Dec. 11), Southern Illinois (Sept. 15), Pepperdine (Dec. 18) and California Baptist (Dec. 21). Longtime rivals SEMO and SIU hook up for the 118th time on the hardwood. SEMO remains on the road for the start of Ohio Valley Conference play which begins with a visit to rival Murray State (Dec. 30). Two days later, Austin Peay (Jan. 1) comes to Cape Girardeau for the Redhawks OVC homeopener on New Year's Day. The Redhawks also host Tennessee Tech (Jan. 13). Tennessee State (Jan. 20), Morehead State (Jan. 27), SIU Edwardsville (Jan. 29), Eastern Illinois (Feb. 5). Belmont (Feb. 12). UT Martin (Feb. 24) and Murray State (Feb. 26) in home OVC play. Trips to Belmont (Jan. 6), Tennessee State (Jan. 8), SIU Edwardsville (Jan. 15), Eastern Illinois (Jan. 22), UT Martin (Feb. 3), Austin Peay (Feb. 10), Tennessee Tech (Feb. 17) and

Morehead State (Feb. 19) complete SEMO's 18-game conference schedule. The 2022 OVC Tournament will be held at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana on Mar. 2-5. This is the fifthstraight year the tournament will be played in that venue.

Home Game vs. Morehead State will Air on ESPNU

Southeast Missouri's home game against Morehead State will air on ESPNU as part of the 2021-22 ESPN Basketball Television Package. That matchup is set for Thursday, January 27. Tip-off is set for 7 p.m., CT at the Show Me Center. This year's slate of Conference basketball games across ESPN networks includes nine total men's basketball games (six regular season contests and three OVC Tournament games) that will appear on one of the linear networks during the season. Four of the regular season matchups and the OVC Tournament semifinals will air on ESPNU, two games will be televised on ESPNews and the OVC Tournament championship game will air on ESPN2.



Pand Korn began his first head coaching job at Southeast Missouri in the middle of a global COVID-19 pandemic.

Throughout all the challenges and uncertainties during an unprecedented 2020-21 campaign, Korn' led his first SEMO team to an overall record of 11-16 and seventh-place finish in the Ohio Valley Conference.

The Redhawks made the OVC Tournament for the first time since 2016-17 and saw a +4 improvement in total wins and a +6 jump in OVC victories from the year before. SEMO's nine (9-11) conference victories matched the program's most in a season in 20 years.

Statistically, SEMO ranked among the top five in the OVC in 3-point field goal percentage (5th, .352), rebounding margin (5th, +2.2), defensive rebounds (5th, 25.6 per game) and defensive rebound percentage (1st, .764).

Korn was officially introduced as SEMO's head coach on Mar. 23, 2020. He is the seventh head coach in SEMO's NCAA Division I era (since 1991-92).

Prior to arriving in Cape
Girardeau, Korn spent five years
at Big 12 Conference member
Kansas State working
the four seasons as an
assistant coach and one as
the program's Director of
Operations.

In his final four years back at K-State after returning following a three-year stint at Missouri State (2013-16), Korn helped the Wildcats to 82 wins and threestraight NCAA Tournament appearances. K-State posted back-to-back 25-win campaigns for the first time in school history (2017-18, 2018-19).

During his first year back in 2016-17, the squad won 21 games, including eight over teams that advanced to the postseason, and knocked off Wake Forest in the NCAA First Four before losing to #18 Cincinnati in the NCAA South Regional First Round.

Working primarily with the post players, Korn was a big influence on the development of two-time All-Big 12 First
Team selection Dean Wade, who became the fourth Wildcat to earn All-Big 12 First-Team honors in 2018 and just the second to do so in back-toback seasons. Wade is one of just three players to rank in the school's Top 10 in both career scoring (1,510) and rebounding (685). He was instrumental in

the progress of Makol Mawien, who has started all 103 games in his K-State career and emerged as one of the top big men in the Big 12.

Korn was also key in the growth of All-Big 12 selections Wesley Iwundu and D.J. Johnson during his first season as an assistant coach in 2016-17. Iwundu, who was twice named Third Team All-Big 12, became the first Wildcat since 2008 to be taken in the NBA Draft when he was selected with 33rd overall pick by the Orlando Magic. Johnson, an honorable mention all-league selection, broke the career field goal percentage record at 59.5 percent, while setting the single-season mark for the second consecutive season at 62.3 percent in 2016-17.

Korn spent one season

on Bruce Weber's inaugural staff at K-State as Director of Operations in 2012-13, helping the Wildcats to a 27-8 overall record and their first-ever Big 12 regular-season title. It was the school's first conference title since 1977, while the 27 wins rated second-most in school history.

Overall, he has 15 years of
Division I experience, which
includes time at his alma mater
– Southern Illinois (2004-12).
Korn has extensive ties to
Weber after playing his first four
years (1999-2003) for him at
Southern Illinois. He redshirted
in 1999-2000 before playing the
next three years for Weber. He
concluded his playing career for
(current Purdue head coach)
Matt Painter in 2003-04 before

spending the next eight years (2004-12) at SIU as an assistant for then-Saluki head coach and current K-State associate head coach Chris Lowery.

Korn returned to Manhattan in May 2016 after three seasons at Missouri State, where he served as an assistant coach to then-head coach Paul Lusk from 2013-16. At MSU, he helped the Bears to 44 wins, including a 20 -win season and a trip to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament in 2013-14.

Korn helped mentor a number of All-Missouri Valley honorees during his stay at Missouri State, including 2014 All-MVC Second-Team selection Jarmar Gulley and 2016 MVC Newcomer of the Year Dequon Miller. In addition, he coached three MVC

All-Freshman Team honorees in Austin Ruder in 2014 and Obediah Church and Jarred Dixon in 2016 as well as two Most Improved Team members (Dorrian Williams in 2015 and Chris Kendrix in 2016).

Prior to his first stint at K-State, Korn spent eight years (2004-12) at Southern Illinois, including his final six years as a full-time assistant under Lowery. He helped the Salukis post a 145-116 (.556) overall record with four postseason appearances, two Missouri Valley Conference championships and one State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament title. The squad won 20 or more games and advanced to the NCAA Tournament on three occasions (2005, 2006, 2007) during his tenure as an assistant coach, including a 2007 trip to the Sweet 16. He was a graduate assistant at SIU his first two vears before being elevated to a full-time assistant coach on Jan. 31, 2006.

A native of Plano, Illinois, Korn helped the Salukis through one of their greatest periods of success from 1999 to 2004. The squad went from 16 wins his redshirt-freshman season to three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances under Weber and Painter. He was also a part of three Missouri Valley regular season championships as a player.

The 6-foot-9 forward saw action in 121 games in his career, averaging 5.2 points and 2.3 rebounds in 14.5 minutes per game. As a senior, he averaged

9.7 points on 41 percent shooting with four rebounds and 1.9 assists in helping SIU to 25 wins and a 17-1 mark in MVC play. He was named to the league's Most Improved Team.

Korn earned a bachelor's degree in Marketing from Southern Illinois in 2004 and his master's degree in Administrative Studies from Missouri State in 2016. He resides in Cape Girardeau with his wife, Kristin, and daughters Brielyn and Ashtyn.
